



This is the address given on the 12-City American Speaking Tour, September, 2002.

espected peace loving American dignitaries, ladies and gentlemen, I extend my warm greetings and gratitude to all of you for coming here this evening. You are now joining more than seventy million people worldwide including seven million in Korea and seven hundred million blessed couples in the heavenly spirit world who have participated in these gatherings for peace.

We are living in a truly historic and providential moment. This is a time of great heavenly fortune, the time when we will build the ideal world of peace that Heaven and Earth have longed to see for six thousand years. It is time to build the Kingdom of God in Heaven and on earth.

Throughout providential history, God raised various religions to arise in accordance with different historical periods and regional cultures. Working among these diverse traditions, men and women of faith have made continuous efforts to achieve a world of peace.

Yet even today, human beings groan in travail, because we are still unable to free ourselves from all manner of unethical and immoral behavior. People everywhere are dismayed to face the truth that, having failed to stem the tide of immorality, it is now rushing in with the power of a surg-

ing storm, threatening to sweep us all away in its turbulent waves. This is the tragic self-portrait of the modern human being. Does this mean there

boes this mean there is no hope for us eternally? My husband, the Reverend Sun Myung Moon and I have dedicated our lives to conveying the Word of God. These prophetic messages have been proven to be a true witness that transcends the earthly limitations of this age and our environment.

Today, once again, I come before you with a message from Heaven. To believe or not to believe is for each of you to decide for yourself, but I stand here firmly resolved to act in God's stead to convey His message to the world in the time of the Last Days. The title of this message is, "God Is The Origin of Peace."

I sincerely hope that you will open the doors of your heart. I encourage you to humbly receive Heaven's warning to all of us living in the Last Days. In this age of ignorance and confusion, we must demonstrate wisdom. In the beginning, human beings were created to live centered on God in the Garden of Eden, and to live in freedom and peace for eternity. However, as a result of the fall of our first ancestors Adam and Eve, the vision of this original world never became reality. Instead, from the day the fall occurred, a history of suffering and sorrow has unfolded on this earth.

God intended human beings to live with His true love and true ideals, but we were unable to grasp those ideals and did not even know what true love is. He wanted for us to sing songs of freedom and peace, and to possess the complete happiness of becoming one in heart in the presence of the Creator, and returning glory to Him. He intended us to live in an environment of perfect joy, but we lost the garden of happiness.

Tragically, we have not been able to become a holy people. Satan invaded the human family, defiling the relationships of true parents, true family and true brothers and sisters. Satan corrupted our true tribe, true society, true nation and true world.

That is not all. Satan is the one who has driven God Himself to spend the past six thousand years in a state of suffering and adversity. The fall marked the beginning of the history of death. From that day on, the earth became a world of suffering instead of a world of peace. No matter where in the world we live, we have been doomed to the

way of conflict and struggle instead of peace. Within the individual, there is contin-

uous conflict between the mind and body. There has been conflict within families that has expanded into conflicts within nations and the whole world. Today we find there is no place on earth free of conflict. We need to come to terms with the fact that we are responsible for this history of sin. I repeat - all conflict is the result of the human fall.

If the whole world had originally grown from the good seed of a good tree and in a good environment, then without doubt, the world would today be a world of peace, a world of hope, and a world with a secure future. But this is not the case. We live in a world in which good and evil are tangled together. Even a good seed cannot bear good fruit when surrounded by an evil environment. The same is true for human beings. For humanity as a whole to be good, first it is necessary that each individual be good, but for them to bear fruit, we must create a good environment in the nation and world.

Just as creation passes through the four seasons, human history should continue eternally by revolving through cycles that are like the spring, summer, autumn and winter. Because of the fall, though, our world has never had that first moment of hope in which all humanity could take delight, the joyous springtime when we could greet the day of glory.

Cain and Abel, the children of our ancestors Adam and Eve, were not born out of God's love. Adam and Eve were to have created God's true lineage, but they created Satan's false lineage instead through the act of the fall. So the children they bore were not God's children but could only be

Adam and Eve became the sinful ancestors of humanity, and the Bible records that they were chased out of the Garden of Eden. That is why in John 8:44, Jesus scolded the people, saying: "You are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father you will do."


ples of the type of behavior that brought about the fall.

This is certainly not the type of behavior planned by God at the time of creation. God did not desire to bring about such a world, and we did not want to be born into such a world.

Therefore, God has set His purpose to clear away this tragic, sorrowful and painful history and return to the world of peace, happiness, freedom, and goodness that He originally desired. He is working to set this fallen world right. This is the path of restoration and the path of the providence of salvation.

As the descendants of Adam and Eve, all humankind is fallen. But within each of us there still exists an original mind or conscience that is directed back toward the original world. This is why people throughout history have always desired and longed for the world God originally wanted to create. This longcherished desire remains today as an ideal that cannot be extinguished or ignored.

God has carried out His providence again and again, in each historical period, so that He could inspire fallen human beings to return to His ideal with a new heart. Finally, we need a Savior, for if no central person capable of moving Heaven and Earth with these ideals appears, then true freedom, peace, and other ideals will never come about. he Washington, DC kickoff for True Mother's 12 city North American tour on September 16, 2002,

was a great success, with many outstanding individuals coming to receive their appointment as an Ambassador for Peace. The program began with the Bridge of Peace, sponsored by WFWP, founded by True Mother. Mrs. Susan Fefferman guided us through a very moving cere-

mony, in which women from divergent backgrounds, many times consciously seeking to reconcile on behalf of for-

mer enemies, crossed the bridge of peace with a heart to resolve past differences. Representatives of religions, races and nations that were enemies crossed the bridge with a heart to repent, forgive and reconcile.

When the women came off the Bridge of Peace, an atmosphere of love blanketed the room. Everyone's hearts opened. Very important guests came to hear this special message from True Mother entitled "God is the Origin of Peace." Over 20 ambassadors from the diplomatic corps, as well as a former US senator and his wife, and the mother of Washington, D.C. Mayor Anthony Williams were appointed as Ambassadors for Peace. The Washington Times reported that 750 VIPs attended. Others estimate that over 1,000 came, as the overflow area was jammed.

Ms. Robin Read, the president and CEO of the National Foundation for Women Legislators, NFWL, and board member of several major US corporations, gave a special introduction to True Mother. Her husband, Sam Brunelli, a former Denver Bronco, is also a leader in the family moral values movement and special adviser to important American political leaders. Robin praised True Mother's work for humanity and her ability to go beyond social barriers. Archbishop George Augustus Stallings, chairman of the ACLC executive committee, founder of Imani temple, gave an important mesters of God, and build true families that will lead to world peace. tions.

