Re. : Offering Publication of True Parents' Life Achievements and Gifts on the Occasion of Foundation Day

May God and True Parents' blessings and love be with all regions, mission nations and providential organizations.

On the occasion of the historic Foundation Day, we would like to produce and offer publications that summarize True Parents' lifetime achievements and the course of the providence along with a gift to the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind. Each region and nation should do their utmost in preparing these offerings.

1. Outline of project

1) Purpose:

To manifest the great achievements of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind by compiling and offering publications that encapsulate True Parents' lifetime achievements and the course of the worldwide providence on the occasion of the providentially historic Foundation Day, and so that these may be used as educational material for future generations.

- 2) To celebrate and illuminate Foundation Day with all the members of the world by offering a gift congratulating the wedding of God.
- 3) To be offered by each region and mission nation
- 4) Each region and mission nation should create a preparatory committee for Foundation Day and prepare a commemorative publication and gift.

2. Guidelines for producing the publication

- 1) Publications should focus on True Parents' achievements that encompass the history of the mission nation, key activities and accomplishments (of the church and providential organizations), which will include the dispatch of missionaries by True Parents, the early years of the mission, True Parents' world tours, designation of holy grounds and anything True Parents may have said in relation to that mission nation.
- 2) The narrative of the publications should be made in Korean and English.
- 3) The editing and narrative of the publication should be carried out under the supervision of the regional president and respective national leader and based on historical facts (photos and other materials should be utilized). Existing publications (e.g. Footprints of the Unification Movement) may be used as reference.

- 4) The regional headquarters should compile the content prepared by each mission nation in that region and create a publication for the entire region.
- 5) Size and length of publication
 - (1) Publication should be 24 cm x 34 cm
 - (2) The length (number of pages) shall be decided by the compilation committee of the regional headquarters based on the importance of the contents compiled by the mission nations. The recommended length is 700 pages and if the length of pages is roughly double of this standard, the publication can be published into two volumes.
 - (3) The publication should have a hard cover and the paper quality should be appropriate for a commemorative publication. The cover design should be the designated design provided by the World Mission Headquarters.
- 6) Publication schedule
Each region should complete production before 12.13 by the heavenly calendar in the 3rd year of Cheon-gi (January 24, 2013). Please note the draft of publications from each region must first receive approval of the International President before it is published.
- 7) Publication and copies to be submitted
The compilation committee at each region may decide the total number of copies to be published. Each region should submit twelve copies to the World Mission Headquarters.

3. Gifts

- 1) Gifts should be prepared with utmost devotion and with the participation of all members. A gift should be prepared by each nation and be something that represents that nation.
- 2) Gifts should express and be symbolic of the providential and historic significance of True Parents' lifetime achievements and of Foundation Day (i.e. God's holy wedding and the start of Cheon Il Guk).
- 3) One of the representative gifts of the mission nation in each region should be selected to be presented on Foundation Day to the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind by the regional president and regional representative participating in the summit council.

4. Project budget

Each region and mission nation is responsible for preparing the budget for this project.

5. Administrative matters

- 1) Please make sure that the finished publications and gifts arrive safely in Korea by 12.20 by the heavenly calendar (Please be mindful of customs procedures).
