Providential Blessing Heralds Pentecost

n May 27, 2001, in the Trianon Ballroom of the Hilton Hotel in New York City, Heaven truly fired a "shot heard 'round the world.' On this memorable day in that historic location, a simple, brief, yet dignified Marriage Blessing ceremony of some 60 couples was performed, officiated by Reverend and Mrs. Sun Myung Moon in their capacity as True Parents. But Father and Mother Moon have held blessing ceremonies linking hundreds of millions by satellite, officiating from such marquis locations as Madison Square Garden in New York or Seoul's Olympic Stadium. Why did this humble, small ceremony attract media from around the world, generate front-page



news on every continent, and create a more powerful impact upon the planet than any such blessing in history?

First, it was because some 50 of the couples were in fact religious leaders: ministers, imams, and clerics; Pentecostals and Baptists, Lutherans and Muslims, Native Americans, Sufis, and more; spiritual leaders in their own right. But it was the participation of one or two such men of God that shook the world, and provided for many a new and profound understanding of the significance of the Blessing of Marriage: His Grace Archbishop Emmanuel Milingo of the Roman Catholic Church, and the Most Reverend George Augustus Stallings, founder and Archbishop of the Imani Temple African-Amer-

UNIFICATIONISM FOUNDER'S DISCOURSE ON

This is an excerpt of a sermon given on February 18, 2001 at the Belvedere International Training Center, Tarrytown, NY. The interpreter was Peter Kim and these notes were taken by Michael Kiely (NM: Lagos)

ineage took a wrong turn from the misuse of the love organ. What is the meaning of the numan fall? It is misuse of the love organ. Therefore, the lineage took a wrong turn. Without the fall, lineage and the love organ should have come directly from God.

God's attributes are eternal, absolute, unique and unchanging. Our lineage and love organs should be that way. That should be the organ God likes, not the one that Satan can interfere with and destroy. The human fall was the destruction of the lineage. The original lineage should have been a royal lineage, but now it is the lineage of

butchers. That is why they are in opposite positions.

You have many stepfathers and mothers, stepbrothers and sisters here in America. The word "step" means the lineage is mixed. Dirty water. The blood and everything are mixed there. What about your ancestors' lineage? Is your lineage crystal clean? Is it like ocean water? Or is it all mixed up? Originally, human lineage should have been like ocean water, crystal clear. But in America we see free sex being practiced. It denies original lineage. Such a society, is it God's Kingdom of Heaven? Can God dwell there?

The sexual organ is like a way to connect to continue the lineage. We talk of inheriting a lineage from thousands of generations. Within us the lineage is to be connected to another level. It is a culminating point. But is our lineage clean or mixed with the practice of free sex? Concave means shaped in a certain way. Is yours like clean water or filthy water? If we look at it in a microscope, will you see nothing or will you be shocked by seeing all the mix of dirty stuff? If we truly have a conscience, how can we go around and open our concave container to receive things? It will be so dirty.

Man's convex love organ, thousands of your ancestors culminate there. When these two organs meet together, lineage is mixed. Through that, new life is created. Do you think that new life would want to get involved in the dirty, filthy lineages of its parents? Will the newborn try to run away from this filthy abomination? "I would rather not be home," it might say.

The human being has more than 40 billion cells. Included are cells from Adam, our original ancestor. How complex we are in terms of the structure of human cells.

If you truly understand the background of the sexual organ, then as teenagers when you meet and try to make relationships, won't you be scared of and afraid of doing that? If you make a wrong move, you cannot reverse it. If you create a mixture of black and white, maybe not in your generation but down the road (a few generations) a sign of this mixture will emerge. The worst possible man and woman meet together and have a relationship, and then won't they create the worst devil? They both inherited Satan's lineage. Do vou think they can separate it from them? If you young people do something, you will create a worse thing than the atom bomb. People do not believe in their children. Even after you raise your children, you cannot control them after a certain age.

They have their own life. But when you grow up and have your own love organ without any principle, how dangerous it is. That is why Jesus said, "Repent! For the kingdom of God is here." What he meant was to repent about the false use o the sexual organ. The kingdom of God and heaven are included there. God's lineage started there but does not appear there.

In the human fall, there was false accusation. We should love our enemy, but what about our love organ and lineage. You sisters look so gentle and pretty, but your lineage is filthy and dirty. You need a blood transfusion. But there is only satanic lineage? What can you do? Where can you find God's love? That is why throughout human history God created many religions through which he trained people to receive the Lord of the Second Advent. The role of the messiah is to clean the filthy blood lineage and give God's blood to mankind.

All humans have Satan's blood and false lineage. So, someone (the Messiah) must come with the skill of a doctor to change the blood lineage. It is an engrafting process. The wild and true olive trees need a grafting process.

Even if the wild olive tree might be one-thousand years old, you can cut off the main bud and put a new bud into it. Can you see a difference between the true and wild olive tree buds? No. True religions have been opposed for this reason. They were chased out of their homes and villages. Is there only one lineage or more than one? (One) Forever. Do vou own such a lineage? What kind of lineage do you have? It is complicated. Yours is full of mud and junk. Do you think God can accept that lineage in the Kingdom of God? Can you change your lineage with lipstick and rouge? You can change your brand of lipstick (but not your lineage that way). When you are young, you may have pinkish red lips. When people die the color of their lips changes from red to blue. What about the sexual organs? Do they need makeup? How can we cleanse our sexual organ?

Nowadays people talk about cloning. If you take cells from someone, don't they contain your lineage and genes? Can you get rid of that lineage? How can we solve this problem? Even if we pluck out our eve and remove our nose and repent for thousands years, we can't do it. When we approach God with satanic clothes, can he accept us? Don't you think God can smell you? Dr. Sang Hun Lee's book says one can smell peo-

The worst possible crime we can commit in this world is adultery. The smell of an adulterer in the Spirit World will be the worst stench. Do you want to multiply this kind of lineage? (No.) No. Your conscience will say no. Do you have confidence that you can enter the Kingdom of God? Show your hands? None? Have you engrafted True Father's teaching onto yourselves? Do you believe in his teaching absolutely? Even without knowing the details? True Father started with absolute faith and prac-

Blessed couples received true lineage. Lineage is the problem, a big problem. It is a problem because of the misuse of the sexual organ. Leaving your husband and making a relationship with someone else is a big problem. Satan is like a prostitute. Don't we all have that kind of mind? Perhaps a Westerner may feel "If I sleep with this oriental man, it will be good." We all have this problem, no matter how old. Sometimes old women have the urge to live with a handsome young man. Among six billion people, there are all kinds of handsome men and women all over the world. If you become a promiscuous person, you can commit all kinds of

Unless we can overcome sexual, physical desire, we cannot be connected to God. In other words, we need God's help. Otherwise, we will fail. Sexual desire is so strong. That is how we were created. What do we need to overcome this? We need the truth, knowing that the human fall turned history upside down 180 degrees. Then we can force ourselves to overcome physical desire. Our mistake was that God has lamented for thousands of years and thou-

sands of people were killed.

Young people, we must have a clear idea where our lineage is connected. Then we will think again about what we will do? Even an old person can have such a desire. Our flesh is the base of Satan, so it is our enemy. We should absolutely center on our conscience and through it, on our mind. If we don't, we will not enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Even if you are a missionary for many years, what you receive from True Father you cannot pay for, even with the sale of your home.

When the engrafting process with True Parents occurs, you start a

True Parents occurs, you start a new olive (or apple?) tree. In the secular world people cannot forget their first love, but when you have this engrafting from True Parents, you should have the same feeling. On Fifth Avenue (in Manhattan) you will see many well-dressed ladies on the street. But do they think about their false lineage? They may have an expensive suit, but this has nothing to do with changing lineage. Neither does makeup make a difference.

What about young Americans who go to nightclubs and dance and have one-night stands? They mix their blood. Your lineage is so filthy; there is no way to clean it. When a young man appears in front of us and holds our hand and tries to make a love relationship, we know we should not make a relationship, but we are sometimes stupid.

How can you be engrafted? You cut off the branch and put a new bud there. The messiah is the first person who has successfully engrafted, sometimes cutting off hands! After four-thousand years he has finally been successful.

In order to get rid of false lineage, even if you go into a coma like a vegetable, you cannot clean

your lineage. Think how difficult it must have been to have one man, the messiah, come to clean out everything. Don't you think God would like to have cut off and made a new lineage? People repent every day, but it is impossible to have an engrafting process on their own. You were engrafted at the main bud. Clan, tribal and national messiah. This is the National Messiah branch (pointing). Cut it off. We need these levels, but we need the worldwide level to complete the engrafting process.