In these circumstances, God cannot appear to us in glory, peace or freedom, and the path of restoration cannot be an easy one. God appears in the midst of difficulties, and to meet Him we must first make ourselves a sacrificial offering. This is because the path of restoration is the way of indemnity.

This means that until we are able to wipe away the sorrow in God's heart and dissolve all the grievances there, we cannot hope to accomplish peace among humanity, much less see God's ideal of creation bear fruit on earth. Since we caused God's pain through the fall, we are responsible to liberate Him from the burden of grief that weighs like a massive stone in His rifice and bloodshed, and suffered through wearisome religious rituals and rules. This history is referred to as the providence of salvation, or the providence of restoration.

Originally, if human beings had not fallen, our mind and body, being centered on God's love, would not contradict each other. Because of the fall, however, the mind and body came to stand in opposing positions. Even if it were possible to somehow arrive at an ideal world, without each individual solving this problem and establishing a true standard of heart, even living in the ideal world of one's dreams would be meaningless.

The Absolute Being, who is the Lord of Creation, created the entire universe to love and to become one with Him. Human beings, the highest among created beings, are to stand in the position of lords of creation. To do this, we must be able to incarnate God's heart. Becoming one with God's who caused our first ancestors to fall. If Satan did not exist, there would be no need for indemnity. There would also be no need for the phrase, "unity of religions," which we now proclaim with all our might, nor would we need expressions such as "the liberation of God," or "the liberation of humanity."

The fall brought about the destruction of human life and turned history into a record of anguish and failure, a chronicle of war. In order to wipe away this history and unravel all the fundamental problems, God needs to establish anew the original starting point. He does this through a person who can live a life of true love for the sake of God, humanity and all creation. This is the mission of the Messiah.

What did Jesus do when he was on this earth? Although he was persecuted and died on the cross, he truly loved humanity. Jesus left this world giving the supreme of death without tears coming to our eyes.

When you see young people thrashing around in a quagmire of drugs and debauchery, you will feel compelled to devote your full heart and soul to saving them, as if they were your own children. This is a manifestation of the love that unconsciously and naturally seeks to give rather than receive.

Unity is another prerequisite of freedom and peace. Consider the life of a husband and wife. If the two have not become one, how can they enjoy the freedom of husband and wife in a true sense? If a husband and wife are not one, then there is no hope for harmony in the family. Peace in the family will be an impossible dream.

A person blasphemes God if he stands before the unchanging God and says he will become a changeable person. We blaspheme love if we stand in the presence of His unchanging love and practice a chang-

ing love. The foundation for peace begins in our own hearts when we share both sorrow and joy with God. From there, we can expand the base of freedom and happiness in the world.

For this reason, a religious movement must arise on this earth that teaches us to achieve complete mastery over the body, and is able to unify the people of the world. Jesus started such a movement.

Please bear in mind that these words are a warning from God proclaimed to humanity wading through the turbid waters of a corrupt world in the Last Days. We are all called to fulfill this task of restoration. It is our destiny. We can never escape our destiny which Heaven's is absolute command.

I think that everyone, at some point in life, searches for the

heart.

But who among us is truly thinking like that today? Even the most devout believers in Jesus are blind and deaf to this truth, thinking that they will simply be saved. However, as fallen human beings, we need to return to the state before the fall.

Having lost God, we must go back to the state of grace we would have been in had we never lost Him. Having lost the True Parents of humanity, we must return to the position we would have been had we not lost them. We must return to live in a garden of peace centered on God and True Parents as their children. What strategy does the omniscient and almighty God use to change this hellish world into a world of peace? We need to be reminded that in order to accomplish this purpose, God has endured a history of sacheart does more than establish the parent-child relationship between God and ourselves. What is meant by restoration through

Such wars, though, were relatively small occurrences in a much larger conflict. Neither of them lasted more than five years. Yet the struggle between mind and body that goes on within each of us is the worst kind of war. It is a war that knows no end and whose inevitable result speeds us on see **ORIGIN** on page **8**






we put 100% effort into Sept. 14th, made our offering, and used this as a "stepping-stone" to Sept. 27th. Our actual mobilization time was only 10 days.

n September 19, 2002, the powers in heaven were shaken in the South. Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon brought her Crusade for World Peace to Atlanta. As part of the twelve-city American tour a gala banquet was held at the Renaissance Waverly Hotel from 6:00 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. Every one of the 600 banquet seats was filled, and over two hundred people stood along the back of the ballroom. (One newspaper reported 1,500 guests.)

Dr. Moon brought a brilliant message of incredible hope and love, declaring that the True Parents are on the earth today. "The time of peace has come! Heaven's long wait has ended. We are living in the final moment of the Last Days of human history. The True Parents, whom Heaven and Earth have hoped would come and have longed to see, are now on this earth."

The audience included elected officials, ministers, over forty top Korean leaders from Atlanta, university professors, media representatives and business leaders. The religious representation was very diverse, including representatives from Southern and Missionary Baptist Churches, United Methodist, AME, AME Zion, Church of God in Christ, Pentecostal, Catholics, American Muslim Society, Nation of Islam, Yehudah, Sikh, and other denominations and faiths.

The outpouring of support was massive and impressive. Bishop Jonathan Greer, pastor of The Cathedral of Divine Love in DeKalb County said, "I am affiliated with this movement, because it's the right thing to do. It's all based on building strong families. That's a principle I have been teaching my whole career, and it needs to be spread around the world. True world peace isn't going to come through the systems of the political world, and not even through religions. But only through applying God's principles, the Kingdom principles.'

There was an awesome feeling of unity in the room. One Pentecostal Bishop was moved by the presence of God's spirit, and said, "I am not familiar with the concept of True Parents, and please don't talk to me about the Messiah. I just know that the love in this room was almost too much for me. I prayed to God, asking Him if I should be here and He clearly told me to come, saying that this movement has something I need, and that I have something to offer." Moon's speech. "I felt as though Mrs. Moon was truly my mother. She touched my heart with love and spoke directly to me. Thank God. Thank God. Thank God, for Mother Moon."

State Senator Donzella James said she was honored to award Dr. Moon with a trophy and a proclamation from the Secretary of State citing Dr. Moon's efforts to strengthen families and promote

> world peace. "I am proud to work with Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, because she and I have similar goals. That is to love and be directed by God, and to prepare our children for the future, and strengthen families. I believe that Rev. Moon and his wife

are genuinely trying to achieve world peace."

