

My amazing vision and prayer before joining the Unification Church

80th anniversary of Korean Independence from Japan. I had an incredible experience around the time of the 40th anniversary of Korean Independence from Japan. I was on my first 21 day workshop and on that workshop at Chislehurst something incredible happened. It could only happen because True Parents are the Messiah. I tell the story again beneath.

In November 1983 My Dad and myself drove through to Arbroath for a Labour Party Constituency meeting. At that meeting the adults discussed a young lad who had gone to the Hare Krishna. They discussed him negatively.

I felt their criticism was inappropriate at a public meeting and thought that the young man was just searching. I prayed for him.

Then something incredible happened. He was not at the meeting and I had never met him but suddenly when I prayed for him he appeared in something like a bubble at the right hand side of my head. He showed me two trees, One was a beautiful fully formed tree with beautifully green, green leaves and the other was an old dead tree with only one fork in the trunk. Quite big and tall but with no branches. He challenged me. He said. "You are praying for me but I won't believe in God unless you break the Dead Tree."

I said I couldn't, That it was up to him to find out if God existed or not" Then he said " OK, Then I won't believe in God" so I broke the dead tree with my mind and the experience ended. His name was Richard Fairley and I had never met him physically before. He was not at the meeting.

Scroll forward 14 months or so and I had met The Unification Church in Aberdeen, My first contact was on January 2nd 1985, I was working hard as a mobile security guard at the time so I could not go to the Church building in Aberdeen until 22nd February 1985. That night I was taught the truth about the Human fall.

I kept working and eventually agreed to attend a seminar at David Livingstone House Chislehurst, London. It was a 21 day retreat at a house that had been prepared for David Livingstone to retire to. On the first night there, the participants were introduced to each other. I was introduced to a young man also from Scotland. I was 26 and he was 19. He said he was from Arbroath and I said I was from Montrose. Then he said his name, Richard Fairley and I knew who he was.

I said nothing. Then later during the workshop during morning prayer. We get up to pray quite early on these retreats and often you nod off whilst praying. He nodded off while praying and dreamed the experience where I broke the Dead Tree with my mind and he went to tell the workshop coordinator. He told me but I said nothing.

The next day was the 40th anniversary of Korean Liberation from Japanese rule. 15th August 1945, This happened 15th August 1985.
