He said, *"This is now only the third time in American history where the fate and destiny of the nation is tied to one man."*

We had that happen with **George Washington** at the beginning. It was tied to one man. George Washington, as the leader and general of the army had to win against the British. America's fate was tied to George Washington. **Abraham Lincoln**: in the whole Civil War crisis the nation was tied to Abraham Lincoln. He to win that war. And Now with **President Trump** the destiny of America is tied to this man, this one man.

From the Divine Principle perspective, we understand the central figure position, micro and macro. We understand the central figure position through providential history, so that for us it is not surprising. But for Americans this is the first time, probably since Lincoln, when everybody can feel that the destiny of the nation is tied to this one king, one man. And what's happening to him? They're going after him in indictment after indictment; bogus charges after bogus charges. It's ridiculous. And now they're hitting him with a RICO (Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act). That's racketeer influenced organized crime.

You have to remember America's love and fascination for what? Rebellious Founding Fathers. They're cowboys, they're gangsters, they're outlaws, they're federal felons under the British code. Jesus was a federal felon by the way; Jesus was also a federal felon under the Roman state.

Americans do not only have a fascination, but they understand that not all rebels are bad because the Founding Fathers were the rebels; they were the ones fighting against the Empire. That's what Star Wars is all about; it's about rebels against the Empire. I'm not a big Star Wars fan; I don't know a lot about it, but at least I know there are rebel forces and there's the Empire. Is that right? That much I know.

The point is: the rebels in that, where did that come from? That comes from the American Founding Fathers where the rebels are actually the good guys; they're fighting against tyranny and the Empire are the bad guys. So, America has this fascination in its narrative structure and in its history, in its mythology, in the stories that they love to tell. And of course, this has influenced the entire world about what? Rebels are not always the bad guys. Many times, like the Founding Fathers and like Luke Skywalker, they're the good guys. Hence, the fascination with the cowboys in Clint Eastwood, the fascination with the gangsters in Tupac.

Chris Rock said, "*they're making Trump into Tupac,*" and he said, "*Orange is a new black.*" Because now they're making him a federal felon under trumped-up charges and a two-tiered justice system where all of them can get away with all these crimes. But Trump? Now, see, this is what the black community has been saying for the last 20, 30 years. But the white conservatives have been saying to the black community, "*Oh, you're complaining. We back the blue; we back the blue.*" They did not hear the cries of the black community, right? Now they feel it. Why? Because Orange Man, he got locked up and people know this man represents the people. Isn't that incredible?

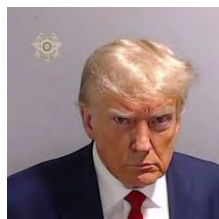

He came out so good. Perfect how he came out. He's saying, "I'm going to come back and I'm going to smash you." It's good he wasn't smiling. Jenna Ellis was smiling; she was mocking the whole thing. But thank God President Trump came out fantastic. Look at him. He looks like a gangster. He's totally a gangster, and Americans, we like the good gangsters. So, it's incredible how things are changing, things are turning. Everything's flipped on its head.



And now people remember Jesus Christ was a felon too. He was not a nice guy; he was not playing nice with the Roman Empire. He was a federal felon and got executed for it. You talk about the root of Christian civilization? Well in Christian civilization, we know that not all federal felons are bad because Jesus CHRIST was a federal felon. Amen! You see how that works? Of course, there are bad felons. But as people who work for Christ we should not be surprised because as I always repeat, he never said, "Pick up your pina colada and follow me to the country club." He said, "Pick up your cross and follow me. Be ready to be persecuted, mocked, hated, KILLED for my name's sake." So, as a Christian civilization, we should not be surprised.

So many things are happening in this modern period, folks; that is absolutely incredible. We're going to get into it today. Oh my gosh! We have too much to cover; way too much to cover!

Isaiah 53

But let's jump into the Isaiah 53. You have to understand that the entire evangelical prophetic tradition is collapsing. All the prophecies and the calculations they've tried to do, whether it be Daniel chapter 9, whether it be the early chapters of Isaiah with the virgin birth, or whether it be Isaiah 53. These are critical chapters in the evangelical world in the last couple of decades, probably, and that's how they're trying to calculate time, "Jesus is coming soon. He's coming soon. He's coming soon." This kind of thing. But this is now collapsing due to the advent of the internet. Let's get into it today. You have to understand that in the evangelical world, one of the key passages for saying that Christ Jesus was the Messiah is found looking at the Old Testament, the Hebrew Bible and saying, "Look at Isaiah 53. This is prophesying the coming of Jesus Christ."

Isaiah 53: 1-8

So, let's look at the first eight verses of Isaiah 53. Let's read together.

¹Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

²For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.

³He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

⁴Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

⁵But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our

peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

This is a famous one. How many people have heard that scripture? Almost every Evangelical Church is preaching and prophesying over that scripture. Amen!

