Our 7-day DP seminar brought together 36 people—staff included. We had 22 core participants from 10 different countries: a nice mix of long-time members (first and second gen) and new friends (guests). The workshop initially aimed to support witnessing activities in the Czech Republic for our advanced guests. Every guest reported a profound experience, thanks to the quality of the lectures and the supportive community. It was wonderful to have different backgrounds all in one place, sharing and learning together.



Under the motto “In Search of God’s Heart,” the seminar featured Divine Principle lectures updated with Cham Bumo Ron content, the Korean epic as part of Second Coming chapter, and lectures on the life of our True Parents and various testimonies. The main lectures were delivered by Marcela Gregůřková (Czech Republic), Sarah Ahmed (Lebanon) and Martin Slezák (Czech Republic). The material resonated

deeply with attendees, leading to profound realisations. A friendly community atmosphere was a highlight; friendships were easily formed during chats, reflections, and fun activities like the Korean Yut game.



We also made sure to put our faith into action. One afternoon, we all volunteered at a local NGO that helps homeless people. It was a very grounding experience, reminding us of the real needs in our community and giving us a chance to serve others just as we were discussing in our talks. It made the principles we learned feel very real.

For the cultural part of the trip, we did some sightseeing, focusing on the historical figure, Jan Hus. Exploring his story and the places where he made his stand for truth added a lot of meaning to our discussions about conviction and history.



All in all, the seminar was a huge success. By combining spiritual learning with helping out locally, everyone left feeling inspired. The feedback was very positive and local guests are encouraged to continue with the follow-up workshop that we are already preparing.
