n May 1 2005, at Blue Sea Garden, Yeosu, around thirty-four thousand people, which includes Mongolian Federation leaders from around the world, representatives of the nations of the world, participated in a commemorative service for the 51st anniversary of the founding of HSA-UWC, which was held at Blue Sea Garden in Yeosu.


Rev. Song Yeong-seok, the master of ceremonies, prepared all the participants with holy songs which was followed by True Parents, True Family and the VIPs entering the stage. Rev. Hwang Sun-jo offered the prayer and after that the MC introduced all the VIPs on the stage. After this there was an award ceremony lead by Rev. Kwak,

for some leaders who offered 15 years of their life in mission.

Rev. Dr. Kwak Chung-hwan, read father's speech, which was given on March 4, this year at Cheongpyeong Heaven and Earth Training Center. After that Mr. Kim Chong-soek, the mayor of the city of Yeosu, gave the congratulatory remarks. A conguratulatory song was offered by Mrs. Kim Mi-ran and Mr. Lee Kyu-song which was followed by offering flowers and gift to True Parents.

True Father came to podium joyfully and gave a speech tentatively titled: "Building the Original Ideal Kingship of True Love from Myself to the Cosmos". In part of the speech Father said

he constructions for the hew FFWPU Headquarters Building was completed on the foundation of the fortunes coming from the victories in the era after the coming of heaven and the crowning ceremony of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind as the King of Peace of Cosmic Unity. The dedication ceremony for this new building was held on May 5, 2005 with the attendance of True Parents.

The ceremony for that day began from 9 am on the 8th floor of the new headquarters building. Around 1,000 participants were gathered for the ceremony that day including national messiahs, relatives of True Parents, elder couples, regional directors of the Family Federation in Korea, leaders of providential organizations and core mem-




bers from around the metropolitan area in Seoul, Korea.

The ceremony was lead by Director Kim Young-jun of the Family Department who was the emcee for the day. A simple tape-cutting ceremony was held on the 1st floor lobby in which True Parents sanctified the building and wrote calligraphy to dedicate the new building. The main ceremony took place on the 8th floor. Rev. Song Yeongseok opened the ceremony with a prayer followed by Rev. Kwak Chung-hwan's report on the details of the building. DR. Kim Minha, president of the central association for Peace Ambassadors in Korea gave the congratulatory address. Kim Mi-ran (soprano) offered a song in congratulation; Lee Gwangsoo, Lim Jeong-im presented flower bouquets to True Parents. True Father then took the podium and spoke on this occasion of the dedication ceremony. The ceremony ended with a prayer by Rev. Kwak and three cheers of mansei lead by President Kim Bongtae.

Earlier at the lobby, Father gave a simple prayer before cutting the tape. True Parents presided over the sprinkling of holy salt to sanctify the new building. True Father wrote calligraphy for the new building: "Mansei, for the Kingship of Peace throughout Heaven and Earth." (unofficial translation) and then went up to the 8th floor to participate in the main ceremony.

In his report, Rev. Kwak spoke about the meaning of this day saying, "Today, May 5, the 5th year in Cheon Il Guk, is truly a significant day; it has been four days since we celebrated the 51st anniversary of the founding of our church and it is also the first anniver-

bu will reflect on the past at the moment when you look back on your life. Therefore we must indemnify the entire past. We need the revolution of indemnity to dissolve all the mistakes of the past. God sent the messiah in order to restore everything for God and humanity.

The course we went through in the past should not be seen as a path just for individuals, but as a way that all people must go. The revolution of indemnity will make a circle that will separate all of human history. To make a circle, your left and right hand must come together. Therefore, in Cheon Il Guk, two must become one. If you try to make a circle with one hand and all fingers, it is not symmetrical. Two hands, matched finger to finger, make a symmetrical and a symmetrical to the past of the past of

metrical circle. When the right and left come together, the fingers should then interlock so that they can never be separated.

Even I must go through an indem-

nity course. I cannot blame my fortune or inheritance; I must recreate my fortune centering on God. This is the way to go to the bottom of hell and then rise up.

I've met many theologians. Dr. Richard Rubinstein and Dr. Harvey Cox had many important experiences and offered appreciation for my insight. Harvey Cox wrote an introduction to one of our books, which will open his way

in the spirit world. Many of the world's scholars have challenged us, but we responded and returned the challenge. In every case, they changed and came to a better understanding.

Iraq is today's hot spot; it is the area where Adam and Eve were created and lived. Many countries in the Middle East - Iran, Syria and others -- have had a hard time.

Many Americans drink, take drugs and commit immoral sexual acts. To

justify what they have done, they have come up with the ideology of free sex. After drinking or taking drugs, they have allowed their passions to run uncontrolled in any direction. The free



sex ideology promotes promiscuity and homosexuality. Immoral love can go in any direction; thus we even see incest between a grandfather and his granddaughter. The free sex ideology is Satan's plan to destroy the family

I came to America to reverse this sin and heal this nation. America may be actually worse than Sodom and Gomorrah in this regard. Wife swapping has gone on even among society's elite; if a woman becomes pregnant, sometimes they are not sure who the father is. What about those women who wear earrings in their belly buttons? The woman's organ is like a cave and the man's is like a snake. Some women

dress provocatively to seduce men, to seduce the snake to come into the cave. The Bible says - don't eat the fruit.

You should understand that I have gone through so much hardship since I was 16 years old. Adam and Eve fell when they were 16. Satan must be defeated on all levels -- from the individual to the family and to the whole world. Satan knew my identity. Therefore he has been working to destroy me or kill me on every level - individual, family, and so on.

However, there was no accusation with which he could strike me. Because of that, I could live. If I couldn't have the right foundation, I couldn't go to sleep.

The whole world has opposed me. The communist powers tried to do away with me. However, I was never defeated. When people strike me, they find that a mysterious force supports me and I become more powerful as they decline. Michael Jenkins, do white people in America support me? Dr. McGhee,

how about black people? Both have persecuted me. Many are against me, but some understand now.

Yesterday, I shared with Mother. Only Mother really understands what I am doing. Mother knows how much I suffered and that I speak all through the night with heaven without sleep. Dr. Hendricks, do you believe in the spirit world? (Yes, Sir.) Is it a concept, or do you understand and believe? (Understand and believe.)

Dr. Yang, how will we fish today? If you receive the prize today, it will be because of your ancestors and history, not your own effort. Our offering on True Parents Day was not so great. If we always make offerings like that, our church will die. After the crowning ceremony, you must offer everything.

America is based on democracy and has the philosophy of brotherism. Therefore Americans have a hard time understanding the concepts of God as king, and the importance to the nation of filial sons and daughters.

Michael Jenkins, do you understand my teaching? (Algay Sumnida). Do you understand that I am right about this? (Yes). If there is no clear formula, all of you will be lost and separated. You must connect the relationship of everything at every level with God and True Parents.

True love is the realm and standard through which we can relate to God. I am the person that stands between God and all humanity. You represent all the world's 6 billion people. You have authority to challenge them. If you do, you will win every time. Do you understand? (Yes). I am not following behind you. You must go forward yourselves.

I have asked you to return to your hometowns. I have asked you to bless everyone at this time. That is the responsibility of tribal messiahs. If I speak a little bit more, so many secrets would come out. True love is more effective against your enemy than any weapons such as rifles, guns, or rockets. I had to overcome death many times. It has been a historic journey.

When I look at your faces, I can see that 80 % of you don't understand what I am saying. And you are humble people. I am so lonely because I know God, and He hasn't spoken anything about His suffering. I know the history of the struggle between God and Satan. I fully understand this history and God's agony. My role has been to reconcile this sad history. Satan should surrender and reconcile with God. Who should be in front? God or Satan? Satan has always been in front. But I reversed the order. bringing Satan to surrender and then putting God in front, in His proper place.

When a grandfather has his 60th birthday party, his children should be ready to inherit their father's role. When someone walks into the room, I can see everything inside. I don't focus on it because I want to leave open a way for them to make an offering.

Mrs. Chung was blessed with Jesus in 1970. Mrs. Chung, you must lead all the Chung family to unite with Heaven. If the Chung family had supported this, it would have helped the restora-

tion move incredibly rapidly. Mrs. Chung came from a very prominent family. Dr. Yang, Michael Jenkins, and all America must understand who you are and support you.

Dae Mo Nim (Hoon Mo Nim), keep going. Don't ever boast. Remain humble. You must bring people.

Lucifer felt that he was the owner and that he should kill God. This must be all washed away. Satan's desire was to destroy and obliterate God totally. God, however, does not desire the death or the destruction of the enemy, but rather his uplifting and restoration.

You should understand that you must love your enemy. This is the most fundamental principle. You may think that the Arab

countries are your enemy. However, you must not go down that path. You must love your enemy. Even though Japan attacked Pearl Harbor, General



MacArthur did a good job of restoring and respecting Japan's dignity

There is a statue of MacArthur in Incheon. He is standing there to protect Korea and is longing for the day of reunification. If Truman followed MacArthur's suggestions, everything would have been changed in just three months. America didn't have the guts at that time to take on China. America suffered under the attacks of communism because of this failure.

(To Dr. McGhee) - What is your name? (Hildreth Glennel McGhee) I can't remember all of that. I just remember McGhee. You represent all of the black community. I want all to know I welcome you with all of my heart.

Black, white and yellow are coming to love and respect me to the degree that they understand. However, most don't understand.

Now Israel is building a security wall. Dr. Yang is becoming famous there, as

well as Michael Jenkins. Dr. Yang's name means "cleaning up the dirty water." Michael Jenkins. Michael means microphone; Jenkins means destroying. You must destroy that wall. How old are you? (52). I feel that you are 32.

(To Rev. Eu) Japan has been raising financial support for the world providence. This was to restore Japan's history. Japan must focus on witnessing; from now on, you may focus on this before fundraising. If you witness to 10,000 people, it will have a huge effect. You need to go to the whole world and



teach all the world's people. Japan is in the Mother's role, and I stand as Father to the world.

The branch king is more than a heavenly ambassador. These people were chosen as the ones who can bring peace to those countries. Michael Jenkins, you are a branch king, right? (Yes.) Do you understand that your role is to bring peace?

Japanese members, please stand up. Japan should witness; you should not rest. You must bring many members. Your mission is still not fulfilled. You should make a new determination and then start. You should give yourselves totally for the salvation of the world. Japan committed many crimes of historical proportion against Korea and the world. You are still indemnifying this history; you must not fail. Within eight months you must witness. The spiritual world will help you. You must still continue your donations. And you should donate with a thankful heart. That's what I've taught you. From April to December, you must find many new members and prepare them to go out to the world. Just have one mind. Through this you can be forgiven for your past, and heavenly bless-



ing will come to Japan and to your descendants. I bless you now and believe that you must fulfill your mission.

Dr. Yang, you held a conference in Jordan. It was very important providential work. You are restoring the path of the chosen people crossing the Jordan. You must work with the political and military leaders there to bring peace. The purpose of our trips is to restore the pilgrimage spirit of the world com-

Now the communist countries produce all kinds of consumer goods for a cheap price. America can't go back to the days of supercheap mass labor. America may collapse economically in the face

of China's challenge. You must understand China. China is like a snake -one day this way, another day that way.

> You may lose everything you invest in China. America is capable of supporting China to create a market for machine tools and such. This will help

If you seek to die, you will live. If you seek to live, you will die! Martin Luther King had the guts to stand up and fight. He was a great leader for Heaven. I made a plan to embrace the black community, which is why I went to Harlem to make a special speech at Dr. Wyatt Tee Walker's church. I love the black community for supporting

me.

There are female and male insects, animals and birds. Nobody can deny that female aspect of the world is absolutely essential. The two aspects of male and female are always present. Why? The pair system of the world is a universal law. The flowers all have plus and minus, male and the female. It is only through this that the female and the male can come together and multiply. God created all things with all of His heart and mind. God wanted to keep all of His flowers in His bosom. The pair system is a universal law. That's why the same-sex pairing doesn't work. Without lineage, they will be gone within one generation.

