Declaring the Era of the Peace Kingdom

This address was given on March 23, 2004 at the United States Capitol, Washington, DC

The starting point to unravel the problems humanity faces today is the certain knowledge of God, the Father of all creation and, on that foundation, the building of true families that live in attendance to God. This calls us to establish and attend God in our families, not as a concept but as the substantial Parent of us all. To do this, we first must clarify the relationship between God and humanity. God is the original entity of true love, true life and true lineage, and He is the True Parent of all people. If human beings had not fallen, we would have reached perfection in God’s true love as His true children and lived in attendance to Him as our Parent. God’s plan was for perfected human beings to bond as true husbands and wives, bear and raise true children so that they would live in a Kingdom of Heaven on Earth, and then live together eternally in the heavenly world as families in the Kingdom of Heaven. Think about it for a moment.

If your father went to hell and only your mother went to Heaven, what kind of Heaven would that be? If your parents were to go to hell and only you children went to Heaven, how could that be called Heaven? The Kingdom of Heaven is where the whole family lives together in an eternal peace kingdom. On earth

en on earth? First, each member of the family needs to complete his or her individual character. Each person has to shed the fallen nature that has passed from the fall down through the generations, and achieve the perfection of his or her character. In other words, each person

envy, greed, hatred and all other evils, will never again take root in the person who has achieved this state.

Shedding the fallen nature is not easy. The reality of fallen human beings is that we vacillate even when trying to break habits formed over the relatively short span of a few years or decades, like smoking or drinking alcohol. We cannot expect, then, that it will be easy to cast off fallen nature, which we inherit through lineages going back thousands, even tens of thousands of years.

It is impossible by human effort alone. We need to stand on the foundation of absolute faith, establish God as our vertical axis, and struggle our entire life. Even then, it is a difficult fight. We cannot even think we will gain victory unless we enter a state of absolute love for God, loving Him even more than we love our own parents and children, and attending Him as our True Parent. We cannot hope to win this fight without a foundation of absolute obedience to God, following Him even at the cost of laying down our life.

Herein lies the reason that religions place fasting, sexual abstinence, sacrifice and penance in the uppermost

position. We must be born again, recast as new persons in whom Heaven can reside and with whom the spirit world can cooperate. We cannot betray an iota of shame even if our entire life and being is exposed before all God's creation. Our character should be like a "high noon settlement," on the straight vertical line of God's grace without the slightest shadow, so that Satan will flee from our presence for eternity.

Second, individuals who achieve such completion of character come together to form true families, and the members of these families work together to establish what I call the "four great realms of heart." Such families resemble, in form, an individual who has accomplished the complete oneness of mind and body. I have said that the Kingdom of Heaven is a place we enter family by family. Not every family, however, is qualified to enter Heaven automatically. You need a foundation to be a true family and to complete the four great realms of heart. A true family that can enter the Kingdom of Heaven is composed of true individuals who have completed the four great realms of heart in themselves and who are of a lineage centering on God.

What do I mean, then, by the "four great realms of heart"? I refer to the perfection of the heart of parents, the heart between a husband and wife, the heart of children, and the heart of siblings. This is found in a true family bound by God's original true love, true life and true lineage through a chaste three-generational lineage of grandparents, parents, and (grand) children. Here, the love between parents and children establishes the vertical relationship between upper and lower; the love between the husband and wife establishes the horizontal relationship that brings left and right into definitive oneness, and the love between siblings establishes the relationship between front and back. In this way, God's ideal of creation is no longer a mere concept or dream. It is perfected in reality through the completion of the four great realms of heart centered on true lineages, family by family.

The realm of parental heart is acquired naturally as parents go through the process of bearing children and then raising and educating them with true love. In other words, it is the heart that enables the parents to own true love with respect to the children. Without children, no one can own love as a parent.

Next, the realm of conjugal heart is the love relationship that extends true lineage. In this, husband and wife each are grateful for the other having established them as an owner of love, and each learns true love through giving and receiving with the other. They enjoy learning of true love when the husband lives for the sake of his wife, even if it means sacrificing his own life, and the wife attends her husband with the heart of attending God. The perfection of the husband-wife relationship is possible only on this basis.

The moment a bride and groom share love on their wedding night with God's blessing, they inherit the palace of true

love, the palace of true life, and the palace of true lineage. The wife, through her husband, receives God's ideal son, who is also Heaven's older brother, Heaven's husband, and Heaven's parent. The husband stands in the corresponding position in receiving his wife. When the realm of conjugal heart is perfected, the relationship between the husband and wife also becomes absolute, unique, unchanging and eternal, because God is absolute, unique, unchanging and eternal. So the term "divorce" cannot even exist. Theirs will be a life of happiness, filled only with the blossoms of mutual respect and love.

Next, how can we describe the heart of children, and how is it obtained? The parents are the center, in God's position in the family, and it is impossible for a child to be born without parents. For these reasons, the relationship between parent and child is established not by human morality but by a heavenly morality. Thus the parent-child relationship is a vertical relationship, not horizontal. It is not a relationship of destiny, which means that human effort can change it, but it is a relationship of absolute and eternal fate.

Children experience and learn the heart of true love as they attend their parents in daily life, placing their parents in a position higher than themselves. Through a natural process, they come to understand that the love, life and lineage that they inherit from their parents originate in God. Children who watch and learn from their parents in this way will grow up to become husbands and wives who have no fallen nature, and ultimately they will obtain the position of true parents themselves. The spherical motion of the family unit that continually repeats the three-generational pattern in this way is the basic model for building the Kingdom of Heaven.

Lastly, the realm of the heart of siblings arises through brothers and sisters who live as a family in attendance to the same true parents. I said earlier that the heart between brothers and sisters establishes the relationship between front and back. True parents are a husband and wife living in truth, and children who attend such parents will naturally learn the discipline of heavenly morality and ethics among siblings.

It will be a beautiful sight, where a younger brother attends and reveres his older brother as he would his father, and the older brother looks after his younger brother with a loving heart. The older brother represents "front" and the younger brother represents "back." The older brother represents the father, while the younger brother represents the mother. The perfection of the realm of heart between siblings is the foundation for all people to live for the sake of others through love and service.

Respected guests, as the number of "true peace family kingdoms" perfect-

ing the four great realms of heart increases, "true peace tribe kingdoms," "true peace nation kingdoms," and ultimately the "true peace world kingdom" will appear. In this way this will become the original world of God's ideal, the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth, the eternal Kingdom of Peace on Earth. I am declaring this here today. Humanity has lived without the certain knowledge that establishing true families is the most serious, foundational commandment of Heaven.

A new era has arrived today. The number of people around the world who have received my teaching and are standing resolutely for the sake of building the Kingdom of Peace is growing by leaps and bounds. Heaven and earth are shaking with the cries of bright young people who are determined to build true families even if they must offer their lives in order to protect their purity. Already, we find hundreds of millions of blessed families around the world. These families are shoring up a world in which ethics and morality are rapidly deteriorating.

That is not all. The spirit world is one step ahead of us in breaking open the age of the peace kingdom. Starting with the five great saints, more than 120 billion blessed families are working day and night to cooperate with us on earth and prepare for the day that is to come. According to the Principle of Creation, God's ideal world should be completed first on earth. Although people today are descendants of the fall, God's unending love and the spirit world's cooperation now allow us to understand the nature of the heaven-

IIPC : Forging a Path to Reconciliation at a Time of Global Crisis

Several dozen religious and civic leaders were honored March 23 in Washington for their “exceptional dedication” as peacemakers.

“Crown of Peace” awards were presented at a dinner at the Dirksen Senate Office Building, the highlight of a three-day conference on peace and reconciliation, which ends today at the Washington Plaza Hotel.

To end divisions of pain, suffering and conflict, “one core principle is necessary—the principle of living for the sake of others,” said the Rev. Chung Hwan Kwak, chairman of the IIFWP.

The Rev. Moon, the founder of the federation, and his wife, Hak Ja Han Moon, received Crown of Peace awards for their lifelong public service. In his remarks, Rev. Moon said historical divisions are solved when men and women form “God-centered families” and live in harmony with other such families.

“Sooner or later, we have to give what we have to our descendants and leave this world,” said Rev. Moon, who turned 84 this year. “What gift could be more precious than that of completing the family ideal in your family, so as to guarantee eternal peace and happiness to your children? Surely no one who has such an opportunity should hesitate to take up the task of building the peace kingdom on Earth.”

Eliezer Glaubach, a mediator and political leader in Jerusalem, and Imam Mohammed Ali Elahi, director of the Islamic House of Wisdom in Dearborn, Mich., were honored with Crown of Peace national awards for their efforts to reconcile Jews, Christians and Muslims in the Middle East.

The dinner included a ceremony in which representatives of Judaism, Islam and Christianity exchanged symbols of one



another’s faiths as expressions of reconciliation.

The Rev. Walter Fauntroy also received a Crown of Peace award.

Mr. Fauntroy, pastor of the New Bethel Baptist Church and former D.C. delegate to the U.S. House of Representatives, was honored for his work for civil rights and for economic prosperity for low-income communities.

Jewell Praying Wolf James, a member of the Lummi Indian tribe in Ferndale, Wash., and head of the House of Tears Carvers, was honored as a peacemaker for his work in creating “healing” totem poles “to ease shared grief.”

Mr. James and his craftsmen have carved such a pole to commemorate the September 11 terror attacks and a carving for the peoples of the Middle East.

Nearly 90 other religious, civil, political and educational “ambassadors for peace” were cited for their regional efforts. Members of Congress assisting at the event included Sen. Mark Dayton, Minnesota Democrat, Reps. Roscoe G. Bartlett of Maryland, Christopher B. Cannon of Utah and Curt Weldon of Pennsylvania, all Republicans, and Democratic Reps. Danny K. Davis of Illinois, Harold E Ford Jr. of Tennessee and Sanford D. Bishop Jr. of Georgia. ❖

Forging a Path to Reconciliation at a Time of Global Crisis

This is the Opening Banquet: Keynote Address given by Rev. Kwak, Chairman, IIFWP and IIPC, in Washington D.C., at the Washington Plaza Hotel, March 22, 2003.

On behalf of Rev. and Mrs. Sun Myung Moon, it is my honor to welcome you to this Leadership Seminar sponsored by the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace and the Interreligious and International Peace Council. Thank you for your attendance here and for recognizing the importance of our coming together to consider the theme, "Forging a Path to Peace at a Time of Global Crisis."

