


Hello,

Hyung Jin Nim started the service by discussing how an ideological agenda is being imposed on our nation. Please pray for President Trump. The media didn't like that fact that True Father identified Communism as political satanism. They were calling him "Hitler," just as they call Trump that now.

Hyung Jin Nim again critiqued the Pre-Tribulation doctrine, which was popularized in the Scofield bible commentary, published in 1909. Seminaries across the United States received funding along with donated Scofield bibles. The doctrine interpreted New Testament scriptures to mean that Christians will be "raptured" away from the earth before the tribulation and return of Christ.

But if you read Matthew 24:37-49 it says that the time of Christ's return will be like the time of Noah when evil people were swept away as in the flood judgment. Those who remained were Noah and his family who had been judged to be righteous. From this we can learn that the righteous ones who love Christ will remain on earth to work with the returning Lord and the wicked ones will be "swept away." The PreTribulation teaching makes Christians weak, thinking they have no responsibility during these tumultuous times.

Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God. Therefore whoever resists the authorities resists what God has appointed, and those who resist will incur judgment. For rulers are not a terror to good conduct, but to bad. Would you have no fear of the one who is in authority? Then do what is good, and you will receive his approval, for he is God's servant for your good. But if you do wrong, be afraid, for he does not bear the sword in vain. For he is the servant of God, an avenger who carries out God's wrath on the wrongdoer. Romans 13:1-4

Hyung Jin Nim pointed out that in America, the highest authority is the Constitution, which honors our God-given rights. Government officials are supposed to be subject to the Constitution, not the reverse. If

we submit ourselves to bureaucrats who are in rebellion to the Constitution, then we will be in rebellion against God.
