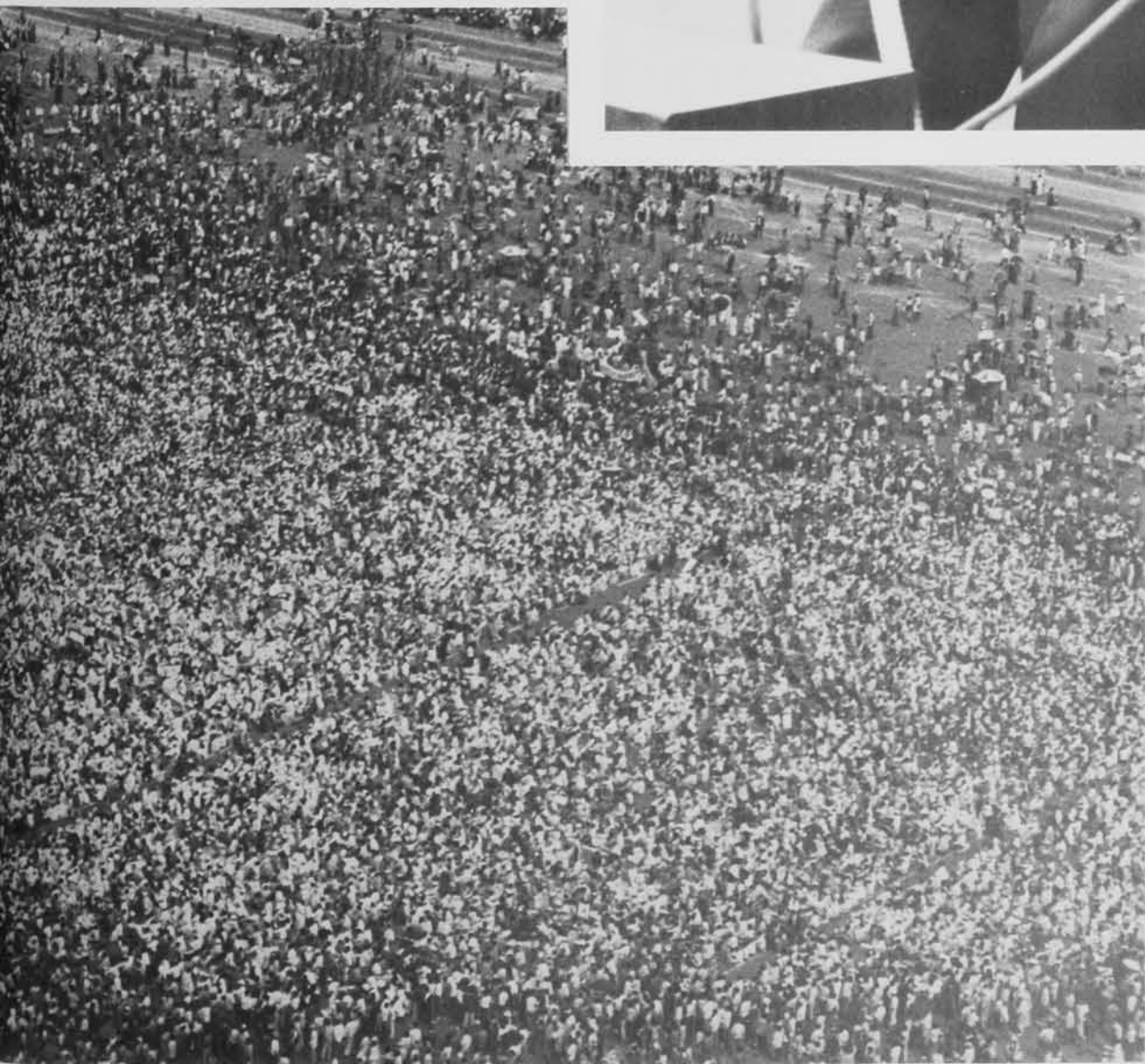

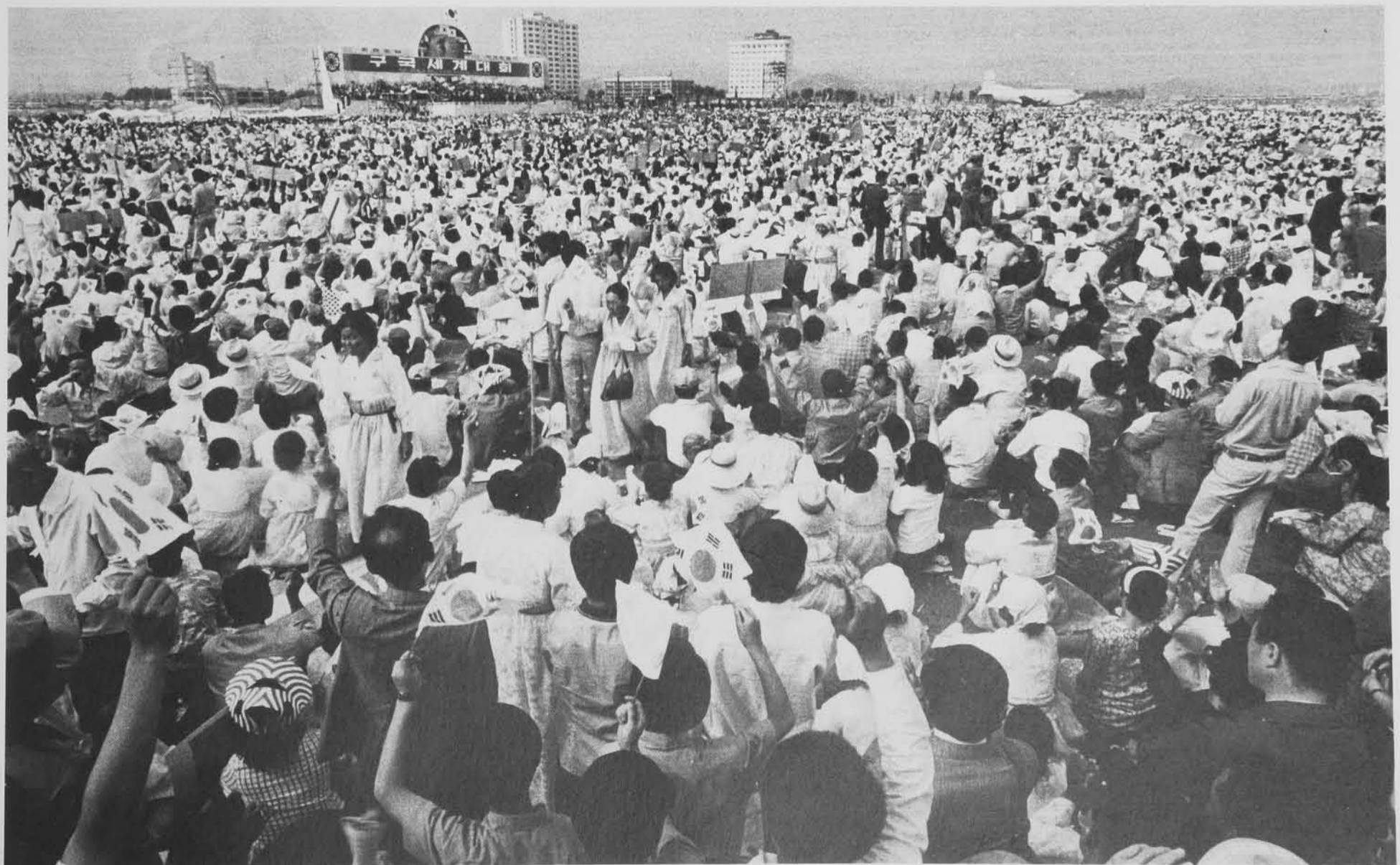

Mr. Young Whi Kim delivers the keynote address.