The IIFWP was launched by Rev. Moon to initiate a global movement for peace, centered on universal spiritual and moral principles, and calling for broad cooperation among committed volunteers from all nations, races, religions and cultures.

Peace, most fundamentally, has to do with the quality of relationships. That is, peace describes a state in which relationships are harmonious and cooperative. Harmony occurs in the natural world as objects behave in accordance with the internal physical laws of the universe. Likewise, harmony and peace are achieved in human relationships when we follow the spiritual and moral laws of the universe.

For this reason, without an understanding of God, and God's principles, peace will never be achieved. As human beings, we are not merely physical beings. We have been cre-

ated as beings that are both physical and spiritual. We are spiritual beings who exist in physical bodies throughout our lifetime on earth. At a certain point in time, each of us will pass out of our physical existence. However, we will continue to exist as spiritual beings, and we will each dwell in the spiritual world for eternity. Our quality of life in the spiritual world will depend on the level of spiritual maturity and heart we achieve during our physical life.

The reason the world's great spiritual teachers have advised us to live according to spiritual principles and to avoid material pleasures and comforts is precisely because our physical life is both very significant and very temporary. Like a fetus developing in a mother's womb, our physical life on earth is a time of spiritual development, training and growth, a preparatory school for our eternal life. Just as life in the womb precedes and prepares us for our life on earth, our life on earth precedes and prepares us for our life in the spiritual world.

When we think of peace, we must think on many levels. Too often we associate peace with the administration of political power. That is, we often think that peace can be brought into being by an external force or by some external law. Peace, however, does not begin from the realm of politics or government. Peace begins with the individual.

Furthermore, peace moves from the most internal dimension to the external, from invisible to visible, and from spiritual to physical. Thus, when we speak of the individual as the foundation of peace, we refer most fundamentally to the internal character and spiritual awareness of the individual.

The first challenge for peace is my own self. If I cannot establish peace within myself, by establishing God-centered harmony and cooperation between my mind and body, then I cannot expect to create a world of peace. For example, if I am troubled and conflicted within my own character—if my conscience is continually overruled by

the desires of the body—I will not be at peace, regardless of the situation in the external world. Thus, the basis of peace is to solve the problem of my individual character. And, solving the individual character problem is primarily a matter of spiritual development.

The core principle that guides the work of IIPC is "living for the sake of others." Moreover, this principle can be the basis of a new methodology for peace and good governance.

The principle of "living for the sake of others" is not the teaching of any single religion or moral philosophy. One can find it represented in the sacred writings of virtually all the world's great religions, not to mention the great moral philosophers. Not only is it a great teaching, it is a practical guide or rule for action and practice. We recognize this principle at work in the lives of Jesus, Moses, Mohammed, Buddha, Confucius, Socrates, Gandhi, and other such spiritual leaders.

Our greatest religious founders understood this principle to be as basic as the natural laws of the universe, such as the law of gravity or other laws of mathematics, physics or chemistry. When we violate this law, there are grave consequences. Peace itself has its foundation in the application of this principle.

Just as God is the author and origin of the most basic scientific laws of the universe, God is also the author and origin of the basic spiritual and moral laws of the universe. Just as we gain enlightenment concerning our physical cir-

cumstances through scientific knowl-
edge, we can gain enlightenment con-
cerning our spiritual circumstances
through religion.

The foundation of a true and last-
ing peace is God. However, human his-
tory, due to the Fall, has not been an
expression of God’s original ideal. Con-
sequently, God has been seeking to re-
establish relationships of true love with
human beings. In fact, in order for
providential history to advance toward
restoration of fallen humanity, God
needs to work through an “Abel-like”
individual, family, tribe or nation. For
example, within Adam’s family, God
sought to work through Abel, who was
relatively faithful and righteous. How-
ever, sadly, he was killed by his own
elder brother, Cain. Despite this set-
back, God continues to work accord-
ing to this formula. Ultimately, by work-
ing with an Abel-like individual, fam-
ily, tribe and nation, God seeks to
establish a foundation for the Messia-
h, one who comes to restore the Fall
of Adam and Eve and establish God’s
lineage and the Peace Kingdom of true
love.

That is, throughout history, God has
sought to establish His family on earth,
His lineage of true love. Today, this
dream is becoming a reality and all
humanity is mov-
ing toward a direct
relationship with
God, as partners
in a relationship
of true love. According to Rev.
Moon we have
entered an age in
which the eternal
and living God can
exercise full
dominion, a
dominion of true
love, which is
God’s most fun-
damental attrib-
ute. This age of
peace has true love as the basis for
human relationships. This new era of
peace is characterized by the practice
of living for the sake of others.

At the outset of 2004 Rev. Moon pro-
claimed the dawning of the “era of the
Peace Kingdom.” The Peace Kingdom
refers to the establishment of a realm
of universal harmony, cooperation and
prosperity among all people, beyond
race, religion, nationality or culture.
Within the Peace Kingdom all human
beings belong to one family and one
lineage of true love under God. The cit-
izens of the Peace Kingdom are broth-
ers and sisters living together in true
love.

Of course, the world we inhabit and
the world we read about every day in
our newspaper or the world we see rep-
resented on the news channels reveals
a very different story. Here we see a
world of conflict and suffering rooted
in human selfishness, stubborn pride,
and moral failure.

How can we possibly move from the
world we see around us, to a world of
true and lasting peace. How do we move
from a kingdom of evil, to a Kingdom
of God? For this we need a guide, a
navigator who can see beneath the sur-
face. Rev. Moon can see with spiritua-
l eyes, and knows the timetable of
God’s providence and the conditions

that have been made and the condi-
tions that are necessary if we are to
move further ahead. Time and time
again I have experienced his insight
into God’s providential plan.

On October 3rd of last year,
the IIFWP launched the IIPC.
At the Inaugural Assembly of
the IIPC, Dr. Moon delivered
an address on the “elimina-
tion of boundaries.” In that
speech, presented to a gath-
ering of 1500 international
delegates from more than 160
nations, he offered the fol-
lowing guidance,

“When we love our ene-
mies and make oneness with
them, the boundaries between
us will collapse. That is why
God’s strategy and tactic has
always been ‘love your enemy.’
There can be no greater strat-
egy for peace than this. Throughout
history this incred-
ible fact has escaped human-
ity’s understanding, and it
has yet to be grasped even in
modern times. Today I tell
you clearly that God’s strat-
egy and tactic for human sal-
vation is to love your enemy.
You and the members of the Unifica-
tion Church who have followed me until
now are the representatives of history
as well as of the current world who
now know Heaven’s incredible secret.

Our responsibility now
is to inherit this prin-
ciple, put it into prac-
tice, and become a
true human being. If
you accomplish these
things, you are sure
to become a key play-
er in bringing about
a world of peace.”

A Peace Kingdom
is a kingdom of men
and women who live
according to the prin-
ciple of “living for the
sake of others.” It is
not a realm ruled by
any single dictator or

leader, or through any external power
or military force. Peace proceeds from
the individual, to the family, the soci-
ety, the nation and the world, and has
its foundation in the principle of living
for the sake of others.

The Peace Kingdom is established
as we each come to inherit the true
love of God, applying the principle of
living for the sake of others in our fam-
ilies, our religions, our associations,
and in our governments. We inherit
the true love of God on the founda-
tion of harmony, unity and
cooperation.

The key to peace is for each
person to develop true moral
character based on a heart of
true love. Moral character emerges
as the conscience develops
through a relationship with God’s
love and truth. Our resolve to
develop good habits and moral
character is strengthened by a
deep awareness of the reality of
our spiritual life and the spiri-
tual world around us, and know-
ing that our destiny is to dwell
eternally in the spiritual world.
This awareness informs our every-
day decisions, pointing us always

Thus, peace is not brought

into being by external force or power.
Rather, as we each mature and per-
fect ourselves in the true love of God,
peace will emerge naturally and accord-

many dramatic changes. In particular,
the coming new era will be character-
ized by three primary developments.

First of all, there will be a growing
interest and awareness of
the spiritual reality that
surrounds us. Whereas
recent history has been
overly materialistic, human-
istic and even atheistic, we
are in the midst of a spiri-
tual awakening that will
transform history.

Secondly, more and more
people will come to realize
the sacred and social sig-
nificance of the family. Once
again, in recent decades,
and in societies around the
world, we have seen a break-
down of the family and the
emergence of strange and
dysfunctional family struc-
tures. However, in this cen-
tury, as our spiritual sens-
es are attuned, we will come
to appreciate the absolute
and sacred value of the fam-
ily as the school of true love.

Finally, the desire for
true peace will grow stronger
as we open our spiritual

senses. Peace is not the goal of any
single nation or race or religion. Peace
is a global issue. Unfortunately, our
world suffers from so many conflicts.
Still, peace is the hope of all ages, and
we are going to witness the dawn of an
age in which we learn to overcome the
divisions of the past. We will learn to
reconcile with one another and love
one another, beyond race, beyond reli-
gion, beyond nationality, beyond bound-
aries.

Without cultivating our spirituali-
ty, however, it is impossible to mani-
fest or embody a character of true love.
Without developing our spirituality, we
cannot hope to establish an ideal fam-
ily and we cannot properly educate the
next generation. Thus, these three
trends are interrelated. Through spiri-
tual development we set the founda-
tion for the establishment of families
of true love, and on this foundation a
true and lasting peace is possible.

