6th March

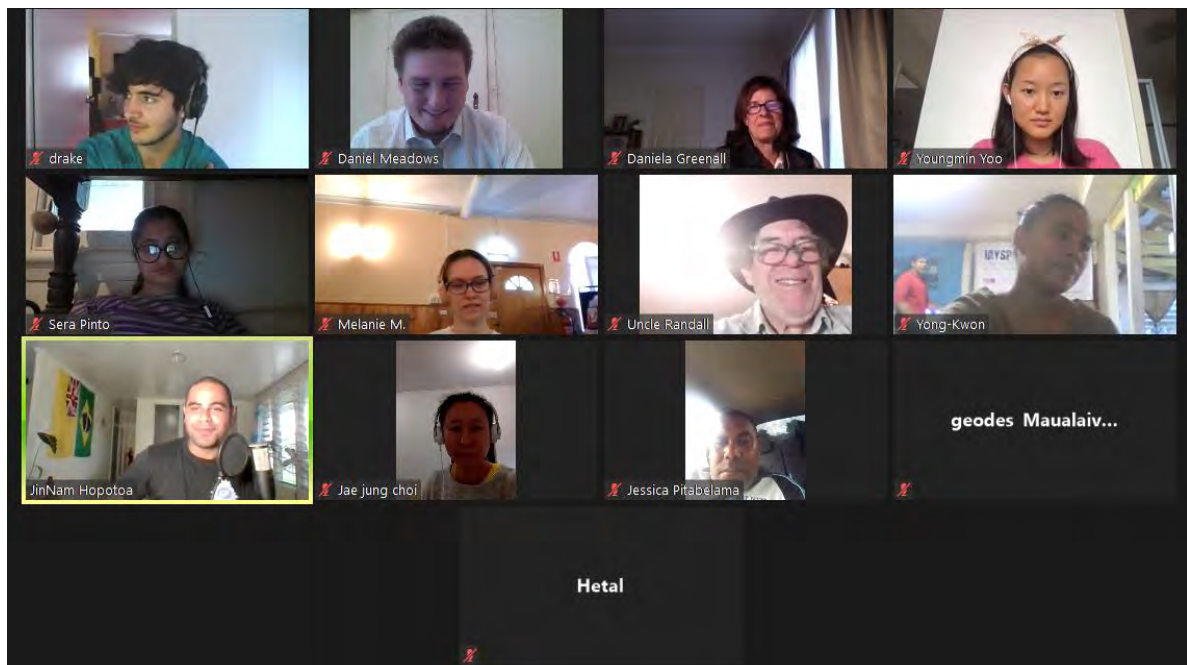
Angelo Natanni and James Babb sealed the hole in the wall under the cabins to make the area safe for visitors and children. Repair has also begun on the damaged church trailer.

6th March

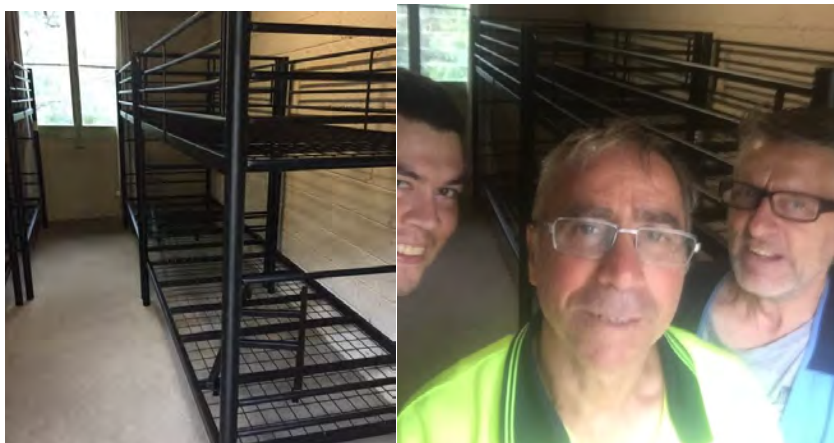
