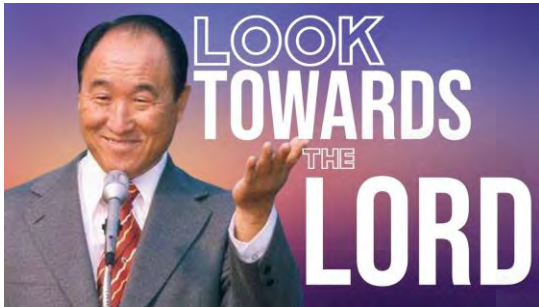

Look Towards the Lord

(Applause) Oh, please, folks! Please, please. Big shout-out to our Pennsylvania and Tennessee crews and to all the volunteers from all around the area, for a successful fifth annual Rod of Iron Freedom Festival, folks. Amazing! *(Applause)*

We had a wonderful Blessing back down in Tennessee on the 14th, commemorating Father's supernatural escaping from the Hungnam concentration camp. Father spent two years and eight months from 1948 to 1950 in that death camp under North Korean occupation. By the Will of God, the bombs came down from MacArthur and the UN forces and blew up the buildings, and Father was able to walk out. He said to the people, *"Stay within a five-meter perimeter of me and you will survive, you will be saved."*

In the camp, there were at least thirty prisoners per cell packed-in like sardines, and of course nobody wanted to sleep near the toilet, because it was a hole with wretched feces stank coming out of there. Nobody wanted to stay in the worst spot in the whole cell. Father said, *"I'll take that. I'm the reverend. People had all sorts of dysentery, all sorts of malnutrition issues, stomach issues, terrible water diarrhea. Horrific! He would be right near the toilet with everybody packed-in like sardines, so when people had to go and do the number two nasty wet one, oh, he would get splattered. He wrote about that. But he would just continue to praise God; even though he was getting splattered by feces he would continue to praise God. That's the spirit with which Father wrote *The Blessing of Glory* which we commemorate and sing as the Cheon Il Guk anthem. That's the spirit. That's the incredible Christlike love that even in the death struggle...

People don't contextualize history so they forget. They see all these things that are happening in the modern world, such as right now President Trump becoming a federal felon for doing nothing but simply questioning the election and running, and now he's a federal felon. What people have to realize is that all our Founding Fathers were federal felons under the British. If they had lost, any one of them would have been beheaded, tortured, quartered - that's when they tie you up to horses and rip your limbs off. Every single one of them, George Washington, Thomas Jefferson; everybody would have gotten that treatment. They were federal felons. Jesus himself of course under the Roman state was a federal felon. Even Father under multiple communist regimes was a federal felon as well. Do you see? There's kind of a pattern here when the powers that be don't like what you're doing.

History Tied to One Man

It's such an incredible time right now. It's a very dangerous time for our country because we're currently in the middle of a communist revolution, and in the middle of a civil war. It is still cultural; it's not kinetic yet, but it's cultural in the current time frame. It's very heavily now in the lawfare realm of a civil war, where they're using the entire apparatus that's supposed to be fighting for justice to go after their main opponent. You see this in communist countries, folks; in communist countries, you know those very far off places that will never get near America. Uh-uh. It's here folks, it's here. It's here. And of course, if America falls, the entire world is in peril. It's not about fear-mongering, etc. People have their head in the sand; they don't want to accept the reality.

We are in the midst of a communist revolution, folks. It's the same now even though in the West, we don't like the idea that a whole nation's destiny may be tied to one man. I guess this kind of goes against our feelings of democratic principles as being supreme. But no, that's not how history works. History does not move in that fashion. It is many times tied to one man.

During George Washington's time, the destiny of America was tied to one man; one man, **George Washington** and his victory. During the Civil War the destiny of America was tied to whom? **Abraham Lincoln**; it was tied to Lincoln. If Lincoln had lost, we would have had a divided America, we would have had a split America and we would have had to wage war on the other America. You see what I'm saying? You would have had a total destiny change in history.