Our world is about to be turned
upside down through a revolution of
the heart—a revolution of true love and
goodness. The IIPC is an instrument
that will help usher in the Peace King-
dom, bringing not only hope to billions
of people the world over, but bringing
concrete solutions to our critical prob-
lems. ♦

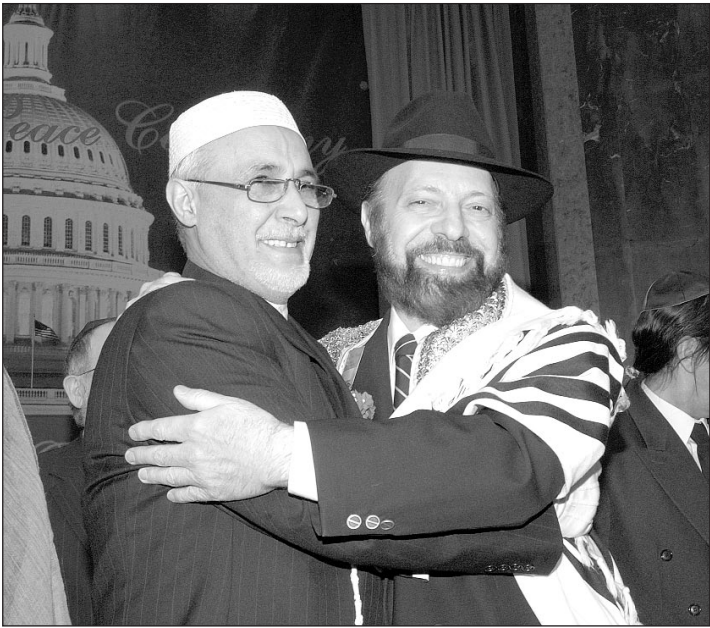

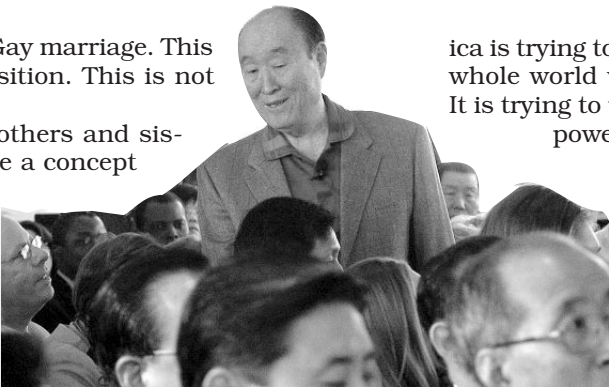

One year ago on Good Friday, 120 Christians followed the lead of Archbishop George Augustus Stallings and stepped across the threshold of history taking down the crosses from their churches on Good Friday. 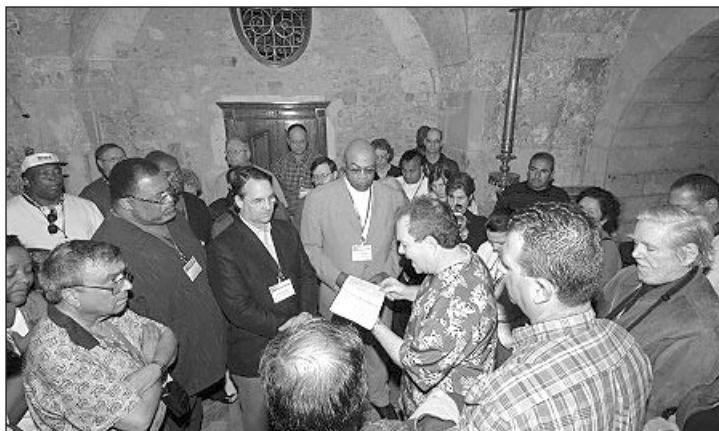
could be reunited. Father could not attend this ceremony because it was officiated by Heung Jin Nim.

April 4 Pilgrimage to Jerusalem

Haitham Bundakji, an American Muslim cleric from Orange County, California, was up front in the al-Aksa Mosque, Friday, when shots rang. The imam just ended his sermon, but there was no mistake about the noise. People were running screaming and then, he said, he saw fire and smoke.

Someone got on to a loudspeaker and called the Israeli policemen to leave, and fear God. "Allahu Alkbar," God is Great, the caller repeated. Bundakji, a Palestinian who immigrated to California and became a chaplain at the Garden Grove Police Department, was one of some 80 clerics and laymen from the United States, Canada, and several other countries who came to Jerusalem in an ongoing effort to reconcile the three monotheistic religions. Their idea is that a religious reconciliation could help resolve the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. The trip was organized by IIFWP, an organization founded by Rev. Moon. Al-Aksa Mosque is Islam's third holi-

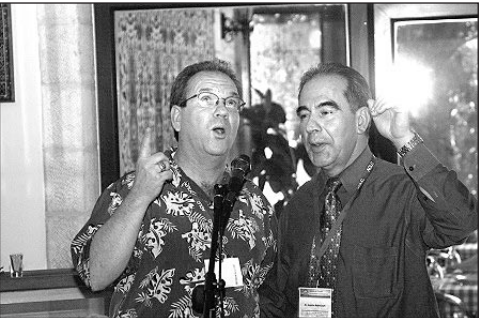


the group that used that route to get in and out of the Palestinian area. Only half a dozen people were at the Greek Orthodox section of the Church of Nativity during a Palm Sunday prayer. The street that used to be the main entrance to down, from Jerusalem, was now a dead-end route leading to a barricaded army post.

The road to the Deheishe refugee camp, south of Bethlehem, passed by the bombed out Palestinian security headquarters and burnt out rusty remnants of camouflage colored Palestinian security pick up vans. The refugees' plight clearly aroused the visitors' sympathy. A hat was passed along the visitors' two busses and within minutes \$700 were collected. However, sometimes group members had difficulties getting their message across. Bundakji said he had tried to talk to an Israeli police captain involved in Friday's clash. Bundakji said he showed his California police card, and smiled. "Please, may I speak to you," he said he asked. The officer had no patience for niceties. An agreement negotiated with the Wakf provided that the worshippers be allowed to leave quietly, Ben-Ruby reported. "Get out. Out," the captain reportedly ordered. "But I am your friend... I love you," protested Bundakji.

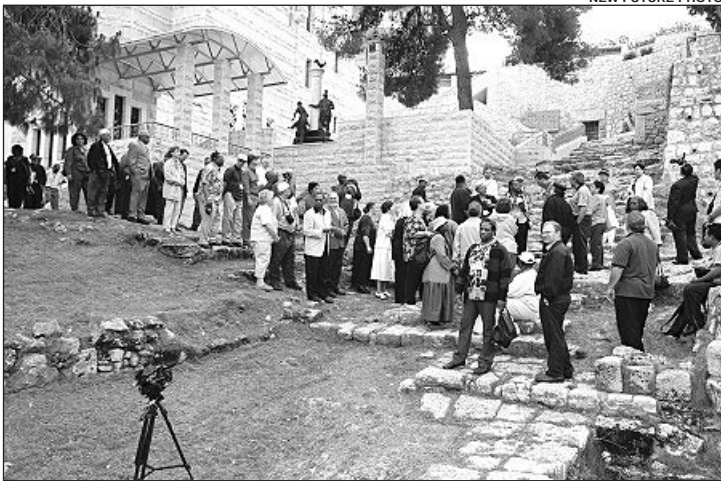
The emotions the Rev. Michael Jenkins, Deputy Chairman of IIFWP and other visitors demonstrated at the meeting with the Wakf leaders seemed to have gotten across. "We pledge our lives to protect al Aksa Mosque," Jenkins, declared. Church bells chimed when the group met Salhab and they were still together when a moazin called Muslims to prayer. The call originated on the mount's loudspeakers and quickly resonated throughout the Old City. Jenkins closed his eyes tightly and clasped hands with Salhab and Bundakji.

Bishop George Augustus Stallings Jr. held his palms, facing upwards, as



est site. Muslims believe that the Prophet Mohammad ascended to heaven from a nearby rock now topped by a golden dome. To Jews, it is the holiest site of all, the place where their ancient temples had existed. Bundakji brought the group there, Sunday.

An later attempt by the group to enter Bethlehem through an army checkpoint, failed. The crossing was closed and the visitors shared the Palestinian experience of crossing the lines illegally, and on foot. The busses drove up to the outskirts of the Christian town of Beit Jalla, near Bethlehem. White haired visitors and men using canes joined the others in climbing a steep incline to the Palestinian side where local busses awaited them. Police did not interfere with

Tears rolled down some participants' cheeks. Salhab smiled when members followed Jenkins in repeating the Arabic and English version of the Islamic text recognizing God as the only God and bearing witness that Mohammad is his Messenger. "You can see the leaders here are beginning to feel that we are really sincere," Rev. Phillip Schanker proclaimed.

"The seed (for resolution of the conflict) is germinating and developing," added Jenkins. He expected to succeed, "If we can be patient to continue to relate, especially on the basis of love and family and faith." The political path would lead to a dead end now, he indicated. "We can't relate on politics. Political relationships will lead to very definitive yes or no questions that we're not ready to address yet.... Even if we get political resolutions or different accords, if our hearts are still full of anguish and enmity it will end up tearing down any accord, it will just come out again," he said. Earlier, on Saturday, about 21 members of the group visited Gaza and met with senior Palestinian officials and activists.

The trip was coordinated with Ra'fat Sa'dallah, the chairman of the Palestinian National Association for Youth in Gaza, who received them and arranged a tour in Gaza City. Jenkins of the IIFWP and Haitham Bundakji, who is also director of the Islamic Center of Orange County,

CA., headed the delegation that included Islamic, Christian and Jewish clerics as well as U.S. senators. "

The IIFWP has plans to keep sending delegations, included Muslim, Christian and Jewish clergymen, former Israeli Knesset members and a senators in the United States Senate," said Sa'dallah. The delegation later held a meeting with Palestinian religious leaders, Palestinian Authority representatives and individual Palestinian initiators. ♦

Reflections on the 5th Peace Pilgrimage

The holy places are not just for one people or one religion, but for all people. Originally, the Temple was to be a house of prayer for all people (Isa. 56:7). When people build walls to lock out those of another faith, they block the spirit of God.

I saw Jews cry because Muslims built a mosque on their Temple foundation. I saw Muslims cry because Christians closed their mosque or tore down their mosque to build a church in its place. But Jews, Christians and Muslims cried together when our imams returned safely after the attack on Al-Aqsa during Friday prayers on April 2. Like Jacob experienced with Esau, I saw the face of God in them. This is a living example of God wiping away tears and making all things new (Rev. 21:4-5).

Furthermore, through the grace of True Parents, we can make any place holy. At the checkpoint. Upon arriving at the checkpoint in Gaza en route to Jerusalem, we learned that Israel had closed her borders. We called down the spirit of God through music. After several songs, we began singing:

Sweet Holy Spirit, sweet spirit of love, Stay right here with us, filling us with Your love. And for these blessings, we lift our hearts in praise. Without a doubt we'll know that we have been revived, When we shall leave this place.