Freelance writer and political columnist Maynard Eaton of the Atlanta Voice attended the program. "As a reporter, I am by nature skeptical. And having read a lot the negative things about Rev. Moon, I walked into that door with a lot of skepticism. But I must say I was overwhelmed. I hadn't



umph the Church and Kingdom of God in Christ and presides over 36 churches in Georgia, Florida and South Carolina. "I have been with the movement for 30odd years and at no time have they attempted to get me to join their church. What's happening here is universal. INTERNATIONAL RELIEF FRIENDSHIP FOUNDATION IRFF Medical Project in Albania

e all gathered at Tirana bus station in the morning, April 20, and at 8 o'clock we began our journey to the southern part of Albania. We estimated that there was 6 to 7 hours of traveling ahead of us. The first 2 hours didn't seem uncomfortable at all; we enjoyed the new and only highway in the Albanian road system. At 1 o'clock in the afternoon we arrived at one of the biggest cities of south Albania, Tepelena.

Our original plan was to stop one hour outside of this city and cross the River Vjosa by boat in order to reach our first project site, but the water level had risen and the boat couldn't cross. So, from Tepelena we got a minivan and just squeezed in all of our belongings, and added another hour and a half to our trip. We arrived at our accommodation at around 3 o'clock.

The rest of the day we spent offering gifts to our 2 Albanian host families, and exploring the local area. We concluded the day with a group meeting as preparation for the next, the first day of service.

At 7 o'clock next day we gathered for breakfast, planning to leave at 8 o'clock for the first village. Our schedule for the visits had been prepared by the local mayor. We arrived at the first village, Dhemblaj at about 9.30, later than we expected, our arranged transport hav-

ing failed to arrive. Many people were there waiting for us together with the mayor.

The population of Dhemblaj is between 500-600 people, about 100 families. We were given a place for the free medical service, the building that had been the museum of Enver Hoxha, a former communist leader. The mayor arranged a nurse to help us and was amazed at the way people just kept coming. It was difficult to get into the doctors consulting room; it was only possible after pushing strongly through the mass of noisy, smiling villagers.

On this first day, 45 people came and were treated by the doctors, this was more than on a normal day in the hospital. Gradually, as we got more information we started to understand these people better. For example, people would say things like "I've had this problem for 3 months" and "my 2 vear old child has been sick for 2 months." The problem on surface is



that the doctor from the government doesn't often come, but I'll explain more later. At 3 o'clock that afternoon our doctors finished their work and decided to







return the next

day because there were many school children, and it was important to examine them.

A local family prepared lunch for us with mutton, a popular and typical meat of Albania. This was the first time that some of our group had tried food prepared this way. The joy and respect they felt made this day like a celebration for them. The unique, soft character and songs from the Japanese volunteers from the IIFWP brought tears to the eyes of the people.

The next morning we went again to find some transport. People who want to travel usually arrive early because the roads are so bad, and there is no transport available later. We waited, but unfortunately no van came, but while we waited, we had a meeting with the local mayor. He expressed his gratitude for this project and left us in no doubt about its necessity. Actually, he said

> not even one doctor wants to stay here, not because it's a poor area, but because it's a so-called "dead" place. There is no cinema here, no restaurant, or even a pub or anything that brings the people out of their homes. Life is monotonous.

> Finally we found a car, we were 8 people seated in a jeep designed for 5, but we were happy to go, we knew that people were waiting for us. At around 10 o'clock we arrived. On this day our doctors checked 30 students from the village school and some others who could not get treatment the day before. Some of the children were very sick, and this made us sad. Others just had small problems.

The next day we went to a truly beautiful place, called Motohasanaj. It is situated on top of a small mountain and waiting for us was a fabulous view of the whole area. A local family offered their house for us to use as a clinic and soon after people started to gather. This is a difficult place to get to and though there are 150-160 houses, there are only 5060 families living here. The rest have left to find a better place with better prospects. This is typical of the degeneration of this area, there were still high schools here in 1995, but today there are only primary schools.

As we continued our service we came to realize our stock of medicine was inadequate, the doctors had already started to give pre-

scriptions. People here are very open and obliging, and patiently waited for their turn. At around 2 o'clock in the afternoon, the doctors finished their work and after gathering with the rest of the group, we traveled back to our accommodation.

The next day we stayed and worked at Sinanaj, the central town of this area and with the best infrastructure - the reason why a government doctor had visited 2 months previously. This town has a new clinic, the only one having 5 treatment rooms and full-time nurses. Around 30 people came including children from the neighboring school.

The doctors managed to finish their work around 2 pm. That was when we faced a big dilemma concerning how best to continue the project. The nearest village was larger and about 2 hours away, and we didn't have staff for a bigger place. The only other place was a small village nearby that had seen its population decrease to 10% of what it was in 1997. Just 6 or 7 families remained, so we questioned whether it was worthwhile going there. Somehow we felt, if we simply neglect that place, we are not finishing our job here, our mission would not be complete. So, we decided, next day, early in the morning we would go there, as our last location.

So, for the rest of the day we went for a walk, to get to know nature in this part of the country. Typically this part of the country is mountainous, so especially in summer time there are not so many green spaces. Only in the spring can we see meadow flowers and green grass here. At other times everything is burned dry and brown by the sun. (photo 11) But there was a surprise, unexpectedly, even for our Albanian participants, 200m down in a valley we found forest with tall trees on the banks of a stream, it was like another climate. This environment could resist even the highest temperatures in the mountains.

In order do not lose time, we decided we would visit the last place (Mamugjinaj) and travel back immediately after we finished. We arrived at the village before 8 o'clock and just went to one of the houses. The people didn't know that

we were coming but gathered there within half an hour. Every one of them had something to discuss with a doctor, it was necessary to refer some serious cases for further analysis at the hospital. We could give medicines in just a few cases; others received prescriptions. By 9.30 we had finished and we went back to our

he twenty-first entury presents a hostile face to many millions of children in many African countries. An increasing number of children are being forced to the streets as result of poverty, abuse, torture, rape, abandonment or orphaned by AIDS.


Human rights violations against children in the 1990 have become a common and disturbing occurrence across the continent . Indeed denial of basic

The International Relief Friendship Foundation (IRFF) being concerned of saving lives of thousands of people, has made its second coming into Mackenzie community in Ndola, Zambia where 35 youth from 6 countries of the world (Zam-

bia, Tanzania, Uganda, Zimbabwe, Slovenia and Slovakia), among whom three second-generation met from 7th to 18th August 2002 in Zambia with a purpose of building a second class at the orphans school of Mackenzie community in Ndola.

The project started with a two day orientation at Twikatane farm in Lusaka where participants had the opportunity to know each other and through the interaction styles, they learned the importance of working in team with one set goal by practicing the sense of living for the sake of others and the importance of sacrifice . The school environment was changing day after day and became an attractive place for many adults and children of the community including the World Food Program Officers who were inspired to interact with participants.