⁶ All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

⁷ He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

⁸ He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

Then it goes on. **Isaiah chapter 53, verse 5** is a commonly quoted one. Everybody has heard verse 5. *"He was bruised for our iniquities and with his stripes we are healed"* is the shortened version of that. This is a critical scripture in evangelical prophetic tradition talking about: *"Look! The Old Testament was prophesying Jesus coming, and it was prophesying what? The cross! It was prophesying the cross. Isaiah hundreds of years before, was prophesying the cross and the suffering servant of Jesus Christ."*

Oh! Shin Joon, the Third King's beautiful video *[A letter to Grandma](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KziFG8ycKhA)* <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KziFG8ycKhA>, wasn't it amazing? (Applause) How many people cried watching that video? He's a true filial son and a grandson. We're grateful to all the Sanctuary folks. Just like with our brother Kook Jin Nim, True Cain, you protect Father's lineage, you protect the Second King, you have to also protect the third King AS you would do with Father. This is part of our tradition. Amen! But anyway, such a beautiful letter to his grandma; his true cry out of love. Of course, they're saying he's a heretic and I brainwashed him to be an unfilial child and to be a naughty boy. But it's okay. As we talked about with Trump, not all federal felons and naughty boys are bad. Satan always calls naughty boys on God's side bad; always. And nowhere is this OBD coming out of the Bible. Golly! I don't even want to get into that; it's so crazy!

Let's get back to Isaiah 53 now.

⁵ But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

This is the verse in Isaiah 53 that most in the Christian tradition, and also the evangelical prophetic Christians claim, *"Look! Jesus had to die on the cross; it was predestined. He had to die because it was prophesied hundreds of years before by prophet Daniel."* This is a big deal; this is a very big deal in the Christian prophetic tradition. The problem is: people who quote this scripture never have read Isaiah chapter 53 or read chapter 41, etc. They have not read the context. Remember, these breaks in the chapters were done later on. The prophet Isaiah wrote a book, so the books are all tied together. Now unfortunately, I'm going to have to start smashing this with the proof of the Scripture. So, let's jump now.

The Suffering Servant

This whole scripture of Isaiah 53 is about what? The Suffering Servant.

11 He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

This whole chapter is called the "Suffering Servant" chapter and this is supposed to have predestined or shown that God's original plan was the cross. Amen! The word for servant in Hebrew is "abdi." Everybody, say, "abdi." (*Abdi*) That is the word servant.

Now, let's see Isaiah in context. We're going to jump back to **Isaiah chapter 41 and verse 8 and 9**. This is now the context. Isaiah 53 does not stand alone as an island in the book of Isaiah; it's part of the book. It's part of Isaiah's entire writing and it has a flow. So, you have to know what's before it and what's after it to understand what he's talking about in Isaiah chapter 53. Are you with me, folks? Does that make sense? It makes sense, right? If you're reading a book whether it be Hamlet or Harry Potter, you're not just dropping in on a chapter saying, "Look at that!" You're reading the whole book. Therefore, he's assuming that you've already read Isaiah 41, 42... 48, 49; he's assuming you've read this before you got to Isaiah chapter 53.

Whereas the evangelical prophetic tradition takes out Isaiah 53 and says, "Look, look, look, that's proof of the cross." That's a big problem. See, this is why, in the Divine Principle, we talk about dual prophecy; we say that depending on free will, the prophecies that are in the Old Testament can go left or right, depending on how the humans behave.

We see this in our own life. You made some decisions when you were 18, 19, 20 years old which then changed the direction of your life. Right? A lot of you first-gen folks, you came in your 20s, and you saw how your life went totally differently. If you had never met Father, you had never met the Returning Lord, you would be in another place and another time; "probably six feet under" is what many of you are saying. Although many of you got locked up for the Lord, so you're a good felon, just like Trump!

Isaiah is looking at the whole thing; he's not thinking you're going to read 53 only and that's all you know about Isaiah. He's assuming you read 41, 42, 43, 44. Does it make sense? That makes sense.

Isaiah 41:8

So, let's now go to 41 and verse 8. Let's read it together.

8 But thou, Israel, art my? What does it say? *Servant*. What is that word? *Abdi*. The same exact word as 53; same exact word. What did he say?

8 But thou, Israel, art my abdi (servant) Jacob whom I have chosen, the seed of Abraham my friend.

Who is the servant that Isaiah is talking about? He's talking about Israel. You have to assume that you are reading the book of Isaiah and in chapter 41, it shows what? That the suffering servant is Israel.

Isaiah 42:6

Let's go to 42 and verse 6. Let's read together.

6 I the LORD have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles;

Whom is God talking about in terms of the righteousness? He was talking about it in chapter 41. He said, "*Israel, you art my?? Servant*" and then He's talking about Israel in terms of righteousness, their righteousness: "*the nation's righteousness will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant...*" Do you understand? Does that make sense?

Isaiah 43:1; 10-11

Now let's jump to Isaiah chapter 43. In verse 1 it says:

1 But now thus saith the Lord that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not

Whom is he talking to? To the nation of Israel. Jump down to 43 verse 10.

10 Ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, and my servant ... Same as Isaiah 53; same exact word. He didn't change the word servant to mean a singular in verse 53.

...my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.

11 I, even I, am the Lord; and beside me there is no saviour.

So, again, "Abdi"; you saw that again in verse 10 of chapter 43.

Isaiah 44:1-2, 21

1 Yet now hear, O Jacob my ?? servant; which is what word? *Abdi*. You can see how Israel and Jacob is used interchangeably here, but again it means Israel.

