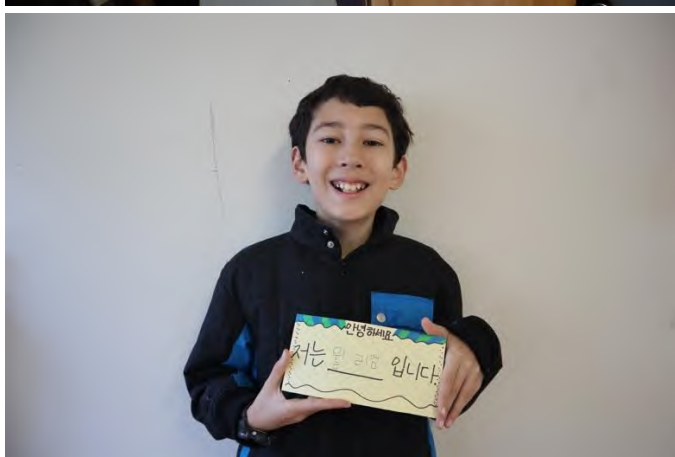
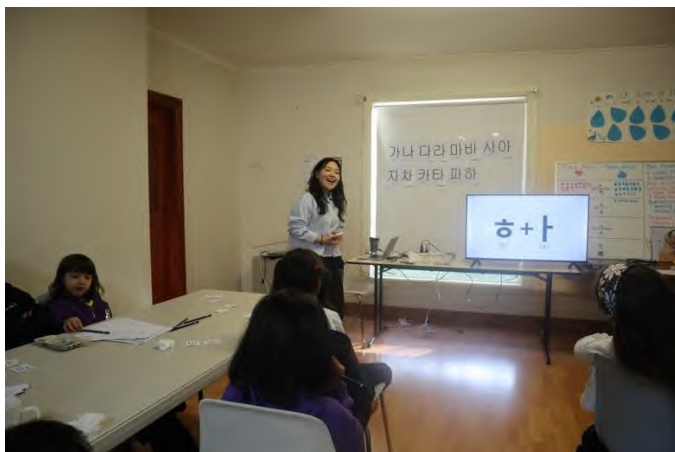




From July 6–12, the 2026 Winter Workshop was held in Melbourne, Australia. Under the theme, “Flowing as One, We Rise as a Wave,” the workshop focused on the spiritual growth of our second- and third-generation Blessed Children, encouraging them to become the "Pure Water" centered on True Mother. A total of 20 participants, ranging in age from 7 to 16, attended from both Sydney and Melbourne.



Throughout the workshop, participants attended lectures on Heavenly Parent's dream, the Human Fall, and the overall Providence of Restoration based on the teachings of the Cham Bumo Ron, as well as the Epic History of the Chosen Han People of Korea. In particular, they explored the providential significance of becoming "Pure Water" and learned that this value is rooted in our relationship with and connection to True Parents.