The house to house visit in the community by Sister Eliska relieved hundreds of the inhabitants, the community was served in provision of HIV/AIDS Education, Hygiene, Nutrition and relief from light sufferings (pains, etc.).





accommodation.

During the week not only our foreign participants but also Albanian ones could feel as if they were on an expedition, meeting with different customs and backgrounds. Our journey back emphasized this even more. We chose another way from the way we came; as with our orig inal plan, we went through the river that we couldn't cross coming here. We managed to save 3 hours by traveling by this route, and what a pleasure it was! Crossing the river without shoes, by donkey and by boat, hiking across hills covered with bushes, this was the last opportunity to say good-bye to this unforgettable and beautiful place, Albania. Finally, what was the overall result of this project, of course we could provide valuable assistance to people, but could we change the circumstances of their life?

It is true that doctors visit this area only rarely but also people are moving away from their suffering and their need. They don't have any hope to rise out of their circumstances in this area. Families can eat fruit and vegetables such as carrots for example only in 2-3 months of the year and the local shops can only supply the most basic things, like noodles. Items such as fish, preserved fruits, honey, and jam are already scarce. People are bored with dull and mundane things, and young people feel trapped. Scientific research has shown that one cause of many sicknesses is isola-

tion, separation from the world and from

other people. We visited just a few places but they were in desperate need of help.

A person who knows the dusty and dirty Capital and other cities of Albania, also knows that this area is one of the treasures of the country with its beautiful mountains, clean environment and strong family traditions.

Could there be more investment in this part of the country?

The government plans to build a hydro-

Unification News RYS Peace Initiative in Indonesia

uring the summer of 2002 the IIFWP has been very active in the field of public service and the Religious Youth Service (RYS) has provided an important element to that public outreach. This worldwide summer of service included RYS projects in Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, New Zealand, Australia, Trinidad and Tobago, Indonesia and joint projects with the IRFF in Albania and Zambia.

The RYS projects involved nearly three hundred youth whose contributions included repairs, landscaping and construction on numerous schools, a clinic, a character education center, a church, a Bahia center, and a hospital. A common bond that ran through all the projects is the desire to promote peaceful cooperation among people of all faiths. The efforts recorded in the Mayan village in Santiago Atitlan, Guatemala or the rural village near Ndola, Zambia and in Banten, Indonesia all are unique models of the beauty, the spirit of reconciliation and joyous excitement that is generated through the RYS.

The IIFWP and the Ambassadors for Peace have helped in moving forward the

RYS so that it is currently drawing the attention and support from both the NGO community and numerous government ministries. The following is a short report on the 110th RYS project that was held in a nation with the largest Muslim population in the world, Indonesia.

RYS Indonesia

They came almost clueless, without any real understanding of RYS, and the programs purpose, mission and vision. Even as the project moved to its midway point some of the 28 participants continued to struggle with the toilet conditions, food and the punctuality and no-smoking rules. Yet as the program continued and the clarity of purpose grew all of these young people caught the true spirit of RYS. In the waning moments of the project all were crying, not wanting to finish the RYS project and hoping the day would last just a little bit longer.

The Indonesia RYS project in Banten was held on August 22-31 an coorganized by the (MATAKIN) Indonesian Confucius Society, the Ministry of Women Empowerment. the IIFWP of Indonesia and YJIMS. RYS volunteers worked to transform an old somber house, once used by the first president of Indonesia, into a cheerful kindergarten. Our work included building a playground, a kindergarten, repairing furniture and redecorated the

house. The project provided a very good opportunity for youths from various faiths, races, and nation's as well as representatives of various organizations to be of service to community as one. Besides Indonesia, participants came from Singapore, Malaysia, Japan and Sri Lanka and represented Islam, Christianity, Buddhism, Hinduism, and ancestral worship.

In addition to the central service project many other activities were held. A family talk was conducted especially designed for rural villagers and teacher training courses were conducted for 10 kindergarten teachers. A ceremonial offering of a goat was made following the tradition of Abraham and Ishmael and basic food items were distributed to nearly 50 families. The cross-cultural programs were enhanced when seven Japanese delegates joined the project for two days and one Singapore participant prepared sushi for the participants.

At the end of the project, participants were brought to a quiet hill area for reflection; reflection is an integral part of the RYS experience. At one of those reflective moments by a campfire, Roy, a member of the minor-







ity Chinese community, shared that the RYS has helped him as a minority to achieve dreams that alone he felt unable to actualize. Fannie, a young Buddhist admitted that this is the first

time that she had been away from home with people of other races and religions. Fannie noted her surprise on how those who had been strangers to her were now so close that she did not miss her family. Many of the group were surprised at how RYS had created bonds that tied together regardless of race or religion. Indeed, their experience proved that there are more essential things that bind us together and serve as a bridge to cross ers

shared parts of their experiences that on reflection made them laugh at themselves. One participant testimony clearly illustrates the internal journey that was made to go beyond fear and suspicion into the realm of trust and friendship.

" I was fearful when I heard we would be sleeping at the Muhammadiyah headquarters, (a major Muslim

organizations in Indonesia). My perception of this organization was that they did not tolerate Christians. But look at me...after only one night, I was so at ease in the headquarters that I can even make jokes with the members of Muhammadiyah. Perceptions can be so wrong! If it were not for RYS, I would not have set foot here and get to know this Muslim organization and its members better".

One female participant who had suffered because she lives in the conflict area of Madura said " I had looked forward to this program because it gives me opportunity to meet other ethnic groups. There are so much that I wanted to know and share".

But one of the most touching event was when they all presented two hand made cards to John Gehring and Fazida Razak. On the card they thank us who are non -Indonesians, for caring enough about their crisis laden country and wanting to promote inter-religious

peace and tolerance. They were touched that we left our family behind to be with them. \clubsuit

Unification News 40 YEARS IN AMERICA

espite its legal gains, the church lost the one case that was the most highly publicized, most costly and that mattered to it the most. The indictment, prosecution, conviction and imprisonment of Rev. Moon on tax evasion charges

had an air of inevitability about it. Tax convictions have been a time-honored way of rooting out undesirables and although the review process makes it more difficult within the American system, there still has been a tendency "to go after unpopular, but not necessarily criminal figures who can only be tripped up on tax evasion charges." The odd thing about Rev. Moon's case was that it continued to move forward in the face of so many obstacles. First, the audit of Rev. Moon's tax returns for the years 1973-75 showed a total liability of \$7,300, less than the \$2,500 per year required by IRS guidelines for criminal prosecution. Second, three career attorneys from the Criminal section of the U.S. Department of Justice's Tax Division questioned whether

> c o m e was the same. This stimulated a variety of theological constructions. Members utilized terms such as "sacrifice" and "crucifixion" to describe the course of events. Some interpreted the situation in ways that resembled ransom theories of atonement. Though "completely innocent," Rev. Moon made "an offering of himself for America and the world, for Christianity and all religions" was how one major church leader described the scenario. Others understood that he offered himself in a substitutionary way for the Unification Church which had failed repeatedly to win an adequate following or exert substantial influence in America.