Same currently, whether you like Trump or not. By the way, his popularity rating is going through the roof. Democrats, rappers on the Left are coming out saying, "*Trump 24!*" (*Applause*) That's good. Micro, macro. You've got all these big black-community rappers now coming out saying, "*Trump. I'm voting for Trump. This is crazy!*" But culturally, you see the lawfare. And of course, they want things to pop off kinetically and they want things to escalate further as they start World War III around the globe.

True Father & Politics

It's a very bad time, but also you have to understand that God uses bad times to wake people up, to bring people to His Kingdom, to show them the evidence and the proof which they demand so much, "*I don't believe in you, God. Life is fine. America's fine. We're doing great. We got shopping malls, restaurants all open.*" But not anymore.

After covid and all that, and now the economic collapse and inflation, gas prices have fired up. So, not anymore. People are struggling just to have some steak once per month. Everybody's got to cut back on some ribeye, etc. People are paying \$3000 for just groceries now, \$2,500 on the lower end. But if you want to have a steak a couple of times, it's \$3000. You've got gas prices that are ridiculous, the heating costs, unbelievable, and of course with the electricity and now the cold winters, oh my gosh; everything is going up as we are getting overextended into war, and we're already at war with Russia, folks. Hello.

We're already at war with a nuclear power, thanks to the crazies in D.C., because it's not only the Biden administration, it's also the neocons, folks. Father as the founder of the Washington Times would attack the neocons; he was doing that in the 1980s. You got to remain chaste before marriage, and once you get married, then you have fidelity."* There's only one place that God designed sexuality for and that is for marriage; not for anywhere else. No boyfriend, no girlfriend, no dating sex. An unchristian culture has taken over America and we've become pagan through that. And by the church not saying anything and allowing this, look at what we've become: we've become a totally licentious culture. Everybody's fornicating so now you can't criticize the gays who are fornicating or you can't criticize the bisexuals because YOU are fornicating. You see what I'm saying? As a culture you don't have any moral high ground.

That's why in Christian history always, always, always, chastity was a critical discipline before marriage. And that's why Father always taught us so hard on the training of chastity before marriage, *"Remain pure; do not fornicate."* This was one hundred percent standard Christian culture and normal value that everybody taught until the modern period when everybody wants to get loose. No Moral High Ground in the West

If you get loose and you fornicate, if you make that fornication culture mainstream, you cannot criticize anything else; you don't have any moral high ground to criticize any other type of fornication. Then of course it leads now to what? Open pedophilia! They're

The New World Order Flag

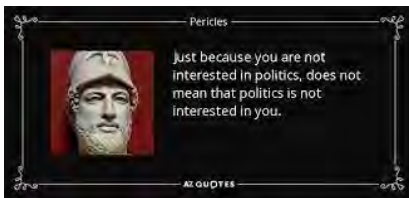

We do have to run a little early to our brother Rich Caridi's wake. Thank you, Rich. Rich was such an integral part of the Freedom Festival. He was a former commissioner of Pike County and in the beginning when we got here we were at his commissioner's meetings; we were at every meeting telling them about the NDAA (National Defense Authorization Act), the imprisonment of Japanese, and overreach of government. What's great about training? You can always improve. It's continual improvement. It's an endless continual improvement, which is wonderful. Which means it has no cap. You can always work on it. Amen! There's always hope, which is so amazing. That's a great thing about continuous improvement, mind-and-body unity, discipline and training.

Psalm 5

All right, folks, let's get to Psalm Chapter 5. This is an amazing psalm. This is a psalm about prayer, and we need prayer. We need prayer at this time, and not the type of prayer of desperation. This psalm is very interesting. Let's start at verse 1.

