UPF Norway organized a Nordic seminar in Oslo on Saturday, 12th November, under «Principles on Peace».



We chose to dedicate the event to the «International Day of Tolerance» which was coming up only four days later. On the «International Day of Tolerance» it is relevant to address issues like discrimination,

racism etc.

However, our presentations addressed the topic from a different and more fundamental perspective. Our perspective focused on the fact that we all belong to one universal family, one family under God, across our national or religious backgrounds.