Although these interpretations were mostly in-house and would not

there was any liability at all and unanimously concluded in a written memorandum that prosecution was not advisable. In fact, according to one account, the Department's chief of criminal tax prosecution warned that because Rev. Moon's tax returns did not claim a large charitable contribution, "the government might find itself in the embarassing position of owing him a tax refund." Third, the prosecuting attorney had to convene three grand juries before getting the necessary indictments. Fourth, a mostly unlettered jury had to sift through hundreds of prosection tax exhibits and technical argumentation that, in the opinion of the trial judge, were glazing over the eyes of even trained legal observers. Fifth, the U.S. Solicitor General and the Supreme Court had to ignore briefs from most of the country's mainstream religious groups that main-


tained in holding funds for the church in his name, Rev. Moon had no tax liability and exercised an accepted and widely practiced trustee role known as corporation sole.

However, for the church, especially in retrospect, Rev. Moon's tax case was not about legal niceties. Rev. Moon's previous trials and imprisonments, both in North and South Korea, were part of the church's lore and hymnody. To be sure, there were vast differences in time, place and circumstance between what already had been memorialized and what in America was being experienced first-hand. In particular, followers had far more resources with which to mount a defense than they possessed in the late 1940s or mid-1950s. Nevertheless, the outministry, including two massive marriage blessings, the Youth Seminar on World Religions, *The Washington Times*, CAUSA-USA, and several ministerial outreach programs which included a donation of 250 large trucks to the National Council for the Church and Social Action. Finally, as has been noted, Rev. Moon's prosecution and jailing gained the church a significant amount of grassroots support. Taken together, the investigations leading to his indictment, the trial and appeal process, and his imprisonment consitute what can be termed "the Danbury course." More than any other sequence of events, it was the fulcrum around which the history of the Unification Church in America turned.

Two important congressional investigations helped instigate Rev. Moon's indictment on tax evasion charges. One was that of the U.S. House Subcommittee on Inter-





national Organizations, chaired by Rep. Donald Fraser (D-Minnesota). Its probe into Korean-American Relations and, in particular, into the activities of the Korean Central Intelligence Agency (KCIA) in the United States was described earlier as an ominous development in 1976. The Subcommittee and the church had an adversarial relationship from the beginning of the investiga-

tion, and several members declined to answer questions or cooperate due to what they regarded as the Subcommittee's intrusions into church matters and breaches of confidentiality. In early 1977, the Subcommittee gained additional funding and intensified its investigation in the wake of Korean influence-buying on Capitol Hill, which in the idiom of the time was known

as Koreagate. In its determined effort to establish links between the KCIA and the church, the Subcommittee leaked several confidential, unevaluated intelligence documents which led to press reports that the church "was founded by the Director of the Korean Central Intelligence Agency...as a political tool in 1961" or, alternatively, that it had emerged "from its origins as a smalltime Korean sex cult to a worldwide organization operated by the Korean Central Intelligence Agency." Both of these allegations were patently false, as the Subcommittee's final report indicated.

The Subcommittee subpoenaed Col. Bo Hi Pak for testimony on several occasions but may have not been entirely prepared for his responses. In his initial appearance, Col. Pak complained bitterly that the Subcommittee was "ostensibly pursuing a probe of the KCIA" but had "given the impression to the world through the press that the United States Congress is investigating the Unification Church of Reverend Sun Myung Moon." In his second appearance, Col. Pak escalated his rhetoric, stating his belief that the Chairman was "being used as an instrument of the devil."

He continued, "I know it is easy and popular in the short run to persecute new religious groups. So it was for Nero. So it was for Julian the Apostate. But does history remember them for their social reforms or foreign policy or human rights? No! It remembers them as the great persecutors in history. And so history might remember Donald Fraser, if it remembers him at all. You may get my scalp, Mr. Chairman, but never my heart and soul. My heart and soul belong to God.

In his third appearance, Col. Pak charged that the Subcommittee had "secretly determined to destroy one man...Reverend Sun Myung Moon, and his movement." He also detailed the Chairman's "operational ties" to communist organizations and cited the testimony under oath by a former Polish intelligence official that Congressman Fraser was "an agent of influence on the Hill for the Soviet Union."

All of this was great theatre, and, in fact, the move-

ment circulated a documentary version of Col. Pak's testimony, entitled *Truth Is My Sword*. However, it did not materially affect the subcommittee's final recommendation that "The Department of Justice, the SEC, the IRS, and other executive branch agencies currently investigating allegations relating to Sun Myung Moon, Pak Bo Hi, the UC...and other individuals and organizations comprising the Moon Organization...should coordinate their efforts and create an interagency task force." The movement's response noted that having spent \$685,000 in an eighteen month investigation with thirteen full-time staff employees only to conclude that the "Moon Organization was not an agent of

influence for the ROK Government," the Subcommittee "now called on the federal government to form an 'interagency task force' and find some charge, any charge, on which the Church or its members can be found guilty." No interagency task force was created, and Congressman Fraser lost in his bid to gain a seat in the U.S. Senate. Nevertheless, his Subcommittee helped perpetuate a climate of suspicion and hostility in relation to Rev. Moon and the Unification Church.

The other congressional investigation consisted of two unofficial meetings convened by Senator Robert Dole (R-Kansas). The first, a February 18, 1976 "Day of Affirmation and Protest," was previously discussed. It afforded anti-church activists the opportunity to present their grievances to representatives of seven U.S. government agencies. The second, which followed on the heels of the Jonestown tragedy in Guyana, was a one-afternoon information session for members of Congress on "The Cult Phenomenon in America" sponsored by Senator Dole on February 5, 1979. The first of these "unofficial" inquiries

was the most consequential in launching the IRS investigation which eventually led to the indictment of Rev. Moon. This was because on January 6, 1976, prior to the Day of Affirmation and Protest, Senator Dole wrote a letter to the IRS commissioner stating that an audit of the Unification Church "may be warranted" and requested his response. While it was not unusual for members of Congress to write letters to officials in the executive branch, Dole's letter carried extra weight as he was a ranking member of the Senate Finance Committee which had direct control over the IRS budget. Three days after sending the letter, Senator Dole and his staff added more pressure by issuing a press release highlighting the note's content. The Day of Affirmation and Protest provided further notice that "he was serious about what he said to the IRS.