We didn't know when and how we would leave. But with the chorus of this song, I lowered my hands to the floor, gathering up the sin and death of this world to raise up to heaven, and then gathered the glory of heaven to bring

Holy Spirit came down in a bus parked by the Gaza checkpoint where so many people have died of terrorist attacks. A Jew and a Christian became caught up in the spirit and changed the tears of heaven and earth into overwhelming laughter.

As we sang more songs, the Palestinian guards came closer to the bus to listen. Eventually, we were able to leave the bus, be processed through the Palestinian checkpoint, and proceed towards the Israeli checkpoint. In the eaves of the corridor little birds twittered and fluttered, singing their own odes to the creator. No checkpoints detained them.

While waiting between metal rails in the Israeli holding pens, under the eyes of a guard in a watchtower above us, index finger on the trigger of the Uzi pointed toward us, we kept singing. One young guard kept coming over with requests for his favorite pieces. Blacks and whites, Pentecostals and Unificationists, sopranos and tenors, we joined our voices in light, uplifting songs. With Uzis aimed at our feet and knees, we set the rhythm: "truth is marching, truth is marching, truth is marching." Then we took up the prophetic words: "Mine eyes have seen the glory of the coming of the Lord" and lifted the hallelujahs up through the barbed wires unto the spangled heavens.



King. I am determined now more than ever to set up non violent conflict resolution workshops for the religious leaders on both sides. We must address this urgent crisis. It can be resolved with God's power.

James Cowin:

I am Jewish and quite proud of my lineage. All my life I have considered the Palestinians, if not enemies, at least alien. In years past, given the political struggles we endured, such a view seemed in line with the providence. Yet, in Gaza, in the midst of seemingly the most violent of the adversaries of my people, I found myself volunteering to help the Palestinians in their campaign to publicize their efforts to bring normalcy and peace to the hearts of their children. I knew I could not have done this without my life of faith in the Principle.

Probably my most meaningful, experience of the trip was up on the stage in the banquet hall in Nazareth, when Rev. Jenkins called all the Jewish members to stand with him and receive applause. Before this, all the groups introduced had received warm but normal applause. But, suddenly, every Palestinian in the hall was extremely alert, and when Rev. Jenkins said, "We're not just doing things on stage; all these people are working to bring peace to Palestine," the applause was overwhelming. I was experiencing the culmination of my experience in the church. Before this, I had known that I could not fulfill our church mis-

sion with my old consciousness. But now I deeply felt that I was in the process of changing. I still puzzle over the feelings that I am supposed to have when my worst enemies applaud me for helping them to defeat (at least on an external level) my own people.

I have been trying to comfort Jesus at all the holy sites of his life we visited. I didn't know if it meant anything. In answer to my prayer, Jesus said to me, "You comforted me and welcomed me in my own country. That means a lot to me." I felt he took my hand. I cried a lot.

Thank you, Mother and Father Moon. I saw Sacajawea and Pocahontas in the spirit world speaking about their way of peace. As sisters we must gather the sisters and help them to teach peace in the homes, the schools, the city, the country, and all nations. Our sisters have asked us to help them in their crisis, the death of their loved ones, and their broken spirits. They asked me to stay and come to their homes. I was very touched in the Upper Room. The birth of Christianity was at one time a mosque, a worship place for Muslims. This is very clear proof of how close Islam and Christianity are.

I was very disappointed in the great ignorance of many members of the Arab-Israeli conflict and ignorance of Islam. A pre-trip basic education should be given to the pilgrims.

Most thanks to Father and Mother Moon, for their vision and support for just and peaceful solutions to the Arab-Israeli conflict.

How Can Interfaith Heal Our World Crisis?

UTS Interfaith Prayer Breakfast

On Tuesday, March 9, a group of Muslims, Hindus and Christians gathered for prayer, food, and fellowship at the Unification Theological Seminary (UTS) in Barrytown, New York. Notable participants included the President of a major Baptist New York State Convention, an imam from a local mosque; leaders of a local Hindu Temple; the Executive Director of the county interfaith council; a professor in Religious Studies in Poughkeepsie, Bishop Ki Yeal Lee of the Upstate New York Family Church, Dr. and Mrs. Dietrich Seidel, professor at UTS and Marist College, Dr. Tyler Hendricks, President of UTS, who served as emcee, and Dr. David S.C Kim, President Emeritus of UTS.

The theme of the gathering was "How Can Interfaith Heal Our World Crisis?" The program began shortly after eight with a prayer offered by the Reverend Berger. Dr. Hendricks introduced the ACLC and then called upon each participant to introduce her or himself. Then he introduced the speaker, Mr. Chris Antal, a candidate for the degree of Masters of Divinity and Director of the Just Peace Project at UTS.

Mr. Antal spoke on the topic "Growing Up in a New Religious America." He noted that Dutchess County, like many communities in America, is a multi-religious community, and that local residents have a unique opportunity to learn about the world religions simply by getting to know their neighbors.

"Religion and Ethics Newsweekly." It contained an interview with Diana Eck, Professor of Comparative Religions at Harvard University and author of A New Religious America (2001). Eck spoke about the need for Christians

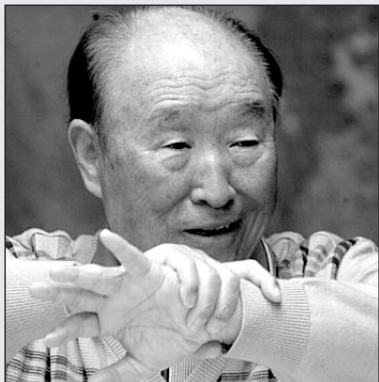
in America to not just "tolerate" their new neighbors, but "know" and "love" them "as they are."

Mr. Antal concluded his talk by sharing about his first encounter with Professor Eck during a meeting at the

Department of State in 1998, when she was serving on the Advisory Committee for Religious Freedom Abroad. Mr. Antal and his wife gave testimony at that meeting about the persecution their church had experienced in Japan in the hands of clergy. He shared how that meeting awakened him to the reality of inter-religious conflict and inspired in him the desire to search for religious underpinnings for tolerance and respect for others—ideas that could promote interfaith dialogue and cooperation.

After the talk, Mr. Antal guided a discussion about, "what in your religious tradition instructs you to love your neighbor, especially your neighbor whose faith is different than your own?" This led to a lively and enlightening discussion.

Following the discussion, mezzo-soprano and wife of Bishop Lee, sang "The Lord's Prayer," setting a deep atmosphere for a series of prayers from various traditions. Leaders from the Unification, Christian, Hindu and Muslim communities offered prayers. The event concluded with a word about the significant progress co-sponsor ACLC is having bringing Jews, Christians and Muslims together in the Holy Land. The participants had ample time for further discussion and networking over coffee, and to join Dr. Seidel on a guided tour of the seminary chapel. Everyone left with a gift bag that included a video about the Middle East Peace Initiative. ❖

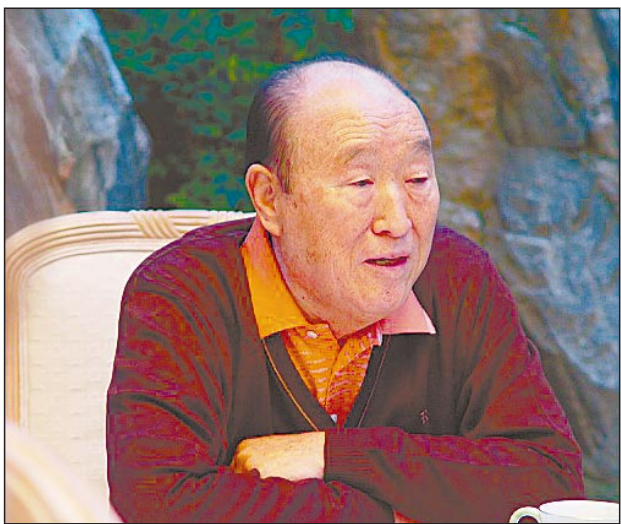

I believe this is the first time both Father and Mother went out striped bass fishing together on the Hudson River.

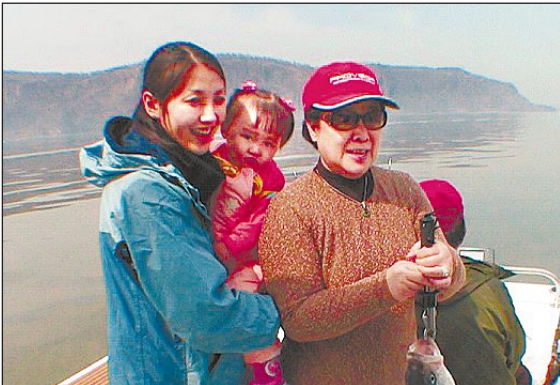
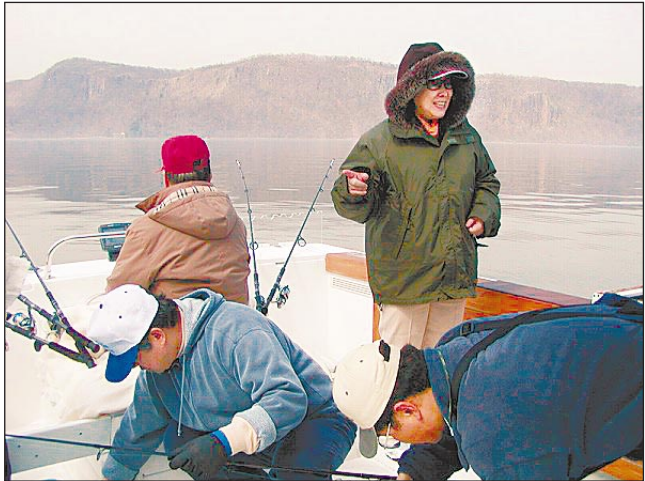
It was a beautiful day to be on the water and to fish. We fished for two hours and caught twelve "keepers" including Father's 33" fish which is the biggest fish of this season.

This is from unofficial notes taken at the address Father gave to the ministers April 7, 2004 at East Garden by Rev. Michael Jenkins, translation by Rev. In Hoi Lee.

It is essential that you clergy understand the spiritual world. When you go to the spiritual world you must teach the people there to remove all barriers.

If I didn't offer this coronation to Jesus do you think the Chief Priests and the Jews can look at him in the spirit world. It would make huge confusion in the spirit world when True Parents go there. You know about the Western Wall in Jerusalem. Who is going to liberate all this suffering. You clergy must solve even the problem between Jesus and Judas. Who cannot believe what I am saying now.

