Marie grew up with aspirations of being a teacher, but her accomplishments in life far exceeded anything that she could have ever imagined!

After learning the Divine Principle in 1972 in Chicago, Marie was reborn. She became a Christian and understood many well-kept secrets of the Bible. She devoted her entire life to revealing those secrets to

the world as a teacher and minister of the Unification Church.
