We are pleased to announce the establishment of the Youth Department Organising Committee, which officially began its work this summer to lay the groundwork for an inspiring continental Youth Department for FFWPU Europe and the Middle East by spring 2026.

True Mother has continually expressed her love and desire for youth to become like "pure water"; she spoke about the pure water generations in her proclamation at the Cheon II Sanctum Entrance Ceremony in April and said this in Munich last year:

You, who are Pure Water, should become the central figures in the work of national restoration and world restoration that your Wang Omma is carrying out, by establishing the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth where we can all attend Heavenly Parent in our homes, families, churches, and nations.

In line with True Mother's desire, continental Youth Departments were established around the world to strengthen youth activities. This initiative was first pioneered in our region by Bogdan and Yoshiko Pammer, former Vice Presidents of FFWPU EUME, whose dedication and heart laid the foundation for this work. As they moved on to a new mission, three couples from the former EUME Vice Presidents' team formed the Organising Committee to carry this effort forward.

The Organising Committee is working to establish a strong, functional Youth Department within the structure of FFWPU Europe and the Middle East. The department will design and implement strategies and structures for continental-level youth activities and programs, including:

- Providing an environment where youth can grow spiritually and freely share their hearts,
 ideas, and visions for the future of the providence.
- Overseeing continental youth activities of the HyoJeong Youth Academy, including EMPOWER, the Foundations program, the HJ Pilgrimage to Korea, and other related initiatives.
- Organising continental youth assemblies and programs focused on empowerment and development.
- Identifying what the youth of EUME need to develop healthy lives of faith and support those efforts.
- Serving as a focal point representing the youth of EUME and liaise with FFWPU World Mission Headquarters.

As the Youth Department begins to take shape, we warmly invite all members – youth, elders, parents, and national leaders – to share their ideas and perspectives. The Youth Department aims to foster a culture of openness and dialogue, where everyone feels valued and heard as we build together. Your honest input is vital in shaping the department from the very beginning.
