On September 18, 1976, the Washington Monument Rally to commemorate America's bicentennial was held successfully.



This rally was recorded as the largest religious gathering in the United States. In this rally, there were the 30 thousand from the American government, religious , and journalists who deny the unification movement.



T rue Father delivered a message entitled “America and God’s Will,” and declared that God had summoned him to this country to proclaim a new revelation in order to lead the young people of America, the leaders of tomorrow, out of decadence and back to Him.

T rue Parents proclaimed the Day of Victory of Heaven on October 4 in the same year. The Washington monument rally can be the first victorious moment to proclaim the spirit world in front of the national citizens.

The Washington monument rally is the final obstacle to overcome as I realize the dream of completing the worldwide course of indemnity, which I must achieve before I turn 61. This is going over the hill of Golgotha during my lifetime.
