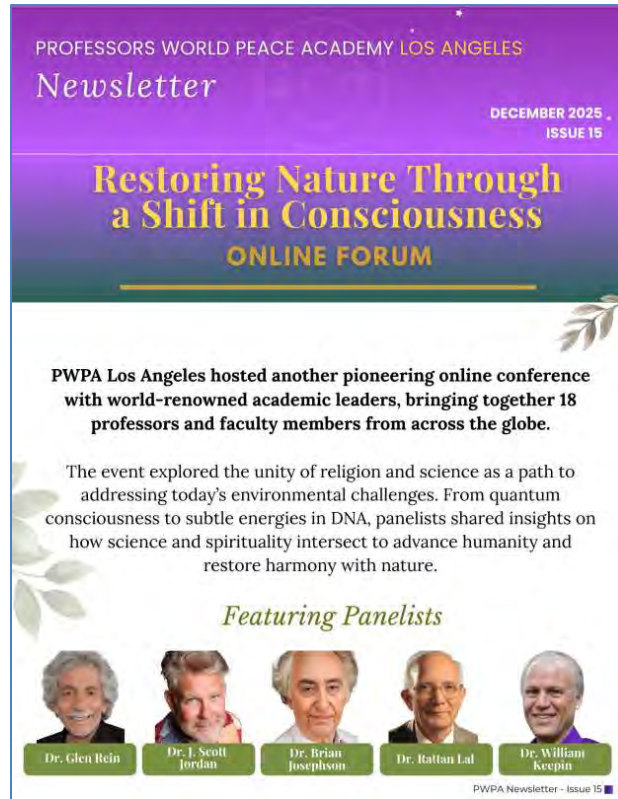


## PWPA LA News: Restoring the Natural World through a Shift in Consciousness

# Restoring Nature Through a Shift in Consciousness

## ONLINE FORUM

**PWPA Los Angeles hosted another pioneering online conference with world-renowned academic leaders, bringing together 18 professors and faculty members from across the globe.**

The event explored the unity of religion and science as a path to addressing today's environmental challenges. From quantum consciousness to subtle energies in DNA, panelists shared insights on how science and spirituality intersect to advance humanity and restore harmony with nature.

# PANEL 1: Unity of Religion & Science

*Why is the unity of religion and science essential for the progress of humanity in this age?*

**DR. BRIAN JOSEPHSON**

**Professor Emeritus of Physics at Cambridge University and Nobel Laureate in Physics**

Dr. Josephson discussed his work connecting physics and biology, noting that physics has overlooked key aspects of reality. Drawing on John Wheeler's "observer-participancy," he explained that quantum theory points to the role of the observer and suggested this could extend to "observers from the far," bridging science and religion. He also referenced his publication, *Physics and Spirituality: The Next Grand Unification?*, which argues for unifying science and spirituality to better understand reality.

**DR. RATTAN LAL** **Distinguished Professor of Soil Science at Ohio State University**

Dr. Lal explained that nature's four components (soil, water, air, and biodiversity) face immense demands with rapid population growth, while 40% of soils are already degraded. Linking soil, spirituality, soul, and stewardship, he emphasized that uniting religion and science is essential for managing, protecting, and sustainably preserving these vital resources.



**DR. WILLIAM KEEPIN** **Co-Founder and Executive Director at Satyana Institute**

Dr. Keepin described that bringing science and spirituality together is important because spirituality is the science of a cosmic interbeing. He noted that science today is largely limited to the creation plane, missing the verticality in each human. Every person replicates the cosmic process within themselves, and by going beyond the mind, can access the full infinity of divinity, showing why uniting religion and science is essential.

**DR. GLEN REIN** **CEO of the Quantum-Biology Research Lab & Co-Founder of Glee Biologics**

Dr. Rein highlighted that science and religion have much in common. Universally, religion calls the source God, while science calls it the quantum or vacuum—both from which all things arise. For humans, religion calls it the soul, science the fundamental energy of consciousness. He emphasized they are united, using different names for the same concepts.



**DR. J. SCOTT JORDAN** **Professor of Psychology at Illinois State University**

Dr. Jordan noted that we can understand the cosmos as an internally related unity. He illustrated viewing ourselves as self-sustaining energy transformation systems, rather than purely physical, mental, or spiritual beings. This holistic perspective helps us recognize and manage the natural entropy costs of our existence, offering a practical approach to addressing the entropy challenges we have created within the context we inhabit.



# Energetic Mechanisms Associated with Raising Consciousness

**DR. GLEN REIN**

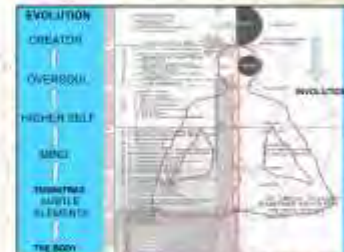

In this thought-provoking presentation, Dr. Rein, a quantum biochemist, unpacks the science behind "raising consciousness," integrating biophysics, sacred geometry, yogic traditions, and new experimental findings on how subtle energies influence DNA.

Discover answers to questions such as:

- **Can we bring our consciousness into higher-dimensional reality and absorb that energy into the physical body** through mechanisms such as down-conversion via toroidal DNA, wormhole/catenoid structures, phase conjugation, and subtle geometric resonances?
- **How, and to what extent, can we resonate with this divine energy** by aligning the biofield with higher energetic layers through resonance between subtle-energy levels and the physical body?

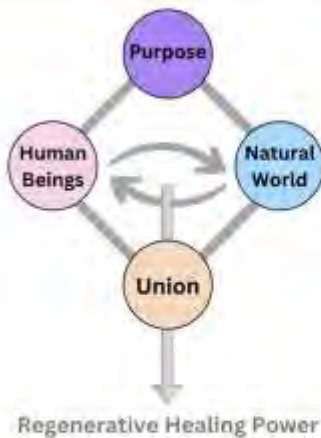