1 Give ear to my words, O Lord, consider my meditation.

2 Hearken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto thee will I pray.

David the psalmist is singing unto the Lord. He's praying unto God and he's saying, *"Please God, listen to me. Give ear to my words."* That means, *"Lord, please listen to me; please hear my cry."*

3 My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O Lord; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up.

This is an important phrase, *"In the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee,"* In the morning before the dew would evaporate from the grass; that time in the morning is the time to begin the day in prayer, heartfelt prayer to God. It's preparing oneself for the entire day.

What does he say at the end of verse 3? He says, *"I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up."* See, many people when they pray, they're focused on me, *"God give me this; God, Give me that. God, my knee hurts. God, my back pain; please heal that. God, my auntie, my uncle, God, my grandma."* You see what I'm saying? It's more about me.

But David is saying, *"No, direct your thoughts to God."* Why don't you think about how He's feeling today? Why don't you think about how God is doing today? Everybody has stuff to do, so before you get into your stuff, why don't you direct yourself towards Him first? He's a personal being. He's the Creator, so He's more intelligent than us. And also, He's personal, so He has emotion. Then, why don't we direct our thoughts to God?

"God, what are You thinking today?"

God, direct me to Your thoughts today.

God, direct me to Your heart, Your feelings today.

God, direct me to that sorrow that You feel when You see this country today.

But also, the hope, knowing that You're the Creator and that Your children love You."

You see what I'm saying? Many times, we get caught up in prayer and it becomes like a ritual and a petition. They call it "petitionary prayer"; it is when you're petitioning God for something, *"I need this, God; I need that, God; I need this, God; I need that God. Give me a white car, give me a Lamborghini. Give me ..."* Oh my God! Don't do that! Please don't be doing that. Okay? That's no good! The law of attraction stuff, that's just materialism. God is not about that; He doesn't need any Lamborghini. He made the whole dang universe; He made planets, stars, galaxies, Milky Way. Lamborghini is a joke; it's a joke. Compared to the genius of God, a Lamborghini or Ferrari is a joke. It's pathetic, it's terrible comparatively.

When we pray with God, as Psalm is talking about, *"Direct your prayer towards Him in the morning."* We have a tendency to want to get into our stuff because it feels more personal; it feels like God is listening to us, etc. But the psalmist is saying, and Father talked about it many times, that in our prayer we have to think about GOD's heart first. We got to think of GOD's pain and suffering first. We got to think about all the times that He was let down too. Obviously, we can't stay there, but we have to at least sense that first. That has to be on our mind.

If He's your Father and you love Him, as soon as you open the door and see your dad, it's not about saying, *"Dad, give me the coconut juice and give me this and that. I want two eggs with bacon. I want an egg McMuffin. I want a bagel with everything on it. But you know, I want to lose some weight, so can you dig out the center a little bit and then I can take a lower carb intake in?"* Okay, folks. Daddy's like, *"Child, I just got out of my bed, and you're asking me for the bagel with the works in."* Are you with me, folks? Better if your daddy comes out, *"Oh father, what a beautiful day! What do you intend to do today, father. Let me hear about what you desire today, father."* That's a different child. And his dad says, *"Oh, this child actually cares about me."* There's a difference.

In our prayer life too. This is what this Psalm is reminding us of. It's important. We got to get back to learning how to pray, because many times we don't know how to pray. We may recite something like that, which is a good beginning point, but also there has to be a heartistic development, a spiritual development, and this is what this Psalm is talking about, *"Direct your hearts toward God; direct your thoughts towards Him. See how He's doing today."* Amen! See how God is feeling and thinking today after He saw massacres in Israel or the bombings in Palestine. You know what I mean?

Now In the Middle East

By the way there is a difference between the Judeo-Christian worldview, the Islamic worldview or other worldviews. The Quran for example teaches that you are to hate the unbelievers. There were successive revelations and anything that was revealed later by Muhammad, supersedes the earlier passages. So, for example, any of the controversial killing passages against infidels, Jews and Christians, come later. Before Mohammed took over Medina and gained power, he was talking about peace, *"Peace, peace, we have our religion, you have your religion."* Those are called "the peaceful verses."