Within days, the IRS began what Carleton Sherwood, in Inquisition, The Persecution and Prosecution of the Reverend Sun Myung Moon (Regnery Gateway, 1991) termed "the most intensive and expensive criminal tax investigation of any religious figure in U.S. history." According to Sherwood, "Within five months of the Dole non-hearings, a squad of IRS agents had taken up permanent offices in the Unification Church's downtown New York headquarters, while a team of field agents began round-the-clock surveillance of selected church members and their telephones." In 1978, after two years of investigations, the IRS was unable to find anything that compromised the church's tax-exempt status but turned over to the New York District Attorney's Office "certain anomalies" in Rev. Moon's tax returns for the years 1973-75. At issue were two sets of assets openly held in Rev. Moon's name: 1) accounts totalling \$1.6

million at the Chase Manhattan Bank; and 2) \$50,000 worth of stock in Tong II Enterprises, Inc. The government contended that Rev. Moon owned these assets benefically and therefore owed taxes on the bank interest and stock value. The church held that Rev. Moon held these assets as a trustee for the followers of the Unification faith and therefore owed no such taxes.

The Office of the U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of New York pursued the matter aggressively but, despite convening three grand juries, was having trouble getting an indictment. Also, as already noted, career attorneys from the Criminal Section of the U.S. Department of Justice's Tax Division did not deem Rev. Moon's alleged tax liability sufficient to warrant prosecution and signed off on a triple negative recommendation. However, in August 1981, the New York District Attorney's Office presented new charges of perjury, conspiracy and obstruction of justice which reopened the case and led to Rev. Moon's indictment. These charges stemmed from two sources: a "Japanese Family Fund Ledger" and promissory notes submitted by the defense to account for the sources of funds in the Chase Manhattan account; and the grand jury testimony of Takeru Kamiyama, who was understood to be Rev. Moon's financial advisor. The government claimed that the Japanese Family Fund Ledger, which listed dates and amounts of contributions from Japanese Church members between June 1972 and March 1976, as well as loan agreements reflecting transfers of funds from foreign church members to be deposited into the Chase accounts were prepared after the IRS had begun to investigate Rev. Moon's tax returns and were "phoney." It claimed that Mr. Kamiyama had lied to the grand jury.

This alleged "cover-up" was the "bridge" that led to the trial and conviction of Rev. Moon. However, Rev. Moon's defense team and a number of later observers questioned the sturdiness of that bridge. First, as the brief for Rev. Moon to the Court of Appeals noted, "The

record is barren of any evidence whatsoever that Reverend Moon was involved in or consulted about the preparation of any of these...documents." Second, the church and its defense lawyers acknowledged from the beginning, both in conferences and sworn testimony, that the Family Fund Ledger and promissory notes were good faith efforts to reconstruct "actual prior transactions." Third, and most important, the perjury specifications against Mr. Kamiyama were seriously flawed. The most egregious problems were the errors in translation by the grand jury

interpreter. An analysis of the transcript "found over 600 translation errors. more than 75 of which materially affected...perjury charges" brought against Mr. Kamiyama. There was even a serious question as to whether Mr. Kamiyama ever testified under a valid oath, as the translator "was entirely ignorant of the basic word perjury, and never properly warned the witness about the sanctions against lying under oath." He also hopelessly botched the oath's translation. The errors were so grievous that after reviewing the case three years later, the U.S. Senate, under bipartisan sponsorship, passed the "Court Interpreters Improvement Act of 1985" which extended standards established previously for courtrooms to grand jury proceedings. What was worse in Mr. Kamiyama's case, according to Carleton Sherwood, was that the prosecuting attorney had obtained evidence of the faulty translations but suppressed it.

Notwithstanding legal safeguards, the government's determination to convict Rev. Moon raised the issue of his getting a fair trial. The major problem was obtaining an unbiased jury. A pre-trial survey conducted by a noted public opinion reseracher which covered all demographic segments in Southern New York showed that Rev. Moon was "the subject of profound public hostility." In the sampling of 1,000 persons,

The overwhelming majority...knew of and were negatively predisposed toward Reverend Moon (76.4% responding unfavorably to the name "Reverend Moon, "70.4% unfavorably to the name "Sun Myung Moon," 67.3% unfavorably to the term "Moonies"...and almost all using such perjorative terms as "crook," "hoax," "racketeer," who "brainwashes" and "exploits the young" to describe Reverend Moon. Indeed, as many as 42.9%



acknowledge that "[i]f [they] had the chance, [they'd] throw Reverend Sun Myung Moon in jail.

On March 10, 1982, Rev. Moon's counsel "moved for a bench trial on the ground that pervasive public hostility precluded selection of a fair and impartial jury. However, the government refused to consent, giving as its reason Rev. Moon's post-arraignment speech at the Foley Square courthouse, published in the *New York Times*, which criticized the government's motives for

prosecuting him. In his remarks, Rev. Moon suggested that the prosecution was motivated by racial and religious prejudice. As he put it in a memorable turn of phrase, "If my skin were white and my religion Presbyterian, I would not be here today." The government asserted that a jury trial was necessary lest Rev. Moon "blame any adverse result...on religious and racial bigotry." However, defense attorneys argued in their Apellant Brief that "the government in substance and effect punished him for exercising his rights to freedom of expression."

Despite his stated belief that a non-jury trial would have been "fairer," the trial judge sided with the government and refused Rev. Moon's motion for a bench trial. In attempting to get an "untainted" jury, the judge frankly recognized that "the leaning has been heavily towards people who don't read much, don't talk much and don't know much because they are obviously the persons who start off with the least bias...the less educated and less intelligent people." The downside of this was the jury had trouble comprehending the case, a

> situation that the government exploited by introducing a great deal of evidentiary complexity and over 2,000 documentary exhibits. The defense contended that the selection process had not produced a jury cleansed of prejudicial attitudes but, quite the contrary, one that "was saturated with negative information." Moreover, "the selection of an unusually uneducated and uninformed jury," according to Rev. Moon's lawyers, "increased the risk that the jury would substitute prejudice for reasoned judgment, denying a fair trial."

