Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Convey God's word to the congregation (giving Sunday Service)

Oversee the spiritual well-being of the local church members. This may include education, counseling, worship services, small group ministries, camps, etc.

Build, support and mentor Ministry Team to provide the best service to the community.

Promote church growth; support the development of Tribal Messiahship as a top priority.

Encourage service to the local community

Act as point of contact with the Sub-Region Headquarters of the FFWPU.

Prepare local church plans in partnership with the council.

Oversee local church administration- hiring and oversight of church staff, church records, membership lists, etc.

Participate as a member of the church Council with the special position of spiritual advisor. The pastor has the privilege of casting a tie-breaking vote if necessary.

Operate within the budget approved by the Church Council

Administer pastoral functions such as those related to birth, membership, Il Shim education, engagement, marriage blessing, and death.

Compensation

The salary as the pastor would be \$1,200 a month, plus accommodations, room and having utility expenses covered, such as electric, water living expenses. There is no moving expense covered.
