Re. : World Mission Headquarters' Official Statement Regarding the "Joint Resolution Issued by the Mongolian Peace and Unification Movement"

May God and True Parents' blessings and love be with all regions, mission nations and providential organizations.

A joint resolution by the Mongolian Peace and Unification Movement was issued on December 13, 2010 and systematically disseminated to the leaders and members of the worldwide movement causing concern. This is to announce the official position of the World Mission Headquarters regarding this resolution.

Mongolia is one of the key providential nations of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind. It is a nation that built up a substantial foundation through the activities of the missionaries who pioneered the mission in Mongolia in the early 1990s, the hard work of the previous national messiah Rev. Chung Hwan Kwak, the leadership of its national leader Rev. Sang Hyuk Kang, and above all the great support and guidance from the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind. Mongolia, in particular, plays a pivotal role in the providence for the Mongolian Peoples' Federation for World Peace.

The True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind deliberated over their choice for the new boon-bong-wang to Mongolia during the period from the end of November and early December, so that Mongolia, a key providential nation, can fulfill its providential mission to heaven through even more robust activities and attain victory as a central nation that can contribute to the great providential finale on Foundation Day, January 13, 2013.

It is a fact that the previous national messiah Rev. Chung Hwan Kwak and previous boon-bong-wang Mr. Jin Man Kwak did work hard for this nation. The True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind, who direct and lead that providence on the front line, dismissed Rev. Chung Hwan Kwak and Mr. Jin Man Kwak on November 20 (10.15 by the heavenly calendar) from their respective positions of national messiah and boon-bong-wang. During hoondokhwa on November 24, True Father asked one prominent ambassador for peace from Korea whether he would be able to carry on the mission of boon-bong-wang to Mongolia if he were appointed. Later, on December 24 (10.29 by the heavenly calendar), one hour before the start of the Cosmic Assembly to Proclaim the Substantial Word that Firmly Establishes the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind, at Cheon Bok Gung, True Parents appointed Dr. Bo Hi Pak as the boon-bong-wang and national messiah to Mongolia. True Parents then gave instructions that he should go to Mongolia without delay and educate the leaders and other members so that they can further contribute to heaven.

Dr. Bo Hi Pak submitted to this heavenly decree and despite other pressing matters, he called and e-mailed the national leader, Rev. Sang Hyuk Kang, the National Headquarters of

Mongolia and former boon-bong-wang Mr. Jin Man Kwak. He then departed for Mongolia on December 8th. True Parents' providence is focused on circumstances in heaven and many times we have seen True Parents organize a thousand-person or even ten-thousand-person rally at short notice, at times 2–3 days, despite earthly circumstances. It is the mission of the Unification family and a sacred tradition to carry out True Parents' instructions without delay or even allowing time to entertain humanistic thoughts.

The members of the Representative Council of the so-called Mongolian Peace and Unification Movement that controls the leadership in Mongolia, stated against the will of its members, that they were unable to welcome the boon-bong-wang who was personally appointed and sent by True Parents. Furthermore, they expressed that they could not trust the World Mission Headquarters, which they alleged was implementing a unilateral decision, and they refused to welcome Dr. Bo Hi Pak, their boon-bong-wang and an elder of the Unification family. They prevented members from meeting Dr. Pak and used force to destroy the windshield of a vehicle used by Dr. Pak and his entourage in Mongolia.

This incident was an outright rejection of the instructions and will of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind, and an action challenging the authority of God and True Parents. Their behavior went against providence and the Principle, completely undermining one of the traditions upheld by the Unification family.

After Dr. Pak completed his visit to Mongolia and left, a number of those in his entourage remained for a couple more days in order to talk with the leaders in Mongolia. On the day these members finally left Mongolia (December 13), Mr. Jin Man Kwak the former boon-bong-wang and his staff entered Mongolia and even now are directly giving instructions to the local leadership. On the day of his entry to Mongolia, a joint resolution by the Mongolian Peace and Unification Movement was sent by e-mail to the World Mission Headquarters. (The resolution was sent in Korean. No English or Mongolian version was provided). Immediately after that, the resolution was disseminated worldwide through the UCI organization, giving the impression that the Mongolian membership had made this resolution on their own.

In the end, Jin Man Kwak and members of the Representative Council ignored True Parents' directions and did not even meet the boon-bong-wang sent by True Parents. Instead they prevented him from meeting the members and portrayed themselves as leaders who are working for True Parents and actually perfecting True Parents' providence. Mr. Jin Man Kwak is the key figure, manipulating the leaders and core members in Mongolia at the expense of innocent members, and he is at the center of the UCI problem.

The World Mission Headquarters strongly demands the following of Mr. Jin Man Kwak, those who are working with him and the Mongolian Headquarters:

1. Mr. Jin Man Kwak, who is the key instigator of recent incidents, and those who are working with him should desist from interfering with the providence in Mongolia; he should step down from his position, return to True Parents and absolutely follow their directions.

2. The Mongolian Headquarters should attend their boon-bong-wang Dr. Bo Hi Pak, who is under True Parents' direction, decide on a schedule, and hold an inauguration ceremony for the newly appointed boon-bong-wang with the Mongolian membership and ambassadors for peace. Furthermore they should absolutely obey True Parents' directions.

3. The Mongolian Headquarters should be transparent in their management of public assets in Mongolia, which were built up under the full support and guidance of True Parents and the devotion of the leaders and other members, use it for the restoration of Mongolia and report the current situation of the assets to True Parents.

4. Any representative council or board of directors that will be responsible for the providence in Mongolia should be formed in the same manner as one is in other key providential nations. Namely, the regional president and the newly appointed boon-bong-wang should be consulted when pooling candidates for such a council or board; the pool should include three times more candidates than the number of seats you are proposing to have on a board or council. These candidates should be reported to True Parents and chosen directly by True Parents to form the council, or board of directors.

These are the guidelines being announced by the World Mission Headquarters so that Mongolia can clearly reestablish itself as a providential nation of God and True Parents.
