Just last week, there was an eruption of an underwater volcano near Tonga, which was likely the biggest recorded anywhere on the planet in more than 30 years. Tonga is a Polynesian country of more than 170 South Pacific islands and home to about 100,000 people. 

Let's work together as one family under God.