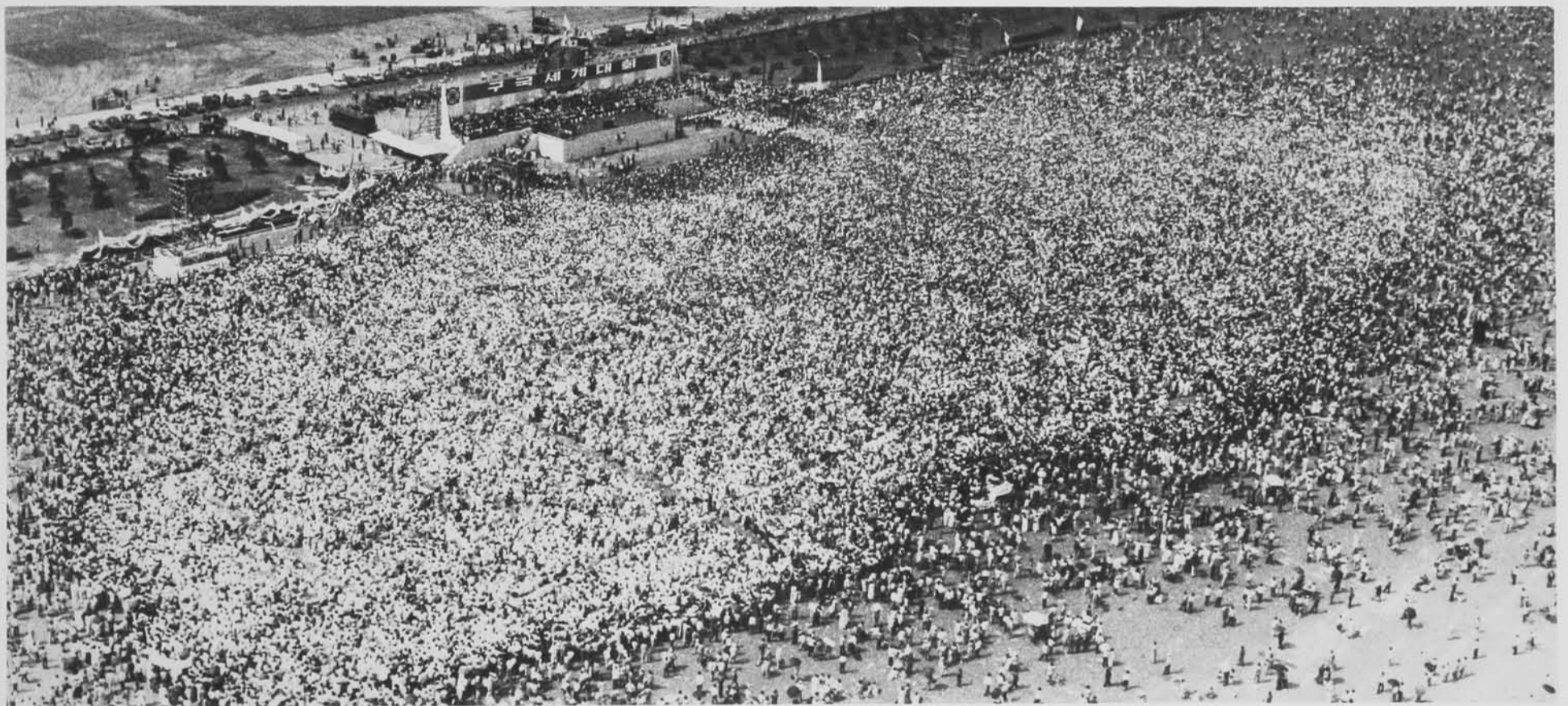

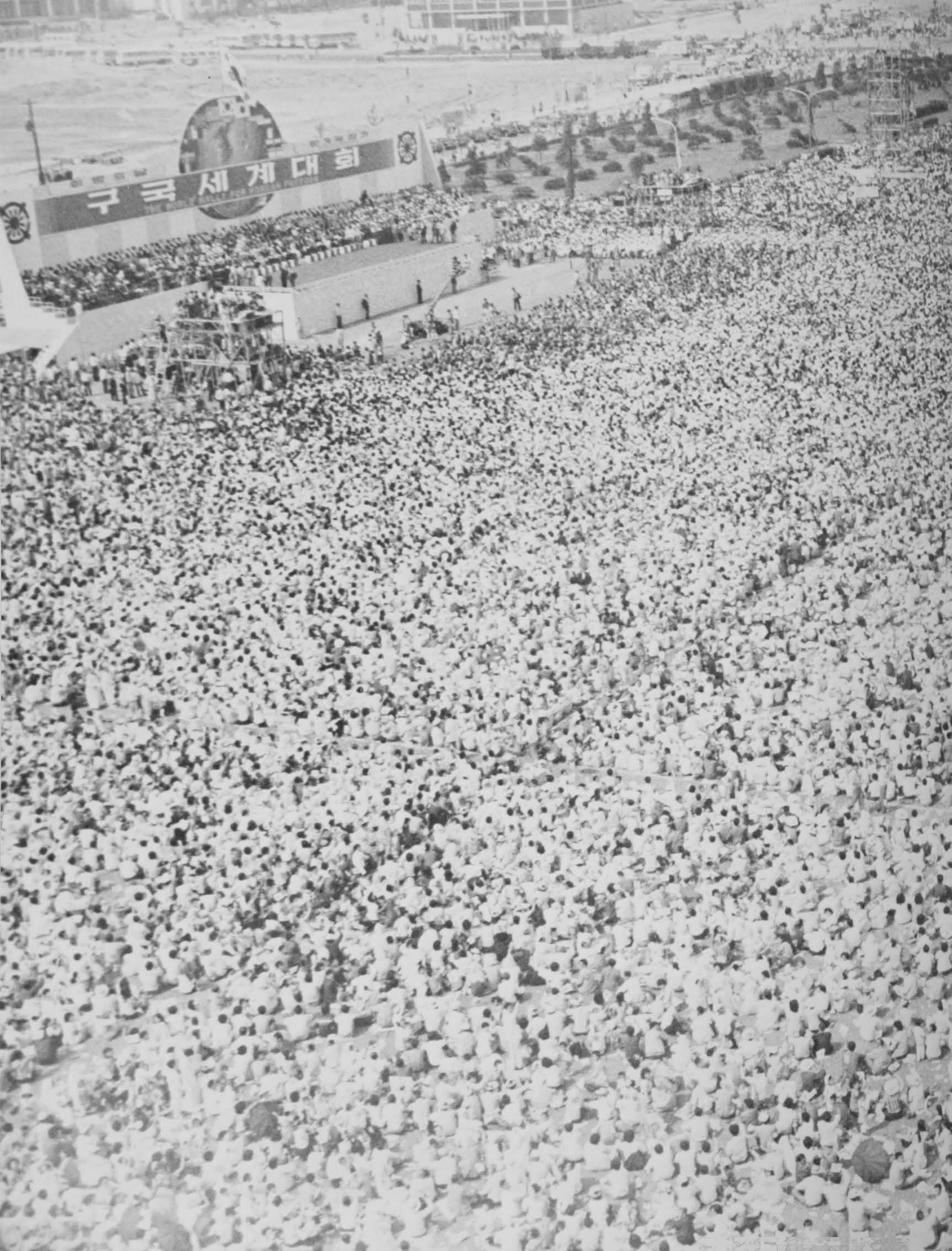

## **Resolution of World Representatives of the Unification Church International from 60 Nations**

Korea is the Fatherland of Faith for the members of the Unification Church International throughout the world. We solemnly believe it is our sacred responsibility to safeguard our holy land from Communist aggression.