You must unite all Christianity and

all religions. Look at the Presbyterians and the Methodists. How can they represent Jesus and be divided. From the readings from the spirit world you can see that even Karl Marx has changed.

Do you think that I wanted to be the Parents of all Humanity and the Second Coming. I didn't even think about it but only thought about how to com-

fort God.

Bishop Stallings you took down the cross. But your work to liberate Jesus should also liberate God. Jesus was chosen to bring love to all people and remove all barriers. You should very clearly understand this.

Although you did a great job in Gaza and Israel you must really commit yourself to save them. You must become a representative of Jesus. How will we deliver this message of Jesus with all of this confusion in the world. It is like fertilizer for the fruit of the fall.

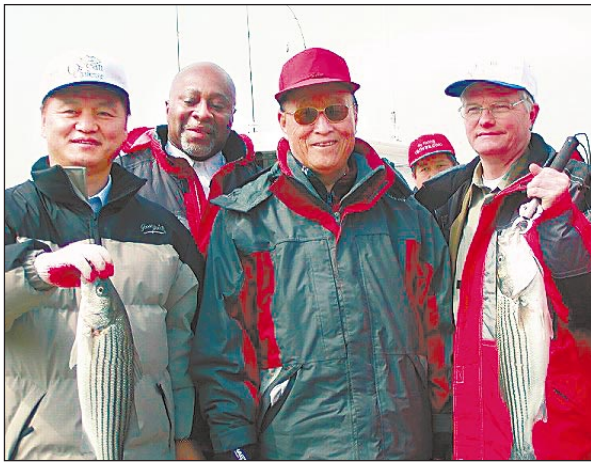
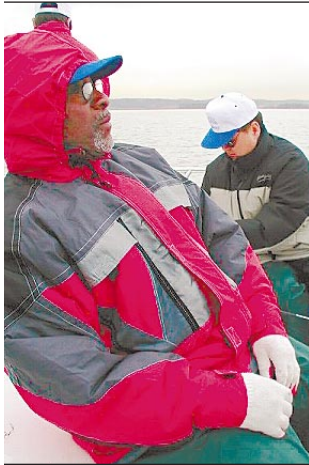
tion to unify all. You should commit to give your life totally for the sake of God. You should risk your life.

the spirit world. There is one central root for all of humanity. Everyone grew from the false olive tree, it is rooted in the Fall. This must be cut and engrafted into the True Olive Tree. The Coronation of True Parents and King and Queen of the Peace Kingdom was no small event. This was not a symbol or a simple matter. This Coronation of March 23rd was a most serious condition in history and was a central point for the Peace Kingdom.

We must do away with individualism. Individualism is against Jesus. We must make all denominations into one. Do you want to follow me or stay in your own denomination. It is time for your to follow me but you don't understand clearly. It looks like untruth. Jesus helped you to reach me. You can go forward and don't even need to report to me. If you do the right thing you'll be protected. If you did the wrong thing this time in Israel you would not have come back. Father was so serious about you and praying for you. You came back and God is so relieved.

You don't know how serious the coronation was in history. If that didn't happen then there was a possibility that an atomic bomb would have been dropped on the Gaza Strip. Dr. Yang and Rev. Jenkins and Bishop Stallings, I had to push you so much to do the Coronation on Capitol Hill. You didn't know how much seriousness was behind this. I pushed Rev. Kwak, Dr. Yang and Rev. Jenkins so hard. Only I knew what was going on.

Did you help me. You haven't helped me. Jesus was in the same situation. The chosen leaders didn't understand and didn't help him.

Did you see the Passion movie. I didn't want to see that movie. I didn't want to experience the pain and sorrow again. We must realize that the pain and suffering of Jesus is caused by Christianity and they made all the divisions and blocks in history.

Did you support me. How did you

come to this place. Dr. Yang asked me to bring the clergy here. You didn't come on your own. I just want to convey this message to you. Study the resolution in the spiritual world of the five major religious leaders.

Archbishop Stallings do you ask Dr. Yang to treat you special. You should be the student of Dr. Yang. Who attends True Parents. Dr. Yang is the one who attends True Parents. Therefore you must study under Dr. Yang. Who can imagine that this kind of simple per-



son from Korea became the Messiah of the world. I never thought about that. I just kept obeying God. Such a complicated path I walked. No one understood and no one believed. Still God guided me to continue to follow until he lifted me so that I could overcome every kind of situation of the world.

Who emphasized the separation of Church and State. It is not God's viewpoint. How will we bring the Peace Kingdom. It will be through the blessing of the family. There is no religion in the Peace Kingdom. We go beyond religion into the Kingdom of God. In this country of America the Unification Church was blocked. What kind of religious freedom is this?

Bishop Stallings and Rev. Edwards, I am not defeated by you. Even physically I am not defeated by you. How about the clergy here. Who is meeting me for the first time. You came here by force didn't you? (No Father, by your love). In the Media world the Washington Time and UPI I can expose the crimes of any people. One nation under God. One universe under God must be proclaimed. You think America is over God?

In the Gaza strip I made up my mind that if one of your died in the Gaza strip I was prepared to mobilize the world movement and media to support you. I was determined to do everything and anything to protect you and save the people there.

Because God exists I could found the Holy Spirit Association for the Unification of World Christianity. Because of this foundation created 50 years ago I could come to the point in which all of your could come with me.

I am the fiercest fighter in the world. I can bite each one of you because of the foundation I have and you won't complain.

I want to give you some direction are you willing to follow what I say:

What if I ask you to live naked from now? Will you follow that? (Yes- if weakly). I know all the background of the civilization. Even I went to jail in America but they could not kill me.

You are in the position of the High Priests at Jesus time. Who killed Jesus.

The Jews at the time of Jesus did. It is very clear. I could be a most fearful and frightening person with the power of Judgment. Without tourism how can Israel survive. Do you think they own all the holy sites and can just prosper by selling tourism on the foundation of God's work. This land is not just Israel's alone. This is God's land. The Mosque there is a holy place in which Muhammad ascended into heaven. But historians try to deny it. God knows. Abraham made a mistake by not cutting the dove and the pigeon.

Because of that Ishmael and Isaac divided. Then the Jews somehow inherited. Bishop Stallings, you should be very clear about the details of history and the providence. You must understand that history of the Old and New Testament and be able to teach the understanding of the Second Coming. The denominations are fighting each other. This must stop. Through this fighting America lost God. All of you, if I was not here the Christians and Muslims could not come together. I offered 34 years of my life here. Therefore America had to offer that coronation or nuclear war could have come. Also, race war would come. Asian is 3.7 billion. White and Black are actually a small number. In terms of number you can't make such a big noise or the Asians may overcome you. The President and this nation should not be proud of our power.

understand these things. Sayomi your wife was very smart to marry you. You should be grateful for your wife. You should know how to overcome homosexuality. How?

We should do Tong Ban Kyok Pa (breakthrough on the Neighborhood level). We should build an association of families and neighborhoods and then oppose homosexuality.

If you white people go to Africa or S. America you can be killed. However as we go the way God then God will guide and protect us. I don't want to sacrifice you. I want you to live. If you go to the Holy Land and make issues then maybe you will be killed. I don't want to sacrifice you. All of you should now help me out. You are black and white, Spanish and Asian and Indian. All races are here. This is the way to go.

All the false olive trees look down on the Unificationist that is the True Olive Trees of Blessed Central Families. All should engraft to the True Olive Tree.

Then all the Family problems in America will be solved.

Compared to Unificationists you will realize that their marriages are good. All the husband and wife that love each other is not the complete aspect of the True Family. The True Family is based on the love of three generations. This is the blessing of Husband and wife and going for three generations. You should have as many children as possible. If white society so many races have come in and there has been a cultural war between the races of America. When the minorities overcome the size of the White people maybe have no place. Many minorities that America fought harbored the resentment. How has America treated the American Indians. They slaughtered hundreds of thousands. If we don't solve this it will become endless war.

Do you think the Jews stand alone as number one before everyone. No. They are not in the first place. They must serve and take the proper role.]

I came to America because America must play a major role in God's providence. That's why I'm here. All this property here in East Garden. I am thinking to sell it all for God's providence. I'm very interested in Helicopters now. America doesn't believe that it will ever perish. However this is not for sure. Only if America fulfills God's will it will prosper.

I need to go to my Hometown and be buried there. All the Korean people and North Koreans respect me very much. Do you think all the senators and congressmen will respect me. You must create a U.N. type police to protect world peace. That's why the 38th parallel could be protected.

Why did I go to Danbury prison in America without any sin? Around that time of the court case, when indicted they didn't think I would come back to America to face the trial. But I came back and faced the indemnity course. I didn't spend one penny for myself or otherwise God would judge me.

Boston Day at East Garden

Two more votes are required to the amendment to be confirmed: a second vote by the state legislature in 2005 and a popular vote in 2006. ❖

Although Baltimore is part of the Washington, DC region, it is a satellite community, physically located on the outskirts of the region, one to one and a half hour's drive from DC. The testimony I wish to share is to encourage those brothers and sisters who are working almost solo or with only a few others.

We did have an upbeat, innovative program—several presentations under the title, “The Symbol of the Cross in Light of the Gospel of Reconciliation,” the main theme being Reconciliation. Considering the heartfelt desire and need for reconciliation in our world, whether global in nature or more personally relevant to our own familial relationships, neighborhoods, and in our society, the theme of reconciliation appeals particularly to our target audience in Baltimore, the African-American clergy. Rev. Dr. Arnold Howard, one of our key ACLC Co-Conveners and most instrumental in bringing two-thirds of the guests, lifted up this primary concern in promoting our event. This theme/topic drew the bulk of our audience to Morgan Christian Interfaith Center that day. We had a total of 60+ participants of which 30 were true guests. The balance of the attendees were support persons—hosts, food-preparers, greeters, speakers, AV technicians, and ACLC core members. How is it that God placed the right person who knew the hearts of the Black Christian clergy and who know the better topic for our outreach program? I personally did not know, but Heavenly Father indicated this through Rev. Howard. Our small core team (Rev. Dr. Arnold Howard, Rev. St. George Crosse, Rev. Daniel Wilkerson, Rev. Willie Ray) has been teaching me many things. God and the spirit world brought these persons together and inspired them.

