

WFWP Albania - Int'l Women's Day: Rights - Respect - Action For Each Woman and Girl

On March 6, 2026, the Albanian Women's Federation for Peace, in partnership with the Universal Peace Federation, organized an event at the Peace Embassy on the occasion of International Women's Day, under the theme: "Rights - Respect - Action! For Each Woman and Girl." Approximately 105 women and girls participated in the event, representing various fields of society and sharing messages promoting equality, respect, and the empowerment of women.



Greetings were conveyed by Mr. Defrim Methasani, Chairman of the Universal Peace Federation Albania, as well as Mrs. Katerina Minolari. She also emphasized the principles of a Peace Ambassador and the values and responsibilities this role represents within the community. During the event, 11 new Peace Ambassadors were appointed, including both experienced academics and young female activists.

The event was moderated by Mrs. Lili Doda, a winner of one of the previous speech competitions, together with Mr. Bledar Peçaku.

The program was enriched with artistic performances by Mrs. Violeta Mita, who recited a poem; Albana Bajraktari, and Jeric Gavaran, who performed a song each; as well as instrumental performances by Riad and Roan Dedić, music students from Durres.

Representatives from the Public Vocational Training Center No. 4 also attended the event, advertising educational opportunities of their institution.