Suppose we did engraft at the end of the branch of an individual. Then can you walk proudly saying you have completed the engrafting process, even though your root is satanic? If the root system dies, a new tree can grow.

Without having anything to do with the messiah tree, people suddenly see the new tree and climb it and try to pick the fruit and eat it. If you are truly engrafted to the new tree, then if you remain at the tip of the smallest branch, the center of the branch, you are still connected to the root directly.

Do we have the confidence to say we have completed all the responsibilities so we can call ourselves central blessed couples? Can we say we have come through all the stages of the engrafting process successfully and can thus can call ourselves a central blessed couple? (No) If your arm or leg must be cut off, even if we must simply endure amputation, we must endure and be successful in the end. Even though True Father has taught us this truth, some people have the attitude, "Father's talk is just talk, I must live my own life."

At the end of our prayer we don't pray but report how "my" central fruit is growing. We are a central blessed family. Without learning from us, othsity. Even True Children were told not to go to graduate school (at other institutions?). One senior blessed couple disobeyed True Father and put his children through other schools. They all failed.

Even in the IMF crisis time, True

Even in the IMF crisis time, True Father built Sun Myung Moon university. Other schools reduced their scale, but Sun Myung Moon University expanded. The main campus building is currently being built. It is huge. The dorm and lab have already been built. Prestigious schools like Yonsei and others, we will see in the future (what will happen to them). We have built our schools for the sake of your children.

As parents for three generations we have to have a filtering system for three generations so we can clean up (our lineage). It is Hood Dok Hae. It is the best filter you can find. By doing Hood

grand children playing, they look like True Father. The grandchildren have no fear. They climb up and jump. Without that spirit of adventure and courage, do you think True Father would have been able to find truth? In the future what do you think will happen among all those who truly understand the truth of God and the value of the lineage; wouldn't they want to have a small branch of True Family lineage in their family? The time is coming. It won't matter if you are British, Italian or German. Those families will all want to have something to do with True Father's lineage.

Remember the blood lineage. What makes your five senses work? Your lineage. The meaning of the human fall is the contamination of the blood lineage through sexual intercourse. Because of that, God has been incarcerated for

thousands of years. The first love should be connected to God. How great and precious the Unification Church teaching is! We go beyond the concept of messiah. True Father sends blessed couples out all over the world to be national, tribal and family messiahs. How precious we are as blessed couples!

True Father is fired of Physical World, but in Spirit World everyone will welcome him. What world does True Father prefer? He can control all of the Spirit World. He holds the one key. If True Parents comes to live in your home, you may serve him well the first few days, but then you will grow tired of him. True Father has enough foundation to live comfortably. But you don't have that foundation. Can you maintain that level of comfort?

When we go to Spirit World, we want to see the reality of a great banquet with great performers and dignitaries. That kind of banquet will happen every day in the Spirit World!

Do you understand? We possess the most fearful organ, the love organ. Unless we become one mind and body, we cannot enter the kingdom of God. Even after forty days of fasting, you forget meal time. But to unite mind and body, you still cannot enter. We are still struggling

Your mind, on Sunday morning, says "I want to go to Belvedere." But your body says, "True Father won't come." Later on, if you have given into your bodily desire and you find True Father came and spoke, you will regret it. Those who have the confidence that your lineage is not contaminated at all, show your hands. No one? What shall we do? What choice do we have?

between mind and body.

If you go to a restaurant with ten of your friends, maybe the best restaurant, you should try your best to find the most humble seat out of ten. That is a 180-degree different position (from the usual attitude). If you eat all together, will your fork go to the most favorite food? Just do the opposite. Take the dish no one cares about. If you eat the worst dish, you still have a chance to eat the most delicious dish. Out of 100 people while everyone else is eating the most delicious food, you become the last to eat it and you eat the most humble food. If they see you doing that, then you will be served as the leader and will have the opportunity to eat delicious

ers cannot change. They must learn from us, our tribe and family. We must have the determination to have one nation connected to them. We must have a knife to cut off the bad lineage, even without grandparents.

People do not know how this truth was found. Has anyone imagined having a coronation of the kingdom of God? If the coronation Ceremony is true, then politics and everything else do not matter. Humankind did not know the truth. Suppose God says by radio, "I will take seven presidents to the Spirit World" and it happens; will people follow True Parents? This kind of time is coming.

True Father has done everything. He has forgiven evil spirits in Spirit World and matched them with good spirits.

What does sung hwa mean? Glorious ascension. The secular world doesn't understand this. Unification Church members are considered crazy. Secular people think we will end up in hell. ican Catholic Congregation.

These courageous men of God are both known for their willingness to stand up for truth even in the face of great adversity. They were joined on this historic occasion by such pioneers as Pastor and Mrs. T.L. Barrett of Life Center Church of God in Christ in Chicago, who were reunited after 10 full years of separation, estrangement and divorce. Their "marriage miracle" occurred during the 50-state "We Will Stand!" tour, and became a model for the healings and miracles that were to touch many families during that tour.

Rev. and Mrs. Jesse Edwards of the Pentecostals of Philadelphia, who faced severe criticism for joining hands with all faiths in the "We Will Stand! Tour, also rededicated their vows. Minister and Mrs. Benjamin Muhammad, Director of the Million Man March and the Million Family March, Bishop and Mrs. Dan Johnson, passionate leaders of Heart of Fire Ministries, and key leaders of the American Clergy Leadership Conference (ACLC) joined in consecrating their marriages in the ceremony entitled, "We Will Stand in Oneness!" Other distinguished participants included Archbishop Timothy Baymon, President of the World's Bishops Council, and former president of Guatemala, Ramiro De Leon Carpio.

Origins of this Interreligious Blessing

As the We Will Stand tour, which began in Bronx, NY on February 25th, proceeded to 52 cities across America, Father Moon's unswerving message of family and fidelity as essential to the building of God's Kingdom and the restoration of America became crystal clear. He challenged America's faith leaders to take up the mission of restoring the sanctity of sexuality and rebuilding their families and churches by example. Even as Rev. Moon confronted audiences nationwide with frank discussions of God's presence and work in conjugal love, childbirth and parenting, he firmly but lovingly prodded the faith leaders to set the standard.


Father challenged Archbishop Stallings, whose church allows married priests but who had yet to embrace that path himself, encouraging him to



complete himself by finding a wife. Pastor Barrett's testimony of meeting Father well past midnight after the Miami tour event is now famous. Father encouraged him to marry and be an exemplary leader of the family movement. He then learned of Rev. Barrett's desire to be reunited with his wife of 24 years, and after deep reflection and prayer predicted a rapid reconciliation which even Pastor Barrett had a hard time to believe, until it happened 10 days later! And in each city Father Moon challenged the pastors to be models of fidelity, faith and family.

As the Barretts' wonderful testimony spread throughout the tour, and Archbishop Stallings felt

called to complete God's love, life and lineage through marriage and family, the spirit of healing and renewal arose, touching one after the other. Additional couples in Pastor Barrett's church followed his example by reconciling. Tour



participants began to seek healing for their marriages through prayer. Through such interfaith unity for fidelity, faith and family, we felt the spiritual power being released that could even overcome divorce and adultery.

> Rev. Stallings was led to his future bride, who moved him deeply when they were introduced just before the tour. Throughout the busy tour others tried to encourage him in one way or the other, or to prevent the budding interest from being a distraction. Meanwhile, the Archbishop offered the relationship to God, confident that if Father Moon was truly anointed by the Lord to bless marriages, that he, too, would see the hand of God in this relationship. Sure enough, despite many potential brides and possibilities, both Father and Mother zeroed in on the very woman that Rev. Stallings felt God had led him to. Through Father's serious questioning, and Mother's loving preparation, the new couple felt lifted up and embraced by True Parents' love.

> As plans proceeded for Archbishop Stallings' wedding, the word spread and others emerged

who sought the guidance and support of Father and Mother Moon to bless their marriage. Plans were changed to include 3 couples, then 12...no...let's have 21! How about 36? Ok, 40! But the number of couples seeking to participate in this truly international, interracial, and interreligious ceremony continued to mushroom as the wedding day approached.

A Providential Participant

As the plans for the ceremony developed, there were some who inevitably thought of Archbishop Emmanuel Milingo, who had offered prayers and blessings at previous ceremonies, but who as a Roman Catholic had stayed well clear of any idea that he himself would marry. Some who knew him reached out to Rome, but His Grace was nowhere to be

found. Suddenly, we found that he was already in New York! And his disposition toward the Blessing was dramatically different. We felt the hand of God moving deeply and silently in this situation.