Since February of last year, two other sisters (Marianne Goldberg, Kumiko Francis) and I tried to reach out to clergy from a database of ACLC contacts, inheriting the foundation laid by Rev. & Mrs. Gregg Jones. We worked hard to invite ministers to Ocean City for last year's ACLC Convocation. Of ten persons who came from the Baltimore area, a few have steadfastly supported our efforts here. A couple of ministers have been truly called by heaven to champion and expand the ACLC mission here. My primary role and responsibility to date has been to care for, pray for, serve, call, whatever God inspires me to do to support these persons—stand on my head for days if necessary—to

move our local providence forward. I found over the past year that depending upon the earnest seriousness of my heart to do for True Parents and the specific prayer requests for assistance to absolute good ancestors in the spirit world, help would show up Meeting and working with Rev. Howard has truly been the pivotal answer to my appeals to God for help. There is no greater value than a righteous and experienced man of faith, and this has been the help Heavenly Father has sent—not of my doing.

For the period after Ocean City (3/2003) to now, God has guided my intuition of the heart during this “incubation time,” to study and to build our team unity and the sense of family. We strove for consistency, despite the days when only one or two of us would show up for a meeting. I guess spirit world could see after awhile and after tears of repentance, frustration, loneliness, and discouragement



over time that we were serious. To be able to work with such prepared persons as we have in our core team has brought immeasurable joy and hope to me. I am absolutely convinced of the assistance of the spirit world's help and earnest intent. This is in my mind a clear manifestation of the providential time we live in. Regardless of my shortcomings and limitations, if God needs something done and I just show up, it will happen. I just had to try. Only God and my absolute good spirit ancestors know how many tearful prayers I've made at every turn, every discouraging moment to date. I have come to know that as long as my heart remains determined to show love and loyalty to True Parents, to try to take ownership of True Parents' requests to us Elder Son nation members, then spirit world is obliged to help us succeed. Two-thirds of our small core ACLC team is studying the Divine Principle. And, these ministers are attempting to teach as much as they understand. Our team of “2nd Israel” brothers/sisters are taking the lead in the directions they feel called by God to go with ACLC. I am constantly trying to understand how to make sure we are growing in understanding True Parents' way of faith as we proceed. The beautiful outreach event we held on 3/20 is just one of many programs being put together by brothers and sisters, around North America. This expansion is what we should already have done many years ago. Now we are desperately playing “catch up” and the future of America is at stake. When I see the current generation of dispirited young people—for example in high schools—I sense the grave,

grave danger America is in. One particular day, when I fell into a fit of despair preparing for our 3/20 program, Rev. Howard shared with me the value of a spark in getting a mega-ton rocket off the ground. All the millions of dollars, the brilliantly integration of technology, organization, and human effort to send a space craft out of the earth's atmosphere could not occur without a spark—one tiny catalytic chemical reaction to ignite the fuel in the rocket. Without that tiny “spark,” the elaborately planned project would be forever on hold. God is so poetic (—and so is Rev. Howard, who served as a USAF captain and got his bachelor's degree in aerospace engineering prior to going into ministry). In many a moment when I bemoaned my lack of capability, God pushed me on through a precious person standing by me. I really understood who we, the initiators and “gophers” are. Speaking of precious persons, during the course of preparing this event, God challenged me to the nth degree to develop unity with my central figures and key persons on the regional and national levels. Because of disagreements, our program changed several times over from its original concept. Our funding disappeared and reappeared a few times. When faced with “bad news” from one sector, another sector would respond with “good news.” Every day there was a hurdle, a challenge. Amazingly enough to me, our key minister, Rev. Howard, took all of the ups and downs in stride, already having experienced such in other circumstances and venues. Our local FFWPU leader, Rev. Matsui, always managed to keep faith and patience—especially with me. The regional ACLC leader, Bishop C. Phillip Johnson, would patiently counsel and console my frustrated pleas. And in the end, my beloved regional director, Rev. Hong, was right on point about the program content in the first place. By the arrival of our program day, I could say, we all worked hard for the unity of heart we'd achieved. Upon that foundation of unity, signs of a real beginning for ACLC in our city manifested itself in the totally enthusiastic response we got from the attendees. It is in this beginning moment, I am grateful to report that Baltimore—as any other city in the US with just a few people—can bear fruit at this time. Exercising absolute faith, absolute love, and absolute obedience (or as much as we can muster) will garner the spirit world's help. Believe me, if heaven can use a simple person like me to do this, God can certainly use each and every brother and sister to change the destiny of this country. ❖

IIPC-Oceania Inaugural Conference

The Prime Ministers from Samoa, Tuvalu, and The Solomon Islands; the First Lady of Palau; cabinet members from Papua-New Guinea and Kiribati; a Speaker of Parliament from Vanuatu; several former Heads of State and Government as well as eminent religious leaders from surrounding countries attended the IIPC-Oceania inauguration. In all, 77 participants from 14 independent nations and one territory were among those who attended the inauguration. This three-day conference with its theme “Building a Global Movement for Lasting Peace,” convened March 9 -11, 2004, in Apia, Samoa.

Samoa was proud to host the conference inaugurating the Oceania branch of the Interreligious and International Peace Council (IIPC). The IIPC is sponsored by the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace (IIFWP) and from its inception this inauguration received, with gratitude, the full support and cooperation of the Samoan government. Invitations to the conference were sent out to Heads of Government throughout Oceania, accompanied by a letter of commendation from the Prime Minister of Samoa, the Hon. Tuilaepa Aiono Sailele Malielegaoi.

The decision to create a working partnership between both religious and political leaders is rooted in the strategy for world peace envisioned by the Founder of IIFWP / IIPC, Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon. A true and mature human being, Father Moon teaches, must have proper unity between mind and body. This model at the individual level also applies to leadership and good governance. Therefore, in order to chart a path toward lasting peace on all levels, we need to take into account both the physical and spiritual dimensions of human nature. In other words, political and religious lead-

Guinea came to officially represent their respective heads of government. On the religious side, participants included the Rev. Oka Fau'olo, Chairman of the Samoa National Council of Churches; Rev. Enja Enos, President of the National Council of Churches of the Marshall Islands; Rev. Pakoa Maraki, Secretary General of the Christian Council of Vanuatu; Mr. Ratu

address emphasized Father Moon's conviction that “the greatest strategy to realize world peace is through loving one's enemies.” This is not only a noble endeavour, he stated, but also a methodology that the world at large still fails to really comprehend.

Rev. Kwak reminded the delegates that models of good governance are need-

Sopoaga, spoke of the need for regional co-operation and noted the introduction of a new Masters Degree program to be made available through the University of the South Pacific (USP) titled “Principles and Values of Good Leadership and Governance.” The final speaker, the First Lady of Palau Mrs. Debbie Remengesau, immediately caught everyone's attention

when in a single sentence she combined her two roles: the wife of her country's leading politician and mother of her nation. On the political side, she noted that “the seas don't separate us, but rather the oceans connect us together as a family of island nations,” adding with sincere concern that, “the biggest crisis that concerns me is the ‘family crisis.’ How many of our children will grow up with an ethical standard that teaches them to live for the sake of others?”

The third session of the day outlined the core values and guiding principles of the IIPC and was titled, “IIPC

Principles of Peace and Good Governance.” The speakers were Rev. Greg Stone, Secretary-General of IIFWP Oceania, and Mrs. Karen Judd-Smith, Director of IIFWP Office of UN Relations. The first commentator was Major-General Sitiveni Rabuka, the former coup leader

and former elected Prime Minister of Fiji, who from his own experience and insight paid tribute to the things that make for peace, confessing his error in having “degenerated from being a peace keeper to a coup leader” while an officer with the Fijian Army. He reminded us that peace is the absence

of fear, all the while expressing serious concerns about the future of Fiji with its racially diverse population of indigenous Fijians and predominantly Hindu Indians. The second commentator was Rev. Falani, the President of the Christian Church of Tuvalu (representing 94% of the population), who asked, “How do we avoid the path of violence and bring peace to the Pacific?” Drawing from his religious vocation, he believed an integral part would require “revitalizing our vertical relationship with God.” The last session of the day consisted of roundtables on “Principles of Peace and Good Governance” with a focus on two distinct areas: government and religion.

During the second session titled, “Good Governance for a World in Crisis,” two Prime Ministers and a First Lady were the three speakers who offered their insights into the most critical issues of our day and recommended

ways in which governments and political and religious leaders, as well as international organizations, can better contribute to peace, social stability and prosperity at a time of global crisis. The first speaker, the Prime Minister of the Solomon Islands, Sir Allan Kemakeza, noted that “despite our differences, humanity is one.” Emphasizing that “we are here to unite the human family,” he explained that in the Solomon Islands “it is a time of national forgiveness and reconciliation.”

The Opening Plenary began with an invocation by Rev. Oka Fau'olo who stressed that “we should never forget that God is the foundation for true peace.” This was followed by the Welcoming Address from the Prime Minister of Samoa. Prime Minister Malielegaoi said that in Samoa the functions of church and state are clearly separated at the official level. However, as individuals “many of us are involved in both functions. For example, I have been Chairman of my Catholic

ed at all levels of government, from the United Nations, to national governments, to communities, to families and down to the individual level of self-governance. At the lower levels, he noted, it is easier to see that good governance requires that the physical passions be curbed in



order to allow truth, beauty, goodness and true love—the highest ideals of the human spirit—to emerge. As simple as it may seem, setting the proper relationship between the physical and spiritual dimensions is a key element in true and lasting peace, individually and globally.

Interfaith Drama in London

On Saturday 14th February, 40 people from different faiths (including Islam, Christianity, Hinduism, Sikhism, and Buddhism) came together to take part in the start of the World CARP-JK and RYS (Religious Youth Service www.rys.net) interfaith youth drama project.

The day had been set 3 months ago and preparations had been continuous throughout that time period. The project organisers (Ravindra Galhena, Ajay Rai, Marshal Desouza, Sarah Chasseaud, Rita Zaccarelli, and Simon Cooper) had been working hard together. The event was a great success for all who participated.

The main two parts to the day's schedule were four service projects at different holy sites in the West London area, and then in the afternoon drama exercises and skits based around stories from the different faiths.

