

## WFWP Rome, Italy hosts the Barefoot Peace Walk

On March 24, 2026, Rome hosted a very significant event, THE BAREFOOT WALK FOR PEACE, organized by Reem Al-Hajajreh of Women of the Sun from Palestine and Yael Admi of Women Wage Peace from Israel, both nominees for the Nobel Peace Prize.

WFWP Italy served as a promoter and active partner of the initiative, publicizing it on social media, sharing the invitation with all contacts, and participating in the event.



The two leaders emphasized how mothers are often the first to suffer the consequences of conflict and the last to be heard:

"While wars continue, the voices of those who pay the highest price - mothers and women - are systematically ignored and excluded from the rooms where decisions are made about their future and that of their children. Today we say enough is enough; all of this must end."

The mothers' message is clear: children have the right to a safe future, and they should not grow up facing the risk of being killed or trained to kill.

[#Motherscall](#) calls for an immediate and definitive end to violence and for the inclusion of women in peace negotiations, in accordance with Resolution 1325 (known as the "Women, Peace, and Security

Agenda") adopted 25 years ago by the UN Security Council.



The march began at the Ara Pacis and ended at the Terrazza del Pincio, with thousands of participants from across Europe.

The message they carried was profound and important, but throughout the walk, there was an atmosphere of peace and harmony. There were no party flags, religious symbols, or banners from any of the many associations present - precisely as intended by the [#motherscall](#) organization. Nor were there any slogans shouted against anyone; instead, there was silence, allowing participants to look into the eyes of those walking side by side and exchange a few words to get to know one another, or to reconnect with friends among the participants whose bonds had been strengthened over time through their commitment to peace. An experience that touched the hearts of all participants and sparked hope and the desire to continue spreading the message.

This was the first in a series of events that [#themotherscall](#) will continue to organize in major cities around the world in conjunction with global meetings such as the G7 and others.

The courage of these women - who come from two countries that have been at war for decades and are risking their lives simply by talking to one another and marching together - is a force that surpasses that of weapons, and above all, an example that can truly make a difference.