Archbishop Milingo is a devout Roman Catholic, celibate all his life, who prays the rosary for the Holy Father daily, and has a profound awareness of the spiritual world. Each day, when he says mass, at the sacramental moment when Christ enters the Eucharist, the 71 year-old prelate experiences the Lord's presence and communes with him. Despite the fact that his gift of healing was rejected by church authorities, while he was scandalized, exiled from his diocese, and finally prohibited from virtually any expression of his charism, he remained faithful to the church and ecclesiastic authority. His Grace notes that his mission from God, to heal the sick, cast out devils and preach the Kingdom of God, is nothing different than Jesus commissioned his apostles to do in Luke 9: 1-2. He correctly points out that the Bishop's commission is indeed inherited from the apostles. But he has been castigated, humiliated, and "made a stranger and a fool in the church that I love."

But the Archbishop's loyalty is to see **BLESSING** on page **5**

Jesus and the Blessed Virgin first and foremost. After careful review of the Principle, and reflection upon God's purpose, His Grace came to see the holiness of sex, and the sanctity of marriage. Where he had once seen sexuality and spirituality in conflict, and thus embraced celibacy as the loftiest spiritual path, he now felt a higher calling to embrace God and reflect His nature through fidelity. In a press conference after the ceremony, the Archbishop explained how God's nature is completed in the union of man and woman, and how the two become, "flesh of my flesh, and bone of my bone." He compared the presence of God in the union of husband and wife to the mystical presence of God the Father in the trinity, in the union of Jesus and the Holy Spirit.

Despite Archbishop Milingo's humility, grace, and purity of heart in expressing his choice to marry, this unheard of act by a bishop of the church previously sworn to celibacy has turned the religious world, and the Catholic world in particular, upside down and inside out. Emails have poured in to his newly established website at www.archbishopmilingo.org. Many have praised his courageous stand, claiming that the church must change in response to the times. Faithful Catholics ask how could he have forsaken his vow, why did he not seek a dispensation to leave the priesthood and then marry, and how could he have gotten mixed up with Reverend Moon?

But most seem to miss the deep message that Archbishop Milingo is conveying through his public act of marriage, or his own sense of stepping up to a higher calling, rather than forsaking a vow for personal fulfillment. The Italian media quotes church authorities that claim he is brainwashed, kidnapped, or somehow controlled. The Archbishop calls such claims "rubbish... to discredit me and to avoid the issues I am raising." Meanwhile members of the three orders founded by the Archbishop write of the struggle to find their way amidst confusion, derision and shame. Some send letters placing a curse on those who led the Archbishop astray. Others even prayed before that either the Archbishop or Rev. Moon would die before the wedding.

Standing in Oneness

Tremendous support has come from various quarters. Archbishop Stallings, whose marriage caused a media frenzy in Washington, DC, has joined Pastor Barrett and others in support of Archbishop Milingo and his new bride. At a gathering of clergy and press conference in Chicago, Monsignor Milingo professed his undying Catholic faith, pointed out the significance of the unity of African and African-American religious leaders, and challenged the clergy here to fulfill America's destiny as the second Israel. "We must vindicate the blood of Jesus!" he cried. Invitations from churches all over America are pouring in, seeking the deep teaching and powerful healing ministry of the African

It is reported that more than 100,000 Catholic clergy have left their clerical roles in the last 25 years, mostly over the celibacy issue. Thousands more are secretly married, even as sexual


scandals, lawsuits and rumors have plagued the clergy who remain. Archbishop Milingo has said he seeks to bring honesty and healing to the sins within the church, and restore the dignity and calling of those who have been shunned due to marriage. More and more of these "expriests," as they are called, have reached out to connect with the Archbishop. Others write encouraging His Grace to ordain married priests. He has so far rebuffed such calls. He has reached out privately to the Vatican and the Holy Father, seeking to find the way to pursue God's calling and fulfill his gift as a Roman Catholic.

Media Frenzy

More than 40 media outlets covered the wedding ceremony, and the powerful press conference that followed. The Italian press went wild, as did many in Europe, where Archbishop Milingo has a large and faithful following. The American press was similarly vocal: "Maverick Archbishop Weds in Manhattan," "Wedding Highlights Celibacy Issue," noted the headlines. With a cover photo of the "kissing cleric," the New York Post compared the Archbishop's action to others who faced censure for challenging the church to change, such as Martin Luther and Galileo Galilei. Front page articles ran in Brazil, Argentina, Columbia, and across Latin America. African papers followed the story closely. Even the Korean media was buzzing. Meanwhile, the Archbishop's statement has been translated into many languages. He has been interviewed by CBS's 60 Minutes, Fox network, NBC, ABC, and many international media as well.

s a Catholic baptized in infannation in 1958, I have lived celibate life, and tried to serve God with my whole heart, preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and minister to His people. In the process, I have faithfully served the Catholic Church as Curate, Parish Priest, Archbishop of Lusaka, and Special Delegate for Migrants and Itinerants, among others. I have never sought any worldly station or rank, and have desired only to serve the Lord, His church and His people. The Holy Spirit has been my comfort and counsel, and the Lord Jesus and the Blessed Mother have shed light on my path. I am especially grateful to the Holy Father, Pope John Paul II, whose encouragement, acceptance and support have never

Now, at 71 years of age, after a lifetime of devotion to the Church and to my priestly vows, the Lord has called me to take a step that will change my life forever, which will enable me to be a vehicle of His grace and blessing to Africa and the world, but one which I expect will alter my relationship with the Roman Catholic Church as well. I take this step only in obedience to the Lord Jesus Christ, and only after many days of prayer and fasting. I suffer not for the opinions of men, and seek only to do God's will. It is important, however, that the many people in Africa, Europe and elsewhere who have trusted my guidance or been blessed by God through the instrument of my service be fully informed of my reasons and motives for this action, lest anyone seek to malign or twist my purposes for their own ends.

It is only through the command of Jesus, and the counsel and support of Reverend and Mrs. Sun Myung Moon that I take this unexpected and bold step, one that I have wrestled with in my heart for some time. Purpose of Marriage and Family

As Genesis 1:27 says, "So God made man in His own image. In the image of God he created him, male and female ..." Our

Lord affirmed this scripture when he said: "Have you not read that the one God made them male and female, and for this reason the two are to become one flesh... and what God has joined together, let no man put asunder" (Matthew 19: 4-7). He tells us that marriage itself is the fulfillment of God's purpose of creation- that since God's image is male and female, it is only as a couple that we can fully reflect His nature. After creating Adam, God said, "It is not fitting for man to be alone" (Genesis 2:18). His first direction to them was, "Be fruitful, and multiply. Fill the earth and subdue it" (Genesis 1:28)

Still, the priestly vow of celibacy has a profound meaning in the providence

of God. Our first ancestors disobeyed God, partaking of the forbidden fruit. Ashamed of their nakedness, they covered their lower parts, and hid from God. They were cast from the Garden, and their marriage and family life had nothing to do with God. Humanity has inherited the sinful lineage of these fallen parents. Jesus said, "You are of your father, the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires" (John 8:44). Because

> of the false love between men and women from the very beginning, the path of total devotion to God's service has required us to sacrifice such human desire. St. Paul explained the struggle between serving God and being married, praising those who would "refrain from marriage" (1 Corinthians 7:28-40). Jesus acknowledged those who had "...made themselves eunuchs for

the sake of the Kingdom of Heaven" (Matthew 19:12). Thus my vow of celibacy has been one that I offered with my whole heart.

With the blood of our false father, Satan, running in our veins, we cannot enter the Kingdom of God lest we be born anew, receiving the body and blood of Jesus, and inheriting God's love, life and lineage through His only begotten Son. Thus I have and will continue to celebrate mass every day of my life, for Holy Communion represents the truest and most intimate union with our Heavenly Father.

Yet God has shown me that the oneness of a Godly man and woman is a true reflection of the Holy Trinity. Just as God the Father is one with and manifested in the mystical union of Jesus and the Holy Spirit, so our Heavenly Father can be fully present in the union of a man and woman in the communion of marriage. St. Paul held up the relationship between Jesus and the Mother Church as the model for marriage (Ephesians 5:22-32). The early church, like Paul, looked upon marriage as an unfortunate necessity. Gradually, the vocation of marriage and its original, holy purpose has been resurrected. At the close of Christianity's second millennium, many in the church have realized that the sacrifice of celibate life has fulfilled its purpose. We enter the era when every man and woman is called to fulfill his or her original purpose to reflect God's image.

Sadly, many are unable to reconcile this original longing with their celibate vow, so their commitment has become a hollow shell, an unreachable standard. All manner of defilements, including unnatural lust, illegitimate children, and other secret horrors have burdened the lives of those seeking to serve Him. The increase of homosexuality and pregnancy among priests and nuns has become common knowledge. In this way, Satan's blood has continued to flow into and through God's Church. This satanic blood must be cleansed, and God's true love, life and lineage be restored. To paraphrase Paul, it is time to grow up, to put away childish things, and to face the truth not dimly, through a glass, but face to face.

