In Loving Memory of Our Dear Sister, Judie Lejeune

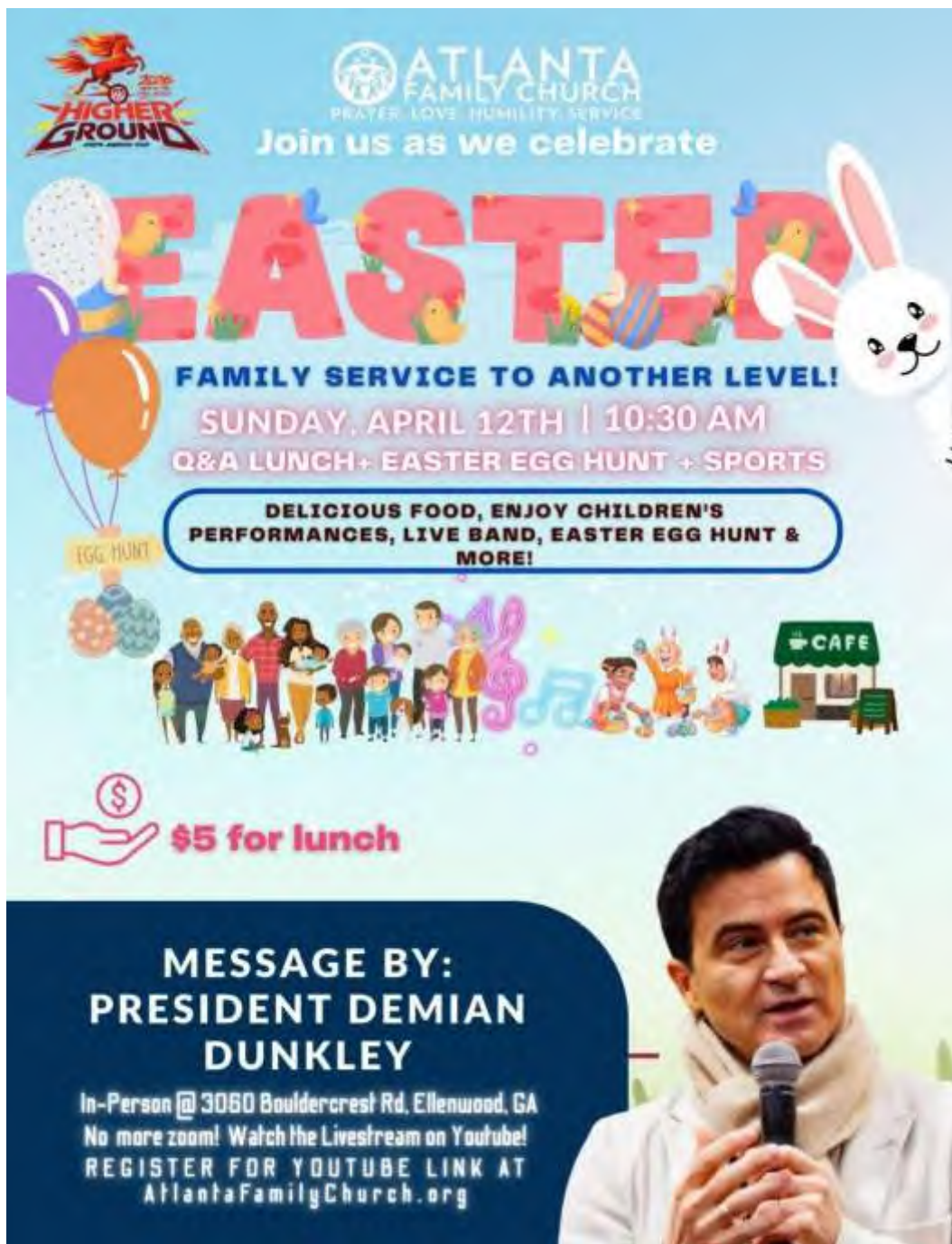
Our beloved elder sister, Judie Lejeune, made her peaceful transition to the eternal spiritual world on Friday, April 10 at 10:40 p.m.

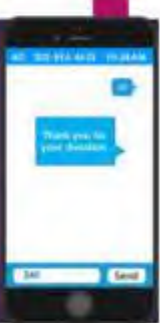


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