2 Thus saith the LORD that made thee, and formed thee from the womb, which will help thee; Fear not, O Jacob, my ?? servant; Isn't that interesting? What's that word again? *Abdi*.
and thou, Jesurun, whom I have chosen.

Again, the suffering servant in the context of Isaiah is what? The nation of Israel.

Isaiah 45:4

4 For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, I have even called thee by thy name: I have surnamed thee, though thou hast not known me.

Again, you see the mention of servant. Why is Jacob used interchangeably with Israel? Because he is the ancestor, right? Who wrestled? (Jacob) That's why they're used interchangeably, because from one seed comes Israel. The same seed of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob but that seed produces what? Israel!

Isaiah 48:20

Now let's now jump to chapter 48 and verse 20. Let's read together.

20 Go ye forth of Babylon, flee ye from the Chaldeans, with a voice of singing declare ye, tell this, utter it

even to the end of the earth; say ye, The LORD hath redeemed his servant Jacob.

You see this?

Isaiah 49:3

³ And said unto me, Thou art my ?? servant, O Israel, in whom I will be glorified.

That's why they call us a cult, because we make you actually read the Scripture. Did Pastor Sean make those up? Huh? Uh-uh. You all saw with your own eyes. You read it with your own eyes starting from chapter 41. Did I make those up? No, I did not.

In context when you come to Isaiah 53, it's now been well established since 41. You want those scriptures one more time? It was 41 and verses 8 and 9, 42 and verse 6 and 7, 43 and verse 1, 43 and verses 10 and 11, 44 and verses 1 and 2, 44 and verse 21, 45 and verse 4, 48 and verse 20, 49 and verse 3. You see a trend here: *abdi, abdi, abdi, abdi*. He's talking about the nation of Israel. Does that make sense? By the time he gets to 53, everybody knows he's talking about Israel. Everybody who's actually reading the book of Isaiah, not just one passage from it, everybody who's reading the entire book, which all Hebrew people must do; everybody understands that from 41, we've not been talking about a man who's going to go on a cross. We've been talking about a nation. Is that true? You all saw that from 41, right? You saw it. Did I make those up? You all saw it up there. My two sons are on the tech team, they must have written it up there? Huh? They must have changed the Bible and put it up to prove daddy's point. No! They're on Bible Gateway; unless they're the secret owners of Bible Gateway, which they're not. So, you all saw that; everybody saw those scriptures. Very clearly, in the book of Isaiah the suffering servant is the nation of Israel. Does that make sense?

Now let's get some context in on Isaiah chapter 53. We have to back up just a couple of verses into chapter 52; we're going to back up just a little bit.

Isaiah 52:13-15

¹³ Behold, my servant shall deal... Oh, do you hear that word again? My servant.

¹³ Behold, my servant shall deal prudently, he shall be exalted and extolled, and be very high.

¹⁴ As many were astonished at thee; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:

¹⁵ So shall he sprinkle many nations; the kings shall shut their mouths at him: for that which had not been told them shall they see; and that which they had not heard shall they consider.

Who is talking here? God is talking in these verses. Can you see? He's saying, "*Behold my servant.*" Now, who is the servant? Well, we've been talking about him since Isaiah 41. You all saw that, right? Everybody saw it? Everybody saw Isaiah 41, 42, 43, 44, etc., etc., 48. We're talking about the servant Israel. In Isaiah chapter 52, now God is talking about the nation of Israel. Then when it starts at Isaiah 53, it's no longer God talking. For the first eight verses of Isaiah 53 guess who's talking? It's not God. These are the gentile kings; these are the kings that are talking. How do you know that? Because just one verse back in

Chapter 52 and verse 15

15 So shall he sprinkle many nations; the kings shall shut their mouths at him: for that which had not been told them shall they see; and that which they had not heard shall they consider.

Here it mentioned the kings, the gentile kings; the kings that rejected Israel. You see that?

Isaiah Chapter 53 verse 1-3

Now from 53 verse 1 to 3, who is crying out? It's the gentile kings, the *goyim* kings and what do they say?

1 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

2 For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.

3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief:

This is a poetic soliloquy of the king singing about the suffering servant whom Isaiah already identified from verse chapter 41, as what? The servant is who? The nation of Israel, the chosen nation. Are you with me folks?

See how that works? In Isaiah 53 the kings are crying out because they did Israel wrong; they went against God and His chosen people. You understand? Does that make sense? So that's who's speaking in chapter 53 verse 1 through 8.

4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities:

They're saying, "Why have we been destroyed as a nation? Because we attacked and belittled the suffering servant," who is what? Israel. Do you understand? So, the *goyim* kings, the gentile kings, they are talking about what Isaiah was talking about from 41, 42, 44, 48, 49, etc. The suffering servant as the nation of Israel. They fought against Israel, but now they're destroyed. You see what I'm saying? Are you with me folks?

5 ... he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

They're acknowledging that their nations collapsed because they went against Israel, God's chosen people. Does that make sense? It's not talking about a man going on the cross.

Although from the Principle perspective on dual prophecies, it can mean that, depending on the free will of the people, right? Why? Because as we talk about George Washington, and we talk about President Trump, the fate of a nation is tied to its king. Just like in the Old Testament Scripture in the book of Samuel, when God is talking about the different kings. Or in the Old Testament where God is saying for example that there's a curse upon Ahaz or Ahab and Ahaziah; these are bad kings of Israel. The fate of the nation is tied to that central figure.

