WFWP Senegal, in close collaboration with the Universal Peace Federation in Senegal, held an event to celebrate the International Day of Peace and to commemorate the 30th anniversary of WFWP International on September 21, 2022.



The President of WFWP Senegal, Mrs. Paule Cecile Sagna, opened with a speech about the value of women. She shared about Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, the co-founder of WFWP, and how she dedicated her life and heart to build a world of peace by loving all humanity unconditionally, thereby setting an example of how to practice love, sacrifice and dedication. Through Mrs. Sagna's speech all participants could feel deep appreciation for Dr. Moon and learned how a woman can have the strength, power and heart to change everything.