I have spent my life confronting the devil. Now, by answering God's call to resemble Him fully and restore his original ideal of marriage, I pray to open the way for many others to separate them-

My Calling and Mission

On April 3, 1973, I discovered, almost by chance that I was blessed with the gift of healing. Since then, God has continued to use my gift to bless many. The

Spirit of the Lord is upon me, for He has anointed me to preach the gospel, heal the sick, and beyond my own expectation, to exorcise demons. As I obeyed God as His instrument, countless miracles took place. Thousands upon thousands were blessed through this ministry. Medical Doctors and Native Healers, alike, witnessed the power of God, and many came to the Lord's church through the preaching of the gospel and the charisma of healing. Powerful spiritual experiences took place amongst the congregation of the faithful. The Daughters of the Redeemer, The Brothers of St. John the Baptist, The Children of the Good Shepherd Jesus, and numerous ministries and missions blossomed through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. I came to know the powerful presence and work of the spirit world.

Many in the church hierarchy could not understand these powerful manifestations of the spirit, and sought to control or limit them, by restricting my ministry. In spite of my devotion to God's word, my daily offering of mass, and my commitment to the Holy Church, I was accused, feared, and slandered. In addition, I saw that the European cultural dominance of the Church had both limited the Christian message and prevented Africans from truly discovering their original value and spiritual identity. While loving the church and its tradition, I was determined to help overcome the African's imposed sense of cultural inferiority, and to bring new vitality to Christianity by nurturing it in the rich soil of Africa's spiritual heritage. This effort, too, placed me at odds with some church authorities.

My effort to fulfill the mission God has given me has been increasingly frustrated, blocked, and even sabotaged, by some in ecclesiastical authority. I was accused of all manner of earthly and spiritual evils, called to Rome, sued, questioned, examined, and isolated. Ugly rumors were spread about me. Though the concerns were answered one by one, it became clear that I would not be allowed to return to the Archdiocese of Lusaka, to serve the African people whom I love. Obediently, I have remained in Rome nearly twenty years. Although I have been prevented from saying mass in any church within the city limits, I could not abandon the call to preach the gospel, heal the sick, and cast out evil spirits. Painfully, I have become a challenge for the church that I love, and the church

that I love has become a fetter that restricts me from my God-given mission. I have wrestled in prayer, asking myself which shall prevail: my vow of obedience to ecclesiastic authority, or my pledge of obedience to God?

and protect God's church. As I have struggled between the call of God and my obedience to the church, I know that many greater than I have faced the same dilemma, from saints to reformers. Like them, I have no desire to leave the church that I love, and yet I can only follow the Lord's leading.

I pray that my embrace of God's ideal of marriage and family, my determination to follow the Lord's leading

and the call of my conscience, and my commitment to the salvation of Africa and the world will touch the hearts of the faithful, and serve as a wake-up call to the church as it enters a new millennium. Two thousand years ago the very people whom God prepared did not know the hour of their visitation. Even as Jesus proclaimed the coming kingdom and preached a new gospel, those who clung to the past named him a devil.

There will no doubt be those who claim that I have been unduly influenced by others to follow this path. For this reason I have carefully explained the past that makes this course inevitable. Some will believe that I have been converted or controlled, but I assure you, my decisions are my own. I am obedient first and foremost to the command

of the Lord Jesus Christ. In lifting up the universal ideal of the family for all humanity, Reverend and Mrs. Moon have never asked me to deny or abandon my Catholic faith. tional values of family, community, respect for elders and spirituality. It is our mission to renew that heritage, to bring the healing love of Christ, and use the building block of Godly families to rebuild the society. God has called us to bring a movement of healing and renewal, and for the continent of my birth I will invest the rest of my earthly life. I owe my life and my love to the Lord Jesus Christ, and the Blessed Virgin Mary. I offer my eternal gratitude and respect to the Holy Father, Pope John Paul II. I am and always will be devoted to the church that I love.

The same living God who has led me to a life of service to His church and His people, has now led me work with the honorable Reverend and Mrs. Sun Myung Moon. I am not joining Rev. Moon's church, for his work is not for any one church, nor any one nation, nor any one race. It is to break down the barriers between all races, nations and creeds, and realize the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth. I prayed to Jesus, and the Lord Himself has shown me that His kingdom must be realized through human hearts and hands, and must be based upon true love and true families. He has anointed this ministry and confirmed the rightness of my path. The Special Task Force (STF) Experience

earest Fathers and Moth-My name is Jimi Baughman, and I'm writing this to you because I want to tell you just a little about my experience on STF (Special Task Force). For those of you who don't know what STF is, it's basically a one to two year program that was set up by Jin Hun Nim at the request of True Father in 1994. It was designed to create "the conversion experience" for Blessed Children, where we could find our faith in God, True Parents and the Divine Principle as something real and applicable in our daily lives as opposed to something that was just spoon-fed to us by our parents a Sunday School teacher. Basically, after graduating high school, we can get the chance to do some old style MFT (Mobile Fundraising Team—I'm sure many of you parents may have a thousand different memories and stories to tell from having this kind of experience!) fundraising and we are also heavily involved in major mobilization and other church activities (one major thing we were helping out with almost full-time this year was True Father's 50-state "We Will Stand" speaking tour). Right now, we are currently

working towards growing the movement's membership through several different witnessing projects. There's quite a lot to say about STF, and even as I write I'm a little overwhelmed by how much I could express if there were words to convey how deep my understanding of God and True Parents have become, but I'll try my best.

If you have ever gone through MFT training, than you will know what I mean when I say that it is truly an awesome, soul-changing experience. I cannot even believe sometimes that I should be so lucky, spending my days so close to God out there on the front-line. Of course, many times when we are living in this way for God, it's not so easy; we have to face the reality of Satan within ourselves and fight hard in order to overcome our fallen nature, not just for one day but sometimes even for weeks, and let me tell you, it gets so challenging! So then maybe you, as the concerned parents of Blessed Children who might be considering joining STF, might be worried that your son or daughter will have to go through a suffering course on STF...maybe you have even gone through a suffering course yourself and don't want your child to go through what you had to in the past. I'll be honest with you; many times, I myself have struggled, and sometimes I have felt that truly,

this is too difficult. I'll also tell you that I know that many, if not all, of mv brothers and sisters with me on STF have felt this same way at some point or another. But I really feel that if one wants to cultivate a true life of faith, treading this thorny path is absolutely necessary. After all, for example, True Father did not become the person that could totally be one with God's heart by going through life just doing whatever made him feel good...and if he didn't struggle so much and overcome it thus becoming one with God, then where would any of us be today?

But on a more personal level, there are two reasons why I believe this path of trials and tribu-

lations that STF puts us on is so vital to the growth of our lives of faith as Blessed Children: awareness and desire. On STF, we begin to become aware of

In this way, not only can we come to understand God and True Parents' heart, but we can even be able to understand our own parents' hearts. That's something that I know all parents desire! So please, in all earnestness I ask that you seriously consider encouraging your children to join STF, because from my experience, I

can tell you that no other program has what it takes to mold us as Blessed Children into what God desires of us.



orld Peace through Inter-religious action is the long term goal of the Religious Youth Service (RYS), a

project of the IIFWP. The quest for peace is a journey, a process that requires steps which will lead to healing and reconciliation. In Australia, the path to peace and well being must go through the Aborigine people, the continent's original people. The RYS staff and an informal intercultural team of organizers decided at an IIFWP Australian Seminar in December to begin grassroots RYS programs with an Aboriginal community.

On Jan 24th 2001 more than 30 young people traveled from Sydney to Nambucca Heads (north of Sydney on



the coast) to join local Aboriginal youth in constructing a Peace Park and restoring a bus shelter while engaging in friendly dialogue and interaction. Among the participants in the five day service project were representatives from Buddhist, Christian, Moslem and Unificationist organizations. All the participants were warmly welcomed by representatives of Aboriginal spirituality along with local clergy and lay leaders from the catholic faith.

Michael Jarrett (Gunbaynggirr tribe) took it upon himself to invite RYS to the area and gain support of the

Macksville Shire Counsel (donated the painting supplies), the local lands counsel which supported by offering building materials plus the support of Abo-

riginal youth and elders. Michael commented; "There has been a lot of talk of reconciliation between indigenous Australians and other Australians but it is time to not just talk about it but to do something."

