

UPF Russia: Eco-Picnic Spurs Action for a Cleaner and Greener Voronezh

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Voronezh, Russia – Games and an “eco-picnic” attracted around 60 participants at the City Botanical Garden in Voronezh on October 11, 2025. The activities were organized by **Ms. Elena Knyazeva**, coordinator of environmental programs of UPF-Russia, in cooperation with **Mr. Mikhail Glushchenko**, a well-known traveler and environmental activist from Voronezh.

The initiative aimed to promote environmental awareness and civic responsibility through practical action. Participants joined together to clean and beautify the garden area, collecting 20 bags of litter and helping to restore the natural harmony of this unique urban green space.



Beyond the cleanup, the program offered participants a chance to connect with nature and each other. Families with children took part in an eco-game session designed to teach sustainable habits in a fun way, while a guided tour introduced everyone to the rare plants and ecological treasures of the Botanical Garden.