So, with Jesus as the King of Israel, it can mean that if Jesus is killed your nation will be destroyed. But also, it can mean that if Jesus becomes the king of that nation of Israel, by serving

Israel you'll be serving the king. If Jesus became the King of Israel, which he could have become if the people had accepted that the Messiah had come.

But do you see how the evangelical prophetic tradition of Isaiah 53 is collapsing in the modern world due to the internet and due to the Scriptures being released in Hebrew? You got to separate yourself from the view that we just read in the English version. And we know what it means. Every Christian must acknowledge that the actual original language Hebrew is the Word of God; you must, otherwise you're not Christian. You have to accept the Old Testament as the Word of God. Is that true? Especially if you're Protestant you have to accept sola scriptura which means "only by scripture." That's your only authority. As a Protestant, you have to accept the Old Testament HEBREW Bible, not the English translation, the actual Hebrew Bible, as God's Word. You have to. You can't get around it. You cannot get around it.

Every evangelical church, every Protestant church must accept the Bible in its primary language, Hebrew, as the primary source. Is that true? 100% true. That is not debatable whatsoever. And if you do, then you have of course more issues.

Isaiah 53

We'll start in **verse 6**. Now remember Isaiah 53 verses 1 through 8 is talking about whom? The suffering servant. But we've already seen how Isaiah has established that the suffering servant can also mean what? The nation of Israel. That's what he's talking about in terms of his prophecy. Why? Because he as an Old Testament prophet is expecting the messianic period and the Messiah the anointed one to come and do what? Become the KING of Israel. Hello! Hello! No Jewish person is accepting the Messiah to come and die on a cross. Not one; not one! Because it's not prophesied that way in the text. They're waiting for the King of Israel. Hello? They're not waiting for somebody to die; they're waiting for the king to take control of Israel and the world and "*beat the swords into plowshares*" etc., and bring world peace. That's what they're expecting. That's their prophecy. That's what Isaiah is also expecting when he's talking about the Messiah coming. And what? He will be the head of Israel, right? So, the fate of that man is tied to the nation and also the fate of his seed is tied to the nation.

I'll show you right there in **Isaiah 53 verse 10**

¹⁰ Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

Do you understand? "*Thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin.*" Did you hear that? "*He shall see his seed.*" Which means what? It means he will see children; he will see descendants. Everybody just read that? Oh, yeah, right there "*he shall see his seed*" Did Pastor Moon make that up? Did I write that in the Bible right now? Uh-huh. It's right there, "*He shall see his seed.*" And what? "*He shall prolong his days*"; he will live long. This is not talking about a man who died on the cross, because he didn't live long and he didn't have seed. Does that make sense?

So, this is of course what the Jews in Hebrew say to the Christians, *"You're talking about a different scripture."* Isaiah talks about, *"he was bruised"*, yes, and he is referring to Israel, but, *thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, - he will have progeny- he shall prolong his days.* He's not supposed to die quickly. He's actually supposed to have children. Every single rabbi waiting for the Messiah, guess what? Expects the Messiah to have children. Do you know that? They expect the Messiah to have a family, to take a wife and have a family. In the Christian world, that's unheard of because it's been two thousand years of church saying, *"no, no, no, no, no,"* and saying that the Catholic Church or the Orthodox Church, they are the true kingdom of God. Their institutions, their priests that unfortunately are raping children, especially in the Catholic Church. At least the Orthodox priests are married.

Now, in the modern day, Protestant churches are dying and people are now converting to what? The Orthodox Church or Judaism. They're going back to Judaism. Many Protestants now are actually rejecting Jesus as a false religion. The fastest growing church in the Christian world now is the Orthodox Church. Did you know that? The Orthodox Church is growing because they're making the claim that their church holds the tradition from Jesus. But also, a lot of Christians are becoming Jewish because when they learned Hebrew it says something completely different.

Isaiah 53 verse 6

6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

You see that? *"For the transgression of my people was he stricken"*. Everybody sees that? Every Christian Bible translated this last verse, *"He's stricken."* Why? Because of their view on Isaiah as the suffering servant and the prophetic nature of Isaiah 53 as the suffering servant. Does that make sense? What did they do? They translated *"he's stricken"* in singular; he. What does it say in Hebrew? In the Hebrew the word is *lamo*. Everybody, say *"lamo"*. (*Lamo*) *Lamo* means "they, them" and it's not gender pronouns. *Lamo* does not mean "he"; it's not singular. *Lamo* means "they".

So, *"for the transgression of my people were they stricken"*. That's the proper Hebrew translation. Do you understand folks? Which proves again that Isaiah 53 is not necessarily talking about Jesus coming to die on the cross. Are you with me? All Christians must accept the actual Hebrew as a holy language and the Old Testament in its primary source Hebrew as true. They MUST, otherwise they're not good Christians. Every Protestant has to do it. Is that true?

Jesus did not come to die

So now what's happening? The Protestant prophetic tradition is collapsing; as the internet comes out that one-sided prophetic tradition is crashing. It's crashing. You see that? It's not prophesying as many Protestant denominations say, that Jesus had to come to die.