Participants worked, ate, slept and shared with each other in a way that they found themselves being woven together

minicommunity. The sharing helped break down inhibitions and provided fertile ground for friendships to grow. Most RYS projects have several notable highlights but this project had its definitive moment during the graduation ceremony and cultural program. It was during that time, as participants presented aspects of their cultural tradition through

song, dance and drama, a spirit of mutual respect and healing filled the room.

The mood of the atmosphere at the end was well summed up by the comments of participants and community members. Amanda Jarrett, Michael's eldest daughter shared: "I am more confident and have a lot of faith in other cultures after interacting with these wonderful people. I

now feel sad because I don't want them to go because I feel blessed and very close to everyone." An Irish Roman Catholic Priest serving in the district explained to staff members: "You will never know what you have done to this community, there is so much darkness here that what you did is like bringing a bright light. I cannot remember an event over the past five

years where there was so much joy in the children faces. No one got drunk,



no fighting, neighbors who don't talk

to one another are now here togeth-

er..." One Laotian-Australian partici-

n June 1st nineteen students participated in New Eden Academy's commencement ceremony. (Eighteen graduated last year.) It was a moving and beautiful ceremony attended by 150 guests, family, friends and members of the Bridgeport community. Diplomas and academic awards were presented by Dr. Hugh Spurgin, the principal, and Dr. Kyung Hee Chin, the chairman of the Board.

Chi Yun Breland and Oojin Mudgett were the co-valedictorians. Chi Yun is also the first NEA student to receive the honor of becoming a National Merit finalist. Other students who graduated in this "Class of 2001" were Jennifer Barry, Nari Baughman, Kim Buchanan, Andrew Burch, Robin Fiala, Hye Won Gehring, Romin Johnson, Lym Chang Kim, Tamayo Kumagai, David Lee, Victar Mas, Miko Nakai, Tadanari Nakata, Juhan Oppenheimer, Yemi Pickard, Karilee Rogers, and Hyo Ja Tully.

NEA is proud of the accomplishments of our graduates. Some of those participating in the graduation were juniors who had earned enough credits to graduate. By providing a larger course load, NEA has been able to help some students graduate in three years, saving time and money where possible. Many NEA students plan to spend part of their summer overseas attending a Religious Youth Service (RYS) program; others will attend summer workshops.

Internships

This year New Eden initiated a new program for seniors who had already fulfilled most of their requirements for graduation. Four students attended the autumn semester of school and then worked on an internship program during their final semester in the spring. Each of the four students worked out an individualized program which included 12 to 15 hours a week of voluntary service either for a church or elementary school. They also worked on a part-time job, and where necessary they completed an English class by correspondence. Volunteer work was evaluated and intern students were given a choice to either keep a journal or write an essay on their experiences.

Students, parents and teachers were happy with this new program and NEA will continue to develop it in future years. Teachers felt it helped deal with the common malady, "senioritis," which often hits graduating students in their final semester. In plain English, it means

College Scholarships

Hye Won Gehring received a substantial, four-year scholarship from Ithaca College. Jimi Baughman, a graduate from last year, and Gabriella Kirkley, a former student at NEA, each received a full, four-year scholarship to the University of Bridgeport.

Most of the new graduates have been accepted to colleges or plan to attend a university in the future, but not without a one year stint on Student Task Force (STF). Spending a year on STF has become for many of them a traditional next step.

Accomplishments


During the last few weeks, we have had several significant victories, which offer us a more secure future and some interim opportunities:

On June 4 our school received state approval from the Connecticut State Department of Education. The websites, science displays, and PowerPoint presentations of our students were particularly impressive during a site visit by state officials in May.

The most immediate result of state approval is that we can now apply to the I.N.S. to admit foreign student and issue I-20 forms, enabling us to recruit international students beginning as early as January 2002. We

Plans are being made for a twenty-day, summer English language program for middle school students from Korea from July 23 until August 10. So far 18 students are signed up to come. This summer program has the potential to be a regular event every winter and summer.

n Sunday, April 8th, the New Jersey Family Church conducted its third annual IL SHIM Ceremony. Even though it was raining outside, inside the atmosphere was bright and cheerful as 37 blessed children recited their IL SHIM vows and received their purity rings. This ceremony brought to a conclusion over three months of preparation and study that began with the Winter Retreat at Barrytown last December. In order to participate in this ceremony, each candidate had to:

Attend a 2-day Divine Principle workshop (Winter Retreat). Offer a 1 or 2 meal fasting condition as part of a confession/repentance condition. Attend five 2-hour preparatory classes. Complete 4 homework assignments and keep a journal where answers to homework questions and lecture notes were recorded. Complete three 2-hour service projects:

• One for their family • One for the church • One for the community. Participate in a family prayer condition for one week prior to the ceremony. Offer a \$40 donation from their own money

The Il Shim Ceremony was initially conceived to serve several purposes, some of which are listed below. These are not necessarily the only purposes, but rather only those that we have identified to date and which seem of most importance.

- · Coming of age-to recognize children who are moving from adolescence to teen years (into puberty) as graduating from one level and moving into the next. The significance of this transition is also connected with coming into a new level of personal relationship with God and True Parents; that God wishes to relate to them in more of an adult fashion, and that they are approaching the top of the growth stage in their personal spiritual development and therefore are now expected to begin to take more responsibility for their spir-
- Rite of passage—to signify that children who are participating in this ceremony have accomplished certain conditions

of faith (see above) and have committed themselves to certain ideals—such as purity and a commitment to receive the Blessing from True Parents or True Parents' representative.

• Inheritance of tradition—to signify that as blessed children, they have received

the grace of being "freed from original sin" as a result of the conditions made by True Parents and their own parents. As such they stand in a "position of grace" and therefore have a responsibility to maintain this position by keeping the tradition of faith in service to their parents, their church and community, to True Parents and to God. This ceremony signifies their personal commitment to continue this tradition.

• New Beginning—to signify that through participation in this ceremony these children graduate into a new level of life in relation to God, True Parents, their family and church community. They now have more responsibility to

set a good example for other children and show the proper standard of behavior in relation to personal and public life. Hence, by participating in this ceremony, the children should also pledge that from this day forward they would maintain all the conditions of the IL Shim Ceremony Pledge and take a more active role in their personal spiritual growth by committing to faithbuilding activities with their parents and offered through the youth ministry of their church.

IL Shim is a Korean term that means "one heart" or "one heart and mind". This term was chosen for this ceremony because it's implications for intergenerational unity and inheritance. True Parents conducted a similar ceremony called "IL



later, True Parents also conducted an "IL SHIM" ceremony (1989.6.23) to proclaim the total unity between Heavenly Father and True Parents and the inheritance of this unity by the children. This ceremony was conducted on the occasion of True Father's elevation and recognition as head

of all Korean tribes and clans. At that ceremonv. Father said that as children, we must completely remove ourselves from Satan's influence. Father conducted the IL SHIM ceremony at that time to confirm our inheritance of this special status. Hence, we chose to use the term IL SHIM due to its having been already used in True Parents family, and because it seems to be the most

appropriate term for our purpose.

Since the creation of this ceremony, True Parents have been informed of its purpose and content and have given it their complete blessing. In fact, after Rev. Yang and Rev. Hong reported to True Parents, Father instructed Rev. Yang to expand this ceremony to all the regions and even overseas. Since then, Rev. Yang has recommended that all regional leaders in the United States conduct an IL Shim ceremony on an annual basis for their middle school children. In addition, I have received requests from Europe, Japan, Korea, and South America for information about how to conduct the IL Shim Ceremony.

In conclusion I feel it is important to point out that the IL SHIM Ceremony is only a ceremony. It cannot take the place of consistent daily investment on the part of parents. No ceremony can. But I believe the IL SHIM Ceremony can help and support parents in their primary role as their children's religious educators by giving their children an additional means of faith development. In a world where we have to constantly compete for the attention of our kids (verses television, computers, school, etc.), programs like the IL SHIM Ceremony can provide a level of professionalism and communal experience that cannot be duplicated within the family unit alone. When we began this year's ceremony preparation, I told the kids that the IL SHIM Ceremony cannot give you something that you do not already have. Rather, it seeks to reinforce and strengthen your understanding and appreciation for what you have already received by birth, and to support and encourage you to begin living your faith in a new and more public way. Yes, the IL SHIM Ceremony is only a ceremony, but I think that it enabled our kids to begin seeing and experiencing their faith

> tradition in a new and more personal way; a way in which they are no longer just participating in "their parents church", but where they are inheriting and taking ownership of "their own church".

n Jan 26, 2001, my husband, Yook Bang and I were asked to attend the seminar, Dialogue and Harmony Among Civilizations sponsored by IIFWP at the Hilton Hotel. 

thus taught me something else to make me more balanced to handle this gift he gave me.