But the problem with the successive-revelation system is that the later revelations supersede the former. You see what I'm saying? These are problematic issues. There are experts on the field like David Wood <https://acts17.com/>, like Sam Shamoun <https://apologetics315.com/tag/sam-shamoun/>, and all sorts of great apologists online, that I highly recommend you follow.

Look at Europe, folks. One person out of four is now from Islam in European countries; one out of four. You're going to have a fundamental shift in everything culturally. For example, antisemitism will rise; it will, it will rise. You see that now across the West; the Jews are not getting the support they thought they would be getting. You see pro-Palestinian stands everywhere in the public-school systems, *"Take Israel out. We will have Palestine from the land to the sea."* Which means what? We're going to wipe out Israel.

We condemn the genocide that is happening in the Middle East; there are no innocent players there. This was a terrible situation where Hamas came in. Even though you can't get into the Iron Dome with missiles, somehow, they parachuted in. Israel is about the size of New Jersey by the way and it has military bases within five or ten minutes of that concert, but it took seven hours to get there. Oh, come on! Come on! Don't give me this kind of stuff. We're not stupid. We can see it online. Governments do terrible things to create war propaganda and to perpetuate evil and their system of control and power, like sucking us into the Gulf of Tonkin in Vietnam, which is declassified information. Many times, citizens have absolutely nothing to do with it. Governments do ridiculous stuff.

So, it's not just like it started with Israel and I'm going to repeat all the war propaganda. Are you kidding me? It's not that simple. This is what Tucker Carlson is saying, *"It is not that simple; it's not just a good guy and a bad guy."* In wartime usually both governments are bad and they're using the people for monetary profit. THAT'S the reality of war; there's no purely good and purely bad. Come on! They don't want people to have this level of sophistication because if people understand they will not support these crazy endless wars.

About the situation in the Middle East with Iran; people don't understand the biblical history that Iran is the major civilization of the Middle East, folks. You understand? It was Persia; the Persian Empire, Median Persia also Persia. These are major civilizations, as prominent as Rome. The Middle East was usually dominated by the Persian culture and then what happened? The Arab culture especially with Islam was pushed out to the edges of culture.

In the early 1900s, the Arabs, especially Saudi Arabia, got the support of the West and the different banking institutions like the Rothschilds, etc., and the petrodollar was created. Well, all of a sudden now, they want to always wage war on Iran, which is the main civilization in the Middle East. Hello? It's got the largest historical monuments, massive buildings, archaeological sites. You understand? It's the major civilization.

People in the West have no idea about this. They just think, *"Oh, it's one country we should just get rid of."* You can't get rid of a civilization that's been there for thousands of years! It's not that easy. It doesn't work out like that in black and white. Look what Iraq and Afghanistan have done. You've strengthened the Taliban there. You understand folks? It's not that simple.

So now the calling of, *"Hey, let's go to war. Let's blow up the entire Palestinian region because there was never an actual civilization that was called Palestine. The Palestinian name was given to the Jews by the Romans to spite them."* They were naming the Jews basically the Philistines who were their enemies. It's a long history, but the Jews of course have been historically in that region. The argument is, *"Well, Palestine is not really a nation. It's never had a flag until the modern period etc."* You understand? This is not easy to sort out quickly. And it's certainly not easy for pastors to get up there and just say, *"Get rid of everybody in Gaza. Every single one should be blown up."* I REBUKE that type of pastor! I've seen some pastors do that, just following the Israeli propaganda.

Before we start World War III in the Middle East, why don't we answer the question, *"Hey, how the heck did these guys parachute in like this? When you've got a military base ten minutes away, how did they go on a killing spree for seven hours without anybody coming to stop them?"* Why don't we answer some basic questions before we jump into more wars? By the way, just a reminder, we're already at war with the Russian superpower. Hello! We kind of don't want our kids to be tossed in the meat grinder; I kind of don't want my

grandchildren to be tossed in the meat grinder to make these ridiculous politicians rich like Dick Cheney got with Iraq.

