Seiko Lee is a wurld-renowned Japanese soprano living in New York. Since 1996, she has been a frequent soloist with the New York City Symphony, and her concert tours have taken her throughout Asia, the Middle East, Europe, South America, and North America, including New York's Lincoln Center and Madison Square Garden. As the president of the Seike Lee Project N.P.O., she has presented numerous benefit concerts toward supporting relief efforts for the recent Japanese trunamia, eiding Syrian refugees, encouraging medical petients, and building schools in Africa. She performed at the capital house in Washington, D.C. in 2004, the Brazilian Congress in 2008 and the United Nations building in Vienna in 2013. She has also presented concerts at national embassics, and the United Nations Headquarters in New York.