Just 2 weeks before we departed, I caught cold and it was slow to go away because I didn't have time to rest because of my schedule teach-

On to Austria by train and 10 hours of relaxation was a pleasure. The arrival was momentous because the sun was shining and the flowers so bright with vibrant color. America's Heritage of Religious Freedom

robably more than any country in history, the United States of America is steeped in a tra-

dition of religious freedom. As schoolchildren Americans learn the story of the Pilgrim Fathers' coming to this land in search of religious liberty. This origin story informs our national identity to such an extent that the ideal of religious freedom is essential to being an American. The Bill of Rights enshrined reli-

gious freedom as the first freedom. Although its record is certainly not perfect, United States is recognized as a model and leader in the field of religious liberty.

Today's convocation has, as one of its purposes to "take spiritual inventory of where the Nation stands in respect to the fulfillment of its own ideals and traditions." Where does America stand in relation to its ideal of religious freedom? The question really has two parts. How are we doing in terms of practicing what we preach? And how are we doing in terms of influencing others to put this ideal into practice?

In terms of practicing what we preach, I think we are doing very well. This was not always the case however. In our early history, the United States was guilty of serious religious freedom abuses. In Massachusetts, the home of Plymouth Rock, the Puritans expelled Baptists for heresy, executed Quakers, and

> conducted the infamous Salem witch trials. Even after the Bill of Rights became law, some states officially disenfranchised Jews, Catholics, Unitarians. or believers in native religions. Later, Mormons, Seventh Day Adventists, Jehovah's Witnesses and others suffered gravely because of religious intolerance and per-

secution. These religious minorities paved the way for the expansion of religious freedom through their legal battles. We owe them a debt of gratitude.

But even in the last century, America's record is not perfect. We should not forget that prior to WWII, this country denied a safe haven to Jews undergoing persecution under Hitler. Anti-Semitism is still a problem today in some areas. Moreover, there has been intolerance and suspicion toward Muslims and other religious groups that have immigrated to the US in the last half of the 20th century.

> The advent of new religious movements has also created challenges. The founder of one new religion. the Rev. Sun Myung Moon, was imprisoned on tax charges in the 1980s despite the objections of mainstream churches and civil libertarians alike. During the 1970s,


we witnessed the phenomenon of widespread religious kidnapping—under the euphemism of "deprogramming"in an effort to force religious believers of groups such as Scientology, the Children of God. Hare Khrishna, and the Unification Church to renounce their faith. Thankfully, the courts eventually moved to thwart this shameful prac-

So over the years, some progress has been made. And when serious harms arise, the courts have generally done a good job of enforcing the guarantees of the First Amendment. In no other country do so many diverse religious groups co-exist so freely. So in terms of how we are doing at home, I'd have to give America an A-minus. There is still room for improvement, but, especially compared to other countries, we are doing very well.

In terms influence abroad, the story is more complicated. The United States formally committed itself to leadership in this field through the International Religious Freedom Act of 1998. One good thing this did was to put pressure on Japan to enforce its kidnapping laws in deprogramming cases, for which we at ICRF can take some credit. But it has done little or nothing to influence China and Sudan—two of the worst violators—to respect the rights their religious minorities. Even in Europe, where US influence should be substantial, serious government abuses occur. To name only a few:

- France will soon pass repressive legislation to liquidate "cults"
- · Germany officially treats Scientologists as untouchables
- Several countries have created a state system that discriminates against small or new religions
- Some European governments humiliate Muslim schoolgirls by forcing them to remove their head scarves in public
- Rev and Mrs. Moon are banned from entering Europe through the actions of Germany and France under the Schengen Treaty.

So the US gets an A- for practicing what it preaches—and this is indeed the most essential part of leadership. But it gets only a C in terms of directly influencing other nations. It remains to be seen whether the new administration will do better or worse than its predecessor in promoting religious freedom abroad. In any case I hope we will all increase our awareness of religious freedom and work to encourage our government to support it vigorously both at home and abroad. ❖

New Children's Hoon Dok Books



e are happy to announce the availability of five children's hoon dok hae and study books, translated from the Korean under the direction of the Family Federation's international office in Seoul.

Three Words to Live By (Level 1), Words to Grow By (Level 2), Words to Thrive By (Level 3) originally produced by the Korean Second Generation Office and independently translated into English, share the same multiple themes (and quite a number of the same illustrations). They cover God's relationship with His children, the fall of man, the historical figures through whom God worked, and the life of faith that we need today. The content is developed and added to at each level, mak-

ing them appropriate for children from kindergarten to the later years of primary school. It includes simplified readings of Father's words, spiritual guidance, and content for thought and discussion (and even some puzzles). Each volume is organized into fifty-two lessons that can be used for Sunday school or just in the home. The books are beautifully illustrated in a colorful, animation style.

Two other companion books Living with God (Book I), The History of God (Book II),







The books deal specifically with the Unificationist viewpoint of life, and introduce the reader to concepts specific to the Principle and our understanding of the fall, restoration and blessing.


The books are widely used in Korea. In that they are translated, rather than originally written in English, they retain something of their Korean cultural flavor.

Russian Court Upholds Religious Rights

district court in the city of Nizhny Novgorod has sided with the local branch of the Unification Church in its lawsuit against the city Justice Department, which had refused to re-register the church according to the latest Russian law regulating religious activities. Attorney Galina Krylova represented the Unification Church.

Founded in South Korea by Rev. Moon, the church originally registered a local branch in Nizhny Novgorod in 1995. The 1997 Russian law "On Freedom of Conscience and Religious Associations" required all existing religious organizations to re-register by January 1, 2001. The city Justice Department sought to liquidate this religious organization by sending it two warnings and refusing to re-register it in accordance with the new law. The administration of the Nizhny Novgorod Region issued a special press statement warning citizens against this "organization with a dubious reputation." The issue became especially heated

after the Russian Orthodox Community with the support of the city administration held an inflammatory conference, "Totalitarian Sects as the Threat of the Twenty-first Century," last April. In the public statement adopted by the conference, the

A district court in the city of Nizhny Novgorod has sided with the local branch of the Unification Church in its lawsuit against the city Justice Department

Unification Church was classified as "one of the most dangerous cults." All of this occurred despite the fact that the church had originally been registered by the federal Ministry of Justice in May 1992 and re-registered under the new law in December 2000.

Instead of re-registering the local branch, the city Justice Department involved itself in a denominational dispute, publicly criticizing the church. In support of the Justice Department's position, local religious experts advising the Justice Department referred to a document entitled "Public Appeal of the Catholic Bishops of Japan," allegedly proving the non-Christian nature of the Unificationist teachings. Exasperated by the recklessness of the authorities, the local congregation appealed to the court.

Having examined the case, the court upheld the church's complaint. Prior to the church's registration on the federal level, the Expert Council of the Russian Ministry of Justice examined the teachings and practices of the Unification Church and found them compliant with both Russian and international law. Taking this into consideration, the District Court of Nizhny Novgorod found both the warnings and the two rejections by the local Justice Department to be illegal.

The District Court of Nizhny Novgorod ordered the local Justice Department to re-register the Unification Church community.

UN General Assembly President Gives Address

arri Holkeri, president of the 55th session of the United Nations General Assembly, gave

▲ a lecture February 22, on campus. The focus of his speech was on restructuring the Assembly to become more effective and to acknowledge the use for such a body, as it has come under increasing fire from the international community for being too slow and doing too little.

Holkeri, the president of the socalled Millennium Assembly of the UN, served as Prime Minister of Finland from 1987 to 1991 and has been in domestic and international politics for over 40 years. He was given an honorary British knighthood, Honorary Knight Commander of the Order of the British Empire, in 1999 for his involvement and achievements in the Northern Ireland peace process. He succeeded Theo-Ben Gurirab, the former president of the General Assem-

bly, who visited the University last year. Holkeri underlined the necessity to "open the Unit-

ed Nations to civil society at large and to have continued and enhanced dialogue with academic communities."

He affirmed that "the United Nations system needs to be strengthened and reformed to carry out the tasks entrusted to it." He sees the need to develop the core strengths of the agencies as part of his legacy.

Echoing an earlier statement issued by UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan, Holkeri said that "the United Nations has made a couple of mistakes—big ones. We can start with Rwanda and Bosnia-Herzegovina. But we have had some successes like East Timor." The former Indonesia-occupied island was reclaimed with the help of the UN Security Forces almost 25 years after troubles began.

Holkeri believes that the Millennium Assembly must spearhead the obvious need to adapt by establishing new priorities as a body, and this, he said, "requires compromise from all parties at member level." There are currently 189 member countries of the UN, and he anticipates before this year's end that East Timor will be welcomed as the 190th.

