My name is Robert Cunningham, I was born in the US, but I lived most of my life in Canada. I'm part of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) Community. My wife is Carina Mendez, she is from Uruguay, South America and we have been together for 4 years.

I'm creating this fundraiser because Carolina and Ximena are close to my wife, Carina. She worked with them translating the content of High Noon to Portuguese. These amazing sisters have the heart to dedicate their time and effort to their beloved brothers and sisters in our FFWPU community. Their motivation: Bring support to their brothers and sisters in Brazil.

Sadly, on January 10th Carolina and Ximena were attacked by a man with a knife in their apartment. This man was their neighbor, and that is why they opened the door to him. Ximena trying to protect her older sister from the man's attack received the most direct hits, which cost her life. Carolina is in the hospital with injuries to the head, neck, and ear. She is stable, and her life is not at risk.

It's been extremely painful to receive this news. Ximena, at 22, has gone to heaven. Her life and heart have been so connected to living for others that she will forever be an inspiration for all of us, but there are no words to describe her loss. Carolina, 24 years old, has lost the closest person to her. Her younger sister, with whom she did everything together. Now Carolina needs to re-establish her life in some way. And I cannot even imagine the pain that her parents, Fernando Muñoz y María Aparecida Ferreira, are going through.

This fundraiser is to help Carolina heal. She will not be able to work for the next months, so we want to help her cover her living expenses for at least the next 6-months, pay for her therapy, and the medical treatments she needs for her full recovery.


