

## UPF-Korea Event Supports Launch of Heavenly Parent's Holy Community

Seoul, Korea -- On May 20, 2020, UPF-Korea held an event in support of an initiative aimed at building a global community of peace, harmony and cooperation, guided by universal spiritual values and principles. The interfaith initiative aspires to create a worldwide "Holy Community" under God, the Heavenly Parent. The program, titled, "Heavenly Parent's Holy Community," was broadcast live online. A total of 810 participants from diverse backgrounds, and including leaders of UPF-Korea and presidents of Ambassador for Peace Councils across the country, took part in the program, of which 700 did so virtually, following the government's COVID-19 prevention guidelines of social distancing.