Would you discard your partner because you don't like each other? What about the children? Would they welcome a new mother?

What about America? Is it an original nation of the Kingdom or a stepchild nation? It can't be an original nation while supporting immoral behavior. America used to belong to the Native Americans. Is it a step nation or an original nation? Do you think Columbus discovered America? That is nonsense. All the original people were from Asia, but they were slaughtered by the Span-

ish and later European settlers. America is like a stepchild. Michael Jenkins, where are you from? - (Cheon Il Guk.) Where are your ancestors from? (England, Ireland, Wales and Germany). This is correct. It shows that America doesn't have one ancestral line but is very mixed

...If we lose our second generation, there is no way to guarantee the future of humankind. On the other hand, such an education movement cannot be brought about by human theory or volition alone. heaven and new earth; a movement to re-create humankind, through the blessing marriage by True Parents, into a single race characterized by the Mongolian birthmark, that is into a "realm of the blessed lineage and fami-

After Father's speech Rev. Pak No-hee, the new regional leader of Seoul, lead all the partici-

Did I do anything wrong in history? The whole world wanted to take my life: everyone wanted to destroy me. But they couldn't. Why? Because I did nothing wrong according to the principle, so there was no condition for Satan to accuse me. I had to love my enemy. I have to love even the Japanese government, who sought to destroy me.

On True Parents Day we had to create a foundation centering on the unbreakable eternal establishment of True Parents. Based on this, all families could be blessed. This could only occur based on True Parents Day. Without this, none of you could stand.

I am willing to push America to sacrifice for the sake of Africa. We must understand that this is the world of the messiah. We must make that kind of tradition in the world. Dr. Yang, we must be ready to sacrifice everything to save Israel and the Arab countries. I may ask Michael Jenkins to go to some country and then on that basis America can be protected and understood.

Our people stood in front of the tanks in Russia and supported the course of freedom that President Gorbachev took.

You have to become the owner of this country by going back to your hometown. I will go in front of you. Although you may be ridiculed by the people in your hometown, you must go. You are an ambassador from Heaven. You must assume responsibility at this time.

ADDRESS TO ACLC CLERGY

This address was given at East Garden with ACLC key clergy present, on March 28, 2005. Notes by Rev. Michael Jenkins, simultaneous summary translation by Rev. In Hoi Lee and Mrs. Hee Hun Standard. Edited by Mrs. L. Strait and Mr. J. Flynn. These notes are taken from a simultaneous translation. Simultaneous translation is done in summary form and depends greatly on the translator's ability to communicate the essence of the message. These cannot be published as definitive texts and should never be used in the future as an "official" publication on Rev. Moon's words. However they do provide a good idea of the "spirit" of the message.)

ecause of the blood lineage we inherited at the fall, we have been cut off from the spirit world. This has been a crucial situation. There are six billion people in the world, and we must help them by restoring the blood lineage back to the lineage of heaven. The establishment of the blessed central families are to be secured through the third generation, or third grandson.

The central system of God is the family system. This can be set up properly when the blood lineage is restored back to God's side. Then the vertical line from God and the horizontal line through the family will be perfectly balanced and in order. Lineage is the most important thing of all.

Through three generations, God's love, God's life and God's lineage can be realized. We have to bring it through the third generation, or the grandson's position. How can Christian leaders understand such a providence? Only through the Divine Principle.

Through the Divine Principle we can understand the significance of the restoration of Cain and Abel. After the fall the lineage changed, and Satan could control everything. How could God reverse this control? Through the restoration of Cain and Abel.

God's love had to be reestablished in a central point for God to be able to restore the family. The restoration course was to set up the conditions to restore Adam's position, restore the bride (Eve), and reestablish the central point for God's love. On the foun-

dation of God's love, reestablished through the restored Adam and Eve, then this can be extended and secured through three generations.

This process must go through eight stages of perfection: individual, family, tribe, society, nation, world, cosmos, and finally oneness with God.

This must be connected with the one blood lineage of heaven. The most fearful enemy is the problem of love, which can lead to the destruction of the blood lineage. Therefore the most important thing for God is the establishment of a true family that is secure and beyond the problem of the misuse of love. The essential condition to establish such a family is the blessing of marriage.

The destruction of love comes through free sex and homosexuality. This must be addressed with love and restored back to the original standard. The American Christian leaders didn't clearly understand that and therefore they couldn't reverse this trend.

Adam's children couldn't be considered as God's children or of His lineage. His grandchildren of the third generation couldn't be considered God's lineage.

Therefore the most serious thing to be accomplished is the establishment of Heaven's lineage and the restoration of the fall through three generations, through the grandson of the third generation. Ultimately this must be expanded through the eight stages. The basis of this is the individual, family, tribe, society, nation, world, cosmos and God. We must go beyond the fifth realm to become saints. We must go through eight levels to become holy sons and daughters who are one with God. At least we must go through a minimum of five levels in our own course. If we go through eight levels, we reach the complete perfection and restoration. There is no one who would be qualified to go to the Kingdom of Heaven without going through these levels.

After we go through these levels, we can truly celebrate the Kingdom of Heaven. You are the clergy, and you should be leading your church members correctly. When you humble yourselves and connect with God's son through true love, true life and true lineage, then finally we can establish the ideal world; the old world will fade away. This is the realm in which there is no relationship with Satan. There will be God's nation, which will have nothing to do with Satan. Without God's complete restoration course, there would be no way for His kingdom to be built. We



have to think about how miserable God is in this position.

We must have a Peace Kingdom in which God and all humanity can live in true love forever. This also will realize the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth and in Heaven. Through this all the creation will be perfected. No matter how powerful America may be, it doesn't have the power to create the Kingdom of God. When you know this, how can you clergymen rest? You can now establish the proper order of true love, true life, and true lineage. Your denomination has still not reached that kind of level. You must bring your congregation to that level. No matter what kind of wonderful world we want to build on earth, if we still have any link to Satan, it will not be accomplished.

I have invested 34 years of my life in America. America has not really respond-

ed yet. Now is the time for America to respond. Archbishop Stallings, you may think that you have dedicated everything, and yet your church did not go over that level. Christians didn't know the true value of each individual and family. Instead individualism came about, and the churches divided. Because of this condition of division, God has truly been miserable. Americans have



been very proud of themselves and have been very human-centered. Are you clergy serious about this?

For thousands of years God has been suffering in immense pain. Some of you think that the missionaries should be standing in the back and I should be standing in the front. In heaven the situation is different. The missionaries and those on the front line are in the front and standing with God. We must make the preparation to go to the Kingdom of Heaven and really go into the realm of God's Heart.

You cannot be comfortable and save this nation. You must not only sacri-

fice your church, but you must also participate in the sacrifice of this nation. Dr. Yang, you must be serious every day to go one step forward. Some are just interested in reporting, but we must go one step forward every day.

Now is the time for me to focus on the Fatherland. If you look at Korea, Japan, and America, there are no true owners of these nations.

What language should I speak? English or Korean? You must understand how much I went through with language. (Dr. McGhee: Father, we love you no matter what language you speak.)

Within three to five years there can be the world of peace.

You must really understand me and help me to do the things that God wants to do for America and the world to bring the Peace Kingdom. To bring this world into the Peace Kingdom, we must really follow God and the people God has chosen to be in the center.

Is it "Hudson" River or "Hard Son" River? People here are somewhat challenging, so maybe it should be called the Hard Son River. No matter if there is rain or snow, we must go out. Let's see if anyone here is working harder than me. I always want to be on the front line. However now is the time when you should be taking the front line and making me follow you. Who will go fishing today? The fishing industry could completely solve the hunger problem of the world. There are so many

different kinds of animals and fish, there would be no need for hunger. Why can't you hunt or fish? We should teach all those people who are suffering. We have to help all people at this time to bring everyone to work. We can hunt if necessary. We can fish if necessary.

Where should I be laid to rest? In America? In Korea? How about Jesus? Jesus doesn't even have a tomb for his

commemoration. If Jesus had a tomb, it would be honored, and Jesus would be very happy.

You must sincerely pray for True Parents night and day. If you don't pray with sympathy and understanding, you will not be close in heart. You must be really centered on Cheon Seung Gyeong.

How many nations have nuclear power now? If there is a nuclear war, it could destroy the whole world. We must overcome all of this with true love. Nuclear arms must be buried and then destroyed. They should be buried so deeply that this world will not be affected. The tsunami wiped out hundreds of thousands. The members of our movement will be protected. You must understand this now.

You must read Dr. Sang Hun Lee, and understand the spirit world. You must be clear that True Parents offered four children.

Archbishop Stallings, you cannot save people yourself because you are not the True Parent. You have met the True Parents and through them you will be able to save the people. Archbishop, you should not be thinking about living a comfortable life. You must really sacrifice. What do you think would happen if I gave up on you? You say you are proud of your children, but you should be thinking only of how to give the blessing to three generations. All of us must establish this foundation up to three generations.

Who made the boundaries of this world? Satan made them. Satan is so far away from the ideal standard. That is the phenomenon you see in America right now, the idea of individualism and boundaries. You must be true owners. You must be connected to God's idea. We have not been able to make the Kingdom of Heaven on earth. We cannot think about owning land or just about our well being. Who made the concept of ownership that is self-centered? Satan made it.

There are so many boundaries and borderlines! These must be melted away. Boundaries made by false owners. Everywhere there are different owners. How can we destroy all of these boundaries? Satan has been against the ideal world. Satan has been doing all this through divisions and separations. We must work to make one world that is completely without divisions and boundaries.

There should be no respect of any racial boundaries. America is such a huge land with so many boundaries. How about the American Indians? They are Orientals. They were pushed out, expelled, and killed. This must be corrected. You will one day see that 70 percent of the world is connected to the Mongolian line. If we don't do this work, white people may find themselves pushed out. I am working to prevent further conflict and divisions on racial lines

Hannam-dong Welcomes Leaders from Oceania & Korea

n May 22, 2005, a morning hoondokhae session was held at Hannam-dong official residence with some 120 core members from the west Seoul region. Among the 20 Korean leaders included Lee Cheol-seung, Director of the Seoul Peace Prize Cultural Foundation. Rev. Dr. Peter Kim was the emcee for the first part of the program which was followed by the banquet.

The first part of the program began with a prayer by Mr. Kamilotege, a peace cooperator, from the Qualdalkana area of the Solomon Islands. This was followed by some brief remarks from Rev.

God doesn't want to see racial boundaries and fighting along racial lines. God wants us to unite all people together. God hates boundaries. No boundaries! There should be no more boundaries. The question is how we can build a peaceful world. The time has come for us to eliminate boundaries.

You are famous clergymen. I don't want to take anything; I want to give. Also, from God's perspective God doesn't want anything from this world. Bishop Stallings, you shouldn't be proud of your two sons. You should be thinking of God and the salvation of the world. Four of my children were sacrificed for the will of heaven. You must really realize the sacrifices that were made to bring this kingdom.

I wanted to bring that kind of result. Behind me, I had to go through tremendous persecution from Christians, Jews, and everyone else. I had to go over it by truly loving them. Along the way there were unspeakable sacrifices that had to be made. Many of you don't really want to praise me. Some of you here are just looking to use me and see what you can get from me. Many of you don't want to go through the eight stages. There is a big opposition, but we must understand how to overcome it. The reason there is persecution is because people are holding on to their boundaries and want to protect their own boundaries and habitual lifestyle at this

We must reverse the direction. We must turn this situation upside down. Do you want it to be upside down? To make it go upside down, do you want to be in low gear or high gear? If I try not to turn this upside down, I would not have received much persecution. We should now go the correct way. If we aren't in high gear turning every-

thing upside down, then we can never bring this world into the right way. You may say, I don't like everything upside down. You may spit at it. If you do, you will decline.