Therefore, we, the members of the Unification Church International, resolve that if the North Korean Communists should ever invade the Republic of Korea, we shall immediately organize a voluntary army of crusaders to preserve and defend our Holy Land.

## **World Rally For Korean Freedom Resolutions of the Convention June 7, 1975**

The communist take over of Indochina clearly demonstrates the intention of the Communists to dominate all of Asia.

The Republic of Korea is the primary front line against the advancing Communists, and the last stronghold of Asian defense in the free world. If Korea is invaded by the Communist forces, Asia will be plunged into a terrible crisis, facing the grave possibility of being totally taken over by communism.

In order to defeat the aims of the Communist aggressors, approximately one million Korean citizens together with 1,000 representatives from sixty free nations to the "World Rally for Korean Freedom", at the Yoido Parade Ground, in Seoul, Korea, adopt the following resolutions:

1) We consider Communism to be the enemy of God and all mankind. Therefore, we resolve to be the vanguards in the battle against Communism.

2) We resolve to repel and decisively defeat any armed attack by Communist North Korea against the Republic of Korea.

3) We resolve to support and positively cooperate with the government's efforts to achieve total national security.

4) We resolve to urge all free people of the world to wake up, unite, and rise up against the increasing threat of Communist aggression.

## **Message to the President of the Republic of Korea His Excellency, Park Chung Hee June 7, 1975**

Dear Mr. President:

We gratefully and sincerely praise the great accomplishments and outstanding leadership of our Honorable President Park Chung Hee. Not only have you inspired and directed the modernization of the Republic of Korea, and the progressive new community movement, but you have been bravely and steadfastly protecting the freedom of our Fatherland from the vicious threat and provocation by the infernal North Korean Communists.

We wish to express our deep respect to Your Excellency, for you have contributed substantially to the anticommunist movement, and have personally sacrificed more than any other leader, faithfully maintaining your firm opposition to Communism.

On this day, June 7, 1975, hundreds of thousands of freedom loving people from throughout this country will join with 1,000 delegates from 60 nations of the Unification Church International in the "World Rally for Korean Freedom." We are writing to Your Excellency to convey the purpose of this historic event.

World Communism has been steadily advancing, having determined to extinguish the flame of freedom for mankind, to undermine the peace of the world, and to usurp human rights. Beginning in Russia sixty years ago, the Communists have since followed a ruthless policy of advancing aggression and dictatorship. In their relentless campaign for world power they have engulfed the countries of Eastern Europe and have thoroughly communized mainland China.

Recently they have used force to take over countries in Indochina. Through these hostile actions, they have openly reaffirmed their goal of world conquest and their commitment to using armed aggression, justifying any means to achieve their aims.

Your Excellency knows perhaps better than any other leader that when the Communists use such words as "democracy," "our Fatherland," and "the people," in their propaganda, this is merely part of their camouflaged rhetoric intended to mislead and confuse their enemies. And when they speak of "peace," "humanity," and "justice," these are the deceptive catch-words they use to strengthen their self-justification and to quiet the fears of their intended victims.

We believe that Your Excellency well understands that any peace negotiations or armistice agreements offered by the Communist leaders have proven to be mere chicanery, an attempt to buy time to prepare for another escalation of conflict and invasion.

As we analyze the forces surrounding the Korean peninsula, it is clear that we are in a dangerous and difficult position.

To the north, with the support of the Soviets behind him, Kim Il Sung has been seeking the opportune moment to invade the Republic of Korea. From the west, the cunning and powerful Mao Tse Tsung, the perpetrator of the Korean War, is keeping his keen eye on this nation. And in the east, the so-called "Korean Peoples League," faithful footmen to Kim Il Sung, have been constructing insidious plots against us.

The Korean peninsula is the last stronghold of the free world in Asia, the last opportunity to protect freedom of religion and the peace of free society.