Remember how True Father was so against the Iraq war after 9/11 because he had no proof of the Iraqis doing it. Sixteen of the hijackers were Saudi Arabians. Hello? Sixteen of the hijackers are Saudi Arabians and now you want to blow up another country? And then when you blow it up you have companies like Halliburton which is run by Dick Cheney going there making billions of dollars. Are you kidding me?

America Used to be the Good Guy

And you're telling me this is all because of weapons of mass destruction? So how all of a sudden are we supposed to believe everything, that the pathological lying 666 Beast system is saying about this Middle East conflict in its simplistic black-and-white format? The majority of people who still watch Fox, you just said for the last three years that you didn't believe the government, and that the deep state was real. Now you want to BELIEVE everything the deep state says because they put an Israel flag up. Come on. Are you kidding me? War is not that simple. It is not that simple and there are many casualties of war, most of which are the innocent people.

There are some basic questions to be answered before we get thrown into World War III and another giant war in the Middle East. AND now they say that we should take on Iran; that's 90 million people. Do you understand? You could not even take out Afghanistan; how are you going to take out Iran, while we are waning in military power AND we're at war with nuclear Russia AND China's going to take Taiwan, which has 90% of our microchips by the way. What is happening, folks? You're seeing members of the Right and the Left starting to have empathy for one another. Not just seeing us as football teams, "*you're blue and I'm red,*" New York Giants versus the Jets. This is simplistic, foolish thinking. Warfare is not simple; it's sophisticated. Isn't it interesting that now these different factions of civilization that may have very different worldviews are starting to realize, "*Wait a minute, we may have to stand together with Trumpers against what the state is going to do.*"

Now, could this be a Fed op? Sure, it could be. Just as the Democrats ran the Ku Klux Klan, we know they run BLM; could they be doing this to lure patriots in, give them false hope like Q? On The Founding Fathers

So, you're seeing a different type of unity. People forget. Look the Founding Fathers they didn't all get along, some of them hated each other; they wanted to have duels to kill each other. War makes strange bedfellows. Samuel Adams was a mob boss. Hello? We got him looking all like dapper and cute on a beer can, etc. The guy was a mob boss. He ran the Massachusetts Harbor; he was running the liquor. He was the Al Capone of MA. He was killing people; he was whacking people. He was running the drug smuggling. That's one of our Founding Fathers. They were not all these educated British aristocrats from the University of Cambridge and Oxford. No, some of them were mob bosses killing people, whacking them. Boom! You see these strange bedfellows.

What people don't realize is that when the Founding Fathers talked about the Second Amendment, it was to have an armed population. Not so that they can just go hunting or fishing or sport shooting with the gun, but so that if the government is tyrannical and is trying to oppress them, they have the means to fight them. The Founding Fathers understood that the only way you throw off a tentacled octopus that tries to eat you and all your children and keeps coming at you is through having such military power. There's no other way to get this octopus off you.

That's what they decided in the Revolutionary Period with Britain; they decided to fight the octopus of the British Empire. By the way, the most organized and powerful empire in its day lost to a band of wacky farmers and blacksmiths, with some intellectuals and some mob bosses all banding together, fighting with muskets. They lost to these guys. Huh? Which shows what? It shows that just because you have organized military power... There are strengths and weaknesses to that kind of system. I want to bury you, red coats."* See, they had a different view. They were more like the Afghanistan fighters, the guys high in the mountains in caves with booby traps. They're not playing by your rules. You don't get to come in and say (With British accent), *"Yes, we want to fight you. Line up on this field. We will designate ten, twenty, thirty odd markers and we'll have a nice game of football over some tea."* NO! We don't want fish and chips, we want fried chicken; we don't want your tea, we want coffee. We're going to fight you boy!