Now I am changing my gear. You may not like it, but if you don't follow and deny yourself -- pick up your cross and follow -- you will go back into the evil way. We must be separated from this evil world. We have been going the wrong way of false love, false life, and false lineage. Due to the fall, everything went the wrong way. That's why the way we must go is repentance and total denial of this world. Bishop Stallings, you took down the cross. That is the correct understanding. You have two sons but you should realize they are not only your sons but they are God's sons. You shouldn't just be proud of them. That is not God's idea. You should think they are God's historic sons for the whole world. People fear me and would like to expel me from this world because that is always Satan's strategy. Satan is always creating boundaries and trying to keep the people separated from God.

American clergyman are participating here and therefore I am giving you this historic message. You should understand God's strategy. You have to change your existing clothes and be willing to be naked and start over. All the clothes you have been wearing are clothes from the old era. Whatever clothes of the old era there were, they should be taken off; we should stand clean and even symbolically naked in front of God. Nothing to hide us, nothing to cover us. We should stand pure and beautiful before God. I asked all couples to sleep naked, love each other, and approach each other with a beautiful heart continuing through old age. This is beautiful and pure before God. You should have this kind of heart and love. Every night you must be naked as you sleep

and really embrace your spouse with God's heart and love.

There should be no shadows anyplace. There must be no deviation from God's light and love. If you have no sin or deviation from the perfect vertical stance before God, then you will cast no shadow under the light of God's love.

There have never been such couples in history. Now is the time for the revealing and the realization of such an ideal. Finally one couple has now appeared. God is now revealing this kind of truth, which is now unified by true love.

Now the end of the time of evil has come. The whistle has been used in a bad way in the past to attract the opposite sex. Now with true love the whistle can be beautiful before God. With that kind of love, God now wants to dance with his children with no boundaries

I'm asking you whether you couples are naked. If you are warm and caressing and loving to each other, then you won't be able to fight. All of you ACLC clergy, when you go back, you shouldn't even wear underwear !!!! This has been God's hidden message until now !!! I want you to have an ideal relationship from today. How can you fight? How can you divorce or do anything foolish to destroy your true love? You don't need to pray for this or that to be done; you must only report and offer everything to God.

You should not forget what I have said today; please do not forget about our meeting today here. You must understand the value of your partner. You must understand the real value of your spouse.

All Koreans must go back to their hometowns. I will send back immediately any Korean leader who doesn't have the right direction and tradition. You American leaders must take responsibility. You must be responsible for America.

If Rev. Jenkins spoke fluent Korean and prayed like that in Korea, Korea would change upside down.

We have to live that kind of life on earth. Do you love your wife? My push for exchange marriage is the greatest revolution in human history, the crossing of boundaries.

You can change the speed through the use of gears. (Bishop Stallings -Father is the only one that proclaims the unity and oneness of all races with exchange marriage. No one, not one, ever proclaimed this to humanity and lived.)

I have asked top Ambassadors for Peace from seven nations to come to America to hear six days of the Divine Principle. This is crucial for the providence. I have done this in Japan and Korea. After they were educated, I had them become "partners" through a sisterhood type ceremony. I am pushing this kind of wind so that it will blow throughout the world until it becomes strong enough to change the United Nations. Think what can happen! I will speak to these guests on April 13.

Because many immigrants came to America with many sad, conflicting histories, it is not easy for them to unite here in America. They remember all the conflicts in their histories, and they feel fear, jealousy, resentment and all kinds of things. Satan uses all this to divide races and divide America. We are the ones that must remove the fear and melt down these barriers with the blessing and true love. Do you understand?

This is the crucial thing - that you must establish as an exemplary family. You must become a model of love for all races and peoples and pass this on to your children and grandchildren. This is crucial. This is the way to go. Please follow this path. This is critical for us at this time. The theme of exchange marriage is most crucial. ❖

Teaching and Learning in Jerusalem

ome-schoolers from Maryland, Virginia, California, Ohio and North Carolina were part of an educational and humanitarian exchange program with the municipality of Jerusalem in February.

The Jerusalem-United States Multicultural Project, or JUMP, was a joint project between WAIT (Washington AIDS International Teens); Service for Peace; and Jerusalem's youth division, including its Multicultural Dance Troupe.

Of the 21 youth participants, more

than half were home-schooled. The trip was both a working trip and an educational one. The group was trained before leaving in the HIV/AIDS information and performing-arts techniques of the WAIT team in order to perform throughout Israel. Also, participants studied Israel itself: the people, the history and the nation's situation.

Because the U.S. group was partnering with the Multicultural Dance Troupe, languages became important for us to learn. Hebrew, Arabic and English are official languages in Israel, and there are 1 million recent Russian immigrants and

several hundred thousand immigrants from Ethiopia, Morocco and other nations around the globe. The children picked up key phrases in Hebrew and Arabic and taught a lot of English, as well.

During the trip, we were able to visit many of the natural and historical wonders of the region. We visited the ultrasalty Dead Sea, a half-mile lower than sea level, and the refreshing Ein Gedi springs, which are right next door.

We toured the tunnels under the Muslim quarter of Jerusalem that reveal the covered sections of the Western Wall of the temple, and we learned about the ways various religions and populations transformed the architecture and infrastructure of the city.

You can't be in Jerusalem without learning about the faiths of the world. This comes not just in the historic buildings and sites clustered so tightly that they sometimes are on top of one another. It's in the clothes people wear, the foods they eat, the shops that are open at different times, and the passages and expectations of their lives.

We say America has freedom of religious expression, and yet that often becomes a sort of dilution of all faiths. In Jerusalem, all faiths are expressed like a spicy stew filled with diverse ingredients that maintain their individual expression but exist in awareness and closeness to one another.

Many of the students kept photographic, video or written records of the things they experienced and learned throughout the trip as part of a study project. One young man created a photo record, taking about 8,000 pictures, from which he chose several hundred and created a written narrative.

One girl took video and interviewed participants along the way. Another focused on learning the dance moves and choreography of the Multicultural Dance Troupe. The boys from the United States learned capoeira, a martial-arts dance form. In turn, they taught break dancing to the

Israeli boys.

We also met with city and national leadership, visiting city hall and the Knesset, the legislative body of the country. We were addressed by leaders in medicine, education and community outreach. We were welcomed to a Bedouin community, a settlement of the formerly nomadic peoples, and shared a traditional meal, even learning to eat with our hands.

We met students from the Druze populations of the northern section of the country and joined in some of the traditional dances, the Debkas. We performed for, and worked closely with, people of nearly every population throughout the country.

The group learned that Israel is much richer — and much more challenged than is indicated by the simplistic news reports of bus bombings and military actions. The children our group worked with may have been Palestinian, nativeborn Israeli, Russian immigrants or Ethiopian immigrants, but to the U.S. visitors, they became Davna or Mahmoud or Lara, each with a personality, a sense of humor and cool moves.

A trip like this teaches much more than the geography and history of a country. It also imbues students with a sense of the traditions, daily life and family structures. Also, to have an opportunity to teach and to serve in the other nation is extremely valuable because so much more is learned when we teach.

Educating youth to be citizens of the world helps create different futures for our nations. Projects like this are valuable not only for the people who participate, but also for their families and for the process of international communication.

Textbook learning can't begin to rival experiencing a country and culture firsthand. We home-schoolers can take advantage of unusual opportunities and pass on our discoveries to others at home. ❖

third day. We stood where Moses stood when he looked over the promised land but could not go in. A moving service was held in which Bishop Stallings read the scriptures from Deuteronomy and Numbers that explained that because Moses struck the rock twice he could not enter the promised land. We believe that in the era of the Peace Kingdom that all is being forgiven and restored. Dr. Yang, Rev. Ji, Fosayo and I could go to the Holy Ground in Jordan near Mt. Nebo that Father Moon created 40 years

ago. Moses went with us across the Jordan this time. We sang "Joshua fought the Battle of Jericho" at the ruins of Jericho after we crossed the border. Then we entered the City of Peace -Jerusalem. Our first stop was to pray at the Garden of Gethsemane. At the tree in the middle of the Garden is our holy ground in which 40 years ago Father Moon drove three nails into the tree - one for Judaism, one for Islam and one for Christianity. He prayed that the three Abrahamic faiths would become one. We prayed at that spot in the Garden, remembering Jesus agony and yet rejoicing that having received his Crown in Jerusalem he is now exalted and liberated.

The next day we had an all day conference with Sheikh Tamimi, Conference for Interreligious Dialogue. It was officially endorsed by his excellency President Mahmoud Abbas. 50 Sheikhs attended. All the key Islam-

ic Sheikhs from each district of the West Bank came. We shared presentations from our delegates and the delegates under Sheikh Tamimi. We promoted non violent understanding of resolving the conflict in the Holy Land and the importance of the religious leaders taking a central role in peace making.

Rev. Walter Fauntroy,

noted Civil Rights leader and former member of the U.S. Congress for 20 years did an excellent presentation on Non violence and the way that it was applied to break the yoke of discrimination in America. The Shiekhs were very uplifted. It was an historic moment. We then marched together to the separation wall. Our message is that we are in the era in which we must eliminate boundaries. Therefore our position is that the wall will not support the path to peace. We call for the removal of the wall through dialogue,

understanding and mutual agreement. We fully realize that we must dissolve the hatred in the hearts of the people and get to the root causes for the con-



flict. Only when the enemies are reconciled through love and real relationship. We are witnessing tremendous response from Jewish people of faith and principle and Muslim and Christian people of faith and principle. Based on their efforts eventually the walls will be eliminated.

Only through love and absolute commitment to non violent serving, loving and sacrificing for our brothers and sisters can the pains of history be wiped away. There is hope in the Holy Land.







As always the spirit of the Holy Land is deeply moving. Participants of our IIFWP / Middle East Peace Initiative Conference entitled, "Innovative Approaches to Lasting Peace and Stability in the Middle East," is composed of delegates from Korea, and China and the former WWII enemies America,

Germany, Italy, France, England and Japan. It is amazing to see the level of the Ambassadors for Peace that have come from these and a number of other European nations.

Many members of Parliament, journalists and key decisionmakers have joined us for this journey for peace.

Mr. Hod Ben Zvi, the secretary general of IIFWP in Israel welcomed us on the first evening. Father Hatoum offered prayer and Sheikh Ali Birani and Sheikh Samik Natur offered words of encouragement prais-

ing the consistency of the delegations coming to the Holy Land. Mrs. Glaubach offered a special candlelighting and moment of silence for all that lost their lives for this memorial day in Israel. She expanded it to all

those from all faiths that lost their lives in conflict. It was beatiful we all stood for a moment of prayer and rememberance.

Father Moon's vision is real. Dr. Walsh as Secretary

general is chairing this historic conference. Rev. Song from Europe gave the welcoming address. He encouraged us all to truly find the path to peace by understanding God and loving each other.

The next morning began with Dr. Glaubach giving a briefing on the situation in the Middle East as well as the impact of the different journeys to the HolyLand. His testimony was quite deep. "I have lived in Jerusalem for 45 years and still the city facinates me, you can never discover all its secrets. Just think you are standing on the ground upon which Jesus walked, Abraham came and Isaiah prophesied. This is the most historic place and all

the Abrahamic faiths are spiritually tied here." He went on, "I want to tell you sincerely as a dedicated and loyal Jew, I am so moved in my heart that Rev. Moon would ask us to remember this time of Memorial and the founding of Israel. I want to say that only Rev. Moon can do the work that is really necessary to bring us all together and

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to heal the divisions of humanity. He is the one that is doing it. He is achieving amazing changes here in the Holy Land. You may not see it but one who has observed these Religious leaders and international delegations coming to Israel over and over. This is the 14th time. It is amazing. the atmosphere, slowly but surely, its the continuity and the consistency. It is the spirit of this effort. There has been a long history of movements that have come to Jerusalem and changed history, but this is the movement that is really working to change Jerusalem for Peace. Rev. Moon is the True Parent!'

MEPI has conducted 30 events, conferences and special events and briefings since February 2003. It has been a continuous development. Since the first Pilgrimage of America through the MEPI Fact Finding tours 14 "Journeys" to the Holy Land have been conducted. Always the participants are religiously diverse. Some of the key Imams from Europe and the United States on this journey.

