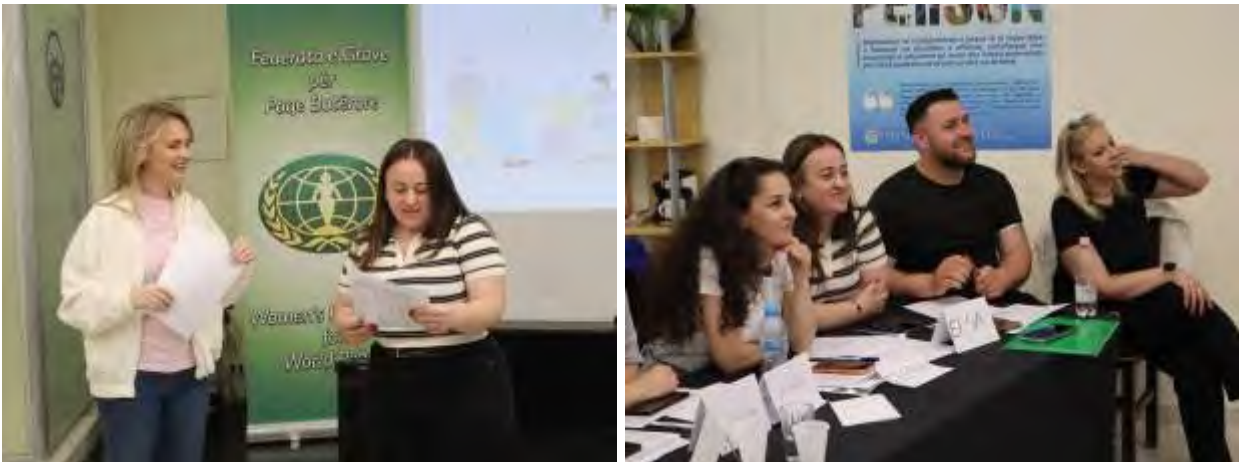


WFWP Albania's Youth Academy For Peace
