The Victorious Life of Maria Perez Durkee October 5, 1954 - June 1, 2015

Our beloved sister, Maria Perez Durkee, has passed into the spiritual world June 1, 2015. She was born on October 5, 1954 in Beeville, TX to Juan and Matilda Casa Perez. Maria met our True Parents and joined our Unification Church in November of 1979. She was blessed as a previously married couple in the 30,000 Couples Blessing in August of 1992 to Brian Durkee. She is survived by her husband Brian, and their children Jessie Perez, Justin Durkee, Stephanie Liganad, and Alexander Durkee, and her grandson Brandon.

The family had previously lived in Islesboro, Maine, in Bayou la Batre, Alabama, and in Jacksonville, Florida where Maria resided until she passed away early this week.

Maria worked for a while in New York City, participated in witnessing activities, supporting ACLC, and was involved in various youth projects to help others feel the love of our Heavenly Parent and True Parents. She helped many ministers and churches to receive the Blessing. In 1994, her family was living in a house that was previously a church center. When a traveling fundraising team came, assuming it was still a church center; she welcomed them and invited them to stay with her family.

In March of 2008, Maria developed a mysterious illness that was finally identified as a rare virus. After over 20 surgeries, doctors finally had to amputate her left leg. However, even this did not stop Maria from continuing to encourage others. She was constantly telling the ICU staff that they were working too hard and she would repay their kindness to her by doing their laundry when she got better.

In 2009, she entered San Jose Health and Rehabilitation nursing home, where she continued in her pattern of serving others.