Interestingly about 40 journalists have joined this effort. Articles are going forth across the world. The foundation of Ambassadors for Peace from Israel. Palestine and the nations of the world come together and a feeling of hope and change permeates the atmosphere.

Next Day, we conducted our opening plenary. Dr. Walsh gave a clear and deeply insightful briefing on our core philosophy which has two main pillars of our philosophy, they are 1) Living for the sake of others. Loving your enemies and sacrificing for others. 2) Reconciliation is the key to achieving peace. We must reconcile and resolve our differences and live together with love and respect for one another.

Dr. Yang's Keynote address was a key foundational message. It laid out the fundamental work of MEPI and that that work centers on bringing the people of faith together. Archbishop Stallings commented, "This is profoundly deep message. It gives the foundation for everything we are doing." Commenting on the presentation was Dr. Mohsen Mouelhi, the Mufti of the Conference of Sufi Jerahi in Italy. Sheikh Mouelhi's message was strong and clear, what we have heard from the conflict in the Middle East distorts the perception of what religion is about. Islam is a religion founded on the Koran and guided by the Words of Allah. It is a reli-

gion of profound depth and spirituality that guides all to truly love and serve God. What we are doing here gives a correct understanding of the role and value of religion. Religion when properly practiced will bring peace. Islam Christianity and Judaism are all founded on God's Word and when practiced correctly causes us to live in harmony together. Mr. Larry Moffit, Executive Director of the World Media Association gave

very clear insight that encouraged all the journalists to see that they were on the cutting edge of a most powerful breaking story. That is that religious leaders will make the way for peace in Jerusalem. It is happening right before

The next session was an overview of IIFWP Vision and the work of MEPI. A kev Knesset member came and addressed the body. He is an arab member of the

Knesset and quite capable and clear in his leadership. He is a person that sees the value of the IIFWP and really encouraged us to continue. He shared that he has spoken on the Knesset floor many times that weapons, force and walls will not bring the atmosphere of trust and understanding. Only through mutual respect and dialogue can this be achieved.

More reports will follow. We are seeing the way of Peace continue to develop on every level. A delegation went to Al Aqsa Mosque today and were well

received. It is quite something to see Imam Bundakji, Imam Jodeh and other Muslim Ambassadors for Peace so diligently pursuing the work of peace. They have understood the vision of Father Moon that the one God of all mankind is calling us to come together now as people of concience and work to bring harmony and cooperation among the



religious people and people of concience who have strong moral principles. This is the real battle we are fighting, not against enemies or powers but rather fighting to bring God's people together. When Joshua did this at Jericho we know what happened - the wall came tumbling down. That is why Dr. Glaubach and so many other Ambassasors for Peace from the Holy Land and from around the world get an overwhelming sense of confidence that as the people of faith come together the things that are not of God will diminish and yield to a New Jerusalem. A holy city that is prophesied in scripture. The one that Rabbi Broadman always talks about in which the day

will come when many nations will come to Jerusalem and all will be called God's people. The day that is realized upon the return of the Messi-

At the session on East Peace Initiative (MEPI), Mrs. Karen Smith, director of the UN office for IIFWP, gave a significant overview presentation on the work and the underlying val-

ues and principles behind IIFWP, presenting aspects of faith and the centrality of the family in a fresh and creative way. Showing how our value systems must be strengthened in the family, she explained that those values must extend to bringing good governance to our communities, nations, and the United Nations. She presented realistic and concrete steps that have been taken in that direction by the



IIFWP, as well as the significance of the vision and contributions of Rev. and Mrs. Moon.

The professors, scholars, and religious leaders in the audience are looking for a more in-depth understanding at this time. Many of them have become Ambassadors for Peace (AFP) over the last couple of years; through Karen's presentation they could see the vision of IIFWP to truly create a culture of peace not simply in theory but in reality. Now they can realize that the AFP that have been participating with IIFWP throughout the world are the very ambassadors who will make this vision real. Her presentation helped the AFP deepen their confidence in the ongoing worldwide development of peace councils composed of all nations, races, and religions -- of people who are practicing reconciliation and building a culture of peace.

In an overview I presented of the MEPI, I described a pattern of growth and development through the 30 IIFWP events, conferences and pilgrimages. Starting in May 2003 the first group of religious leaders came to the Holy Land

with a heart of reconciliation under Father Moon's guidance. They were asked to repent as Christians for the history of anti-Semitism and to end the era of the cross, proclaiming the time has come to embrace one another. (One of the participants, Dr. Zamoran, head of the Robert Schumann Center for Dialogue in Luxembourg, said that this trend of repentance is a fundamental pat-

tern that is now being seen throughout the world.) Well received by Jewish and Muslim leaders, this very first journey opened the door for the Jerusalem Declaration, which was an incredible step forward.

The most interesting thing about the MEPI is that it's simply based on various journeys by approximately 10,000 religious leaders, members of Parliament, NGO leaders and professionals throughout the world who came over the last two years. We have heard many from Israel testify that these continuous journeys to the Holy Land are truly

bringing an atmospheric change in people's feeling. What was deemed impossible before is now being seen as possi-

Over lunch Father Hatoum summed up the MEPI work in his gratitude for IIFWP and for Father Moon.

He said, "Without this stimulus from outside we would never be able to truly achieve peace, but now I can see peace like a light that is coming over the hill. Peace is coming to the Middle East and we can see it's because Father Moon has been guided by God to push us to seek peace, to not allow us to rest or hesitate. All parties -Jewish, Muslim and Christian are feeling the desire to seek peace actively. The key to Father Moon's teaching is very simple - we don't talk about peace; we do the peace."

At the Seven Arches hotel we could enjoy a beautiful luncheon with our participants. From this vantage point on the Mount of Olives you can see the old city of Jerusalem, gazing at the Eastern Wall and the Golden Gate that one day is to open when the messiah returns. The Dome of the Rock shines almost like a golden diamond in the center of the Old City.

Several people asked to give testimony. Mr. Rony Wuulf Smolar has been a journalist for many years and has covered the Middle East quite extensively. In the work of IIFWP he saw one of the components that was most needed - that is, the kind of supportive encouragement needed from beyond the Israelis and Palestinians. "Encouragement and enlightened support is now coming and therefore I can see the peace process moving forward. I'm deeply happy to see this."

Mrs. Neilson, wife of Cong. Neilson, shared about how she had lived on kibbutzes many years ago and saw with her own eyes that there was no problem for the Jews and Arabs to live together, heart to heart, people to people. She

said, I saw Arabs freely come and work together with us, and we would freely go and help them in their village. My former husband was a dentist and we were welcomed everywhere. Even though many were poor, Jews and Arabs had such a family spirit. I was so sad to see this family become divided by fear and conflict. They already had

common culture and common values. It seems that politics has not been able to allow for that kind of relationship. Therefore, she said, I see now through this movement that those doors are opening once again to create the structure and environment, or culture that will allow what I saw on the kibbutzes years ago where people would constantly help people.

Our next stop was at the separation wall. This time we encouraged everybody to simply gather in silence. We heard views on both side about the wall,





Unleashing the Power of Clergy and Religion in the

21st Century

he reason why man and woman have not reached their fullest potential, and become everything that God desired for them from the beginning, is that they have failed to know who God is. And they have failed, as I heard someone say, to develop that relationship to God and with God; because that's what it's all about, a relationship. That is why most church folk have yet to come to the discovery of who God is. Because they just simply want to worship God, but not love God, not know God. They don't know God. They worship God without knowing God. They have no relationship to God. They just see God as a figment of divinity, not God as parent, not God as father. So when we look at God from that particular vantage point, we're going to look at it from an entirely different perspective. Then we will understand why it is important to grow in this daily relationship, this constant, consistent relationship with Daddy, with Father, with Appa, by whatever name we call our father, we've got to have that same relationship with God, because God is our True Parent. Help me somebody. God is our first parent. Work with me now. Work with me! Turn to somebody and say "We will work with him.'

Understand the correlation, the parallels here. God desired that man and woman would not only be the very visible, the tangible representation of Himself on earth, but he desired for man and woman, Adam and Eve, to rule over the earth as He rules over Heaven. So that he made Adam and Eve the Lords of creation. Is that not in the Word? He made them the trustees. He made them the stewards of creation, as I rule the Heaven, you rule the earth. As I have control over Heaven, you control the earth. As I have all power over Heaven, you have all power over earth. That is the way God had designed it from the beginning. That was in God's heart. That was His love. Out of love he creates Adam and Eve. He passed on to them true life, and His true lin-

What God wanted in Adam and Eve was to reach that level of completion, to grow in their maturity; in their spiritual maturity, their individual spiritual maturity, reaching the level of perfection, so they could inherit everything. Adam and Eve had not yet reached that level of perfection that completed state, when they fell in the Garden. They were children. They were still children. They were adolescents if you will. God was their parent and they hadn't vet reached that level of the completed stage in their growth, in their maturation stage, where they could handle the responsibilities that God was placing upon them. From that day on, it's been messed up. There is all this confusion. All conflict is a direct consequence of the fall...the human fall: you can trace it back. That is when our problems began...with the human fall, not when God created the earth, because

God's original ideal of creation was man and woman ruling over the earth. That is why he gave them a triple blessing. Be fruitful. That doesn't mean have a whole lot of children. A man may say "Oh, I'm fruitful. I have 12 kids. My

seed is fruitful." You know testosterone and flexing muscles. No that is not what that means. To be fruitful means to reach a level of individual maturity and perfection where one can then multiply. Folks out here are multiplying and are not fruitful. That's the problem right there. Got a whole lot of folks who are making babies, multiplying, but they haven't become fruitful. And the third blessing was to have dominion over the earth. That is what you and I are called to do, to have dominion. Adam and Eve were called to have dominion. But because they did not reach that completion stage, in their spiritual development, they could not take on their portion of responsibility--to be able to pass on God's pure seed to their prog-

If they had obeyed God, they would have passed on spiritual DNA, the fullness of spiritual DNA to their children, and their children's children. They would have had God's lineage, but because they compromised themselves in the Garden with Satan, they had what one might call cross-pollenization. They were hybrids. They had the lineage of God and the lineage of Satan in them and passed it on to their children's children. So are you surprised that Cain killed Abel? Because the blood had become polluted, the lineage had become contaminated. Adam and Eve did not pass on God's pure lineage to their children, to Cain, Abel, and Seth. They passed on a polluted lineage. We have had problems in the world ever since,

because we can not figure out how to make God's love pure again. That's why we have the problems with the races and the cultures and the ethnicities, because we are dealing with polluted blood, contaminated blood. We have to purify the blood, in order to purify the lineage. That is the challenge that we face.

That is why we have to go beyond religion, and go back to spirituality, so that we can be the people God has called us to be. God has called us to be more than children of God. I know it says in 1 John 4 that we are called children of God. It says that in 1 John 4, but there is something before the New Testament, in the Old Testament, in the Psalms, in the 82nd Psalm, the 82nd division of the 150 Psalms; in the 82nd Psalm, verse 6, God said, "I have said, Ye are gods, and all of you are children of the most high." That is what the word says. Some people may want to translate that as judges and magistrates, but if you know Hebrew, the Hebrew for God or Lord that is used is Elohim. And when this Elohim says "I have said ye are gods" the word for gods is also Elohim, which in my understanding of the Hebrew means God, or gods, or lords. You are the lords of all creation. How in the world can you and I rule...the only one, listen to this, the only ones who can rule over the earth would be God, the only one who can rule over the earth are God or the ones to whom God has entrusted the responsibility of ruling over the earth. You have to be a god to rule over anything. And if you don't come into that realization, that see UNLEASH on page 18

but it is most powerful when you see it. As Dr. Yang said in his keynote address, it underscores the urgency of the need for our effort to bring reconciliation between hearts because the wall certainly is an effort of last resort by people who have no hope for dialogue. Archbishop Stallings led us in prayer at the wall and people were encouraged to be open and draw their own conclusions. Our hope is that we can bring such reconciliation and peace that the walls – physical and between peoples hearts – will be dissolved.

