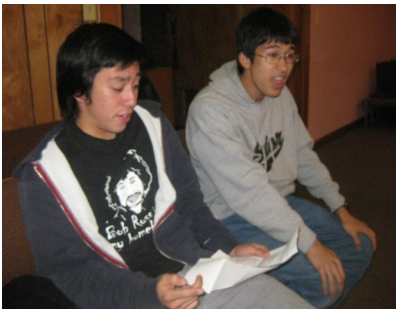

## MS Girls Group

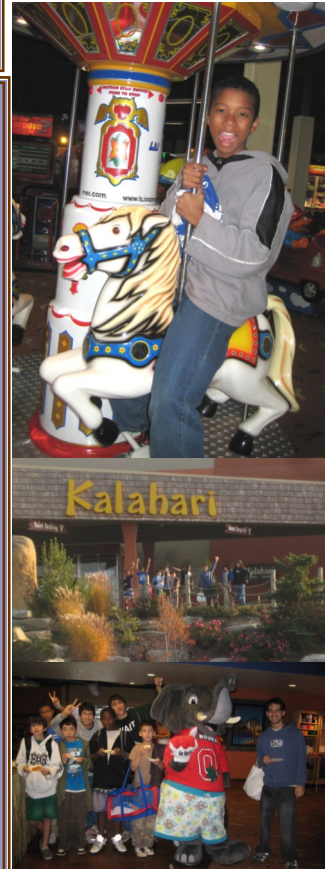
