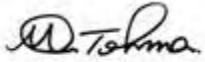

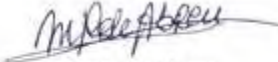

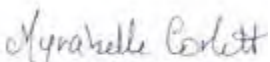

Location:

A stunning seaside retreat awaits at Radisson Blu Resort, Malta St. Julian's. Nestled along the sparkling Mediterranean coastline, the resort offers a tranquil escape with uninterrupted sea views, cultural, historical, and business sites.



In Malta, the standard electricity supply is 230 volts with a frequency of 50Hz. The socket type used is type G which features 3 rectangular pins, including a grounding pin. This standard is similar to that of the UK.

By taxi: The airport is 13km from the hotel (20-minute drive).

Driving in Malta: vehicles drive on the left-hand side of the road, with the steering wheel on the right side of the car. Malta follows the left-hand driving system, the same as the United Kingdom, due to its historical ties as a former British colony.

Public bus service: The public bus system in Malta, known as tal-linja, is the primary mode of public transportation serving all major inhabited areas across the country. You can access the bus service using either a Tallinja card or paper tickets. For detailed routes and timetables, you can visit the official Malta Public Transport website: publictransport.com.mt. Additionally, the Tallinja App allows you to book transport and track buses live.