Next we went on to Yad Vashem, very significant for me in that a new museum has just opened we had never been to before. Always this has been a key stop because it sends a message that our work for

peace seeking to understand the tragedies of the past, and the underpinnings o f much of the spirit o f bewilderment, anger, sadness and hopelessness that the Jewish people have always felt in relationship to the Holocaust. There are no words

that can describe the immense suffering that is captured in that museum. We are also there to comfort survivors and those who lost their lives and those who descended from them, that we might be able to bring hope at last that there is a deeper understanding in humanity that this can never be allowed to occur again.

The museum gives an historical perspective on how a climate of anti-Semitism grew over the centuries and how this all came to a pinnacle through the rise of the Third Reich with its racist philosophy of the supreme Aryan race. Going through the museum with Mr. Baruch Shalev was a profound experience. My last trip through the museum was with Dr. Glaubach, who is a Holocaust survivor. It is truly overwhelming. This time Baruch shared the incredible despair that came over the people who thought they had "made it" in Germany society as doctors, lawyers. Many of the Jewish commu nity had become very prominent and

mingled socially with their German counterparts, feeling that more than anywhere else in the world they finally had been accepted and understood and had their place in society. Baruch explained, you can't imagine the horror of the people who thought that they had truly become integral to German society when those very colleagues and friends watched the Jews being pushed from their homes into ghettoes and finally, under the guise of "relocation," sent off to death camps.

On one wall is inscribed a quote by German theologian Richard

Niemoller: "First they came for the Communists, but I was not a Communist so I did not speak out. Then they came for the Socialists and the Trade Unionists, but I was neither, so I did not speak out. Then they came for the Jews, but I was not a Jew so I did not speak out. And when they came for me, there was no one left to speak out for me."

Therefore, part of IIFWP MEPI experience is to bond with the heart of the suffering that has occurred through religious intolerance and racial hatred, and to bring all of God's people together so that we will never stand by silently. If any member of our family is mistreated, we also can now

affirm, never again.

IIFWP Conference in Gaza

Participants at the conference on world peace and dialogue in Gaza, April 5, asserted today that the

The conference, which was organ-

ized by the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace (IIFWP), included a foreign delegation of 50 religious figures from different religions around the world and was entitled "international dialogue and cooperation for progress, prosperity and peace." US Congressmen and women as well as former American ambassadors in Arab countries were also among the participants.

Several Jewish rabbis were planned to attend, but Israeli authorities refused to allow them to enter Gaza for security reasons.

In the beginning of the conference, Fateh movement's Central Committee member Abdulla Franji welcomed the guests on behalf of the President Mahmoud Abbas. "We welcome you in the 8000-year-old Gaza City on this holy land, and we haven't yet obtained peace or freedom."

Franji also pointed out the dangers posed by the Apartheid Wall in West Bank and Jerusalem, saying it tears Palestinian lands. He called for an international cooperation to tear it down.

Meanwhile, the Federation's Chairman in North America, Chang Shik Yang, stressed the need to remove the wall and make peace in the region, saying that "we are unhappy with the presence of the separation [Apartheid] wall, and it should be torn down sooner or later."

Also, IIFWP's Deputy Chairman, Reverend Michael Jenkins, prayed that God would give the world strength to tear down the wall, praising the Muslim Sheikhs in Jerusalem for their keenness on peace and justice.

'We [IIFWP delegation] have come to

Clergy From 27 Countries Confer on interfaith Peace in Jerusalem

uring a week marked by celebration of the founding of the Jewish state and remembrance of the past, delegates from 27 countries met in Jerusalem for the 14th in-country meeting of the Middle East Peace Initiative (MEPI).

As in past gatherings, MEPI, a project of the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace (IIFWP), has had meetings with religious and political leaders on all sides of the equation. According to the Chairman of

the MEPI Steering Committee Dr. Chang Shik Yang, "Though the struggle in the Middle East is not caused by religion, the solution to the problems of the region require not only cooperation and compromise among governments, but also the involvement of all religions.

Yesterday afternoon was spent with a visit to the separation wall between Israel and the Palestinian lands, followed by a tour of the Holocaust memorial at Yad Vashem. "Arabs and Jews are brothers at the root level, with a multilayered, multidimensional complex history. Just to observe the cycle of violence and payback is not enough. You have to invest yourself in the pasts of both sides, all the way back to Isaac

and Ishmael," said Dr. Michael Jenkins, cochairman of the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace-USA (IIFWP-USA).

Following rounds of meetings in Jerusalem, including an assembly at the Notre Dame Pontifical Institute, the group will meet with religious


and political leaders in Gaza and Ramallah in the West Bank.

IIFWP is in the process of becoming a trusted presence in the region. Jenkins, said, "When we first came here two years ago several hundred of us went to the Al-Aqsa Mosque and were barred from entering by Israeli security. But when they saw we were a multi-faith mixture of Arabs, Jews and Christians and that our intent was respectful and peaceful, they let us pass. Now they smile and greet us when we come."

Dr. Emil Jarjoui, speaking on behalf of Palestinian Prime Minister Ahmet Qurei yesterday, told visiting delegates of the Middle East Peace Initiative (MEPI),

"We have determined that the only way to end this conflict is by common sense, by negotiation [with the Israelis]."

Jarjoui, a member of parliament and director of relations with religious communities, told the delegates, "We are fed up with wars and funerals and blood. We want to live like any other people under the



sun and in the world. When we say this, it is not just words. We are determined to do it. But to do this we need for both parties to sit together as friends, as neighbors who can decide the future."

A member of the Legislative Council of the PLO representing the prime minister, Jarjoui told the group "The wall is going on for 720 kilometers. It is eating up the land. Let's build bridges of reconciliation and love instead of walls. If it is our destiny to live together in this part of the world, let's make a place that is livable. Our roots are here, we were born here and we want to die here. Our hope is that your group (IIFWP's Middle East Peace Initiative) might be the hand that is reaching to



help us end this conflict."

He concluded, saying, "A wall that separates nations will never deliver security. Only peace will. Security will never result in peace. Peace is what gives you security."

Mr. Walid Sadik, a former member of the Israeli Knesset, said, "I live near the wall. Sometimes I hear shots. I see the smoke of burning tires and I wonder who has been killed, who has been hurt. I have been called a PLO agent by Israelis and a Zionist agent by the PLO, but I am doing everything I can to bring peace." In terms of assigning roles to peace brokers, he said, "The 1.2 million Israeli Arabs living inside



Israel, should have the role of mediating between the two sides."

Lord Nazir Ahmed, a Muslim from England and a member of the House of Lords, who was a delegate to MEPI group said, "I fully understand the fears and sorrow of the Jews who have lost so many members of their families. But I urge Israel not to give in to the politics of fear. Let's embrace the politics of hope."

Dr. Fouad Hallak, policy advisor to the PLO Negotiations Affairs Department, gave a slide presentation explain-

ing the current state of the separation wall's development and the overall master plan for the barrier. Critics of the wall say that, when completed, it will cut the West Bank in half, isolating it from Palestinian Jerusalem, and that this will sever vital road links, will cut off access to jobs and will cripple the agricultural and tourism sectors of the economy.

Hallak said, "Israel, every country, has the right to provide security for their people. So if they want security,

they should build the wall along the current "green line" border created in 1967. But they are building the wall well inside the established boundary, absorbing large portions of Palestinian land."

Rev. Darryl Gray, pastor of the Union United Church in Montreal, and one of the MEPI delegates, said, "As black person, I understand the very real historical fears of the Jewish people. However, that fear should not cause a race of people, who

have been victims, to now become occupiers. I am convinced that neither side will have the courage and the will to reach consensus with one another unless both undergo a spiritual change. The challenge of peace for Palestine and Israel is not yours alone. You must lead in peace, and we [MEPI] will follow you. Our challenge is to work with you to secure peace. And lastly, the wall must come down – not just the physical wall, but the walls in our hearts. As long as there are walls, there will not be peace."

The previous day, a portion of the MEPI delegation met in Gaza with Palestinian officials and NGO leaders at a

MEPI symposium on the theme, "Prospects for Nation-Building and Peace-Building in Palestine: Trends of Hope."

Moderated by Mr. Tajeldin Hamad, Secretary General of the World Association of Non-Governmental Organizations, the program began with the Palestinian anthem, a moment of silence and

the recitation of verses from the Holy Koran. Abu Ali Shaheen, nine year Member of the Palestinian Parliament and the keynote speaker, emphasized that "permanent and total peace is built on duties and rights and that peace cannot come from surrender."

Bringing a message of welcome from President Abu Abbas' office, Hon. Kamal Schrafi, Palestinian Parliamentarian, indicated that this conference was timely, noting that all efforts to support the peace process are urgently needed at this time, adding that he was disappointed by the lack of clear support by



Arab leaders in the region.

Lord Ahmed, noted that while the IIFWP delegation came with a clear message of hope, he was sorely dismayed



as he made his way through the security check points into Gaza, indicating that he felt he was entering the biggest prison on earth.

There were a number of other speakers included former U.S. Congressman Howard Nielson of Utah; Sheik Dr. Mohammed Madi of the Islamic University and Mr. Abdel el Haleem el Fringy, Chairman, Palestinian Economic Association. Dr. Thomas Walsh, Secretary General of the IIFWP closed the program noting with gratitude the hospitality, enthusiasm and hopefulness of the Palestinians in the midst of grave challenges.



International leadership convocation 2005 Chairman's Address

elcome to this International Leadership Convocation, sponsored by the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace. Together we will consider the theme, "Leadership for Global Transformation: Exploring the Vision, Methodology and Best Practices Necessary for Lasting Peace."

On behalf of the Founder, Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon, it is my honor and privilege to address you this evening. Let me begin by thanking you for attending this very important convocation.

You represent leading nations in our world. If the leaders and peoples of these nations work together in a unified, cooperative and unselfish way, for the sake of peace, truly our world can be transformed. That is why you have been invited to this conference.

It is our fervent desire that, by your participation here, each of you will be stimulated by a great sense of hope and opportunity for lasting peace. I hope that when you return to your countries, you will take with you a renewed commitment and determination to carry out your important work, for the sake of your family, your nation and the world.

"Leadership for Global Transformation" is our convocation theme. This is an ambitious goal. However, it is not an impossible goal. Leaders with vision, and the courage to act on their vision, can transform the world. We have seen this occur many times in history. At the IIFWP, we are very serious about this mission, and we believe, that with your help, we can succeed in establishing a world of lasting peace.

To establish a universal realm of lasting peace, we need a vision, methodology and practices that are centered on an unselfish purpose. In addition, we need leaders who not only talk about ideals and vision, but who embody these ideals in their character and apply them in their lives.

During this convocation, we will share the vision of the IIFWP, which is rooted in the teachings of its Founder, Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon. As a very young man he received God's call, and, through an intense period of search and striving, he discovered the most essential truths concerning the fundamental nature of reality, the root causes of human conflict, and the way of restoration and lasting peace. These teachings have inspired millions in every nation of the world, and with each passing day there is growing recognition and appreciation for the profound significance of his vision and methodology for peace-building. Dr. Moon was born in 1920. He lived through the time of Japanese occupation of Korea and World War II; imprisoned six times, he spent nearly three years in a North Korean Communist prison camp, and would have died, were it not for those 16 nations that joined the United Nations forces at the time of the Korean War. Launching it from a desolate refugee camp in Pusan, he has built a movement whose presence



is felt throughout the world as an agent of peace.

Two core principles are at the center of his teaching. The first is true love, or the principle of living for the sake of others. True love calls each of us to love not only our own family and friends, but also strangers, and even our enemies. The second is the principle of unification; that is, the principle that calls us always to seek to harmonize and unify those who are divided or dwelling in tension or conflict.

Just as the natural world we see around us operates according to natural laws and principles, there are also laws and principles that govern the way of life of human beings. Like natural laws, these have their foundation in an original and ultimate reality, God.

Just as there is a physical world that we observe with our physical senses, there is also a spiritual world. Together, in their entirety, the physical world and spiritual world form the cosmos. The center point of the cosmos is God, the origin and creator of all things.

