

The Heart of the True Parents

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Today, we are very happy to have the True Parents in this world and, especially, not only have we lived at the same time with the True Parents, but also, we are those who have been loved directly by the True Parents.

True, the True Parents love the whole of humanity, this is why they are the True Parents of humankind. However, we know that humankind can be subdivided into many different categories: Those who believe in the True Parents, those who reject the True Parents, those who don't know of the True Parents, etc.

In general, humankind is comprised of children of the True Parents. Most of these children are Cain type children while, in comparison, a minuscule percentage of these children is that of Abel type children. It is common knowledge in the Unification Movement that the membership at large constitutes the Cain type children of the True Parents whereas the biological children of the True Parents constitute the Abel type children. The reality of the True Parents is that they are in a position of not privileging their biological children over their spiritual children—Church members.

The biological children of the True Parents grew up with the awareness that most of their parents' love was directed toward Church members. Now that the True Children are of age, they probably have hoped that they would directly receive their parents' love instead of continuing to be kind of like an afterthought.

Have we ever thought as to how difficult it is for the True Parents that they cannot express their parental love to their children the way every parent would like to do it? Because of their position and responsibilities in the providence of restoration, the True Parents have found themselves in a position in which they are constrained, limited in expressing their parental love to their biological children. Only the Cain type children can liberate the True Parents from that position. Have we ever thought about that? Have we ever thought that we can prevent the rifts that are taking place in the True Family if we liberate the True Parents from the prison of love in which the reality of restoration has confined them? Instead of judging and criticizing the True Children and their predicaments, why don't we judge and criticize ourselves and our predicaments? Instead of pointing out the True Children's immaturity, why don't we evaluate our own level of maturity? We have to free the True Parents so that they can freely love their biological children—the Abel type children. Can we really look at True Mother and say that she is happy?

The problem is not with the True Parents, but with the children. It is not necessarily with the True Children either. It is mainly with the Cain type children of the True Parents—the members. And by members, the focus is on leaders who hold key providential responsibilities around the True Parents. (Yes, I said it.)

How far are we going to take this? We first did this with True Father when he was on this earth. For a

long time, True Father was in the position in which he could not defend his biological children. It was only until within the last decade of his physical life that True Father started to substantially promote his biological children in prominent providential positions. Why are we still playing the same fallen game with True Mother? Do we understand the heart of the True Parents? Can we liberate the heart of the True Parents through True Mother if we continue to carry as if we are perfect and don't need to change anything? Can we fulfill Vision2020 if we continue to carry on this way?

What is happening is that the Cain type children, mainly the First Generation, have become an obstacle in the relationship between the True Parents and the True Children. In actuality, the First Generation ought to serve as the catalyst that opens the way allowing the True Parents to freely express their parental love to their biological children, thus strengthening the bonds of an ideal family. We ought to liberate the True Parents. We still have a chance to do it while True Mother is still physically alive.

The providence has reached a level at which it is not only up to the True Parents alone, but it is also up to us as to how fast we want the providence to move. Have you ever noticed that the providence has started creeping up since the 1980s? Think about this: When was the first time True Father declared that he had accomplished his individual mission? How much have we supported the True Parents since then? By "supporting the True Parents" I mean how much have we worked with the True Parents? Yes, we have been following them, but have we **really** worked with them? How much of our responsibilities have we fulfilled alongside what the True Parents have fulfilled?

The True Parents liberated God so that God could stand as *The* God, the Creator of the universe, a position that God never enjoyed since He created. They liberated Jesus so that he could stand as the first son of God without resentment and regret for having not done everything that he wanted to do for God and His ideal. Shouldn't the providence have moved forward faster after that? Why didn't it? It didn't because we, the Cain type children of the True Parents, the members for whom the True Parents sacrificed their biological children, did not reconcile the foundation upon which the True Parents could freely express their parental love to their biological children. This is the liberation I am talking about. We basically repeated what the Archangel Lucifer did in the Garden of Eden.

Some of the Cain type children of the True Parents have mostly, if not only, cared about their own wellbeing and the wellbeing of their families that they lost their sensitivity to the essential aspects of the providence. We all learned the Divine Principle. So we know what led Lucifer to fall. What are we doing? How far are we going to keep this up? Did the True Children who have separated from the True Parents do so because they hated their parents? Did they? Or was it because they felt obstructed?
