Act Now for a Peaceful World

Hosted by the Family Federation of Denmark, a commemoration of the UN International Day of Peace was held on October 19 in the Old Senate Chamber of the Danish Parliament in Copenhagen.

More than 150 participants - including Ambassadors for Peace, political and religious leaders, and representatives of NGOs - gathered to affirm their shared commitment to advancing world peace through solidarity.

Held under the theme "Act Now for a Peaceful World," the program featured presentations by speakers from various sectors, who shared their experiences and practical efforts in peace-building.

Speakers unanimously emphasized that sustainable peace begins not with declarations, but with action.

A range of approaches - including community cooperation, interfaith dialogue, and expanded youth participation - were introduced, fostering a deep sense of common purpose among participants.

The atmosphere was further enriched by a performance by guitarist Lars Hannibal, whose music conveyed a message of peace and was warmly received by the audience, adding emotional depth to the occasion.

The event concluded with a reaffirmation of the need for collective action by the international community in the pursuit of peace.

Participants shared a common resolve that "solidarity in action is essential," and pledged to continue advancing the values of peace in their respective roles and communities.
