1. About 90% of boys and 70% of girls, ages 13 to 14, have reported accessing porn at least once.
2. 35% of boys reported viewing porn online “too many times to count.”
3. 70% of boys and nearly a quarter of girls say they have spent at least 30 consecutive minutes viewing Internet porn on at least one occasion.
4. 30% of 17-year-olds have received a sext.
5. 60% of teens in the UK say they have been asked for an explicit photo or video of themselves.
6. 22% of young adults aged 18-24 consider porn to be good for society, and 8% of that age group actually think it is “very good for society”.
7. When used to prioritize what people consider immoral, teens and young adults consider “not recycling” to be more immoral than viewing pornography.

These stats are already outdated. From 1998 to 2007, the number of pornographic websites grew by 1,800%. That was 10 years ago. The more technology advances the easier it is to access porn.

“Don't Talk to Strangers” isn't enough anymore

The darkest side of it is that the porn industry actually targets children. Why? Because porn is addictive, and the younger someone gets addicted the harder it is to overcome. Internet porn actually rewires the brain, and causes the user to need increasing levels of stimulation over time to get the same effect.



Almost all porn is violent, aggressive and abusive in some way. It changes the user's beliefs about love and sex. This makes the world a very unsafe place, especially for women and children. Porn also feeds the sex slave trade, both in the USA and internationally.