The Millennium Summit and the Millennium Charter that resulted from the summit, Holkeri said, is the third-most important document in the UN, after the Charter and the Declaration of Human Rights. The Summit called for a "comprehensive reform of the Security Council in all aspects" and for it to be "more representative of the contributing members and more legitimate."

Role of Religion in Society Draws Large Crowd

recent public dialogue on campus on the role of religion in society was very well attended, suggesting that the issues surrounding religion are very much on people's minds. After speaking at the evening forum, Fairfield University Professor Ronald M. Davidson commented on the refreshing international character of the UB community. The event was undeniably a show of the diversity UB's students and faculty, as panel speakers sought

to answer the question "Does religion have a role in shaping a moral globalizing society?"

The program presented the answers from seven different perspectives. For nearly two hours, atheism, Buddhism, Christianity, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism and Unificationism made their cases in front of an audience of nearly 130 people in Carlson Hall.

The moderator, Professor Timothy Eves, kept the evening charged with humor and antic-

ipation as he introduced both a student and an expert to represent each perspective. Referring to such beliefs and practices as the Four Noble Truths of Buddhism and the dietary laws of Judaism, as well as the key element of the family in Unificationism, all religions said "yea" to religion's positive role. Atheism, naturally, said "nay," referring to, among other reasons, religion's shady role in historical conflicts.

The program did not seek to reach a conclusion or spotlight a particular perspective, and for this reason all seven outlooks worked with an equal share of time. The result was the realization that religion plays a variety of roles in human society. The successful interaction and dialogue among the different perspectives seemed to say

"nay" to the clashes of civilizations predicted by such political scientists such as Samuel Huntington.

The song's lyrics go on: "You think the only people who are people / Are the people who look and think like you. / But if you walk the footsteps of a stranger, / You will learn

things you never knew you knew."

That is teaching at what is perhaps America's most truly international mixture of college undergraduates, at UB. We have increasingly grown accepting of the differences and similarities in nations, cultures and people. When I give a guest lecture or poetry reading at some other much less heterogeneous college or university, I often feel out of place, for I'm speaking to what has become to me a nonrepresentational segment of global undergraduates. Where are tne Russians, tne Nige rians, the Japanese, the South Americans, the Chinese, I wonder? During questionand- answer sessions, why don't I hear won-

derful mixtures of dif-

ferently accented Eng-

lish? Why doesn't my audience look like a rainbow, painted "with all the colors of the wind"?

What's so distinctive about UB is that here the international students are not isolated in pockets nor are they the "different" ones in a classroom. They are here in such numbers that they do not feel out of place or "foreign," and the campus is as truly theirs as it is the Americans'. International students and American students work side by side, sharing responsibilities in virtually all campus activities, from Student Congress, dormitory government and the campus newspaper to S.C.U.B.A. (our campus intellectual organization) and dozens of clubs.

How else to describe it?

Imagine being in an "Introduction to Poetry" class where a South American Dental Hygiene major flawlessly reads a poem by Pablo Neruda in the original Spanish and then helps the rest of us understand the nuances we miss in our English-translation version. Imagine too a discussion about communism, when an American student puts forth the advantages of Marxism, two Russian students strenuously advocate capitalism, and then one quietly observes, "Communism seemed fine in theory, but why did my country have to try it?"

Imagine talking about Louisa May Alcott's Little Women, when a Muslim student from Malaysia raises her hand to say she understands and admires the American family-values of the nineteenth-century, for her family's values are like that today; and what happened to American morals in the interim?

"Maybe it's television," an American student answers. "Or all of your cars," a student from the Dominican Republic puts in.

Imagine a discussion of urban poverty as an American student from the inner city Bronx and a student from Bangladesh swap vivid stories, and the American student becomes appalled at a depth of slum poverty he'd never imagined. "Maids?" he says, "you hire maids as a way of helping the poor?" And then it strikes him that without such a job an entire family might starve.

Imagine speaking about war and there's a marvelously gifted Bosnian Muslim student, already a published poet, who has experienced war firsthand.

ountless numbers of people have already passed on to the spirit world, with the great majority no doubt falling far short of having attained complete resurrection. Since a person needs his physical body in order to grow, we must inquire as to the fate of these persons who now possess only their spirit selves. Can they continue to be resurrected?

In his autobiography *Memories*, *Dreams*, *Reflections* the Swiss psychologist Carl Jung recounts his conversation with a highly cultivated elderly Indian, a friend of Mahatma Gandhi's. In discussing the different ways in which education took place in India, the Indian answered in reply to a question by Jung that his own guru was a man named Shankaracharya. Jung replies:

"You don't mean the commentator on the Vedas who died centuries ago?"

"Yes, I mean him," he said, to my (Jung's) amazement.

"Then you are referring to a spirit?" I asked.

"Of course it was his spirit," he agreed....

agreed....
"There are ghostly gurus too," he

"Most people have living gurus. But there are always some who have a spirit for a teacher."

As Jung records, his conversation is

an enlightenment to him, for over a period of time he had a similar experience, but he had not been able to explain it. Through his Indian acquaintance, he comes to understand people on earth are frequently guided by those on the spirit world.

For Divine Principle, the phenomenon experienced by Jung and his associate is an example of activity by spirit persons who are pursuing their own continuing resurrection. Since these spirit people did not complete the process during their lifetime on earth, they return to earth in spirit form to fulfill the task they left unaccomplished. They do this by helping and guiding people who are still on earth. As the spirit person assists the growth and achievement of such people on earth, he himself is spiritually benefited and progressively resurrected.

Forces of Good.

That spirit persons cooperate with those on earth is an assertion which tends to raise eyebrows. However, as Notre Dame's Morton Kelsey has pointed out, such skepticism is restricted mainly to the perhaps too-rationalistic West. While Kelsey's argument is too complex to repeat here, in his *Encounter with God* he explains that spiritual forces generally have not been given proper recognition in Western civilization, due largely to the influence of one famous Greek:

There is another view of man, how-

ever, found wherever the influence of Aristotle and nineteenth century Western thought have not been felt. In most cultures from primitive ones to the developed cultures of China, India, Islam and of Byzantine Christianity, nonphysical realities have been seen as a more powerful influence on man's destiny than the physical world."

Nor is the fact of spirit cooperation without documentation in the Bible. Jesus' assertion, for example, that John the Baptist was Elijah clearly suggests a spiritual relationship between the two. Although Elijah was in the spiritual world, Divine Principle holds that he was responsible to complete his own earthly mission working with John the Baptist as his successor. Along the same line, the writer of the Letter to the Hebrews suggests that earlier prophets and other servants of the Lord will find their own final salvation only through the present generation:

"And all these, though well attested by their faith, did not receive what was promised since god had foreseen something better for us, that apart from us they should not be made perfect." (Heb. 11: 39-41)

Divine Principle points out that both the period of Jesus' life on earth and the period of the Second Advent are special times when the possibilities for a spiritual advancement for the faithful on earth are especially great. After all, these are times when God's recreative Word appears anew, opening new avenues for spiri-

tual growth and stimulating people of all backgrounds to new heights. Therefore we may expect the earthly activity of spirit persons to be particularly acute during these times.

The twenty-seventh chapter of *Matthew*, for example, tells us that when Jesus died on the cross many saints arose from their tombs. As we have previously discussed, such reports should not be thought of literally, but rather should be understood as describing a spiritual reality. The passed-away prophets and saints were actively assisting God's new dispensation, seeking to elevate themselves to higher levels of spiritual attainment. Since this was the case in the past, Divine Principle would argue we may anticipate similarly intense spiritual activity at the time of the Second Advent

The Demonic

While the relationship between the Indian acquaintance of Jung and his spiritual acquaintance of Jung and his spiritual guru was obviously an elevating one, this is not always the case. Many spirit persons, having lived unenlightened lives here on earth, proceed to the spirit world in a confused or even destructive state of mind. When this is the case, and such spirits relate to people here on earth, their influence is not a benign one.

Without discounting the psychological, emotional and even chemical factors involved, *Divine Principle* suggests that the presence of such dark spirit forces around vulnerable individuals can contribute to a number of different tragic experiences.

In the New York "Son of Sam" murders for example, a man who killed a number of young New York women said he was commanded to do so by an invisible voice belonging to a person named Sam. Also, although clearly an extreme account of spirit possession, the well-known film *The Exorcist* was in fact based on a true story.

It is perhaps in the area of mental psychosis, however, that the possibility of harmful spirit interaction is clearest. In his book The Presence of Other Worlds, Dr. Wilson Van Dusan, a clinical psychologist who labored for sixteen years at California's Mendocino State Hospital, described his own discovery of what he calls the "presence of spirits in madness." Van Dusen had been vaguely familiar with the writings of Emmanual Swedenborg on the interaction of spirits with people on earth but only through his own experience with psychotic patients did he learn what the seventeenth century Swedish scientist was talking about.