Just as works of art are expressions of the inner character of an artist, our world is an external expression of God's own inner character. God's purpose of creation was to establish a realm, external to Himself, that was an expression of His own heart and character and will.

Most of all, God willed that human beings become full expressions of His own essential nature; that is, expressions of true love. The deepest core of God is the realm of heart, the origin of true love. God is the source, origin and true owner of true love. He is the invisible True Parent. Like parents who live for the sake of their children, God created human beings to be His children.

The nature of love is such that it can only be fulfilled in the context of a relationship. A subject partner, seeking to express and fulfill the need and desire for love, must have an object partner with whom to share the experience of love. Without an object partner, love is not fulfilled. A husband without a wife cannot fulfill the experience of conjugal love. Parents without a child cannot experience parental love. Likewise, God cannot fully realize the ideal of love without an object partner. Human beings were created to be God's object partner, to be God's sons and daughters. Only in this way can God fulfill His own ideal of True Love. Only in this way can human beings, each one of us, fulfill our own ideal of True Love.

It is important to point out that knowledge of God and, more importantly, relationship with God, are not merely philosophical or academic concepts. God is a living reality, and our understanding of God has a very practical impact on the way we understand and act in our world

God created human beings with the ideal of True Love in mind. First of all, God wants each individual human being to be a unique, complete and perfected expression of His heart and character. That is, God wills that each human being develop their heart, conscience, character and creativity in such as way as to be a manifestation of God's ideal.

However, God did not create human beings as fully developed spiritual and physical beings. Human begins grow to maturity over time, and the completion of that growth process only occurs if human beings fulfill their own portion of responsibility. Just as we grow physically by means of sunlight, air, water and other nutrients, we also develop morally and spiritually as we relate to God's words of truth, follow our conscience, and as we live for the sake of others. In this way

we strengthen our mind and conscience. On the other hand, if we disobey our conscience and fail to develop spiritually and morally, our body dominates our mind and we fail to fulfill God's ideal for the individual. When this happens, we cannot become God's object partner of true love.

A fully developed individual is one whose heart is close to God's and who practices true love. In such an individual, the God-centered mind and conscience guide or direct the actions carried out by the body. A son or daughter of God is one whose mind and body are unified and centered on God's true love.

God's ideal of creation, however, is not for individuals alone. God's ideal for human beings has its highest expression in the ideal of marriage and family. This is the second aspect of God's purpose of creation for human beings.

God created human beings with the dual characteristics of mind and body. In addition, He created them according to a pair system, as man and woman. Individual human beings, whether a man or a woman, do not, by themselves, fully express God's ideal. Rather, the unity of a man and a woman in an eternal marriage of true love is the fuller expression of God.

On the foundation of the individual development and maturity of an individual man and an individual woman, God's principle of creation calls for the Blesssee **CHAIRMAN** on page **19**

Declaration of the Era of Lasting Peace

Thereas we are the participants in the International Leadership Convocation, sponsored by the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace, along with the Mongolian Peoples' Federation for World Peace, the United Press International Foundation, and the World Association of Non-Governmental Organizations, held in Washington, DC, from April 10 to 15, 2005, on the theme: "Leadership for Global Transformation: Exploring the Vision, Methodology, and Best Practices Necessary for a New Era of Lasting Peace," and,

Whereas we have gathered as more than 350 leaders from China, India, Japan, Korea, Mongolia, Russia, and the USA, including current and former heads of state, government leaders, religious leaders, diplomats, scholars, and other dignitaries, and,

Recognizing that our world is facing serious crises, and is in dire need of visionary and courageous leadership that can put an end to violence, poverty, family breakdown and widespread loss of hope throughout the world, and,

Acknowledging that IIFWP works to address these critical problems and has called for the establishment of a network of interreligious and international Peace Councils at national, regional and worldwide levels to provide a model for the promotion of global governance that can effectively solve critical global problems, applying a cooperative, collaborative and inclusive methodology that goes beyond particular national and religious interests to embrace and serve the hopes and aspirations of all humanity, and,

Noting that throughout the past year, IIFWP has sponsored a wide range of programs worldwide, including international conferences and summits, as well as regional, national and local programs for peace and human development, and that its expanding, worldwide network of "Ambassadors for Peace" is increasingly being recognized as a valuable resource for peace, and,

Whereas we believe this International Leadership Convocation can lead to making a difference in contemporary world affairs, and in light of current trends and challenges to global governance, we resolve to:

Take action in order to promote a vision and methodology for peace that embraces spiritual values, addresses the root causes of conflicts, and practices unselfishness to address the critical problems facing our contemporary world;

Promote increased understanding, cooperation and peace among the participating nations: China, India, Japan, Korea, Mongolia, Russia, USA, in addition to other nations;

Advance the Peace Council initiative as a new civil society mechanism that enables interreligious as well as governmental and non-governmental organizations to collaborate more effectively in addressing critical global problems;

Encourage the private sector to support the on-going efforts for peace and constructive collaboration between countries and continents through non-governmental bodies around the world;

Direct Ambassadors for Peace and members of the emerging IIFWP Peace Councils, as a civil society initiative, to supplement, enhance and improve upon existing approaches to solving our world's problems;

Increase awareness of the significance of the family, including marriages that cross boundaries of race, religion and nationality, and the "four great realms of heart" and to recognize the family as the school of true love, with profound relevance and strategic significance to the critical issues facing the contemporary world;

Apply the principles of living for the sake of others and unselfish cooperation in order to contribute to peace and prosperity in areas of conflict, such as the Middle East, South Asia, and North East Asia.

INTERNATIONAL LEADERSHIP CONVOCATION 2005 Leadership for Global Transformation:

Exploring the Vision, Methodology, and Best Practices

Necessary for a New Era of Lasting Peace

ransforming a world of conflict into a world of peace is an ambitious but necessary task. Today's culture of conflict is evident in rising divorce rates, domestic violence, racial and ethnic tensions, and regional wars that perpetuate grievances and sow bitterness for later generations.

Many factors will contribute to establishing lasting peace, but none is more critical than effective leadership. Accordingly, an international leadership convocation, Leadership for Global Transforma-

tion: Exploring the Vision, Methodology, and Best Practices Necessary for a New Era of Lasting Peace, was convened in Washington DC on April 10-14, by the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace to address the crucial role of leadership in establishing a culture of peace.

Unlike recent IIFWP international convocations, this assembly brought together leaders from seven key nations—Korea, Japan, China, the United States, Russia, India, and Mongolia—and held sessions that looked more specifically at the principles of leadership advanced by the IIFWP and taught by its founder, the Reverend Dr. Sun Myung Moon. An eighth group consisted of representatives from Europe.

IIFWP Chairman Dr. Chung Hwan Kwak greeted the three hundred government, business, academic, and religious leaders in his opening address on Sunday evening and emphasized two core principles of peace that would be elaborated upon in the coming days: a principle of living for the sake of others in one's daily life and, secondly, a willingness to seek harmony and unification, even at the sacrifice of oneself when conflict arises.

Dr. Kwak emphasized that human life is governed by principles that derive from the loving heart of God, and that our maturity in love, culminating in marriage and family life, leads us into a harmonious state in which human beings come to reflect God's essential nature.

Jack Corley, the Secretary General of IIFWP, Eurasia and the Session Panel

Session I on the following morning, presented by Jack Corley, the Secretary General of IIFWP, Eurasia, began what would become a methodical analysis of

the root causes of conflict. Underscoring the importance of correctly understanding the significance of our limited physical life, Mr. Corley clarified that the development of character and the maturing of love are the essential tasks



of life, that the physical body is merely a transitional stage, like the period in the womb, requiring healthy, responsible practices to enable a successful transition to a higher sphere of life in the eternal spiritual world.

The fundamental value of love, inher-

ently understood by parents who try to raise their children to be loving and virtuous, is also clearly compromised and corrupted in the world, and Reverend Phillip Schanker, vice president of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification, USA, explained in Session II how ancient traditions around the world locate a failure of human responsibility, a corruption of personality, as the cause of the tragic dilemma confronting humanity. The Reverend Moon has identified this failure as the corruption of love itself, crip-

pling humanity, implanting selfishness, and alienating the human heart from the pure love of God.

William Lay, who practices law in New York, followed this analysis in Session III with an insightful examination of principles of reconciliation that apply acquire spiritual capital. They were then called to give selflessly to others, to share their wisdom and endowments for the benefit of others. This pattern enabled the rise of the great religions, as well as the emergence of civilizations. The essential condition of leadership,



accordingly, is the character and integrity of individuals, and their earnestness to seek the truth.

Dr. Kwak returned for the final afternoon session with a systematic presentation on the significance of marriage and family life, not simply as tradition-

al rites conducive to social cohesion but as divinely mandated institutions in which human beings fulfill the respective roles of child, spouse, and parent and come sional character of God's love. Dr. Kwak then presided over a moving blessing ceremony, with all the delegates upholding and sanctifying their marriages, and solemnly pledging faithfulness within the marital union through partaking of ceremonial wine or juice.

In the second day, April 11, sessions presented an overview of key works initi-

ated by Rev. Moon that have laid some of the solid foundations supporting IIFWP's efforts to effect fundamental change toward a peaceful world.

Two sessions, V and VIII, under the theme "A New Vision of Peace: The

Thought and Achievement of Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon" covered respectively Eurasia and the USA. For Eurasia, a primary event that opened the door to a flood of developments in the 1990s was a meeting of Rev. Moon in Moscow with Mikhail Gorbachev in 1990. From that moment began an initiative to write and publish curricula for teaching character, morality, and ethics in the secondary schools and at advanced levels. These were based on Rev. Moon's core

ideas and adapted especially to the needs and context of Russia, Mongolia, and China. Through these programs tens of thousands of educators have been instructed in using the materials and now several thousand schools are

using this materials. A complementary initiative developed and promulgated a new philosophy of unified martial arts.


Covering the sweep of time since 1972 when Rev. Moon began to give priority attention to the US, the "Focus on the USA" session used the backdrop of events in Rev. Moon's life to convey the understanding that he is a man of deep prayer and spirituality whose total investment in all that he does draws the support of universal power.

Examples included advances made through his imprisonment in the USA that established unbreakable bonds with leaders of the civil rights movement, and the trust granted to Rev. Moon by Palestinians in Gaza, first because of his history of enduring unfair imprisonment, and secondly because of the great wisdom of his teachings. Support for President Nixon through the campaign of "Forgive. Love. Unite" showed clearly that Rev. Moon does what is right, not what is expedient. Foundations laid during his 13 months of imprisonment in the 1980s are bearing fruit today, in the amazing 50-state tour, the American Clergy Leadership Conference, the Women's Federation for World Peace, the American Family Coalition, the campaign of the Cross Reconsidered, and the Crown of Peace ceremony on Capitol Hill.

Two sessions, VI and VII, demonstrated Principles in Action, one with a focus on Peace Initiatives and a second with an emphasis on Human Development

The Middle East Peace Initiative presentation highlighted the transformative power brought into that conflict zone by the thousands of Ambassadors for Peace coming to the Holy Land in

both historically and on a personal level. It is the pattern of history, he noted, that leaders, or central figures, emerged. These leaders ordinarily had personal endowments, but also were seekers who sacrificed to gain insights and thus





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waves from around the world in 2004. Peace concerns in North-East Asia, have long occupied Rev. Moon's attention and his views of how to proceed are comprehensive for the region. Imme-

diate action initiatives include Pyeong Hwa Motors in North Korea, construction of a peace center in Pyeong Yang, and programs promoting reconciliation in Japan of Koreans from groups connected respectively with South and North Korea. Session VII continued an examination of principles in action with perspectives by presenters on character education and HIV prevention, the significance of the family as an institution that can engender peace, the role of sports in fostering peace, and an analysis of economic policy as an instrument for the betterment of human life.

After dinner participants from the seven different national groups bonded in heart beyond language as they enjoyed entertainment by a professional singer from Japan plus group songs from each of the other major participating nations, including one inspired European.

