Today when we approach Christmas, Luis Carvajal explains us about the birth and life of Jesus:

In part, the Jews did not understand Jesus because he did not meet their expectations regarding the coming Messiah. Isaiah 9:6 said, "... he will be given the names: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." But Jesus could not accomplish in life those prophecies.

Mary was certainly shocked when she received the message of the angel, that she would conceive the Son of God. Also Elizabeth, when Mary went to visit her, she had a feeling that the son of Mary would be very special. The Magi followed the star also with the expectation of a great event.

But instead, did Jesus get the support needed to fulfill that great mission?

Today can the president of a nation govern alone? Or does he need the support of his people? The coming of the Messiah requires that we support him fully and unconditionally. What happened to Jesus in his life? Was ideal the situation that he encountered?

Jesus was the only person in history who was one with God. So his value was unique, divine, cosmic and eternal.

Also Zechariah, who had an important position as a priest, had to have supported Jesus more. The disciples did not understand him either and finally the mayor disciples fell asleep before Jesus was arrested to be charged and killed.
