Dedicated in loving memory to her husband, The Sunhak Peace Prize was established by Dr. Hak Ja Han to help resolve worldwide suffering, conflict, poverty and threats to the environment by promoting a comprehensive, future-oriented vision of peace.

Over the past 10 years, the Sunhak Peace Prize has recognized a total of 17 individuals and organizations from across the globe.



RECOGNIZING LEADERS

Following the vision of “One Family Under God” presented by Dr. Hak Ja han, The Sun Hak Peace Prize follows three tenants for peace: Respect for human development, conflict resolution, and ecological conservation.

By recognizing leaders in these three areas, the Sunhak Peace Prize brings hope and encouragement to changemakers and everyday citizens.



FROM PEACE-MAKERS

From scientists and environmentalists to statesmen, human rights activists, and religious leaders – the Sunhak Peace Prizes awards leaders from all nations and walks of life.

One example is Bishop Dr. Munib A. Younan, a champion for religious unity. Born in Jerusalem as a Palestinian refugee, he has worked to bring religious harmony among Islam, Christianity and Judaism in the Middle East for over 40 years.



TO ENVIRONMENTALISTS

In 2025, The Sunhak Peace Prize had 4 awardees, including environmental activist Wanjira Mathai from Kenya.

One of her many accomplishments is leading the AFR100 initiative – bringing 31 African nations to restore 100 million hectares of land by 2030. To date, 30 million hectares have been restored, creating jobs, enhancing livelihoods, and boosting agricultural productivity.
