

## UPF Conference: “Innovative approaches to World Peace in the 21st Century”

Skopje, Macedonia, 8. – 10. November 2013



After UPF Conference held on 10th of May 2013 at FON University in Skopje, with International UPF General Secretary, Dr. Thomas Walsh and European UPF General Secretary, Mr. Mark Brann (who participate at the Third World Conference on Dialogue among religions and civilizations: “Freedom and Dignity – Fundamental Values in Inter-Human, Inter-Religious and Inter-Cultural Relations” organized by the Macedonian Government), we held UPF Conference from 8th till 10th of November: “Innovative approaches to World Peace in the 21st Century”, in order to establish Peace Council as it was concluded at previous conference.
