

WFWP Ukraine: Russian Air Raids And Volunteering At A Goat Farm

On 14th July we had an air raid for two hours. And then we found out that they were missiles sent to Vinnitsa. The city downtown was bombed, and many civilians died. Our blessed families in Vinnitsa were okay, but their house was shaking and they could see explosions from the window.

The life of our community in Western Ukraine in July was very active. Our young members were doing witnessing, holding a 7-day Divine Principle workshop for two guests, and working with three actionizers who came to stay with us. They also went for a hiking challenge with guests for three days in the beautiful Carpathian Mountains.

We were also volunteering at a goat farm, weaving protective nets for the army, helping neighbors with haymaking, and doing farming together. Thanks to our fertile Ukrainian land, we were able to harvest a large crop of cucumbers and zucchini and made kimchi out of them for everyone. Preparing for the winter, we canned cucumbers and cooked apple jam.

Celebrating together holidays 32nd 7.1 Jeol and 26th 7.8 Jeol, we felt grateful that despite the physical distances that the war created between us, the online world helped us to meet this Holy Day together.



Thanks to the donation of WFWP in the UK we were able to hold a beautiful program for ten second-generation kids of 13+, who stayed in Ukraine and became internally displaced. Except for the actionizing program with fundraising and

witnessing, the children could enjoy nice outdoor activities, going to the cinema and visiting the beautiful City of Lviv.
