Through all of these experiences, Michael and his siblings developed a deep bond that has endured and remains strong to this day.

From his childhood years until his death, Michael was a kind and soft soul. In high school he became friends with intellectuals and musicians, finding them kindred spirits. During college, he began writing poetry. He recently told a story of the first time he heard Bob Dylan and realized how differently a person could think about the questions in life. Some years after college Jack Gerow, his life-long friend got Michael involved with the Unification Church. In his early days with the

church, Michael was proud of his part in helping to start the Il Hwa business and buying land for the horse farm.

As an adult Michael continued to pursue education, getting his undergraduate and master's degree in economics after the age of 45. He often grew to like new bands, even into his 70's. He also continued to pursue interests in technology. His newest hobby was taking pictures of the sky on his cellphone.
