Tirana, Albania – The Tirana Regional Peace Council joined with UPF-Albania to celebrate UPF's 20th anniversary and the UN International Day of Peace at the Peace Embassy in Tirana on September 12, 2025. The theme was "The World at a Crossroads: Principles of Peace – A Necessity."



The Alfred Moisiu Hall in the Peace Embassy was filled to capacity with over 160 attendees from various fields. There were ambassadors for peace, representatives of institutions, special guests and friends of UPF – from Albania, North Macedonia and Kosovo – making this event into a true day of reflection and inspiration.