People don't understand. A certain type of unity is created that is very strange. They say poetically, that war creates strange bedfellows. That's what they mean. During Civil War you see the radical wing of the anti-establishment parts of both the Right and the Left actually starting to hold hands. That's historically the case. That's why, for example, governments are very interested in controlling both elements of the radical Right and the radical Left, because they want to use them many times for controlled opposition, to fight one another, to start stuff off for political advantage.

That's what the FBI has become; it's become a totally corrupt organization that is now going after the president. Nobody believes in it anymore. Everybody knows those institutions are 97% run by the radical Left and are being weaponized to prosecute an innocent man who's trying to run for president, trying to turn on the oil, trying to help the American people bring the gas prices down and stop World War III. ³ My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O Lord; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up.

There are studies that show what happens physiologically when you look up. What happens? You take an in-breath. Did you know this? Go ahead and look at the ceiling, everybody; go ahead and you'll notice your body naturally wants to breathe. When you walk into the Vatican or into Orthodox churches, you have big murals on the top ceiling because they want you to walk in, look up and go, "Wow!" Isn't that interesting? There's something about the gesture of looking up; it's acknowledging we're not the top; there's Somebody who's on top and it's not me. Amen!

Sometimes when we pray, yes, we want to go down there and kneel, etc. But David is reminding us, "No, no. In the morning you got to pray, to think about God's heart and how He feels today and you look up." He said, "Look up." Isn't that interesting? Remember that's where you're getting your inspiration from. It's from above you. It's like if we were just praying looking down, and searching, "Where's God? Is He under the cushion? Where is He? Under the bed?" It's like you see your father sitting at the kitchen table, "Hello Dad, how are you doing today?" and Daddy will be, "What are you doing looking at floor, boy? I'm sitting at the table."

David is bringing us back to that, "In the morning you meditate on God's Word, you go try to feel His heart; you try to feel what He wants today for you, how you can be returning Him joy. And look up. Look up towards the Heavens. Look up to the clouds. Look up to this beautiful canopy of glory." The Bible talks about "All of creation sings the glory of God. The heavens declare His majesty." It talks about that. That's why it's important to actually be looking up towards heaven, "God, give me wisdom, give me grace, give me knowledge today. Let me move with Your Providence. Let me move with Your guidance today." We're not looking down ant holes, we're looking up towards the sky, towards the beautiful majesty of God and to all of creation singing His praise.

So, there are interesting points in Acts Chapter 5; interesting points for our prayer life. We got to remember that in times of craziness, our prayer life has got to be rich, folks; it's got to be rich. We've got to always pay attention, tend to our prayer life, because that's the power by which we get through this tumultuous, crazy, insane time. It would be nice if we could just stick our head in the sand and hide, but it's not happening.

More and more people are waking up. It's becoming more and more obvious how evil and corrupt this system is, and even more obvious how much they want this country to be dead and Trump to be destroyed. They may imprison him; they may kill him in prison. We'll be facing serious historical events in the next year; we don't know what's going to pop off. You know they're going to get Antifa and some groups of BLM. Just because one leader comes out and says he's supporting Trump, they don't all do. So, you're going to start seeing all sorts of factions and all sorts of craziness happening. You know what I'm saying? We can't look at this just black and white; it's very sophisticated.

In the midst of that we can get caught up in the chaos and the craziness of it, but that's why we have to tend to our prayer life, because that's the sanity. That is the rock and the foundation of our daily power and life. Amen! So, we got to direct our hearts toward Him, and daily repent of our sins. Repenting of our sins is important. It means, *"I'm not the center, God. I'm sorry for always thinking about me. I'm going to think about You. Chastise me the way You need to. Burn away whatever needs to be burned away."* Amen! That's a good prayer. *"Let me be a pure thing. Let me not be deluded. Don't let me repeat the same delusional stuff to myself. Kill those thoughts; kill those justifications. Let me see the nastiness of my own sin. I repent. I repent. I repent. I direct myself towards You. Lead me dear Lord. Lead me. I look up. I look towards You."*

God's Patience

⁴ For thou art not a God that hath pleasure in wickedness: neither shall evil dwell with thee.