I read Shin Joon's paper, 40 pages plus, extrapolating more of what the Principle says about why Jesus did not come to die. He came to establish God's throne, God's Kingdom. He even mentioned the Gospel. I did a whole series on that, Jesus himself, himself, talking about what is the Gospel. The Gospel is what? Of the kingdom of God. *"My Gospel is about the kingdom of God."* He clearly is talking about the Gospel as the kingdom of God; not *"I'm going to die and then I'm going to resurrect."* And by the way he only talks about dying and resurrecting on the third year, not on year one, not on year two. But when it gets so bad and everybody's betraying him, he's like, *"Okay, now I got to go the other way."*

That's what the Principle is talking about with dual prophecy. The prophecies in Scripture can go left or right DEPENDING on the response of the people using their free will. Does that make sense? Does that make sense, folks? Depending on free will. Depending on how they had chosen and reacted to Jesus, he could have become the King of Israel at that time. He could have been alive because the Roman Empire was fading. It was waning, it was under collapse, it was in umpteen wars across the world; it was a dying civilization. That was the time when Jesus could have become the King of Israel if they had accepted him, and he could have fulfilled all these Isaiah 53 prophecies AS the King of Israel representing Israel. Does that make sense? Just as Jacob represented Israel. The king also represented Israel, just like David represented Israel at his time. ONE man represents the whole thing. You see what I'm saying? So, depending on how the Jewish people acted out of their free will, it could have gone left or right. Unfortunately, it went to the left. That's why Jesus said what? *"I'm going to come again."*

But we saw in **Isaiah 53 and verse 10**

¹⁰ Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days,

So there has to be the seed and the prolongation of days.

And of course, going back to **verse 8**

⁸ ... for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

Unfortunately, many seminary Bibles translated like this. But the actual Hebrew word for this pronoun is *lamo* which is not "he," not singular. It's plural meaning "they, them," and it's not gender pronouns like the crazy lunatics are saying nowadays. *"THEY were stricken,"* meaning the nation. Hello? Does that make sense? Isn't that crazy? It's insane, crazy. All the Protestant evangelical prophetic Christians would say, *"Look, look, this is being fulfilled. Or look at Jeremiah chapter 9 or look at Isaiah."*

Isaiah 7 and 14. The Virgin Birth

This is ANOTHER thing in the Scripture about the virgin birth or the Virgin Mary. Christians

are saying, "God already prophesied the virgin Mary in Isaiah chapter 7 verse 14." Well let's read chapter 7 and verse 14. This is another prophecy that is claimed. Let's read together.

14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son...

"Look, look, that's proof of the Virgin Mary!" You see how that works? That's how the evangelicals say that, "Look, in Isaiah they prophesied the virgin birth of Jesus Christ." It had to be that way. It can't have come from a man and woman and from a seed and an ovum. Even though God made that whole system, somehow, it's dirty. Do you understand? It can't come from that, just like David, or even Cyrus who was not even a Jew but who was called a *mashia* anointed one in the Bible. The Hebrew Bible refers to the messiah 39 times; one of them is to Cyrus.

So. Look: it said "*Behold, a virgin shall conceive.*" Well again, we got to go back to the original Hebrew. There's a problem with the internet; the internet is destroying these prophecies. Why? Because when you look at the Hebrew the word that is used here is the word "*alma.*" Everybody, say, "*Alma.*" (*Alma*) That's what they translate into virgin, because somehow a man and a woman, a seed and ovum coming together and producing life is somehow dirty; even though God made that entire system, somehow, it's dirty. Obviously, we know it became dirtied through the fall, but the whole system ITSELF is not supposed to be dirty. Amen! It's supposed to be beautiful and it's God's creation. The point is: it's not inherently bad. The penis and the vagina, the sperm and the ovum are not inherently bad. Now, if it's misused it becomes satanic but the system itself is not inherently bad. It's meant for marriage. Amen!

So, they translate "*a virgin shall conceive.*" The virgin here is the word what? *Alma.* Everybody, say, "*Alma.*" What does that mean? That doesn't mean a virgin in Hebrew. What does it mean? It means a young woman; nowhere does it say a virgin. Now a young woman could be a virgin; it's possible, but also many young women are not virgins. That word *alma* does not specify a virgin; it just means a young woman. What is the word for virgin? Everybody, say "*Bethulah.*" (*Bethulah*) Does that sound different from *alma*? *Bethulah* is specifically a virgin. Is that word used in Isaiah chapter 7 verse 14? No! It's not used. In the Hebrew Bible in Isaiah 7 verse 14 *Behold, a virgin shall conceive*, did he say a *bethulah* shall conceive? No! He said what? An *alma* shall conceive, which means what? A young woman. It doesn't mean virgin. You see that? So, this prophecy is also collapsing. You understand? This prophecy is also a collapsing.

