During March 2022, WFWP Ukraine members organized art therapy online workshops. 17 children from large families and families of internally displaced persons from Kyiv and Donetsk region took part.

A teacher-organizer of school 138 of Kyiv city Mrs. Natalia Veselitskaya conducted a master class "Angel of peace gathers his team". Children gladly drew angels and gave names to them. After that psychologist of the Kyiv Municipal Family Center Mrs. Tatiana Gudenko was teaching the participants to overcome their fears, reduce tension. They together created a fun hand, drawing their favorite safe place. After class, the children used those angels and hands as amulets during the air raid sirens.

Another master-class was from master Anna Podolska, where she shared a story about a snail, offered to blind or draw it, as well as complement its adventures together. Many new interesting stories were born from children.