Just as Swedenborg had discovered that spirits representing forces of both light and dark, good and evil, were in communication with people on earth, so Van Dusen discovered his patients both vocally and visually were in touch with forces they regarded, as autonomous spiritual beings. Describing the influence these beings can have, Van Dusen writes:

"I learned to two orders of experience...called the higher and the lower order. Lower order voices are similar to drunken bums at a bar who like to tease and torment just for the fun of it... They find a weak point of conscience and

work on it interminably..... All of the lower order are irreligious or anti-religious...In direct contrast stand the rarer higher order (spirits)...(who) respected his freedom and would withdraw if it frightened him.... The higher order is much more likely to be symbolic, religious, supportive, genuinely instructive."

Presence of Other Worlds

Centuries ago, of course, concepts of spirit influence and spirit possession were prevalent. The New Testament, for example, clearly reflects Jesus' belief in spirit influence. On more than one occasion Jesus is described as casting out demons (e.g. Mt. 8:15-16, Mk. 5:1-20). Also, the Apostle Paul, after his long experience with the spiritual path, writes to his fellow believers in Ephesus of the reality of invisible powers acting on the striving devotee:

"Put on the whole armor of God...For we are not contending against flesh and blood, but against the principalities, against the powers, against the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places." (Eph. 6:11-12)

All these assertions tend to be dismissed by our materialistic West as reflective of an antiquated world view. In light of modern discoveries such as Van Dusen's however, and in light of modern psychiatry's acknowledged inability to heal much mental illness, perhaps a new openness to such perceptions as those of Jesus and Paul is merited.

Despite the potential power for good or evil that spiritual forces may have, Divine Principle holds that the ultimate responsibility for an individual's state of being and behavior rests with himself. It is we who make the bases which determine what kind of spirit influence we may attract.

Chevy Chase's famous dictum "the devil made me do it" may be an amusing out, but such a denial of one's own ultimate responsibility doesn't square with the way God made the world.



Truth comes in many forms, as does human intelligence. Unificationists are special people, familiar with the deepest truths ever revealed to humanity. But there are several kinds of truth, and different skills are required to han-

Specialties

Scientists can do wonderful things with bubbling test tubes, and can probably recite the Periodic Table of the Elements by heart. They create healing medicines and deadly poisons with ease; and can fashion smelly but useful globs, or fabulous crystal baubles. But if they want to grasp the ultimate significance of their efforts, they must turn to spiritual leaders.

Mechanics can grasp the intricate workings of automobile engines, from the computerized fuel injectors to the clashing gears. A few of those mechanics may be theologians as well, but not very many. And while a theologian might look down on such a greasy person, when their car breaks down, they probably won't try to tackle the repairs by themselves.

Philosophers tackle some very profound questions, and can bring clarity to issues which have puzzled ordinary people all their lives. They can also 'split hairs' on some very dense issues that most folks don't ever think about at all!

When the philosopher, scientist, and mechanic have problems with their personal relationships, as they sometimes do, they're all likely to turn to an experienced councilor, or a member of the clergy. Someone who can guide them through the perilous realms of the heart.

Then, to celebrate their revived relationship, each will attend an event of their liking, whether it's a football game, a new movie, or a musical recital. All of these, please note, require still other types of intelligence and skill.

Wouldn't it be great if all these folks sincerely respected each other? They often don't. Worse, they sometimes trash each other, being at odds in a verbal sense, or worse.

Even within their own spheres, people don't always get along. Philosophy has various schools, which have disagreed for centuries. The hard sciences also have zealously defended schools of thought. Even top mechanics can be restorers of classics, or stock car enthusiasts, or Formula One racers. That's not even getting into religion and politics, with their massively divisive variations.

What to do? Here are some words of wisdom from my friend Kathi. During a recent on-line debate, she wrote:

<< I guess my whole point is that the extremes, whether right or left, up

or down, in or out, are too elitist in their assumptions, and fail to take into account the vast majority of middle of the road people who just want to live life on their own terms, without stepping on anyone else's toes. >>

My discussion with Kathi and our mutual friends was the basis for this article. She actually raises a much larger issue. 'Live and let live' has been an American maxim since the beginning. Believe it or not, the Puritans were considerably less uptight than today's selfproclaimed moralists.

There is a clear pattern to the elitism Kathi mentioned. Most people prefer to hang out with others who think and behave like themselves. Surveys have shown that this personal preference tends to increase as people get older, and this holds for Christians, Humanists, and others.

Folks thus assume that all 'good people' think, believe, vote, donate, etc. basically the same way they do. And that, as other people 'grow,' they'll become more like one's self.

Conversely, those who disagree are assumed, at best, to be 'missing' something; or, at worst, to be starkly evil.

Of course, if you directly ask someone if they think like that, they will instantly deny it. Nonetheless, this 'birds of feather' thing is a deep, almost subconscious, personal behavior. (Doubt it? Sign on to the World Wide Web, and check out the extreme polarity of opinions about radio's Dr. Laura.)

Let me put it this way: "Tolerance is a modern American virtue-and if you readers don't display is properly, I'm going to make every one of you attend a Sensitivity Training seminar!" (Just kidding.)

Imposition

How do we treat people who don't agree with us? Good and decent people tend to assume that if others were just a bit more [fill in the blank: informed, educated, concerned, aware, compassionate, enlightened, etc.], they would soon 'see the light.' Thus, their efforts are devoted to education and recruitment.

On the other hand, people who are not so good also want others see things their way. Most are content to threaten folks with a ruined society, or an eternity in Hell. But if they just can't wait that long, they'll drag people into a nearby Inquisition chamber. And if they don't believe in a Hell, sometimes they'll build an Auschwitz or a Gulag Archipelago as a handy substitute...

Such spiteful people are devoted to forcing others into an approved mold, supposedly for their own good, or for the good of society. In the process, they usually manage to gather a large slice of the pie for themselves.

In our modern, relatively peaceful times, such horrible behavior has been universally condemned. Still. similar bad attitudes can occasionally be found. And the folks who are looked down upon have their own ways of striking back.

How many theologians have been overcharged by an auto mechanic? How many have been condemned by philosophers as "fractious and otherworldly," or by chemists and engineers as "airily impractical?"

It gets worse. Perhaps you've seen that popular bumper sticker: My Kid

Beat Up Your Honor Student. Don't assume that they're just kidding! And do send your kid to martial arts classes. Even if they never get into a single fight, it'll do them a lot of good.

There is a solution to these uncomfortable divisions, a quality all too rare in our society: humility. Real empath-

ic sharing, of both viewpoint and emotion. Not the sort of 'tolerance' being pushed on university campuses, which is a politically correct buzzword that's quite false in theory—and in practice,

How to bring such humility into one's life? Make a genuine attempt to get on the level of the mechanic, the scientist, and the philosopher. Learn their lingo, and grasp their mindset. This will result in a broader and more rewarding view of the world.

One may not notice it at the time, but the Unificationist's formula course of fundraising, witnessing, and tribal messiahship is an excellent way of doing just that.

There is a sound historical basis for such mutual respect.

Handymen were pulling us out of the caves when philosophy and science didn't even exist. Farmers, sanitation workers, and plumbers have done more for human health than all the doctors in the world combined.

Scientists, and their actualizers, the engineers, literally built civilization. At great personal risk, they grasped, then tamed, the strongest forces of nature.

Philosophers were puzzling out the functions of the mind and the world, and winnowing the logical wheat from the irrational chaff, when most humans lived in ignorant barbarity.

Spiritual leaders, whether shamans, temple priests, or modern preachers, have always understood a great deal about human nature. Millennia before we knew that the brain was the seat of consciousness, they knew what went on in there—and beyond it, in the soul.

Looking back, the Greek's colorful menagerie called the Gods of Olympus appears silly; a set childish myths, but their tales contained a whole lot of truth. When Freud began to catalogue the murky recesses of the mind, he needed only to borrow some utterly appropriate examples from those Greek

Conclusion

One might know the deepest of truths, but if you and a few companions just know it, isn't going to get you (or the Providence) very far. And, at first, sharing it with others may not work out the way you thought it would.

Even in ancient times, spiritual leaders understood that life has a greater purpose, and that moral laws exist, apart from the arbitrary dictates of humanity. Today it may be popular to criticize the clergy, but they still have the inside track!

At the end of a long day, all of these folks might pause for a moment and look up at the stars. And wonder who they are, down deep; and what's most important about life. About what's true (or not), and how will they know the difference? And finally, where are they ultimately destined?

That's when those who are close God can really shine. ❖

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
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


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


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