Daniel 9:26 – The 70 Weeks

Then of course there are the prophecies in Daniel chapter 9 with the 70 weeks of Daniel. The evangelical prophetic tradition makes a claim that "Well, the Bible is showing the exact date when Jesus was crucified. Because the Prophet Daniel in the Hebrew" - you understand? - "in the Hebrew he's prophesying the death of Jesus Christ on the cross 490 years later through the 70 weeks of Daniel in Daniel chapter 9 and verse 26 particularly." The whole chapter 9 is what they use. In that chapter they talk of the 70 weeks of Daniel and then the weeks are translated into years through different Christian calculations and thus the 70-weeks period becomes 490 years. And they

make the claim that, "Look, from the time of Nehemiah receiving the order from King Artaxerxes to rebuild the Temple in Jerusalem to the time of Jesus' death, that's 483 years that's 69 weeks. It's right there! It's real close! If you bring the number back to Nehemiah until the death of Jesus in AD 32, 33, you're talking about 69 weeks or 483 years." The only problem is that Daniel chapter 9 verse 26 talks about the time of being cut off.

26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary;

Do you see what happened? In that scripture the Messiah is cut off and the city's destroyed at the same time. Hello? Were the Second Temple and Jerusalem destroyed at the same time Jesus died on the cross? No. There's a 40-year gap; which makes it now WAY more than the 70 weeks of Daniel. You understand? That calculation is completely off. You see how that breaks down? Anyways, we can go into more detail later.

By the way, nobody in the New Testament from the letters of John to Paul etc., nobody mentions this incredible prophecy by Daniel apparently, that he prophesied exactly the date that Jesus would be killed. Why? Because God didn't ordain it; God didn't predestine it! Oh, my gosh! Not ONE New Testament writer, not ONE! Not one time do they mention this calculation from Daniel chapter 9. Not one! Not one reference to it, not one mention of it! If it was as PRECISE as they claim; if it was so incredibly precise and was so mathematically perfect, you would imagine that one of the books would mention it, because it's a big deal. It's prophesying the Messiah. It's a huge deal; it's bigger than the creation of the universe. It's huge. ONE person should have mentioned it.

But how come not one mentioned it and this calculation comes up later in the 20th century? Isn't that a problem? And the calculation is off because as you saw in Daniel chapter 9 and verse 26, it said that the Messiah can be cut off and they will also destroy the city. You saw those two things happen. But in AD 32. Yes, Jesus was the Messiah, and he was killed. But did Jerusalem fall on that day? No. 40 years later. Which puts the calculation WAY over 490 years. It puts it at 523 or something like that. You understand? So, even by their own calculation it falls apart.

Divine Principle & Dual Prophecy

Now you see why they call us a cult. Only the Principle can explain the dual prophecy nature. Depending on the free will of the people, God's Old Testament prophecy can be fulfilled through Christ sitting as the suffering servant on top of Israel as the king. Do you understand? Why? Because the king and the nation are always represented as one in the Bible. You understand? Does that make sense? For example, King Ahab brought in all the prostitutes and all the Baal temples, and destroyed the nation. You see, the fate of one man, the king, is tied to the nation. That is a common thing in Scripture. Are you with me, folks?

According to the Divine Principle's dual prophecy, all these scriptures could be fulfilled. If Jesus became the King of Israel, he would be the suffering servant sitting with his nation as the central figure of that nation, establishing the kingdom of God. There would be a time of suffering because all the nations would be against him etc., but those prophecies would be fulfilled. They don't necessarily point to "Look, Jesus HAD to come and he HAD to die." There is an issue of free will here that is explained only in dual prophecy in the Principle. The evangelical prophecies are now falling apart. Do you see? They're falling apart. FREE WILL is a giant, giant piece of the providential puzzle. Everybody, say, "*providential puzzle*". (Providential puzzle) Whoo! I like that. It's a BIG piece of it; free will is a big piece.

You saw in Isaiah chapter 53, they talk about the suffering servant, but now in 41, it said "No! *The suffering servant meant the nation.*" In 42. "No, *it meant the nation.*" In 43 "No, *it meant the nation.*" In 44. "No, *it meant the nation.*" In 45, "No, *it meant the nation.*" In 48, "Nope, *it meant the nation.*" In 49. "Nope, *it meant the nation.*"

So, the evangelical prophetic claim is falling apart. The PRINCIPLE claim is being resurrected in this time. Uh-oh. That's why all the Protestants are now de-converting from Christianity to the Orthodox Church, to Judaism or becoming Moonies. And out of all of them only the Moonies have the Cheon Il Guk Constitution of freedom and responsibility. Hallelujah! Praise God! (*Applause*) A kingdom of freedom and responsibility, not of tyranny, not of monarchical tyranny. God's Kingship is still there, but it's in the judicial branch as part of defending the Constitution in the Supreme Court. Lord, have mercy!

When we look at it in terms of dual prophecy, well then, these prophetic scriptures could have been fulfilled because we're not tied to the theology that Jesus HAD come to die. It was CONTINGENT upon free will and whether the people accepted him as the King, the Messiah, and served him as the King and the head of Israel. It completely would have changed history. We would have had the Kingdom back then, 2,000 years ago. Amen? Praise the Lord!

We would have had the Rod of Iron Kingdom then. The Shepherd's Kingdom. The Shepherd's Kingdom. Remember the *poimaino* reign? The Bible talks about the *poimaino* reign. The Bible talks about, "*you will reign with him.*" In all the scriptures that we talk about all the time, reigning is the word *poimaino*; which means what? Shepherding. Shepherding is the actual translation for reigning. So, you would have had the *poimaino* reign of the True Shepherd Jesus Christ and of his Kingdom of freedom and responsibility. He would have established that and he would have had his seed and he would have prolonged the days.