⁵ The foolish shall not stand in thy sight: thou hatest all workers of iniquity.

⁶ Thou shalt destroy them that speak leasing: the Lord will abhor the bloody and deceitful man.

It's interesting, he talks about God hating the workers of iniquity. When you study providential history, we see that God is very patient with people. He will wait many times hundreds of years of them killing babies, doing child prostitution, worshipping demon goddesses that are saying, *"Kill your babies and sell your children into sex trafficking,"* with the temples of Ishtar and all these kinds of things. This is literally child prostitution; in the ancient world it's called temple prostitution. These are hallmarks of ancient civilization.

The Jewish-Christian God is the first one in all of antiquity, all of the ancient world to condemn and stop the sacrifice of babies. It's a post-abortion system because they couldn't kill it in the womb back then. But burning the children on the fires of Moloch, God condemns that. All types of sexual depravity including bestiality, all is condemned. Children being exploited sexually, condemned. Everything is condemned. It's a very unique feature of the Judeo-Christian God.

From the ancient world, whether it be the Assyrian or Babylonian culture, we have receipts of parents selling their children into child prostitution. Also, in the Babylonian

culture the virginity of young girls had to be taken by strangers who would deflower them. Imagine that? What are you doing? You're destroying these people. You understand? The parents have become so indoctrinated with paganism and this demonic culture that they're giving their daughters to the temple prostitutes to have them deflowered by strangers on the particular Babylonian day of fertility. Any random man can walk up to the temple; there are lines of girls and the one he chooses is the one he's going to deflower. And she's got to be okay with that. You understand how demonic that is folks. Hello?

That's the type of culture you're dealing with and God had to endure this for hundreds of years as people kept on perpetuating this until God dropped the hammer. So, yes, God hates the workers of iniquity, but many times He exercises tremendous mercy and patience, given the amount of evil that people are doing. We see that God is patient. He's forbearing, but he does hate evil. He does hate evil; that is true.

God of Love

⁷ But as for me, I will come into thy house in the multitude of thy mercy; and in thy fear will I worship toward thy holy temple.

⁸ Lead me, O Lord, in thy righteousness because of mine enemies; make thy way straight before my face.

That is the difference between the God of Islam or the different pagan gods and the God of the Bible. Who is the God of the Bible? He is centered on love. The preeminent virtue of the God of the Bible with the inclusion of the New Testament is that God is the God of love; that is the preeminent difference. It's not the God of power. It's not the God of knowledge. Even though God is omniscient, that is not His highest core; that is one of His traits, but not His essence. The Bible says that the essence of God is love, agape love.

And this is the difference between the civilizations. Christian civilization is never perfect, but it should be striving to be a civilization that is strong and also is fundamentally rooted on love. On the other hand, if you are fighting your enemy in the Islamic worldview and other worldviews, you destroy him; you have total animosity, total hate towards them.

The Christian worldview is: if there's a just war and you are fighting somebody, you have to fight them in order to stop their evil and wickedness. But, your fundamental nature towards the person, towards the spirit or the soul of that person cannot be of hate. You understand? You may have to fight somebody to stop them from committing genocide on your children or whatever the case may be, but God calls you to not hate their soul. He calls us to desire even for the most wicked to be saved through Christ and repentance.

That level of transcendent love is unheard of in the ancient world because we're dealing with tribalistic religions, religions that are tribal with in-group, out-group preferences. God loves only who is in in-group. Islam definitely has elements of this and Judaism also. In-group, out-group preferences are big. So, God loves his in-group, but He hates his out-group.