If through some tragedy our Republic of Korea ever fell into the hands of the merciless Communists, the free world would be in danger of losing all of Asia. All the world would be quickly plunged into hopelessness and despair. To restore freedom, peace, and human rights at that point would necessitate a long and bitter fight in which the blood of countless innocent men, women, and children would be shed.

Your Excellency, this nation and this world is now facing a most profound crisis. And on this day we are gathering in Seoul to appeal for a general unity among the people of Korea, calling for all freedom-loving people to rise up in the cause of this nation's security and independence. We are uniting in our pledge to fight with our lives to defend and protect this country.

We are confident that this is God's will and providence. Preserving Korea from Communist encroachment is the mission and responsibility not only of the Korean people, but of all free people and nations throughout the world.

We pray that Your Excellency will arm the Korean people with the power of the Victory Over Communism ideology, and that you will strengthen the defense capability of the Republic of Korea so that we can be powerful enough to defeat the North Korean Communists ourselves, thus ensuring our nation's security.

It is our sincerest hope that our great President, who has underta-

ken the mission to protect freedom, will always enjoy the best of health, that you will defend this land and our people to the last, and that you will be able to achieve the peaceful reunification of our Fatherland at the earliest possible time.

## **Message to the President of the United States of America Adopted by the World Rally for Korean Freedom**

Dear Mr. President:

The tragic surrender of Cambodia and South Vietnam to the Communist aggressors was both shocking and painful to all Christians and free people throughout the world. These events have made us realize that the danger to Korea has not only increased, but that the likelihood of a Communist attack against the Republic of Korea is greater than ever before. It is quite possible that the Republic of Korea will be the next target of Communist aggression in Asia.

Today, safeguarding Korea's freedom is not only the task of the determined people of Korea alone, but it is the responsibility of all Christians, free people, and free nations all over the world. It is clear that the preservation of Korea's freedom and the strengthening of her security is directly related to the preservation of freedom and security of the entire free world, and, needless to say, to that of the United States.

For this reason, representatives from 60 nations of the Unification Church International are holding the World Rally for Korean Freedom on this day, June 7, 1975, in Seoul, Korea. With hundreds of thousands of Korean people taking part in this historical rally at the Yoido Parade Ground, while millions more join us through radio and television broadcasts, we are now demonstrating our conviction and determination to stop any form of Communist aggression from North Korea.

Through this World Rally, in the name of Christians and free people around the world, we wholeheartedly adopt the following petition for you and the United States of America to

endorse and enforce in order to safeguard Korea's freedom.

1) We at the World Rally for Korean Freedom petition you to pledge that any attack by North Korea against the Republic of Korea will be considered equivalent to an attack against the United States of America, and that the United States will react as if directly attacked, retaliating with the intention of destroying the power of the aggressors.

2) We at the World Rally for Korean Freedom petition you to pledge that a strong contingent of United States Armed Forces will remain stationed in South Korea as long as there is a threat of Communist aggression in this part of the world.

3) We at the World Rally for Korean Freedom petition you to pledge that the United States will give its wholehearted support in strengthening and modernizing the Armed Forces of the Republic of Korea, so that the Korean people can further develop the military strength to defend their homeland.

### Message to the Secretary-General of the United Nations: June 7, 1975

Your Excellency,

As we face the recent tragic events in Indochina, where two more nations have succumbed to the relentless aggression of Communist forces, and as we recognize the likelihood of further aggression by the North Korean Communists who have been inspired by the recent Communist victories, it is clear that these are signs of a crisis limited not only to Asia, but represent a worldwide emergency that poses a grave threat to the peace and freedom of all humanity.

The United Nations is the supreme world political council. Its Charter clearly states its commitment is "to prevent the third world war which could destroy all mankind and the whole world with its dreadful destruction; to recognize the basic human rights and equality of all independent nations; and to establish the righteous order."

