# James Plimsoll

Born in Sydney on 25.04.1917. Died on 08.05.1987 in Hobart. Diplomat. Never Married. Australian representative on the UN Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea

# **Reginald Walter Saunders**

1st Aboriginal Officer in the Australian Army.

Born in Framlingham, VIC on 7 / 8 / 1920. Died on 2 / 3 / 1990 in Sydney. First wife: Dorothy Mary Banfield

Saunders commanded the Company of the 3RAR in the Battle of Gapyeong during the Korean War. **Marie Louise TRICHET** 

1684-1759 French Catholic Nun Saint, Founder of the "Daughters of Wisdom" near Yves' hometown in France.

# Pierre CERESOLE

1879-1945 with his wife Lise DAVID

Swiss Peace Activist Founder of Service Civil International (or International Volunteer Service), a peace organisation Yves worked with in 1982-1985 in India, Nepal, Bangladesh and Sri-Lanka before joining the Church. It's called International Volunteers for Peace in Australia.

# Albert CAMUS

1913-1960 and his wife Francine FAURE

French Nobel Prize in Literature in 1957, world famous for some books you may have read: The Stranger, The Plague, The Myth of Sisyphus, The Fall, and The Rebel.
