

Argentina's Youth Winter Workshop in Vicente Casares, Cañuelas, Buenos Aires

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From July 21 to 24, 2026, the community of Vicente Casares in the Cañuelas district of Buenos Aires Province hosted the Youth Winter Workshop, organized by the Youth Department of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU).

The event gathered 17 participants aged 13 to 19, including second- and third-generation youth alongside first-time guests. The workshop aimed to support the ongoing spiritual and personal development of the younger generation, providing a healthy, supportive environment to deepen their faith and connection with God.

Program Highlights

Education and Fellowship: Over the four-day program, activities combined lectures on the Divine Principle, team-building dynamics, challenge games, and social moments designed to build strong fraternal bonds.

Mentorship and Testimonies: Older youth from the community led lectures and shared their personal faith journeys. Additionally, recent graduates of the Formula Course offered inspiring testimonies, providing a relatable perspective for younger participants preparing for the next step in their spiritual growth.

Reflective Bonfire: A central highlight was the evening bonfire, where participants reflected on their relationship with God, evaluated their faith journey through the first half of the year, and set goals for the second semester. Attendees noted that these intimate sharing sessions helped bridge theoretical teachings with real-life application.

The workshop concluded on a deeply positive note. All 17 young participants expressed a renewed commitment to taking personal responsibility for their daily faith lives, aiming to bring joy and comfort to Heavenly Parent's heart.
