The day trip to Northern Mindanao is an opportunity for participants to attend the opening of the 5th Peace Village and visit various schools teaching an innovative peace curriculum.

You'll leave Manila early by charter flight in the morning of December 14 and return in the late evening. If you plan to participate, you need to schedule your departure from the Philippines for December 15.