Considering the "IIFWP, the United Nations, and Trends in Global Governance," Session IX on Wednesday, April 13, looked at the great hopes in which the UN was founded and the way the institution instead became of tool of the cold war that continues to this day as a failed instrument of global governance. While reform has been called for and outlined, this amounts to merely structural change, but not the kind of fundamental change required to create an enlightened system of global governance. Hence the precise need for implementing the IIPC with its intention to involve diverse religious representation centrally in the process of reforming toward global governance through a contract between governments representing nations and civil society representing the people. IIPC aims not just to prevent war, but to eliminate it by eradicating the root causes of war. The IIPC vision is wholistic

as it addresses both internal and external structure and a view of leadership that is doable.

World Peace and the NGO Revolution, Session X, painted a striking picture of the proliferation in the past 20-30 years of a multitude of Non-Governmental Organizations in both the developed and the developing coun-



tries. NGOs are addressing a host of issues not touched by national governments. After several NGOs and concerned individuals joined together to launch the World Association of Non-Governmental Organizations (WANGO), Rev. Moon provided vision, leadership,

and resources supporting the organization's growth to become the largest, general purpose, international membership organization for NGOs. The Women's Federation for World Peace, an NGO founded by Rev. and Mrs. Moon, is pioneering a way for women to be a force for peace through instructional programs on creating peaceful families, service programs, support for schools in impoverished areas, and peace and reconciliation ceremonies centered on the Bridge of Peace ceremonies.

The Session XI lunch program provided an opportunity for delegates to learn about some of the many media initiatives founded by the Reverend Moon. Michael Marshall, editor in chief of United Press International; Frank Grow, vice president of Tiempos del Mundo; Tim Elder, managing editor of the World Peace Herald; and

Charles Kim, president of World & I Online, gave succinct presentations on their respective media projects before the delegates left the hotel for a tour of Washington's magnificent monuments, framed in a profusion of Washington's famed cherry blossoms. These gifts of the Japanese people were in the peak of flower as the Reverend Moon's spe-

cial guests enjoyed the blue skies of a beautiful Washington springtime.

Delegates arrived by bus at the Washington Times, the influential daily newspaper founded by Reverend Moon in 1982, for a brief tour and closing banquet. Much anticipated by the gathered delegates, Reverend Moon came to the podium to deliver an address, The Providential Path to True Liberation and Complete Freedom. Reverend Moon, at eighty five, looked extraordinarily vigorous, and departed from his prepared remarks extensively to reveal both a depth of vision and personal regard for his guests that deeply moved each delegate.

Speaking without interruption for more than two hours, Reverend Moon reiterated and expanded upon many of the themes taken up in the conference sessions, but spoke with a clarity and authority of God's urgent will to reclaim the love that was unrighteously lost,



and the role of the Messiah, coming as True Parents, to cleanse the world of unholy habits and restore the proper order of love. Through the Four Great Realms of Heart—the child's realm, the sibling's realm, the spouse's realm, and the parent's realm—human love is perfected.

"With the appearance of True Parents, the power of God is being manifested on this earth," he told the delegates. "This providence is absolute, and it is our destiny to accomplish it. We who have received Heaven's call have only one path to follow. The goal of our mission is to establish the Peace Kingdom."

"Toward a Global Agenda for Peace: 2005," Session XII: Closing Session, On Thursday, April 14, featured reflections by one representative from each of the major groups. All had been seriously engaged and challenged by the conference to apply IIFWP principles in working together toward building a peaceful world. In a particularly noteworthy comment, the Chinese representative stated that he had never before experienced God, but that in receiving the talk by Rev. Moon he had sensed God and had the clear realization that we are all God's children beyond religion and nationality. Dr. Walsh outlined an International Agenda toward convening the inaugural World level Peace Council in 2005 at the occasion of the 60th anniversary of the UN as a civil society contribution toward UN renewal. Long-time IIFWP participant, Eva Latham read the 7 points in the "Declaration of the Era of Lasting Peace" produced for this conference. She led

all participants in standing and clapping to affirm acceptance of the resolution. At the end of the program, central people in IIFWP led the way in signing the declaration. Others signed later after a group photo.

The delegates then adjourned for follow-up briefings from their respective regions that showed the scope of the IIFWP work around the world.

The enthusiasm for the vision advanced at the convocation took root ultimately as delegates continued into the afternoon, planning concrete action through regional convocations and edu-

cational gatherings that confirm to a suffering and divided world that the grounds of peace are to be found in the God-ordained methodology of living for the sake of others and overcoming boundaries to realize a unified world of peace. �

spiritual consciousness, you will be defeated. When God say "I have said ye are gods" that means "You are my children." That is what it really means. You bear my nature. Remember I told you, you are just as much human as your parents? You don't have any problem with that huh? But if I tell you, you are a god, not the God, but a god; you have got problems with that--becoming a truly divine manifestation of God's presence here on earth.

That is the genius of the Reverend Sun Myung Moon, whom we affectionately call Father Moon, that he would say to us, that what we must seek to discover is the original nature that God intended for all of humanity from the beginnings of time, in Adam and Eve if they had reached that level of the completion stage of their spiritual maturation where they could have been the complete inheritors of all of God's creation. You and I were supposed to be

the lords of this creation, the masters of this earth, to have all things under our feet. We were to be in control, not Satan, not the powers of evil, but you and I. There should be nothing on this earth that should so overwhelm us, inundate us, destroy us, divide us, separate us from the love of God, if we are able to reclaim the divinity that God placed in Adam and Eve from the very beginnings.

We have the spirit of God in us and we have flesh and blood. Think about that. But the genius of Rev. Moon is that, since we are all equal, why not have the races marry each other? Why not? What's wrong with that? We're all the same. We're all equal. But, of course, society can't handle that--especially American society. Oh God! We are still gawking when we see an interracial couple. H-m-m-m. We see two whites together, man and woman, that's ok; black man and woman, ok. Asian and black...Whoa!! White and Black....Whoa!! In America? What's going on here? That we must work to live for the sake of others. To know that we are all equal,

we will live for each other.

When we worship God, when we truly worship God, is when we acknowledge that God is in each one of us. That is true worship. We've got these people in these churches, temples, mosques, and synagogues going through the rituals and gestures, and going outside and cursing and hating and not working with each other. That is false religion. That religion can not save you. It cannot heal you. But when you and I see the real presence of God in each other, when we move back to God's original ideal, where we can go through a process of changing the blood lineage so we can be one with each other, when that one man can love that one woman, and that one woman be faithful to her man and bring up children who are faithful in living our the decrees of God, and when we can train our children how to see God in each other, in all of humanity, then we will have Heaven on earth.

You are waiting until you die to get to Heaven? I want my Heaven right now. I have a right to see Heaven right now. I have a right to experience Heaven right

now. Heaven can be here on earth. On earth as it is in Heaven. We can have it right now, if we love each other, if we trust each other, if we work with each other. If not now, when? If not you, who? It is time to get busy. It is time to get busy my brothers and sisters. It is time to realize that these are the final days. The Messiah is here, we just ain't seen him yet. We haven't looked. We haven't observed. We haven't known. But this is the hour, in which you and I can rise up to be the people that God has called us to be. And we said we are going to stop all this foolishness. We are going to stop making religion a mockery. We are going to stop making God out to be a liar. But we are going to worship God in spirit and in truth. That is the only way we are going to get back to God, in spirit and in truth. Think about it. As long as we keep looking at each other with human eyes, and walking in the flesh, we will never see God. Love Him. Live for God. Work for God. And if this right here is a reflection of Heaven on earth, then why not spread it throughout all the earth. �

ing of marriage. The Blessing of God brings together a man and woman as husband and wife before God. God created not only the character, but also the sexual organs of man and woman with great care, as complementary, each seeking the other for the sake of love, life and lineage. The love of a man and a woman, consummated in a sexual union, establishes an eternal oneness of love, life and lineage. When children are born from such a love, we experience the blossoming of parental love, children's love and sibling love between brothers and sisters.

The family allows for the fullest expression of God's heart of true love in the relationships of husband and wife, parents and children, and brothers and sisters. Furthermore, as the family of true love expands, we establish the extended family or tribe, the wider community of families, society, and eventually the nation and world.

God's original ideal is to establish an ideal world as one unified family of humanity. This ideal world is simply the extension of a single, original ideal family. The family is the paradigm and model for all human relationships in the wider society, nation and world.

Finally, included in God's purpose of creation is an ideal of the relationship between the human family and the entire created world; that is, the environment. God intended for human beings to inherit His heart of love and, in turn, to care for and respect the entire created world. While God has blessed human beings with a capacity to take dominion of the environment, that capacity is to be guided by the same wisdom and love which God has toward all that He created.

Of course, the world of God's original ideal is not the world we experience and observe. We inhabit a world of selfishness, where true love is not practiced and honored, and conflict prevails. The origin of this fallen world takes us back to the time of God's original creation and the original family. Within that family, the ideal of true love was violated and lost. The chaos, suffering and conflict of history followed. And since that time, God has sought to restore human beings and fulfill His eternal and unchanging ideal of true love. The world of selfishness must be transformed into a world of true love. A world of conflict must be transformed into a world of peace. It is for this reason that God has sent the prophets and saints of history, and ultimately the messiah and savior. This is why He has sent Rev. Moon.

God stands in the position of the invisible True Parent, True Teacher and True Owner. It is our mission in life to manifest these attributes in our own lives. We are each to become a True Parent, a True Teacher and a True Owner. This is the mission that Father Moon has pioneered.

As individuals we are to develop a capacity to become a True Parent in the family, living for the sake of our spouse and our children, and then applying that same heart of true love to all people. We are also to become a True Teacher, living according to God's words of truth, becoming an embodiment of God's truth, and communicating that truth to others by our words and deeds. Finally, in relation to all the physical world, we are called to be a True Owner.

As a True Parent we are to manifest a heart of true love, beginning with our own spouse and children. We live for the sake of others within our family, with a desire that each member of the family becomes greater than myself. A True Parent then extends this heart of true love to all people, living for the sake of others, practicing respect, care, compassion and justice even for strangers and enemies, and not merely for one's own children.

What are the implications of such an attitude, grounded in an understanding of God as True Parent. First, being a True Parent serves as a foundation for human rights, for as a True Parent we seek to treat each individual person as a son or daughter of God. Also, a True Parent will

always seek to establish balance. When there is division and conflict, a True Parent seeks harmony and cooperation. When there are significant inequalities among people, a True Parent works to bring balance. A True Parent does not have a concept of enemies, but only of others who are lost and yet to be found. A True Parent understands that true solu-

tions to our most critical problems must begin in the realm of the heart. While the use of violent means to achieve ends may be necessary in certain extreme cases, generally speaking a True Parent works to achieve ends non-violently, through service and consistent unselfish love.

What is a True Teacher? A True Teacher is one who is a being of true moral character, one who lives according to the truthful guidance of the conscience, and who understands and practices the norms of true love, living for the sake of others. Most importantly, a True Teacher affirms and applies the principles of purity and fidelity in relation to the order of true love. A True Teacher testifies to God's truth, and the norm and order of true love.

What are implications of practices related to a True Teacher? A True Teacher protects the integrity of the family as the foundation for peace in the society, the nation and the world. Also, a True Teacher does not misuse any position of distributing information, but remains committed to truthfulness. Thus, in politics, in business and marketing, in law, in the media and in the entertainment industry, truthfulness and the absoluteness of norms are upheld. In this way, the public, and particularly the next generation are not savaged by untruths and moral relativism. A True Teacher understands that education must not only be concerned with career development, but more essentially with moral development.

A True Owner is one who relates unselfishly, responsibly and compassionately to all things. A True Owner understands that all physical things are the property of God. Property and materials things should never be misused or exploited for merely selfish purposes.

Corruption that is rooted in greed and selfishness has very serious consequences for our world, and often undermines the possibilities for peace and human development. A True Owner never misuses public money, and never seeks to acquire

wealth for personal use that is far in excess of what is needed; rather, any excessive wealth acquired is allocated to the benefit of others.

