Biblical Clues to Why We Sin.

- ⌚ Then said Jesus to those Jews which **believed** on him, “If you continue in my word, then are you my disciples indeed; and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”
- ⌚ They answered him, “We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest thou, You shall be made free?”

Biblical Clues to Why We Sin.

⌘ ... Jesus answered them, “Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever commits sin is the servant of sin and the servant abides not in the house for ever: but the Son abides ever. If the Son therefore shall make you free, you shall be free indeed. ... I speak that which I have seen with my Father: and you do that which you have seen with your father ”

Biblical Clues to Why We Sin.

- ⌚ They answered and said unto him, “Abraham is our father.”
- ⌚ Jesus says to them, “If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham. You do the deeds of your father.”
- ⌚ Then said they to him, “We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God.”

Biblical Clues to Why We Sin.

⌘ Jesus said unto them, “If God were your Father, you would love me: for I proceeded forth & came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me. Why do you not understand my speech? Even because you cannot hear my word.

Biblical Clues to Why We Sin.

⌚ You are of your father the devil !

⌚ and the lusts of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, & abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.” John 8:31-44

⌘ The Crime of the Angel Exposition of the Divine Principle
P 58-60

⌘ The angels that did not keep their own position but left their proper dwelling have been kept by him in eternal chains in the nether gloom until the judgment of the great day; just as Sodom and Gomorrah & the surrounding cities that likewise acted immorally & indulged in unnatural lust serve as an example by undergoing a

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

- ⌘ From this passage we can infer that the angel fell as a result of an illicit sexual relationship.
- ⌘ Fornication is a crime which cannot be committed alone. With whom did the angel commit the illicit sexual act in the Garden of Eden? In order to unveil this mystery, let us examine what kind of sin the human beings committed.

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

⌘ The Crime of the Human Beings Divine Principle P 58-60

⌘ Before they fell, Adam & Eve were both naked & were not ashamed. (Gen. 2:25) After the Fall they felt ashamed of their nakedness & sewed fig leaves into aprons to cover their lower parts. (Gen. 3:7) If they had committed a crime by eating some actual fruit from a tree then they certainly would have covered their hands or mouths instead. It is human nature to conceal one's faults. Thus, the act of covering their lower parts shows that these parts, and not their mouths, was the source of their shame. Adam and Eve's sexual parts were the source of their shame

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

∞ In the world before the human Fall, what act would one be willing to carry out even at the clear risk of one's life? It could be nothing else but the act of love. God's purpose of creation, described in the blessings "be fruitful and multiply," (Gen. 1:28) can be achieved only through love. Accordingly, from the viewpoint of God's purpose of creation, love should be the most precious and sacred act. But because the sexual act was the very cause of the Fall, people often regard it with shame and even contempt. In conclusion, human beings fell through an act of illicit sexual intercourse

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

- ∞ The Illicit Sexual Act between the Angel and the Human Beings
- ∞ Thus far, we have explained that an angel seduced human beings to fall & that both the angel and the human beings fell due to illicit sexual love. Human beings and angels are the only spiritual beings in the universe who are capable of having love relationships. We can deduce that the illicit sexual relationship must have involved the angel and human beings.

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

⌘ Jesus said, "You are of your **father the devil**, and your will is to do your father's desires." (John 8:44) We can assert that human beings are descendants of Satan, the "ancient serpent" who tempted human beings.

⌘ Through what circumstances did humankind become the descendants of the fallen angel, Satan? There was an illicit sexual relationship between the angel and the first ancestors. As the fruit of that relationship, all humanity is of the

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

♁ St. Paul wrote, "we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies," (Rom. 8:23) he was acknowledging that we fallen people stem from the lineage of Satan, not the lineage of God. John the Baptist reproached the people calling them "a brood of vipers," (Matt. 3:7) the children of Satan. Jesus said to the scribes and Pharisees, "You serpents, you brood of vipers, how are you to escape being sentenced to hell?" (Matt. 23:33)

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

- ∞ These verses affirm that
- ∞ **we are the offspring of an illicit sexual relationship involving the angel and our first ancestors.**
- ∞ This, in fact, lies at the heart of the human Fall.

How Can We Be Saved.

Biblical scholars have often complained that the word *chesed* in the Hebrew Bible is difficult to translate into English, because it really has no precise equivalent in our language. English versions usually try to represent it with such words as "loving-kindness," "mercy," "steadfast love," and sometimes "loyalty,"

(loving kindness) in the Old Testament

"Loving-kindness" is often used as an English translation of chesed, originating with the Coverdale Bible of 1535. Some consider it to be a somewhat archaic translation, it remains one of the most common translations. "Love" is often used as a shorter English translation. Daniel Elazar has suggested the translation of "covenant-love."

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

Ω **Salvation is Restoration** Exposition of Divine Principle p.175-176

Ω The providence of restoration refers to God's work to restore human beings to our original, unfallen state so that we may fulfill the purpose of creation. Human beings fell & have been held under Satan's dominion ever since.


Ω To restore human beings, God works to cut off Satan's influence. We must have the original sin removed before we can sever Satan's bonds & be restored to the state before the Fall. This is possible only

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

- ⌘ To explain further: we first need to go through a course to separate Satan from ourselves. We do this in order to restore ourselves in form to the spiritual level which Adam and Eve had reached before the Fall.
- ⌘ On this foundation, we are to receive the Messiah and be reborn, and thereby be fully restored to the original state of human beings before the Fall. Finally, by following the Messiah, we should continue our growth to maturity where we can fulfill the purpose of creation.

What does Rev. Moon and the Divine Principle Say?

⌘ For anyone to be restored to the original position or state from which he fell, he must make an indemnity condition by reversing the course of his mistake. For instance, because the chosen people reviled Jesus and sent him to the cross, to be saved and restored to the original position of God's elect, the chosen people must go the opposite way: love Jesus and willingly bear the cross for his sake.
