

World Week for Interreligious Harmony

The Divine Concept in the various Faiths

As part of the "World Interfaith Harmony Week" the UPF has organized, at the Aula Magna of Bergamo junior high school "Muzio", an interreligious Sunday meeting of spiritual inspiration on the theme "The Divine Concept in the various faiths."

After a hymn and a prayer offered by Ignazio Cabras, Carlo Zonato, representing UPF, has introduced the significance of the week at which the meeting was dedicated which was followed by the reading of the

Declaration of the International UPF for the occasion.

In an atmosphere of harmony and sincere brotherhood, four representatives of different faiths took turns on the theme that had been chosen by mutual agreement. They were: Vasudeva Das of the Congregation for Krishna Consciousness, Mohsen Mouelhi Vicar General of the Brotherhood of Jerrahi-Halveti Sufi in Italy, the Buddhist monk Tenzin Kentse of the Ghe Pel Ling Institute of Milan and Adosco Comito of the Family Federation for

World Peace and Unificationism of Bergamo. Each one of them offered the assembly their reflections ended in a personal prayer.

The meeting was followed with keen interest by about sixty participants and, at the end, there has been deep sharing among the participants and a refreshment. The spirit and the value of meeting aroused strongly the idea that this type of inter-religious experience can be repeated at a later date on other issues of great interest and relevance.
