This week our youth will be producing the Sunday Service. All High School and Middle School students should attend the main service.

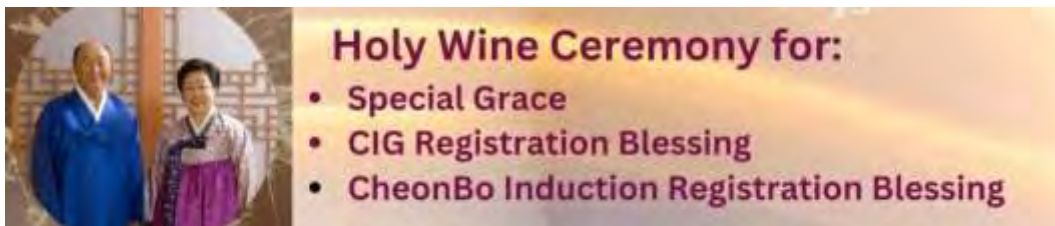
The message will be given by King Muzungu titled "The 2nd Gen Playbook"

## Pertinent Information Regarding the CheonBo Holy Wine Ceremonies:

As mentioned before, all the Holy Wine Ceremonies are held on the subregional level with the Subregional Director officiating the ceremony. Everyone is invited to join the Holy Wine Ceremony.

The same ceremony and the same wine is performing three functions:

- Special Grace for all families including children.
- Cheon Il Guk Registration Blessing for Blessed couples who were Blessed in 2018, 2021, 2022, and 2020 not in Korea, and other new Blessed couples that were Blessed after 2013.
- CheonBo Registration Blessing for couples that will be inducted into the CheonBo Won in October 2023, or CheonBo couples that missed the 2021 Holy Wine ceremony. In the case of CheonBo couples who took Holy Wine and are now bringing their children, only the children are drinking the Holy Wine.

Couples receiving the Blessing in Korea or in Las Vegas will take the Holy Wine before the Blessing ceremony, and do not participate in the local ceremonies.

All participants must be present at one of our churches or the community's usual place of gatherings for the Holy Wine Ceremony. If there are special cases such as hospitalization, too great of a distance from a local community, army service, and so forth, the Subregional Directors have authority to allow special arrangements, and members can connect with their local pastor in these cases.

Members who are traveling on the dates of the ceremony in their subregions, can attend at a church in another subregion. The full list of available ceremonies can be found here. Each subregion has a registration form so members can sign in for which ceremony they are attending.

When participating in a ceremony not in the member's community, please connect with the pastors and register accordingly. Pastors and members can get their registration forms from the Secretary Generals.

For the Holy Wine Ceremony, all participants should bring their Statement of Resolve in a sealed envelope, to be offered during the ceremony.