You see? In the Jewish tradition it's not strange to say, "*Yeah of course, the Messiah is going to become the king and he's going to get married and he's going to have children.*" That's not strange. But it's weird in Protestantism, isn't it? Why? Because they're committed to Isaiah 53 as being the absolute prophecy about Jesus dying on the cross. He had to do it. God had no other way. You see what I'm saying? But of course, they're taking that in isolation, not reading in a context 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 47, 48, 49, etc. as we all saw.

So, this is an incredible time folks, an incredible time because prophetic fulfillment is not only happening. It's unfolding. It's also being debunked. A lot of the mainstream popular prophetic traditions are being dismantled because the internet provides all the scholarship of the world to be able to attack these prophecies, tear them apart if they have to, and show their inconsistency. History could have changed if the people of the nation of Israel had united with Jesus Christ and made him the King. It would have totally transformed the world. You see, that's not a problem for us because we can look at Isaiah 53, we can look at Daniel chapter 9, we can look at Isaiah chapter 7 and verse 14. We see that all in the proper context.

The Holy Royal Jewels

We don't particularly see the sexual system of man and woman making a baby as inherently evil, even though it became evil through Satan's lineage. But the whole system itself is not evil, because God intended it to be for Adam and Eve in marriage, right? Just as Jesus has a digestive system, because he's 100% man, he will also have a reproductive system. It's not like when he goes to the bathroom he looks like some transgender or something like that. Just as he eats food and has a digestive system which digests food because he's 100% man, he also has the holy jewels. Only Satan's kingdom has demonized a man's jewels. Why? Because we became slaves to Satan. The daddy of our jewels became Satan because of the fall. But that was not intentional; in the original ideal the jewels were supposed to be God's. Royal jewels. Amen! That's why we call them jewels. I like that. That's a good name. They're supposed to be the holy royal jewels. Christ's jewels. That's the seed. That's the lineage.

And that's why it's so important that a lot of the young people... Let's give it up for our young kings and queens, young daddies and mommies. (*Applause*) They're investing in the jewels. Hallelujah! They're not investing in the fake paper money of the world and going into debt and getting useless degrees, being \$40,000 in debt and paying that off in the next 30 years, being a debt slave to the banks. No! They're investing in the jewels of God, the real assets of God, family, children, husband and wife. They're building relationship. Instead of building their life based on hedonism and materialism, they're building their life based on relationship. Relationship with God, relationship with His Kingship, His community. Relationship with whom? Husband and wife. Critical. They're investing into that.

That's why they're doing the date training. All the young people, we always remind them, "*Get your date training! Don't get lazy on your date training!*" Why? You're investing into your queen. You're investing into your king. You're investing into your romance and absolute sex life, which is part of God's plan for husband and wife. Amen! And in your husband-and-wife relationship training and having a beautiful date, marriage, and investing in the marriage, you are having fun, too! Everybody, say, "*Fun.*" (Fun) You're having fun in the covenant of marriage.

What about the old self-flagellating Catholic monks? Why did they flagellate themselves and try to beat their penises off? Why did they do that? Because they were waiting for the Messiah. The Divine Principle talks about that in the preparation for the Messiah. They didn't understand

theologically, but in a sense, they understood that there was something wrong with the sexual lust of man. That's what those conditions were for, but they were not supposed to last forever. When the Messiah comes, we're supposed to now get the FULL anointing of the covenant of the Blessing, and once we get the FULL anointing of the covenant of marriage, we can have POWER in there and there's supposed to be joy. Everybody, say, "Joy!" (Joy) There's fun and joy. Yeah! Of course. It's supposed to be fun to be investing in your marriage, romancing your queen, having a great absolute-sex life. This is all BEAUTIFUL for the strength of marriage and the covenant anointing of marriage. Amen! Amen, young people!

Old people, oh you're still young at heart! You're not old. The Queen was talking about a 102-year-old professor from Korea. He's still giving lectures at 102. 102 years old! He says that the secret to his long life is that he just keeps learning; he just keeps learning stuff. He says that's the reason why he's so mentally fit and he's pretty physically fit, but he's 102. 102 years old. He's on Korean TV all over. And you see, even at 102, he still wants to learn this, this, that, that. He keeps busy. He wants to learn new skills, he wants to learn carpentry, he wants to learn paper cutting, he wants to learn fixing cars, whatever it is. He always wants to learn something. That's what keeps him mentally young. Even though he's 102 and he lived over a century, he said it's not boring; he's still improving. So, you old people, are young; you're like whippersnappers compared to the 102-year-old man. You're in your 60s and 70s, you're all young spring chickens.

He's saying there are like three phases of life. You have 0 to 30, that's one phase; 30 to 60 is another phase, and 60 to 90 or 100 is another phase. So, you've got to get ready for those three phases. Your body's going to change but you have to just keep on trying to study things and keep on being excited.