The essential point is that God's original ideal is for human beings to be His sons and daughters, and to be God-like. To be a True Parent, True Owner and True Teacher is to resemble God, and as we resemble God the world can come to resemble God.

The most basic and deepest relationship of heart is that of parent and child. Such is the relationship that God intended to have between Himself and human rently underway represents a most significant development of the IIFWP. I am referring to the Peace Council initiative. In October 2003, Dr. Moon launched the Interreligious and International Peace Council as a model institution of global governance. He even coined a new term for this initiative, the "Peace UN."

Up until recently the Peace Council has been functioning as a loose, informal coalition of Ambassadors for Peace who worked together on the national, regional and global level. At the present time, however, the Peace Council is shifting to a more formal structure. In fact,

in each of the ten IIFWP regions, regional Preparatory Committees are being formed. These will be convened over the next two months to consider the charter, the rules of procedure, the code of ethics and a plan of action for the Peace Council. By mid-summer and advance of the conven-

ing of the UN's 60th General Assembly, we expect to have a provisional charter, and to have Peace Councils established on the national, regional and global levels. Already, Mr. Jean Ping, President of the General Assembly, has been fully briefed on this plan and awaits our midsummer update. Leaders in all fields are being briefed, and their input welcomed.

With the emergence of the Peace Councils, the IIFWP itself will undergo a transformation in its own system of governance. In the process, we expect to become even more active and effective in addressing issues of critical concern to our world. Likewise, Ambassadors for Peace, whose relationship to the IIFWP has been rather informal up to this point in time, will become "peace councilors" with clear responsibilities and tasks within the Council.

In the course of this Convocation program, you will hear more about the IIPC. Rest assured, however, that the Peace Councils have the potential to truly transform this world, bringing together leaders from governments, religions, faithbased NGOs, civil society, academia, business, the arts, sports, etc., all working together collaboratively for peace. It is an idea whose time has come. The dream is about to become a reality.

As we see a convergence of the ethics of the True Parent, the True Teacher and the True Owner with the strategic, activist and organizational power of the Peace Councils, we will witness the awakening of a truly revolutionary movement. I hope that each of you will play a part in its development and in the realization of lasting peace.

In conclusion, let me once again thank you for attending this convocation. I hope and pray that you will become the leaders that this world, and God, so desperately need at this time in history. Let us work together to build the ideal Peace Kingdom. •

Always its so interesting to see husbands and wives together. Often, as it was in this case they are very uniquely different and yet they are totally interdependent. Reiko and I both shared about the challenges of marriage and family. It is super common ground for all, blessed families struggle the same way all families struggle. (We are fortunate however because we have a strong Biblically based teaching on the problem of the misuse of love.)

The discussion was so sincere and everyone was interested. I mentioned that we focus on marriage and family as the most central part of our ministry. They said were very interested. ince we've begun to revive the Blessed Family Association, a lot has happened. Last October, we held our first BFA Convocation at UTS as part of the Educator's Conference. Adoption Ministry Meetings

n April 30 and May 1, 2005 the Adoption Ministry of the Blessed Family Department had it's kick-off seminars, first in the DC area, at the home of Rev. Hong, the regional director, and then in New Jersey, at the home of Mrs. Masako Feddema the director of BFD in New jersey. Guests included couples hoping to adopt, couples who had already offered children, couples who had adopted children, and brothers and sisters who simply feel compassion for childless couples and want to help in any way they can, including prayer.

At both meetings we discussed the many issues that are important to think and pray about if you are considering being an offering parent and also the issues facing a couple hopeful of receiving a child. Many of those present had the opportunity to share their experiences from both sides of the process and quite a few tears

Central to both meetings was the guidance True Father originally gave on the tradition of Blessed Families offering to conceive for childless couples. True Father did not give detailed guidance about this tradition but what he gave was loud and clear and his words were the anchor onto which we all focused during the early foundation of our work to support offering and receiving couples.

His first words were to take the adoption providence out the hands of the church proper. He said that the church shouldn't be directly in charge of adoptions and that adoption is a private act between two couples.

He then said that central figures, no matter how well meaning, should not 'match" a childless couple to a couple with children, nor in any way make couples feel pressured to either adopt or give a child.

He then suggested areas where adoptions might best take place: first between couples in a trinity, secondly within the spiritual family (spiritual parents, brothers and sister or spiritual children) and finally between couples who feel a bond of heart or calling from God.

In 1989 when the Blessed Family Department received these instructions from True Father, they took them to heart. They gave the adoption ministry to the New Family Foundation, a newly formed support group for offering and receiving couples comprised of offering and receiving mothers who had experience as counselors and who had a passion for work in this area.

Now in 2005 the Blessed Family Department has re-established the Adoption Ministry in order to support couples hopeful of receiving a child as well as those parents in a position of offering.

The Adoption Ministry will be preparing a list of these issues for further discussion and thought. We encourage all regional and local churches to become aware of this area of ministering to families and thus hold similar meetings based on the material that will come out.





WFWP Supports the Secretary General's Plan

n behalf of the Women's Federation for World Peace International, I commend Secretary General Kofi Annan for his efforts to focus the UN on the accomplishment of the Millennium Development Goals, to plan to reorganize and reform the UN for the purpose of streamlining and making it more effective in its work of development, and implementation of security and human rights for all, as well as peacekeeping and peace building. The Secretary General has done an excellent job of reaffirming that although the UN is an organization of sovereign states, ultimately those states exist to serve the needs and hopes of the individual citizens within them and the larger world. He has reinforced that the original framers of the UN Charter intended to create an organization to ensure us of a future of peace, where human rights are respected and justice and the rule of law are practiced and maintained. It is clear through this report that the Secretary General fully aims to sharpen the tools at hand, leave behind old tools that no longer function, pick up some new tools and advance on the accomplishment of the Millennium Development Goals. We wish for success, and plan to act as partners in this work. In the response that follows, rather than addressing all points of the report, I will focus on areas where there are meeting points with the aims and activities of Women's Federation for World Peace International.

In recent years, we have seen the Secretary General's belief that collective action between the UN and an active civil society and private sector are needed to meet the Millennium Development Goals. He stressed the importance of partnership between the UN and civil society at numerous junctures through out this report. WFWPI, as an NGO in general consultative status is serious about its partnership with the UN. As an organization we have been actively working to align ourselves with efforts to fulfill the MDGs by hosting forums and panels in conjunction with the DPI/NGO conferences, the CSW

and as stand alone events. Our recent panel, Girls Education: A Key to Poverty Eradication, held at the CSW in March 2005 gave practical knowledge and experience on this important topic ranging from the importance of national legislation to support equity in education to grassroots activities that help build awareness and educate the public about the importance of this issue.

Perhaps more importantly, WFWPI volunteers have instigated numerous projects in developing nations, particularly in Africa. Emphasis on estab-

lishment of International Service Projects in Africa demonstrates the knowledge and commitment that WFWPI has that Africa has special needs and

will need continued support. These projects have included schools, health clinics, HIV/Aids education programs, vocational training and many other economic development projects. WFWP volunteers have come to understand first hand that knowledge and practical skills are the key to sustainable development. Since 1994, we have been involved in empowering those in need, particularly women and young people, by arming them with knowledge and skills. We agree with the Secretary General that "empowered women can be some of the most effective drivers of development". From our experience in the field, we strongly affirm the Secretary General's belief in the importance of Civil Society's role in achieving the Millennium Development Goals and thereby advancing the cause of freedom, security and human rights

One WFWPI project that demonstrates the effectiveness of UN and NGO partnership for a holistic approach to sustainable development is the UNDP, WFWP, and Integrated Family Development Initiatives partnership implemented in Bufumbo Sub-county of Mbale district in Uganda. UNDP awarded a \$50,000US grant to assist 400 families ousted from Mt. Elgon Forest Reserve who were living in poor conditions on steep degraded land. The project increased family incomes from \$200US a year to \$2000 by using modern, intensive intercropping of perennial and seasonal crops and agro forestry methods including coffee and banana trees, beans and groundnuts, other crops of fruit, grasses, bees, firewood. Other skills that were taught include soil and water management, compost making, water harvesting, health and hygiene, family values and ways to avoid HIV/AIDS. This example of integrat-

that all are interconnected and interdependent and we must commit to creating a world that is free from fear. We also affirm that facing threats will inevitably involve Member States seeking and achieving consensus on a vision of collective security as well as an understanding of the nature of threats faced by the world's citizens. We urge the appropriate UN bodies to clarify what constitutes threats to safety and security and prioritize threats, strengthen monitoring, and take action to prevent their occurrence and spread.

or tribes are a reality. Sometimes greed

As people, we acknowledge that the circumstances that are a prelude to violent conflict are often complex, deep and long standing. Sometimes deep resentments among cultures, communities

is a factor. In order to overcome barriers and affect prevention in these situations, transformation must occur within the hearts of the actors. This transformation most likely will not be created by rules, laws or treaties. It is something that must come from within the human heart. Rituals can provide a context for such transformation to occur. The Women's Federation for World Peace Intl. has been holding Bridge of Peace Ceremonies since 1994 between women (and some men) of formerly hostile nations, as well as in multi cultural, multiracial contexts. It is an opportunity for individuals from very different backgrounds and circumstances to meet one on one through a ceremony of forgiveness and reconciliation. This simple but beautiful ritual has the power to open hearts and allow those previously alien to one another to embark on a friendship and perhaps a partnership. WFWPI offers this simple Bridge of Peace Ceremony to the larger UN and world community as a tool of social engineering to open doors and hearts between parties who are hostile to one another, whether representatives of Member States, or parties to tensions that could erupt into violent conflict. We encourage the Secretary General and the Economic and Social Council to strive to utilize existing forums between the UN and civil society to highlight examples of best practices that can be replicated, as well as strengthen avenues in which NGO knowledge and experience can be shared with decision makers and other actors to enhance effective planning and development.

WFWP volunteers have witnessed first hand, the trauma to children that violent conflict brings and have worked to invest care and opportunities for healing for the children they have come in contact with. It is common sense that it would be far better to strengthen systems of prevention and efforts at peace building rather than having to face the aftermath and the devastating affects of violence on the soul and psyche of children especially, but every innocent in the path of violent conflict and other threats to peace and security. 

effective at prevention, we believe that the UN and Member States must increase their "arsenal" of tools for effecting prevention. A great starting point to prevention is certainly taking a step toward reconciliation. The Bridge of Peace Ceremony can be an opportunity to create this first step.

On that note, although the Member tates have been the traditional building blocks, and representatives participating at the UN, perhaps it is time to consider the fact that through out the world, religious and spiritual leaders have historically played important leadership roles in the lives of the world's people. Loyalty toward, respect and reverence for ones faith leader is often stronger than loyalty and respect of one's political leader or head of state. Perhaps it is time, since the Secretary General is suggesting some reforms and actual changes to the UN Charter, that the Secretary General and the UN bodies consider the very important role that religious leaders and spiritual leaders play in the lives of their believers. As the Secretary General states in his

report, there is a moral imperative that unites us and drives us to seek a better world. If anyone in the world could encourage us to rise to the situation and do what is right, rich and poor, north and south, east and west, would it not be the leaders of the religions

and spiritual traditions coming together, arriving at consensus and inspiring us as a single voice to create the world of peace envisioned by the framers of the UN Charter?

As the microcosm of the world would not the UN more fully represent the world community if, along side the General Assembly, there was a body of equal stature composed of representatives from the various religions and spiritual traditions of the world? Such a group could be a fantastic resource of knowledge of the intricacies of cul-

tures and societies, as well as wisdom of human experience striving to fulfill spiritual and religious practice, in enacting problem solving, conflict resolution and fostering a transcendent mentality and determination to find solutions in the face of difficult and persistent problems. Certainly, such a body would be an indispensable presence in the

We thank all of our sponsors and the students who organized the event. The public is welcomed and we hope to see you next year at this wonderful event.






Christian Songwriters Open Mic Night

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
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