To break up the parts of the day we heard reports from the four teams about the sites they visited and what they had learned that was new to them. They showed each other digital photographs of the places they visited on the projector. There was then a moving and inspiring presentation by William Haines a



Religious Education teacher from a North London Comprehensive school who fully endorsed the projects goals and visions.

The goal of the day was to experience a deeper understanding of our own faith and that of others through service and drama. The conclusion was that a large number of the youth and university students who participated held an hour long meeting at the end of the day after the event had ended to discuss the formation of the drama group, and iron out practical matters such as when and where they would rehearse.

Hence the other key goal of the day: that this interfaith drama group would take form and that it would be the start of ten weeks of rehearsals in prepara-

tion for a major performance.

Their plan is to then take the piece of drama (based on their different faiths) to school assemblies around the UK and promote the common values that their faiths hold dear. In this way they hope to pass on their experience from the 14th February.

One participant, Tasneem Housain (a student from University College London who is a Muslim), said: "I am a firm believer in these kind of initiatives which aim to emphasize common values in different faiths as a means of religious tolerance. I would like to thank you all for giving me the opportunity to be part of this. Today was a great opportunity for me to meet other people of different faiths,



with the same opinion that humanity and tolerance is just as important."

The event was also able to receive publicity on the regular news bulletins on Radio Jackie that broadcasts all across South West London as one of our CARP members is a newsreader on the station and telephoned up during the day to interview one of the project directors.

When we finally took our group photograph at the end of the day there was a real sense of accomplishing something for God in the atmosphere: barriers had been broken down and a warm and good spirit had been allowed to enter into each persons heart.

The event had been sponsored financially by the Timebank Respect initiative that has been set up by the Government and the Prince's Trust in order to promote harmony between youth of different faiths. It is also supported by the BBC. ♦

That evening the Prime Minister and the First Lady graciously welcomed the guests at a gala reception hosted by the Samoan Government held at the Robert Louis Stevenson Museum. In a beautiful mountainside retreat surrounded by immaculate gardens and expanses of manicured lawns, each person felt like an honoured guest. Traditional Samoan cuisine and a cultural performance closed out the never-to-be-forgotten IIPC-Oceania inaugural conference.


The next regional IIPC conference will be held in Canberra, Australia in May 2005. ♦

Northern California Winter Workshop

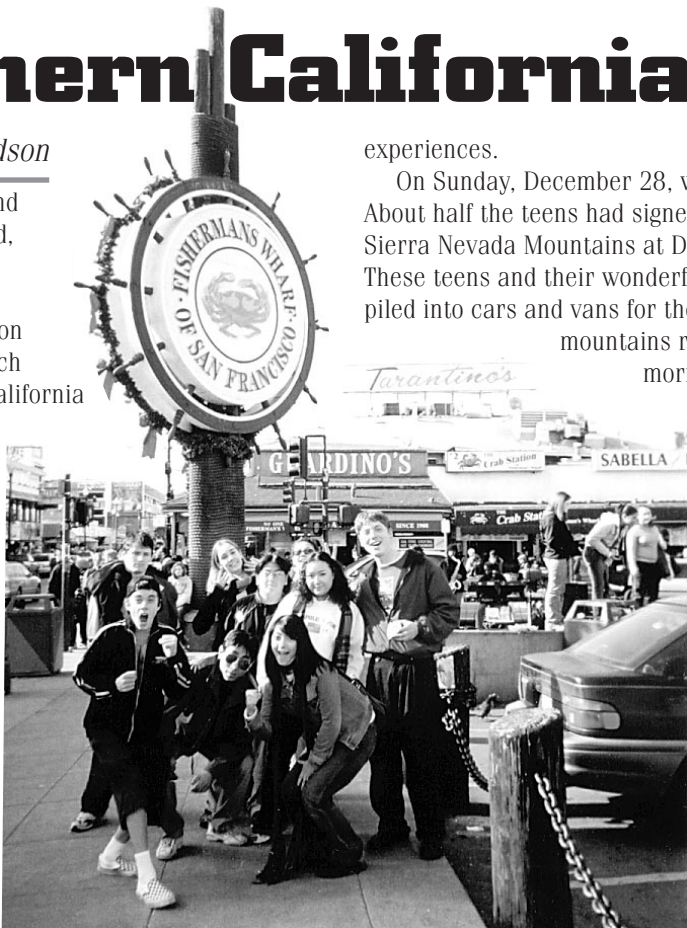

On Sunday, December 28, we had an Outing Day. About half the teens had signed up for skiing in the Sierra Nevada Mountains at Donner Ski Ranch (DSR). These teens and their wonderful volunteer drivers piled into cars and vans for the 3 hour trip to the mountains right after pledge in the morning. Due to the excellent staff at DSR, everyone was able to get onto the slopes quickly. Novices got right into an introductory class while experienced skiers couldn’t wait to head to the top for the first run of the day. Except for a brief break for lunch it was shush, shush, shush! Monday evening started with prayer and reflection. Everyone grabbed coats and other warm gear to head out to the San Leandro Marina. Once at the Marina, everyone bundled up for a short walk to the end of a spit that extends into the San Francisco Bay through the icy wind and slashing rain. After a deep prayer from Kenritsu, everyone had a chance to pray for 21 minutes and even though EVERYONE got SOAKED, it was often a deep experience!! One participant said, “It (the prayer) was great! The rain and wind was awesome! I really felt like I could just tell Heavenly Father everything!

In times of peril, the Unification Movement frequently turned inward, finding resources for renewal in the life of the spirit. As a youth in North Korea, Rev. Moon found that his “scale of thinking was far greater than just my village” and that he “was completely misunderstood.” Therefore, during his early teen years, as he noted, “Most of the time, I would go to the tombs of my forefathers and speak to them, revealing my heart.” This turning to the spiritual world coincided with a deepening of his prayer life and eventually led to a series of spiritual experiences and encounters through which he came to understand his life’s work. The same principle held for the movement as a whole. In the face of rejection by the world, the movement looked to heaven. Some members had dramatic experiences that unlocked secrets of the spiritual world. This was a tricky phenomenon that could lead to excesses, self-absorption and deviation as has been shown. On the other hand, spiritual experiences were a source of fresh inspiration, deepened meaning and purpose, new power and creative innovations. They also afforded members a foretaste of heavenly joys.

The movement experienced two significant manifestations of spiritual phenomena during the 1990s. They were associated with two elderly members who recently had passed into the spiritual world. The first was Soon Ae Hong, Mrs. Moon’s mother, who passed away on November 3, 1989. The second was Dr. Sang Jun Lee who passed on March 22, 1997. The spiritual phenomena associated with Soon Ae Hong, who gained the title Dae Mo Nim (“Great Mother”) and Dr. Lee were decidedly different, reflective of their differing characters and orientations. Dae Mo Nim’s approach was charismatic and religious, sparking a movement-wide spiritual revival after 1995. Dr. Lee’s approach was intellectual and literary, leading to systematic expositions of the spiritual world in a series of published texts. In this sense, the two man-

ifestations were complimentary. However, there also were contradictions and a sense of rivalry. Rev. Moon recognized both sets of phenomena as authentic, both were integral to the movement’s mainstream development, and both had a revitalizing effect upon members.

There were both similarities and marked differences between the spiritual revival centered on Dae Mo Nim in the middle and late 1990s and the revival centered on Heung Jin Nim during the 1980s. Both manifestations focused on personages who were either a part of or who had intimate connections with Rev. Moon’s family. In addition, both Dae Mo Nim and Heung Jin Nim were regarded by virtually all members as exemplary persons. Dae Mo Nim was understood to have dedicated her entire life to the providence, being the only member linked to several spiritual groups considered by Rev. Moon to be forerunners of HSA-UWC. Within the movement, she was known for her humble service, prayers for the well-being of True Parents, concern for the membership, and devotion to heaven. According to later testimonies, having become acutely aware of members’ spiritual struggles and suffering, she determined to go to the spiritual world early, asking God to shorten her life in order to work there for blessed couples and the providence. In this respect, themes of self-sacrifice and atonement were at the core of both revivals.

A third similarity was that Dae Mo Nim, like Heung Jin Nim, had an embodiment. For three years after her passing, Dae Mo Nim was understood to have made conditions in the spirit world for her work on earth. Next, according to an official account, “she chose and worked with Mrs. Hyo Nam Kim for three years” making “incredible, almost humanly impossible...conditions” to begin the providence on earth. Rev. Joong Hyun Pak, the American Continental Director, described Mrs. Kim as “a humble country lady...very spiritual as a child...a faithful dedicated Christian and spiritually open.” Ten years previously

Mrs. Moon was said to have visited her spiritually, indicating that she would one day work with Dae Mo Nim. In 1992, Mrs. Kim began serving church couples, solving problems, and in 1994 leaders reported what was happening to Rev. Moon. In January 1995, he gave Mrs. Kim the authority to act as Dae Mo Nim’s mediator, and on January 1, 1996, she was introduced to the American movement. By this time, members commonly addressed her as “Dae Mo Nim.”

A final similarity between the phenomena centered around Heung Jin Nim in the 1980s and Dae Mo Nim in the 1990s was that they both manifested as revivals. While the particulars might vary, the essence of revivalism was the cycle of judgment and grace. In the spiritual revival of the 1980s, the accent was on individual confessions within the context of forgiveness conferences. The 1990s revival introduced new elements, but the dynamic was essentially the same.

According to Dr. Tyler Hendricks, Dae Mo Nim was “a modern-day Jeremiah.” He wrote, “Because she is a woman, there is a certain softness to her delivery, but she delivers a powerful indictment of our condition. She would say, ‘If you could see yourselves spiritually, you would be so afraid; you would realize you are destined to hell.’ She would beg and plead with us to wake up and become serious and work hard, because we are just covered, infiltrated with evil spirits.”