However, at this very moment in Cambodia and Vietnam a ruthless slaughter is being conducted, human rights are being trampled down, and peace and freedom are being obliterated.



The Communist partisans, impudently mocking the ideals of the United Nations, have abandoned their conscience. They easily renounce international treaties, dropping the pretense of peace policies to enforce their sinister desires. They have exploited the sacred forum of the United Nations to air their propaganda and rhetoric, making an obvious effort to expand the Communist bloc.

And now it is clear that the Communists are moving in the direction of an invasion into the Korean peninsula. Kim Il Sung, who has rejected the free-world goals of peaceful co-existence and humanitarianism, and has refused to engage in meaningful negotiations, is now making every preparation to re-enact the dreadful tragedy and destruction of the Korean War of 25 years ago, which killed four million Korean citizens.

In recent months, North Korea has infiltrated Communist guerrillas into the south, slain numerous innocent people, and assassinated the First Lady of Korea, Mrs. Yook Young Soo. They have committed hostile acts of piracy on the sea and in the air, and have constructed tunnels capable of moving troops across the demilitarized zone. It is clear that they are making determined efforts to provoke an all-out war.

Your Excellency, the Korean peninsula is known as the "powder keg" of the Far East. This means

that a war in Korea would not be merely a war between the north and the south, but could quickly be escalated to plunge the world into a horrible nuclear war, bringing destruction to all mankind. Korea is clearly the face-off point for the two worlds of Democracy and Communism.

It is our holy responsibility to prevent this impending disaster. The Korean People and the United Nations together must form a united front-line against the Communist menace.

In response to this urgent situation, on June 7 hundreds of thousands of freedom-loving Korean people will join with delegates from 60 nations of the free world in Seoul, Korea, to hold the "World Rally for Korean Freedom."

While we are demonstrating our serious determination to repel and defeat any kind of aggression by the North Korean Communists, we are also urgently seeking the positive support of the United Nations in the following ways:

First, we implore you to take appropriate action to force North Korea's Kim Il Sung and his regime to immediately cease their efforts to provoke a war against the south, which could lead to the destruction of all mankind.

Second, in the event that in spite of this warning the Communists perpetrate another war, we urge you to immediately commit Un-

ited Nations troops to the scene of the conflict to retaliate against the enemy force.

Third, we ask that you will convey our conviction and resolution to all member nations of the United Nations.

We pray that you will actively cooperate with this effort, so that we may achieve an historical victory over Communism here in the Korean peninsula, making Korea the exemplary stronghold for the protection of freedom.

### World Rally for Korean Freedom A Warning to Kim Il Sung June 7, 1975

In the name of the members of the Unification Church International in 60 nations throughout the world, and the 35 million patriotic citizens of the Republic of Korea, we are issuing the following warning to Kim Il Sung, murderer and betrayer of the people, who has been devoted to war and slaughter and has acted to destroy the dignity of human life and the peace of the world.

1) Kim Il Sung, we solemnly warn you that if you miscalculate the fall of Vietnam and Cambodia as signals of the opportune moment for a Communist invasion against the Republic of Korea, and you attempt to satiate your self-proclaimed desire to wage a ruthless offensive against the south, then on the very day you initiate such a war you will ensure your own defeat and destruction. We therefore urge you to abandon your fanatic desire to attack the Republic of Korea.

2) Kim Il Sung, in the name of our Heavenly Father, we remind you that the force of religion is more powerful than the mightiest military or ideological armaments. We warn you that if you do not cease in your opposition to God's will, you can not maintain your own life.

3) Kim Il Sung, Satan's slave, before your reign of terror comes to a horrible end, kneel down and confess your sinister war crimes. Then liberate the twenty million North Korean people from your life-smothering Communist dictatorship.

4) Kim Il Sung, we warn you that if and when you provoke an unjust war against the south on that very day 35 million patriotic Koreans and Unification Church members all over the world, united into a oneness stronger than steel, will fight with their lives to bring your evil power to an end.
