Dr. Lan-young Moon and her husband Dr. No-hi Pak visit Poland

Warsaw, Poland, 12. - 14. July 2014



Special Emissary Dr. Lan-young Moon together with her husband Dr. No-hi Pak arrived in Warsaw at 10.20. After arriving in the Peace Embassy and lunch, we started our first meeting at 2.00 p.m.

At the first gathering Dr. Moon introduced herself and her husband and explained the mission she received from True Mother directly. One part, as we understood, is to convey the love of True Parents directly to all brothers and sisters in East Europe, the other could be described more like a “fact finding tour”. Our True Mother wants to know and understand better the foundation each nation has, also the situation of Blessed Families etc. Brother and sisters were able to share their personal situation and the situation in their mission field. We had a very open and honest sharing. This was supported by the deep parental heart and empathy from Dr. Moon and Dr. Pak.

Days before, some brothers and sisters had offered their help to prepare the Peace Embassy and create a beautiful environment for our guests. On that evening our kitchen staff offered a delicious Korean dinner which everybody enjoyed. The sharing

continued until late evening and we all felt nurtured by the love of God.

On the next day, Sunday, Dr. Moon was speaking in the Sunday Service by giving her personal testimony. Dr. Moon joined the Unification Church 1955. She joined as a 13 year old girl together with her mother and was ever since personally educated by True Parents, especially by True Father. She showed her love and filial piety to True Parents throughout her 60 years of membership in many challenging missions and situations, among them many visits to North Korea during the last years as International President of the WFWPU.

The Sunday Service started with a tearful prayer of repentance from the members and the introduction of Dr. Moon and Dr. Pak by the National Leader Martha Kral. After the service we had planned to invite our Special Emissary to a Korean restaurant, but brothers and sisters felt so deeply connected to this beautiful blessed couple, that Mrs. Moon and Mr. Pak just had to go back to the dining room, sharing with them a simple but tasty meal. Eating lunch together, sitting on one big table, brothers and sisters could experience a natural giving heart for everyone and for every question. Later Mrs. Moon

was singing the song “You raised me up” under tears. She told us that she has sang this song many times for True Father, because he literally raised her up. A second beautiful Korean song together with her husband was offered. I felt how everybody was moved and at the end Polish brothers and sisters also offered two beautiful Polish songs with full heart and enthusiastic voice. A warm family atmosphere was created, like in “old days” and some of them expressed later on how much they felt touched by Mrs. Moon’s and her Mr. Pak’s warm and loving heart.

In the afternoon we went for sightseeing to downtown of Warsaw, where we had some coffee and ice cream in a historical coffee shop.

The last day, Monday morning, we had a closing meeting to make a summary of the main topics we had shared and also to find the connection to Vision 2020 cherished by our True Mother so dearly.

As we brought our dear guests to the airport, we felt sorry that the time was flowing so fast and their visit seemed too short for us.

In spite of their age, Dr. Lan-young Moon and Dr. No-hi Pak invested all their energy and heart in Poland and we were honestly moved by their sincere dedication for God’s will.