Knowledge that members were covered with evil spirits was the core insight of the Dae Mo Nim revival. A number of accounts noted that prior to her passing, Dae Mo Nim prayed to God, seeking to know why most of the movement’s blessed couples, though trying their best, were unsuccessful in their missions; why so many of them had physical, economic and other problems; and why they were “sometimes worse than outside people.” According to these testimonies, God answered her prayer and opened her spiritual eyes, enabling her to see invading evil spirits which had dug into members’ physical bodies to build their nests.



and on Earth

The idea that members, especially blessed couples, were covered with evil spirits presented a problem. Generally members assumed that because they received the Blessing, followed True Parents, and lived in a principled environment, evil spirits could not touch them. They now were being told that this assumption was distant from reality. However, as several leaders pointed out, the Blessing was meant to be given unconditionally on the basis of members having achieved a certain standard of perfection. Because members had not attained that standard and were in this sense unqualified, the Blessing could only be given conditionally. Many members, in fact, did not continue to progress but rather regressed, being unable to rid themselves of their fallen nature and satanic habits. This created a base for evil spirits. Members also were subject to the interference of spirits who resented and hated their ancestors. Finally, as Rev. Joong Hyun Pak explained, “Evil spirits see light upon our Blessed couples, and because we seem very bright they come to us.” This, of course, presented something of a catch-22 situation. Whether they did poorly or well, members still were subject to evil influences.

Leaders used both literal and figurative language to describe evil spirits and their actions. To Rev. Joong Hyun Pak, they were “like invisible germs in the air we breathe.” Rev. Kwak cited Mrs. Hyo Nam Kim as saying that “evil spirits stay in our physical bodies like the eggs of an insect.”

He continued, “Thousands of them live among the cells of our body, but when they are released from the body, they appear as normal-sized spirit selves. Spirit beings have no limitation of time and space. Spirits attached to our physical body become smaller.”

According to Rev. Kwak, there were “not so many spirits in the spiritual world” since most “have come down to earth and attached themselves to people.” He stated that there were “millions of spirit selves attached to our bodies.” Rev. Young Whi Kim told American members that “spirits in the spirit world live in groups, and when the group leader comes into a person’s body, the subordinates of that leader come along.” Dae Mo Nim, herself, told members assembled at Belvedere International Training Center that there were “many evil, resentful spirits in every layer of your skin. The more I open, the more there are, even inside your blood stream, inside your bone marrow.”

These images brought many members to a point of serious repentance. Thus, Dae Mo Nim’s activities, like those of Heung Jin Nim’s embodiment during the 1980s, were revivalistic in orientation. However, there were also more important differences between the two revivals. For one, there was sense of abruptness and suddenness associated with the 1980s revival. Heung Jin Nim, had passed into the spirit world unexpectedly through a violent accident. His embodiment, though said to have been prepared by Jesus for a decade, announced himself in July 1987, conducted revivals worldwide within six months, and just as quickly burned out. There was a much more substantial period of preparation for the Dae Mo Nim revival. Dae Mo Nim, herself, had been bedrid-

den for the last ten years of her life. Thus, her passing was not unexpected, and she had ample time to prepare. As noted, she was understood to have spent another three years establishing conditions in the spiritual world. In addition, Mrs. Hyo Nam Kim, apart from her personal course of preparation, unfolded her work gradually over three years between 1992-95 before being recognized by Rev. Moon. This was sixteen years in all. The result was that the revival associated with Dae Mo Nim was far more systematic in both thought and organization.

icated and disoriented during the sessions and loosen their hold, allowing specially mobilized angels to remove them.

As explained by a longtime lecturer, “From a spiritual viewpoint, our bodies are hardened like rock. So there is no way the angels can go in. The angels have to go into our body and get the spirits out, but there is no crack for them to enter by. So we need to sing holy songs and clap. This is the time we can, so to speak, open up our hardened body so that the angels have a way to go in.”

The key point here was, unlike the earlier revival which had a strongly impulsive quality, activities associated with Dae Mo Nim had more clearly stated rationales.

A third difference between the two was that the 1990s revival had a much higher degree of continuity with the movement as a whole. For one thing, it was Korea-based. Some of the problems and a good

The Dae Mo Nim revival also was characterized by a higher level of maturity. Heung Jin Nim was seventeen at the time of his passing and his embodiment was not significantly older. In addition, his embodiment had only been in the movement a few years. By contrast, Dae Mo Nim lived a long and full life that included exposure to a variety of spiritual disciplines. Her embodiment, Mrs. Hyo Nam Kim, had been a Blessed member for twenty years before beginning her public work. As was seen, the 1980s revival centered on Heung Jin Nim’s embodiment was marked by wild excesses, inspirations of the moment and episodes of violence. The revival associated with Dae Mo Nim after 1995 was much different. Participants faced a daily schedule of prayer walks, seventy-minute holy song and clapping sessions, group reading, lectures, and other spiritual activities from 6:00 a.m. until after midnight. There also was a “hitting or slapping” component known as “An-soo” for the purpose of removing evil spirits or healing. However, members were advised against doing this strongly, and the sessions were closely monitored by on-site staff. The singing, clapping and An-soo were for the purpose of shaking and dislodging evil spirits. According to Dae Mo Nim, they get intox-

deal of the unpredictability of Heung Jin Nim’s embodiment were due to gaps of language and culture. In the case of Mrs. Hyo Nam Kim, there was an ease of communication and much more of a comfort level with her approach. To be sure, it included ecstatic shamanist components such as continually beating base drums during clapping sessions. However, these elements were blended with neo-Confucian decorum. The Dae Mo Nim revival also was solidly situated at the Chung Pyung Lake Training Center (CPLTC). The church in Korea purchased the site in 1971 and Rev. Moon frequently returned there for prayer and meditation before or after major campaigns. Located north of Seoul toward the demilitarized zone, it was “a very well-balanced meeting place of steep mountains, deep water and very pure air.” However, its uniqueness was spiritual rather than physical. Leaders of the revival associated with Dae Mo Nim understood that “True Parents had been preparing for a long time to make our Chung Pyung Land into the perfected and restored Garden of Eden...the special gateway to the spirit world and also the training ground to go to the Kingdom of Heaven.” ❖

Politicians are expert demagogues. That is, they try to appeal more to your emotions than to your mind. In almost every case, the slickest candidate, with the best hair, wins. In an age of television, Abraham Lincoln would never have been elected.

Things are going fairly well in this country, so most people see no need to vote. It takes real, widespread trouble to energize the masses, and even 9-11 seems to be fading as a priority, if not in people's memories.

TAX MONEY

When a politician promises you wonderful things, he (or she) is hoping to buy your vote. When they shake your hand, visualize their other hand reaching into your wallet. Remember, they can never give you anything—they have to take your money first. Worse, they'll waste half (maybe even three quarters) of it on sweetheart deals and bureaucratic bungling.

Of course, they tell you they're spending somebody else's money, taxed from 'the rich.' or 'big corporations.' Or that they've 'brought in Federal dollars' from some distant but unnamed locale. Politicians assume you're too ignorant to figure out their game.

Have we gotten our money's worth? In the past fifty years gov-

It's now common to hear 'bankruptcy dates' announced for Medicare, Social Security, and other programs. The government is speeding toward a cliff, and elected politicians lack the guts to even let up on the gas pedal.

FACTS

At election time candidates will roar, "It's time to get tough on (fill in the blank)!" It's usually empty rhetoric. Commentators like Sean Hannity are putting their actual records on public view.

Such plain recitations of fact are often dismissed as a "hateful attack." One is reminded of the old schoolyard taunt "it takes one to know one." and of the psychological term 'projection.'

Remember, other than collecting your taxes and traffic tickets, government has a hard time doing anything right. If a candidate promises he's going to fix things, ask for clear details.

Check out the issues, and run the numbers. You don't need a college degree for this. How much are we taxed? Where is it spent? Who'll

make the rules? Is the problem really going away?

Don't you dare rely on the nightly TV news for information. They are selective, biased, and dumbed down—and it's only getting worse. The mainstream media remains utterly silent on many vital stories.

What's the alternative?

Magazines carry a huge variety of news and opinion. Mother Jones has populist/leftist views, and excellent investigative reporting. For example, they talk about huge chemical companies suing little family dairies, for merely telling customers that their milk doesn't contain said company's artificial hormones. Also, about the Labor Dept. assisting corporations in eliminating worker's overtime pay. Plus, the new Prescription Drug bill locking in high prices, by forbidding agency bids, and individuals from buying in Canada.

Opposite this, *The Weekly Standard* magazine offers conservative news, and some truly insightful essays.

On the air, Free Speech Radio features a progressive (extreme leftist?) viewpoint. Rush Limbaugh offers humorous, conservative views. (Or insensitive, extremist ones?) Informative talk stations such as KSFO can be heard over the Internet. (At, www.KSFO.com) WorldNetDaily and other news sources flourish online.

If you're as busy as I am, you can go pester some policy wonk friends. Pick a variety of people. You may be surprised at how well-informed most folks are, and how well they can back up their viewpoints.

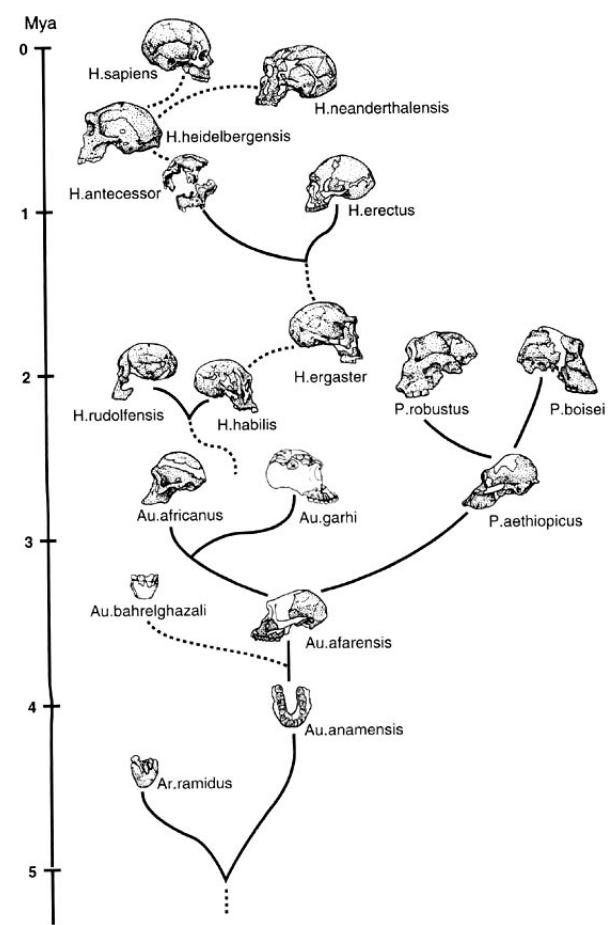