Peace Police and Peace Militia

That's what Peace Police and Peace Militia is about. It's so wonderful because it keeps us training, keeps our skills sharp, but it also has lots of fun in community and training together. And even though we get older, we're still having a great time training together. Why? Because federalized law enforcement, federalized military is illegal in the Kingdom of God. The kings and the priests, the queens and the evangelists, WE are the police and we are the military. It is not centralized. It's the decentralized Rod of Iron Kingdom. That's freedom and responsibility, but that whole kingdom, that whole community is about transcending tribalism, transcending different races, transcending you like your neighbors or not. No, it doesn't matter whether you like your neighbors or not; you still got to work with them in the Peace Police- Peace Militia. You got to still train with them. You're still on the same team.

It's like the 2A (2nd Amendment) community, right? In the 2A community, we have black, white, Asian; we are this and that, but still, we're on the same team when it comes to 2A. Same team in terms of defending a person's right to self-defense; that's the same team. We can differ on theological issues and on all those kinds of things but we're on the same team.

In the Kingdom it's the same, in Peace Police - Peace Militia too. We may have differences in theology in some areas but we still train together. We're still a neighborhood; we're still a community. We still are the decentralized police and militia. We still are the shepherds of our home and our neighborhoods. We are actualizing those biblical principles, not in our brain only, but also in our training, our daily life, and in our community life, with other people in our community. We are not islands.

The Westernized individuated atomized culture is collapsing before everybody's eyes. Everybody's realizing, "*No, you got to have a tribe.*" Tribe is so important, but the tribe doesn't have to be based on race and skin color. The tribe is based on the man Christ. That's what ties us together; that ties us together as a brotherhood. Then the Constitution on the macro ties us together as a nation. You see that, folks? But you see now in this modern landscape, the old Protestant prophetic traditions are collapsing; they're being exposed. And only the Divine Principle can explain the dual nature of both the Old Testament and the New Testament prophecies. That they can be fulfilled depending on human free will. That's the KEY ingredient; whether or not human beings will be obedient to God, and whether or not they will serve the Lord and serve Christ.

By the way we saw that scripture in **Isaiah chapter 53 verse 8** with the word *lamo*
⁸ ... *for the transgression of my people was he stricken.* Whereas it said, *for the transgression of my people were they stricken.*

The Jewish people actually were expecting not only a singular king but they were also expecting a plural. What is a plural? Are True Parents singular or plural? Plural. Adam and Eve, were they singular or plural? Plural. The initial ideal of creation, man and woman, is that singular or plural? Plural? So, there is nothing in the Hebrew Bible that prohibits the Messiah from having a wife and children. In fact, it's expected.

He Already Came

Oh my gosh! Now, I'm in trouble. Now I'm in trouble because I said that. That's why Protestants say I'm a cult leader, because we actually preach what the Scriptures say. No, there's nothing wrong with that. He's supposed to see his seed. He's supposed to see the prolongation of days. He's supposed to see the generations. You see? However, if the people fail, he can go the way of the cross. But in the end God's Kingdom WILL be fulfilled. Why? Because he said he will be back. Amen!

The prophets say, "*He's coming soon.*" Oh, you're too late. He already came! It's not a seven-year tribulation; it's a seven-period tribulation. We talked about that many times with the 70-year period of communism right at the time of the world government. When True Father comes on the scene that's the first time in world history that the world government is actually created. It's called League of Nations, after World War I. World War I creates the world government. You're only seeing that metastasized today explicitly because of the failure of the Han mother. Before,

it was hidden but you're seeing it because it's being exposed. The covid crap tyranny that happened worldwide, now people actually admit that it existed. But it didn't just happen three years ago; it didn't all of a sudden formally happen three years ago. It's been going on since the end of World War I with the League of Nations which metastasized into the UN. Father called the UN, SATAN's UN! Because you're all trying to use it to tax everybody in the world with the freakin' carbon tax! To steal from people. Just last week, the Rolling Stone magazine published another article on True Father. Do you know about that?

We don't buy that climate change CRAP and the COVID mandates and all your crazy tyrannical lockdowns! Yes! You're giving credit to where credit is due. It's not Mitt Romney! It's not Alex Jones! It's Reverend Sun Myung Moon who was the one fighting the Left and the liberals and putting his money where his dang mouth was. While they were attacking him, calling him cult leader and demon, he was doing the work of the Lord. Amen!

And Rolling Stone feels like they got to write about it. This came out August 20th; that's seven days ago. They still got Reverend Moon on their mind! You understand what I'm saying? After the person went to Heaven, eleven years later, they're still traumatized. Give me a break! Praise the Lord Almighty folks. It's an incredible time to be alive.

That's what I'm saying, folks; it's an incredible time to be alive because now Father is the only one who fulfilled the prophecies. But it's an incredible time. People are waking up, folks. These 100-year-old prophecies that they've been peddling for dozens of years, they're collapsing, collapsing. People are starting to

realize the truth about dual prophecy; people realize that free will is a critical aspect of providential history.

Pray for Uncle Trump

At this stage, even though God has already won the victory and Cheon Il Guk is coming, we can either accelerate it or decelerate it. That's why 2024 is so important. We got to fight hard, get the macrocosmic king and priest Trump back in office. We got to get him to destroy the deep state apparatus, and tear it apart from within. And he can't tear it apart just by changing the heads as he did last time. Remember, like the Department of State and the Department of Defense? These are just the heads. You can't do that.