> There were additional procedural problems. The major one was the assumption on the part of the trial judge that "religious issues would not enter into the case." This was compatible with the government's intention to treat Rev. Moon no differently than any other corporate executive. However, it skewed the whole proceeding. Rev. Moon's counsel "contended both pre- and post-trial that his prosecution had been motivated by hostility to his religion." Specifically, they showed that

Unification News IIFWP London Summit of World Muslim Leaders



n August 3-5, 2002, the Summit of World Muslim Leaders was held in London, England. This was the second in a series of Muslim Summits that have been designed to explore the "State of the Muslim World Today," which was this Summit's theme.

Approximately 54 Muslim leaders and scholars attended representing 21 nations. The goal was to keep the proceedings intimate enough to foster true dialogue and sharing at a time when the Muslim world needs most to come together.

The Opening Plenary titled the, 'Role of Islam in the 21st Century,' was moderated by Mr. Tajeldin I. Hamad, Chair of the Planning Committee and included Baroness Manzala Pola Uddin from the House of Lords in London, Dr. M.A. Zaki

Badawi, Principal of the Muslim College in London, Dr. Chung Hwan Kwak, Chairman of the IIFWP and H.E. A b d u r r a h m a n Wahid, former president of Indonesia from 1999-2001, who has been instrumental in



making this conference series a success. Session Two: 'Islam, Human Rights and Democracy,' was chaired by Dr. Imtiyaz Ahmed Shaukat Ali Yusuf, Professor at Assumption University, Thailand and included Professor Sulayman S. Nyang,

Professor of African and Islamic Studies,

Howard University and Grand Imam Sayyed Mohammed Musawi, Secretary General of the World Ahlul Bayt Islamic League.

The Third Session, 'Quaranic Interpretation in Changing Times', was chaired by Dr. Suhaib Hasan, Secretary of the Islamic Sharia Council, U.K., The speak-

ers included Chief Imam Cheikh Hassan Cisse, Founder and Chairman of the African American Islamic Institute, Dr. Mohamad Abdulrahman Al Habach, Director, Islamic Studies, Syria and Professor M. Abdul Haleem, Director of Islamic Studies (S.O.A.S), UK.


Session Four which con-

tinued on the second day included: 'Issues in Islamic Education: Problems and Prospects,' and was chaired by Dr. M. Habib Chirzin, President of the Islamic Millennium Forum. The speakers included Dr. M. Hussin Mutalib, Director General of the Center for Contemporary Islamic Studies, Singapore and Dr. Mumtaz Ahmad, Professor of Political Science, Hampton University.

Followed were group discussions that courageously took on the most pressing issues facing the Islamic world today. Although the Summit was short the impact was far reaching. At the first Summit, which was held in Dec. 20-23, 2001 in Jakarta, Indonesia soon after the events of September 11th, 150 Muslim leaders attended representing 51 nations. It was during this summit that the significant Jakarta Declaration was drafted. This declaration affirmed Islam as a religion of peace and justice and concludes by saying, "We pledge to be courageous defenders of peaceful teachings and interpretation of Islam and to be exemplary peacemakers in our personal, family and social conduct of our lives."

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the defense lawyers contended that the trial court's instructions to the jury were "fatally defective." Finally, the trial judge cut off inquiry into improper influences on the jury and issued a "sweepingly broad gag order" restraining the defense, "on pain of contempt, from communicating with or contacting in any manner whatsoever any...juror involved in the case without the prior consent of the court."


The trial began on April 1, 1981 and lasted approximately six weeks. On May 18, 1981, the jury returned its verdict against Rev. Moon on all charges: one count of conspiracy to file false income tax returns and obstruction of justice and three counts of filing false tax returns for 1973, 1974 and 1975. On July 16, 1981, the court sentenced Rev. Moon to 18 months in prison and a \$25,000 fine plus costs. Rev. Moon's legal team exhausted virtually every appeal motion available. However, in the end, their post-trial motions were all denied. The trial judge denied motions for acquittal, a new trial,

and an evidentiary hearing on selective prosecution. The Second Circuit Court of Appeals, in a split decision, sustained the conviction in September 1983 and refused an en banc review by the entire Second Circuit. The U.S. Solicitor General recommended against Supreme Court review and on May 14, 1984, the Supreme Court justices denied Rev. Moon's petititon for certiorari. The defense's plea for community service instead of time in jail due to fears for Rev. Moon's security also was refused. The only positive outcome was the trial judge's "binding recommendation" to the U.S. Attorney General against deportation. Because the court had sentenced him to more than a year in prison, Rev. Moon was eligible for deportation. The government's lawyers, according to Carleton Sherwood, were "eager to rid the country of Moon" and pressed the judge not to issue an opinion on the matter, "leaving the Immigration and Naturalization Service a free hand to carry out its will." However, in this instance, Judge Gerard Goettel did not see things the government's way. Some had expressed the view that deportation was the government's goal all along and that Rev. Moon's indictment originally was handed down while he was out of the country with the expectation that he would not return and face the charges. Judge Goettel's position was that deportation, in addition to the eighteen-month jail sentence that he himself had imposed represented "excessive punishment." His decision, though technically a recommendation, was binding on the Justice Department and could not be appealed.

The final phase of Rev. Moon's "Danbury course" was his incarceration, first, from July 20, 1984 until July 4, 1985 at Danbury Federal Correctional Institution, Connecticut, and then from July 4, 1985 until August 20, 1985 at Phoenix House Foundation, Inc., a halfway house in Brooklyn, New York. Rev. Moon served thirteen months of his eighteen-month sentence, getting five months off for good behavior. Danbury was a minimum-security facility for approximately 200 men convicted of "white-collar" crimes. Rev. Moon shared a cubicle with Mr. Kamiyama for four months until the latter's release in November 1984. The facility had visiting hours on alternate days between 8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m., and a regular stream of family members, church leaders and official guests visited Rev. Moon. All inmates were required to have jobs, and Rev. Moon performed a variety of menial tasks in the dining room, setting up for breakfast every day, mopping, wiping tables, etc. There were no reported incidents during Rev. Moon's incarceration. He had exhorted church members to "act responsibly and honorably," specifically requesting that they not come to Danbury without permission. Reportedly, in the beginning many inmates avoided Rev. Moon, "afraid that if they were seen with him or attended religious activities together with him that the other

inmates would think that they had become Moonies." Some referred to Rev. Moon as "Full-Moon" and Mr. Kamiyama as "Half-Moon." Others sought out Rev. Moon for counsel. Several fellow prisoners testified to his friendliness and exemplary behavior. Rev. Moon had a parole hearing in October 1984 but was denied by the U.S. Parole Commission on February 20, 1985.