That is not the Christian worldview. The Christian worldview is God loves His in-group, and He also loves the out-group. He wants them to come to repentance, yes; He's not going to love them in all the evil they're doing, no. He wants them to come to repentance, but in the end, He cares for their soul. You understand folks? That aspect of the fatherly transcendent love brings to tempering, the tempering of the hatred of the human heart. For, if we're just involved in winning and gaining power, we will start harboring hate as part of our fundamental being. Do you see how that works? Anything stopping your way towards that, you got to hate it, and you got to destroy it. That's starting to sound a lot more like what? Marxism? Communism? Atheism?

What is it that differentiates the Christian worldview from those things? The fact that it's fundamentally based on the transcendent nature of God, the transcendent love of God, which tempers our desire to become like Cain and to hate, to want to murder and to get revenge. You understand? It tempers that. It says, "*that's not the center.*"

That's why if Christian civilization takes root, it provides a much better safe haven for civilization and the fostering of, for example, in the modern period with the Founding Fathers, the human rights that come from God. A God of love, by the way, a God that loves us and thus has imbued us with these inalienable rights which can't be taken away by anybody. It's not like He has some kind of contractual agreement with us, that He doesn't love us and He kind of just throws His rights at us. No, He loves us. We are made in His image; we're His children. That's why we are given these inalienable rights. This is on the foundation of John Locke who was one of the early Founding Fathers' most quoted author after the Bible. The Founding Fathers quoted the Bible the most, but John Locke was one of the main religious philosophers that illuminated and formed their worldview of human rights.

Back to the Father & His Masculine Culture

There's a problem with that; we can go the opposite way and we can only focus on love, love, love, love, love and then become very weak- which has happened to the church in America and in the West. We've forgotten that it's a FATHERLY type of love. It's not a goddess type of love, it's a fatherly type of love; it is the shepherd like love. So, it has to remain strong like the Father; it has to remain very masculine like the Father but it has to be rooted in love. It has to be rooted in love.

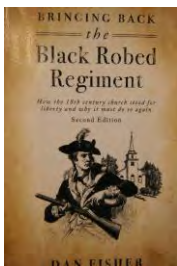
That's why with the Rod of Iron Kingdom and the Rod of Iron Freedom Festival, we're trying to call back Christianity, *"Come back to the Father. Stop embracing this effeminate form of Christianity. You have to go back to the Father, the Shepherd who carries the rod and the staff to beat back the wolves."* You're not following Jesus on a surfboard with a big bong hanging off his haversack. This is not California hippie land Jesus. He's the Shepherd. He's David. He fights the bears, he fights Goliath; he fights the lions. He carries the rod; he has the staff. Are you with me folks?

This is so important. We've got to get back to our prayer life and the church has got to come back to the Father. It's got to embrace the fatherly culture of masculinity. Guess what? When there is a masculine loving father, both the sons and the daughters benefit; both of them are formed in different ways. The daughters become stronger warriors, the sons become loving men who are strong but know how to use that against evil and not against innocent people.

But if we lose that nature of God and He becomes hippie Jesus who gives you mushrooms every time and is basically drug dealer Jesus, this is not the way; it's going to lead to a lot of problems here. We're going to get the destruction of Western Christianity, which has happened and it's being done on purpose, through what is called the "iron triangle" of political takeover: take over the pastor, take over the politician, take over the civil rights' leader. They call it the "iron triangle" when they for example infiltrate the black community to destroy it.

Christianity has been targeted in that same realm. For example, the preachers are preaching so feminine, they can't preach against evil. They won't pick a fight with evil because they're too worried about people filling their pews or how much money is coming in the coffer. The Founding Fathers did that. The throne of Britain had a death warrant on the head of Reverend James Caldwell of New Jersey because he was criticizing King Georgie. Reverend James Caldwell came in with two flintlock muskets in his belt every Sunday to preach from the pulpit looking all dapper in his little fluffy pastor's robe; he put his loaded muskets on the pulpit and began to preach. They were Rod of Iron preachers. These kinds of guys were leading the fight to the British. And guess what? The men in the congregation were all saying, *"We're going to go with you, Pastor."*

This is incredible. Lexington and Concord were done where? In a church field; the first shots were fired in a church field.