For his part, Rev. Moon regarded the day of his departure for Danbury as "a glorious and victorious, historical day." In a "Farewell Address" to members, he stated that he was walking "the road of the cross with hope and a totally victorious mind." He exhorted them not to send him off with tears, but that if there were "tears automatically streaming down...they must not be tears of tragedy...but tears of determination, telling me, 'Trust us. We are going to bring a hundred times greater victory in the days to come." He was convinced that "resurrection and Pentecost will come" and that "the Unification sunrise" was "now coming to the world." At Danbury, Rev. Moon spent time praying, reviewing many of his previous speeches, studying English and Spanish, receiving reports and providing direction to church leaders, working with imates, and reaching out to Christian leaders. Upon his release, Rev. Moon stated at a welcoming "God and Freedom Banquet" in Washington, D.C. that while in prison he "did not brood with hatred or resentment for those who persecuted me, nor did I spend my time...pleading my innocence. Rather, I dedicated the time in prison to prayer and mediatation, for understanding what America must do to follow God's will for the world," Dr. Bo Hi Pak, recently awarded an honorary doctorate from the Catholic University of La Plata, Argentina, found it "providential" that Rev. Moon stayed in a half-way house named "Phoenix House" as there were "two phoenix birds on the Korean president's flag" and in the West, "the phoenix is a bird that never dies or gives up, but always rises from the ashes, comes back, fights, and wins."

his is the third and final article in a series about human nature and interactions. As we've seen, chemistry alone cannot explain human nature; not our souls, or our minds, and maybe not even our bodies.

The most important human interaction is raising our young. If that doesn't go right, there won't be any humans left to worry about!

It's common to regard the trials faced by today's young people as worse than ever before. In some ways that's true, especially if you don't count areas (or historical periods) beset by wars, slavery, and famine.

Teenagers were, quite literally, invented in America. The word itself was first used in print in 1941. Before then, the very concept was unknown.

Historically, a boy went to work when he was ready, sometimes before the age of twelve. Whether as a pioneer, a soldier, or an apprentice, he was regarded by society as a man.

A girl reached puberty and married. Originally, the legal age of consent for American girls was twelve; in one state it was six! Only at the end of the 1800s did reformers, working alongside the anti-youth labor movement, get those ages changed.

Following the Great Depression, the advent of widespread, mandatory High School began to 'concentrate' young people. These students were exempted from the draft, even when World War Two erupted.

This nurtured a separate and distinct youth culture. Advertisers quickly perceived it as a vast new market for clothing, music, etc. Over the years, this phenomena has only increased.

At that time Child Psychology became an accepted field, and a Juvenile Justice system was established. Young people are regarded as having special rights, different than adults.

Now that legal trend is reversing, with "try them as an adult" laws coming back with a vengeance. (Thomas Hine's book *The Rise & Fall of the American Teenager* explains much.)

The peaceful "good old days" recalled by our parents date from mid-century, as crime rates before the Depression were sometimes very high. American youth gangs go back more than 150 years. New York City has long been notorious for its wretched immigrants and brutal hooligans. (Read Caleb Carr's excellent historical novel *The Alienist*.)

Beauty

Humans appreciate beauty. We build museums and scenic overlooks, and enjoy butterfly wings at least as much as their wearers do.

For several decades, all this was assumed to be cultural, as standards of beauty can vary. The postscript was usually that this is oppressive to women, as it faced them with impossible standards, and made them "objects" for men.

ular culture. Also, it's no coincidence that Santa Claus wears a beard.

Researchers such as Victor Johnson have used computer graphics to combine the most attractive women's faces, ultimately resulting in 'hyperfeminine' visions of beauty. (No doubt of interest to plastic surgeons.)

This appreciation underlies much of our behavior. A beautiful woman is less likely to get blamed for a car accident, or to receive a harsh criminal penalty. Tall men get paid more, and have a better chance of being elected to office.

The next time a disaster happens, look carefully at the news photography. Usually the pictures will feature the most beautiful women among the victims and/or mourners.

Conformity

In human societies, even small girls feel a certain pressure to look attractive. (School fairs offer books on makeup for teens.) This is usually a positive motivation, but it can lead to excesses such as bulimia.

Were this an ideal world, beauty would always be a pure thing. Unfortunately, human nature is tainted. Too often, beauty really is skin deep. Fashion photographer Marco Glaviano writes: "I'm not embarrassed to admit that I'm not interested in what's behind the veneer or what it means. When it comes right down to it, I could make a murderer look like an angel, so it's not the inside that interests me."

As a photographer myself, I've seen 'out take' pictures of supermodels (in between photo sessions) scowling, puffing on cigarettes, guzzling beer, and looking not very attractive....

On the other hand, a truly loving couple will grow old together, and hardly notice the slow changes wrought by time. As Paul Harvey loves to report, one now hears about 70th, and even 80th, wedding anniversaries.

Heritage

Early in the 19th century, scientists codified a popular idea: that the races differ fundamentally. For example, that "wretched" Africans could never succeed without European rulers. At the extreme, that all Jews were incorrigible and had to be wiped out.

In revulsion, modern scientists embraced the opposite idea. Saying that culture is everything, and human nature entirely malleable. Scholars like Ashley Montague and Frank Boas claimed that babies are a 'blank slate' upon which parents and society imprint whatever abilities and character the child has. that much of our individual character springs from our genes.

Information theorists have looked beyond the physical genes. Richard Dawkins posited the existence of 'memes.' Otherwise known as information viruses, they're like 'mental building blocks' made of learned facts and assump-

True Beauty

Our Family Church congregations have no shortage of physical beauty. We enjoy the positive effects of an optimistic attitude, of good relationships, and of a healthful and active lifestyle. Members of every physical type are loved by our children, and embraced for their good works.

All humans have some degree of spiritual awareness. People often appear shallow when first encountered, but if you get to know someone, this usually proves false.

Given time, people are able to perceive everyone's goodness, or lack thereof. (Some folks, especially dependent women, may deny what they uncover.) We all hope to find a deeper beauty, the kind that shows in actions, and lasts eternally.

Unificationists have a special love of heartistic beauty, and for heroic deeds. Several recent Seung Hwa ceremonies have brought this out in profound detail.

Conclusion

Unique among the world's creatures, humans recognize beauty, and value it. Due to the Fall this recognition has been dominated by the physical. You must get to know someone, in person, or by way of their deeds, to discern their inner beauty. (This is much more than a cliché!) Later on, as the restoration progresses, such things will be immediately clear to all.

It's inspiring that there is so much beauty and goodness in the world, even though humankind remains far from God's ideal. People *know* that love and beauty are real, and should be true and lasting.

Now everyone must understand the steps which lead to love and beauty, and have the courage to make the journey. True Parents have shown us the way.
